#### **Summary:**

Ofc. Kellee Gately and Cpl. Ray Harding responded to a suspicious person call at 1900 W. Nora. There was a female pushing a lawn mower down the road. When she saw the complainant watching her she ran and hid in a tree and then under a deck.

Ofc. Gately arrived onscene and confronted the suspect. She immediately jumped out from under the deck and ran aggressively directly at Ofc. Gately. She had the opportunity to run multiple directions, but chose to run at Ofc. Gately. Ofc. Gately used her OC spray and sprayed it at the suspects face. This caused the suspect to change directions and run towards the alley.

Cpl. Harding was waiting in the alley and took the suspect into custody.

SFD was called and they brought water and rinsed off the suspects face.

I spoke with the suspect and she did not complain of any injuries other than the burning sensation from the OC spray.

This use of force was reasonable and within policy.

Reviewer comment:

The use of force in this arrest was within Policy and Procedure guidelines. The arrestee was told she was under arrest and did not comply with Ofc. K. Gately's commands to get down on the ground, instead she charged Ofc. Gately and was pepper sprayed. She ran away after being sprayed and was taken to the ground by Cpl. Harding after crashing through a gate and was handcuffed with the assistance of Ofc. Coleman. The arrestee was arrested for Obstructing, Poss. of Stolen Property, Resisting Arrest, and Criminal Trespass-2.

Ofc. K. Gately was in compliance with Policy and Procedure when she used the force of pepper spray on the arrestee. The arrestee was advised she was under arrest and she refused to comply with Ofc. K. Gately's commands. The arrestee charged Ofc. K. Kately and was pepper sprayed. The arrestee ran after being sprayed and was taken into custody by Cpl. Harding and Ofc. Coleman after crashing through a backyard gate. The force used by Cpl. Harding and Ofc. Coleman was proper and necessary to take this resistive subject into lawful custody.

Reviewer comment:

Officer K. Gately was responding to a suspicious person call and confronted the suspect who was hiding. Instead of compying, the suspect ran toward Officer Gately. Officer Gately interpreted this as a possible attack on her person by the suspect as Officer Gately was in full uniform of the day. If the suspect's sole intent was to escape, she could have fled in a number of other directions but chose to run toward Officer Gately. The use of OC10 is authorized at the Active Resistance level. The suspect's actions could be viewed as Assaultive behavior but Officer Gately used only that force necessary to keep the suspect from attacking her. The suspect continued to resist the other officers that contacted her in the alley. The use of force by Officer Gately was within policy.

Comp. Clawson saw her crawl under a large blue spruce tree and she kept with her a black plastic garbage sack full of something and a white and blue pedicure tub. I spoke with comp. when he said I know she is still there because I stayed and watched her in case she ran. The female then crawled out from under the tree and ran southbound into a in backyard. The yard was enclosed with a six foot white vinyl fence. I yelled for the female to stop but she did not. The female had dark hair but her entire head was shaved. She appeared slight of build and approx. 502 inches tall.

The Homeowner came to the back door and told me she saw the female run past her window and turn left. Sheena Enslow told me the female was still in the yard and there was no way she could get over the eight foot wood fence in the back yard. The re was a small 3 ft. fence in front of a walk through gate that led into the backyard. This was an area the dog could not get out of and into the small garden.

I called out to the female and advised her she was under arrest for obstructing and to come out from underneath the porch. I was waiting for another officer to take the female into custody when I saw her crawling out from under a step underneath the porch. I advised the female to stay on the ground. The female def. On 071713 I assisted Officer K Gately at Nora and Cannon reference a female that had been pushing a lawn mower down the street and ran from the compl when he asked her what she was doing. 
