Summary:

On 6-1-2013, at about 2015 hr., officers responded to 1339 W. Central reference [REDACTED] #14 threatening suicide with a gun. Officers contained the scene and evacuated [REDACTED] #14 #4b his father, Ralph E. Jacobson [REDACTED] #4b from the residence. On duty SWAT officers responded to the location. While Officers were responding, 911 was in contact with [REDACTED] #14. 911 advised [REDACTED] #14 was crying, intoxicated, and he was going to point a gun at officers so he could be shot.

Officer D. Lesser set up a perimeter around the residence and the SWAT Bear Cat responded. John Every, from the hostage negotiation team, responded and communications were set up with [REDACTED] #14. A standoff ensued.

Ralph E. Jacobson (Father) informed officers his son had been a corrections officer for the Walla Walla State Penitentiary and was recently fired from his job for drinking. He had numerous guns in the residence, but he removed them about a month ago due to his drinking. Ralph E. Jacobson stated he saw his son walk by him with a pump pellet gun and go into the garage. [REDACTED] #14 had been drinking.

Officer Every made phone contact with [REDACTED] #14 at 2058 hr. [REDACTED] #14 stated the following during the negotiations: He wanted Law Enforcement to shoot him. He was armed with a .38 caliber pistol that was loaded. He was a guard at Walla Walla State Penitentiary for 27 years and he was fired in January because he was an alcoholic. He said he was going to make police shoot him. Officer K. Gately took over negotiations with [REDACTED] #14 at 2201 hours. During this time [REDACTED] #14 continued telling negotiators he had a gun, he wanted to die, he would point the gun at officers, and he would fight. At 2213 hr., [REDACTED] #14 terminated phone contact with hostage negotiators.

At 2224 hr., announcements began from the SWAT Bear Cat located in front of the residence. [REDACTED] #14 then began talking with SWAT officers and making statements that he was armed with a gun, he was going to exit the residence, and he wanted officers to shoot him.

At about 2252, [REDACTED] #14 opened up the garage door and began exiting the garage. He told officers "Kill me. Just kill me." [REDACTED] #14 was holding his right hand down by his side, partially behind his leg. Officers observed a black handgun in his right hand. Officers gave verbal commands to [REDACTED] #14 to put his hand up; however, he did not comply. Officer Howe, Officer Wheeler and Officer Buchmann then used force for the following reasons: Crime: Although [REDACTED] #14 had not committed a crime as of this time, there was community care taking function that required an emergent detention of the subject because there was an imminent likelihood of serious harm to himself or others. By [REDACTED] #14 calling police and stating he was going to point a gun at police, he presented an imminent threat to others, especially Law Enforcement Officers.

Threat Factors: [REDACTED] #14 stated he was armed with a gun, he was seen by a witness with a gun, and he made threats to police he was going to point a gun at police. Negotiators talked with him for 2 ½ hours and could not convince him to surrender. He had Law Enforcement training as a corrections officer. He exited the garage with a gun in hand and he told police to shoot him.

Resistance: [REDACTED] #14 was armed with a gun and officers gave verbal commands to Mr. [REDACTED] #14 to show them his hands and get on the ground. [REDACTED] #14 refused to comply with officer commands. He stated to officers, "Kill me. Just kill me."

Officer Wheeler deployed a Noise Flash Diversion Device (NFDD) and Officer Howe deployed two 40 mm exact impact foam tipped Specialty Impact Munitions (SIM). [REDACTED] #14 fell to the ground. Once [REDACTED] #14 was on the ground officers approached and gave commands to him to put his hands out. He continued to ignore commands. Officers did not know if [REDACTED] #14 had any other weapons on his person. Officer Buchmann approached [REDACTED] #14 and pinned his elbow to the ground to control him. He and other officers were then able to take him into custody. [REDACTED] #14 was transported to Sacred Heart Hospital for a mental evaluation. [REDACTED] #14 was struck by one 40 mm, exact impact foam tipped Specialty Impact Munitions

(SIM) round. From this #14 suffered a small laceration to his upper left buttock/lower back.

Officer Howe, Officer Wheeler and Officer Buchmann's actions were objectively reasonable and within departmental guidelines and training.

Reviewer comment:

#14 stated his intent to force a fatal confrontation between himself and the police. He said he had a gun and was going to point it at a police officer and expected to be shot. #14 exited the house with a black handgun in his hand partially behind his leg. Officers told #14 to put his hands up, but he did not comply. Based on a predetermined plan of action, officers deployed a Noise Flash Diversion Device (NFDD) followed by two 40 mm SIM rounds. The NFDD and the first 40 MM SIM round appeared to have some effect as #14 turned his body but did not yet drop the gun or comply with the officers' commands. A second SIM round was fired, and #14 fell down. This second round did not actually strike #14. Officers approached Jacobson who was still not complying with their commands. Ofc. Buchmann saw #14 hands were empty and pinned his right arm down to the ground with his foot until he was handcuffed.

The predetermined plan by the officers worked very well - very quickly. #14 was fortunate that it did work and that he did not raise his weapon toward the officers, or this could have easily become the fatal confrontation he asked for.

The force used by the officers was definitely reasonable, necessary and within Department Policy.

On 06-01-13 at about 2017 hours, I responded to 1339 W. Central Ave. for a suicidal subject. Heidi Taylor called to advise that she just spoke to her uncle, #14 and he said that he was suicidal and had a gun. #14 father was also in the home with him.

Upon arrival, Officers established a perimeter. Other Officers advised that they observed a male in the front window. After a short time, #14 father came out of the hospital and was contacted by Officers. Information was relayed that #14 was only armed with a BB gun, but it was also reported that he was an avid gun collector and frequent shooter.

Radio advised that they had phone contact with #14 and that he sounded very intoxicated and volatile. He made repeated statements about being suicidal and numerous comments about pointing his gun at Officers so that he would be shot.

After a short time, the Bear Cat armored vehicle responded and parked in front of the residence. I went to that vehicle and maintained cover on the front of the residence as negotiators and dispatchers spoke with #14 in an attempt to get him to come out of the house peacefully.

During that time, I could hear repeated banging and noise coming from the attached garage of the home (where #14 told negotiators that he was). I could also hear yelling from time to time. Most of the yelling was muffled and unable to be understood. However, I did hear statements that "I want to die," "I will make you kill me" and other similar statements.

The command post eventually advised that #14 was very uncooperative and refused to answer the phone any longer. We began making announcements from the PA system in front of the address, requesting #14 come out of the house. After a few minutes, the garage door opened slightly, but closed quickly. There was more banging and after a few minutes, the garage door opened completely.

A plan had been previously developed to deploy a Noise Flash Diversionary Device (NFDD) and blunt impact munitions if #14 came out of the house and was armed, but not pointing the gun at anyone.

My view of the garage was partially blocked by a pickup parked in the driveway, but I observed #14 emerge from the garage, defying commands to put his hands up. His right hand was down to his side, partially behind his right leg. I observed a black handgun in his right hand. When he got to the garage door, the NFDD and blunt impact munitions were deployed and #14 went to the ground. I approached #14 along with other Officers and as I approached, I could see #14 hands were clear. He was laying at the back right corner of a car in the small garage, partially under the car.

As I approached, #14 began moving towards the underside of the car. I had not seen where the gun went and did not know if it had fallen behind him, under the car. When we got to #14 he continued to ignore commands to lay on his stomach with his hands out. Due to the very tight area, I was not able to use normal techniques to control #14 hands to keep him from accessing any weapons. Once I got to him, I placed my foot on his right elbow, pinning his arm to the ground, and grabbed his left hand. He was immediately tense and resistive. I had other Officers pull #14 feet to pull him out from under the car. As we did this, he resisted even more, trying to pull his hands away from me. I was standing over #14 with him laying on his back, slightly to his right side. Fearing that #14 was attempting to access a weapon, I lowered my body weight onto #14 stomach area, attempting to distract him from reaching out. As I did this, he relaxed his arms and we were able to roll him over and handcuff him. He was searched and no other weapons were located.

Medics were immediately called up to check on #14 and transport him to the hospital for evaluation.

I observed a realistic black metal gun (which turned out to be a BB gun) on the ground near where #14 had been standing.

Photographs were taken and #14 was transported to Sacred Heart by ambulance.

Caution should be used on future contacts with #14 as he is extremely suicidal and unstable. A PIN was added for the residence.

On the listed date and time I responded to the area of Central and Adams to assist other officers with a suicidal male with a gun. I am one of the department's Hostage Negotiators and I responded in that capacity.

Upon my arrival I briefly spoke with Sgt. Kannberg who told me the following there was a suicidal male in the garage at 1339 W. Central. I reviewed the CAD call and found out the male was identified as #14 and he was claiming to have a gun. I also learned #14 had been a prison guard for 27 years and lost his job due to his alcoholism. I learned Radio was talking with #14. I requested they transfer their call to the cell phone in Sgt. Kannberg's vehicle. At 2058 hours I reached #14 on his cell phone.

I identified myself to him and explained to him I wanted to help him through this issue. He was very adamant about wanting to die. He told me several times he wanted Law Enforcement to shoot him. He told me he was armed with a .38 caliber pistol that was loaded. He said he didn't want to hurt any police officers, but would point his gun at them, and fire his gun to get them to shoot him. He asked not to be shot in the head and warned me against trying to enter his garage. #14 told me he was a guard at the Walla Walla State Penitentiary for 27 years and was fired in January because he was an alcoholic. He told me his two children didn't have anything to do with him, and he was a failure to his father. #14 said he had nothing to live for and wanted to end it. I tried several different themes to convince him his life was worth living, but #14 was steadfast in his decision to have law enforcement shoot him. While I spoke with him he would spiral through mood swings that ranged from telling me he loved me and apologizing to being angry and warning me not to come into his garage. He continually called himself a piece of shit. #14 said he had written notes to his kids and wanted me to tell them he loved them.

During our conversation the call was dropped twice. Each time I got #14 back on the phone his plan was still the same. I explained that he wouldn't be going to jail, rather he would go to Sacred Heart. He told me he had already done that and it didn't work. During the entire time I spoke to #14 he never told me he was going to shoot himself, he always said he was going to make the police do it.

Officer K. Gately took over negotiations at 2201 hours. Officer Blessing was in the car with me and

On 06-01-13 (about 2015 hrs), I was dispatched with several other officers to 1339 W. Central, Spokane, WA, on a call of a suicidal male (id'd as **#14**)

The complainant (id'd as Heidi Taylor), called to report that her uncle **#14** was armed with a gun and with threatening suicide. She feared that her uncle **#14** may harm her 85 yr old grandfather who was also in the house. **#14** was highly intoxicated and was thought to have taken numerous pills.

A few minutes later, radio received a call from **#14** and he advised radio that he was in fact suicidal and was armed with a gun. He said to them that he was going to kill himself.

#14 advised radio that when officers arrive he will point the gun at them to get them to kill him. We learned that **#14** was a 27 year veteran at the Walla Walla Federal Prison. Family members advised that he was an ex-firearms instructor and a sniper for the prison. He also claimed to be on their "SWAT/SIRT team".

Upon arrival, I took a perimeter position to the West of the house, while we waited for more equipment and personnel to arrive on scene, to include less lethal munitions, armor, and negotiators.

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As we waited for personnel and equipment to arrive, the 85 yr old grandfather came out of the house. He confirmed that the only person left in the house was #14. He advised that #14 did have a gun in his hands, when he left the house, but said it was a pellet gun. He advised that a few months ago, he took all the guns that were in the house, down to a family member.

At about 2041 hrs, the bearcat arrived. I was assigned a 40 mm less lethal gun, which shoots a 40 mm, exact impact foam tipped Specialty Impact Munition (SIM), the round is also known as a "Blue nose", as it is made of blue foam.

As negotiations were going on, myself and several other officers, observed #14 show himself in the front living room window. He was holding what appeared to be a black semi auto pistol in his hand.

As negotiations were going on, information was relayed to us via radio. A neighbor reported that #14 has several guns and the neighbor has gone shooting with #14 recently and knows him to have several guns. This contradicted the information that the grandfather had just relayed to us that there were no "real" guns in the house.

As the negotiators continued talking to #14 We could hear him inside the garage. He was saying things like, he "just wants to fucking die", "is tired of living", that he will "point the gun at the police, so they have to shoot him."

Multiple times during the negotiations, #14 hung up the phone. They advised that #14 was at times ramping up then he was calming down. He was up and down numerous times. Negotiations continued for several hours.

At about 2215 hrs. Ofc. Brasch was able to get verbal communication with #14 via the PA. I could hear #14 say several times that he "is coming out with a gun and we are going to have to shoot him", "he is going to die". "YOU'RE GOING TO HAVE TO KILL ME WHEN I COME OUT. I'VE GOT A GUN, SHOOT ME."

By this time, we had made a tactical plan. My job in the plan was to deploy the 40 mm, less lethal, exact impact round, as other officers deployed NFDD's (flashbangs) if/when #14 came out with a gun and did not obey commands from the police.

At about 2252 hrs, #14 began to open the garage door. When the door opened, I could see #14 standing up in the doorway with his right hand placed behind his back. I could hear several clear, loud, concise, commands for #14 to show his hands and to get onto the ground.

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He refused to comply and instead did the complete opposite. He pulled his right hand out from behind his back, exposing a black hand gun. He then began turning the gun toward us, as he did this, I fired a 40 mm exact impact (SIM), at him, striking him, near the left hip area. An NFDD was also deployed at this time. The round appeared to work, and he turned away from the impact area, alerting me that the round hit and was effecting him. However he still did not drop the gun or obey commands to get on the ground.

He then took a step or two to his right (toward the East), still holding the gun in his right hand. He had plenty of time to drop the gun but did not. I feared he was again going to try and aim the gun at us, placing us in grave danger, so I fired another SIM round.

After firing the 2nd round, he fell down backward onto his back, into the garage door way. We then moved forward and detained him in handcuffs (dl).

I saw the gun on the ground next to him. The gun turned out to be a pellet gun but appeared to be very real looking.

My shots were measured to be taken at 54 feet away. The scene was photographed and the gun was taken as evidence. I collected the Exact Impact foam tips and placed them onto police property.

On the listed date and time I responded to 1339 W. Central in reference to a suicidal male, #14. He was reportedly armed with a handgun and barricaded himself inside the home. Upon arrival several Officer's were on scene. I responded to the front of the home inside the Bearcat. Officer D. Lesser devised a tactical plan that included the use of a NFDD and exact impact munition. After approx an hour and a half of negotiations #14 opened the garage door. He had his right had behind his back and was yelling at us. He was saying something similar to "Kill me just Kill me."

At this time Officer Wheeler deployed a NFDD and Officer Howe deployed the exact impact munition. I was on a ballistic shield and moved up to #14 after he fell to the ground and dropped a gun that he was holding in his right hand. I pinned #14 to the ground with the shield. #14 fell into a very tight area between a vehicle and wall inside the garage. We were able to get him into custody with out further incident.

The black handgun he had was actually a realistic looking bb gun.

On 060113 at approx. 2021 hours, Ofc. Daniel and I (two-man unit) were dispatched to assist officers with a possible suicidal male at 1339 W. Central and the males elderly father was still in the house.

Upon arrival, Ofc. Daniel and I saw a male matching the description of the suicidal male standing near a large picture window talking on a telephone. We had the house surrounded in just a few minutes. Eventually our BearCat (armored vehicle) arrived on scene and was positioned in front of the residence. I then joined up with some other SWAT operator's at the BearCat. We quickly put together a multi-force option plan that was approved by Sgt. Kannberg.

At approx. 2252 hours verbal announcements were being made from the BearCat when the suicidal male opened the garage door. The male refused to follow our instructions and appeared to be holding something behind his back. The information we had continued to receive was the male was armed with a handgun or possibly a BB gun. When the male refused to follow our instructions, Ofc. D. Lesser advised me to deploy a NFDD. I deployed the NFDD near the male and then Ofc. Howe deployed a blunt impact munition device. The male immediately went to the ground and was taken into custody without incident.
