He was reportedly armed with a knife, and he ignored all warnings and commands. Officer D. Lesser deployed K9 Rav. Rav made minor contacts, allowing the suspect to be handcuffed. The suspect was treated at Deaconess and then booked into jail for City Assault-DV and Obstruction.

### INCIDENT DESCRIPTION:

<b>Type of Application:</b> Suspect Apprehension
<p><b>Original Call:</b> On 7/30/2013 at about 0041 hours Ofc Lesser responded to 20 W. Houston, the Royal Scott Motel, in reference to a report of an assault. The complainant said that the suspect (Cook) was hitting a female and that he was armed with a knife but that it was not in use. The complainant also said that the female is trying to get away and that the suspect will not let her out of a Chevy Tahoe vehicle. The complainant said to get someone there now and radio could hear lots of yelling in the background. The phone was then disconnected.</p>
<p><b>Suspect Actions:</b> Ofc Hamilton contacted the suspect in the Lowe's Parking lot across the street and the suspect fled on foot.</p>
<b>Est. Time &amp; Distance of Contact (if known):</b> Less than 5 seconds, approx. 50 yards
<p><b>Officer Safety Concerns/ Why was Canine used:</b> Ofc Lesser decided to deploy K-9 Rav, for the following reasons; The suspect was suspected of assaulting at least one female and there was probable cause to arrest the suspect for Obstructing. It was unknown to what extent of the crimes he may have committed at the Royal Scott Motel. The suspect was armed with a knife stated by the original complainant and he had not been searched. The suspect was actively evading and resisting arrest by fleeing and he had refused all verbal commands and K-9 warnings given by Officer Hamilton and Officer Lesser.</p>

**K-9 Supervisor Comments:**

Officer Lesser responded to assist with an assault of a female call. The suspect (Cook) was armed with a knife but was not using it during the assault. Officer Hamilton also responded and located the suspect. Officer Hamilton had contact with the suspect but the suspect fled on foot. The suspect ran towards Officer Lesser as he was arriving in the area. As the suspect ran past Officer Lesser, Officer Lesser made eye contact and yelled a K-9 announcement. The suspect refused to stop. Officer Lesser deployed K-9 Rav to apprehend the suspect. K-9 Rav chased and apprehended the suspect by contact in the upper buttocks/hip area. Officer Lesser released K-9 Rav when it was safe to do so and back up Officers took the suspect into custody. The injuries were consistent with a fleeing suspect.

On 07/30/2013 at 0041 hours Officer Harvey and I responded to the Royal Scot Motel located at 20 W. Houston on report of an assault. The female complainant stated she could see a male hitting a female who was trying to get away. She described the male as being a B/M in his 30's, wearing a red hat, white shirt, and blue jeans. She said the male wouldn't let the female out of a brown Chevy Tahoe. She also stated that the male had a knife, but that he was not using it.

Upon arrival I made contact with victim Detra M. Burns who told me the following: She has been staying at the Royal Scot Motel and on todays date at approximately 0030 hours, she was in her room (#26) with arrestee Antonio E. Cook Jr. 9AKA J-Rock) She told me that she has been friends with him since she was 13 years old, but that she has never been in a significant relationship with him ever. She said that Antonio had the keys to her Chevy Tahoe and she asked him to give them to her so she could go down and roll up her windows. Antonio "freaked out" when she asked for her car keys. She said they got into a verbal argument because he kept refusing to give her car keys to her.

She went down and got inside of her vehicle and Antonio followed her. As she was inside of her vehicle, her driver's side door was cracked open and Antonio pushed his way into the doorway of

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her vehicle. Antonio yelled at her "No bitch! You aint leavin me out here stuck! Detra told him "Give me my keys I want to lock it up!" At this time Antonio reached into the car and hit her in her jaw causing her pain. She said she put her foot up in a defensive move to protect her from getting further assaulted by Antonio. She said at this time there were other motel tenants who helped get Antonio away from her.

I observed slight swelling to the left side of Detra's jaw. She told me that she felt pressure on both sides of her jaw and she could not fully close her jaw either. At one point she told me she thought that Antonio had broken her jaw.

Cpl. Cordis responded for photos of the injury. Detra told me she definitely wants to press charges against Antonio for assaulting her. Officer D. Lesser took Antonio into custody nearby in the Lowe's parking lot. Antonio was transported to Deaconess hospital for treatment of a K-9 bite which he sustained after running away from law enforcement. See Officer Lesser's report for details.

On 7/0/2013 at about 0041 hours I responded to 20 W. Houston, Royal Scott Motel, reference a report of an assault.

The comp stated that the suspect was hitting a female and that he was armed with a knife but that it was not in use. The comp also stated that the female is trying to get away and the suspect will not let her out of the Chevy Tahoe. The comp said to get someone there now and radio could hear lots of yelling in the background. The phone was then disconnected.

As I pulled into the parking lot of the Royal Scott Motel I heard Ofc Hamilton check out with the suspect in the Lowe's parking lot which was across the street. I got back into my car and as I drove north on Division I heard Ofc Hamilton advise that he was in foot pursuit and the suspect was running west bound right towards me.

I was driving vehicle 509, which is fully marked, and was in uniform. On both sides of my patrol vehicle it has "K9" posted on the front quarter panel and just behind the passenger door. It also has "Police K9" on the trunk. I was just reaching the intersection of Lyons and Division when Ofc Hamilton advised the suspect was running. I flipped a u-turn in the intersection and was now facing southbound right next to the turn lane. I saw the suspect running right at me. As I was exiting my patrol car the suspect looked right at me as he ran past me. I yelled at the suspect "Police Stop or my dog will bite you" multiple times. The suspect refused to stop and ran west bound across Division.

I decided to deploy my K9, Rav, for the following reasons. The suspect was suspected of assaulting at least one female. It was unknown to what extent of the crimes he may have committed at the Royal Scott Motel. The suspect was armed with a knife stated by the original complainant and he had not been searched. The suspect was actively evading / resisting arrest by fleeing and had refused all verbal commands given by Ofc Hamilton to stop along with my K9 warnings.

I opened the back door of my patrol vehicle and deployed Rav to apprehend the suspect. Rav caught up to the suspect in the gravel lot just to the west of Car Toys (nw corner of Lyons and Division) and contacted him on the left upper buttocks and hip area causing him to fall to the ground. As soon as I could see the suspects hands were clear I immediately had Rav release the contact and Ofc Reese took him into custody.

Ofc Hamilton arrived and asked if we had found the suspect's knife. Ofc Hamilton stated that when he had originally stopped the suspect had slammed his knife down on the hood of his patrol car when Ofc Hamilton asked him to put his hands on his car. When the suspect fled Ofc Hamilton said he grabbed the knife along with a cell phone.

Ofc Reese transported the suspect to Deaconess. The suspect's injuries consisted of several



