Summary:

Ofc. Spiering and Ofc. Lewis were working a two person patrol vehicle. They ran a license plate on a Honda Accord. The Honda showed to be a stolen vehicle. The vehicle pulled into the McDonald's drive- thru at 1818 N. Monroe.

Ofc. Spiering saw that the vehicle was stuck in the drive-thru as another vehicle was stopped in front of the stolen car. Ofc. Spiering pulled behind the stolen vehicle and activated his lights. Ofc. Spiering exited his car, drew his firearm to the low ready, and started giving verbal commands to the driver.

Ofc. Spiering said that he could see the driver's hands initially. The driver was the sole occupant of the vehicle. Ofc. Spiering yelled for the driver to get his "hands up." Immediately the driver moved his hands down and to the right. The movement was so quick that his upper body leaned over to the right as well. This is not a normal reaction from someone who just had a police officer tell him to put his hands up. The action by this driver could easily be construed as attempting to arm himself with a weapon. Ofc. Spiering moved his firearm up and pointed it through the back window of the stolen car towards the driver while he continued to give verbal commands.

Ofc. Spiering estimated that it took approximately 5 seconds for the driver to sit back up and bring his hands into view. Once Ofc. Spiering was able to see that the driver did not have any weapons, he moved his firearm back to the low ready position. The male, Aaron J Hall, was taken into custody. A search of the passenger compartment area, that Hall had reached towards, revealed a small amount of marijuana and money.

He was later booked for possession of a stolen motor vehicle, and had two warrants for his arrest (possession of a controlled substance and city theft).

Ofc. Lewis was on the passenger side of the patrol vehicle and said he did not see the pointing of the firearm by Ofc. Spiering.

Ofc. Spiering's actions were within policy and procedure, and he only resorted to force after Hall displayed furtive movements inside of the vehicle.

Reviewer comment:

Based on the suspect's actions and suspicious movements that, to an experienced law enforcement officer, would lead him/her to believe that the individual might be accessing a weapon, Officer Spiering's response of pointing his weapon at the suspect was reasonable and within policy. Once Officer Spiering determined that the suspect was not armed and that he was complying with his orders, he properly lowered his weapon to the low ready position. Officer Spiering's actions and decision making was reasonable considering the circumstances.





On 10/02/2013 at about 0935 hours, I was patrolling the area of Lincoln/Indiana with Ofc. Lewis. There have been numerous Honda Accords and Civic's stolen, especially recently, and I was aware of several on the current stolen vehicle sheet including a green Honda Accord.

I saw a green Honda Accord, WA license #551WKE, pull up to Indiana from S/B Lincoln. The vehicle was being driven by a W/M and appeared to have no one else in it. Ofc. Lewis checked the license plate of that vehicle, and verified it was currently reported as Stolen. I saw that vehicle cross-Indiana, and turn into the McDonald's parking lot at 1818 N. Monroe.

I turned around and got behind that vehicle, which was occupied by only the male driver. The vehicle was in one of the drive through ordering lanes at McDonald's, with another citizen vehicle in front of it. I chose to box that vehicle in at that location, rather than risk the driver having room to maneuver that vehicle back out into traffic.

I pulled up right behind that Honda, and as I did so I could see the driver looking at me in the rear view mirror. The driver's hands were forward in what appeared to be a normal driving position.

I exited my patrol car, and drew my sidearm to the low-ready position. I was in full police uniform, and ordered the male to turn the car off. I then ordered the male to put his hands up, and almost immediately the male dropped his hands and dipped his body to the right, leaning towards the center of the vehicle and appeared to be reaching towards the passenger side floor.

That action was completely opposite of what I ordered the male to do. The male's driver door was not obstructed by anything, since the vehicle in front of him was at the ordering station and he was just waiting in line. The actions of the driver leaning to the right and low were obviously not an escape attempt either. The male driver was occupying a stolen motor vehicle, and facing a felony arrest. The vehicle was obviously capable of concealing numerous weapons, and there was a civilian in a vehicle directly in front of the stolen vehicle. I had parked extremely close to the stolen vehicle to prevent it from escaping and harming innocent motorists, and therefore had no safe option for cover while maintaining control of the male driver.

Based on the male's unprovoked actions, ability for hidden weapons, and proximity of civilians and officers I brought my firearm up from low-ready and pointed it directly at the male through the back window of the vehicle, still ordering him to put his hands up. I wanted to reduce my reaction time to keep myself and the citizen(s) around me, should the male present a weapon. I held my control in that position for about the 5 seconds it took for the male to bring his hands and upper body back upright, and produce his hands both visible and empty. I then returned my sidearm to the lowready position.

I ordered the male to open his door and show his hands out of the door, and he did so. I then holstered my sidearm while Ofc. Lewis remained covering from the passenger side of out car. I approached the male, and took left wristlock control of him. I had the male unbuckle his seat belt with his right hand, and then guided him slowly out of the car and onto the ground in the prone position. Ofc. Lewis assisted me in handcuffing (DL) the male. I advised the male that he had the right to legal counsel and the right to remain silent, and advised him that the vehicle was reported stolen. I advised the male that he was under arrest, and searched him in that prone position incident his arrest. while searching the male, I asked him if he had any weapons on him. The male replied no, and spontaneously stated "just some weed." I recovered a plastic baggy with green leafy substance which smelled like Marijuana, as well as a glass pipe with residue in the male's pants pockets.

I placed the male into my patrol car. Ofc. Lewis processed the vehicle, and located more green leafy substance on the front passenger side floor of the car. (See Ofc. Lewis' report.)

The male identified himself as Aaron Hall. A name check of Hall showed two unrelated warrants for his arrest, which records confirmed. I read Hall his Miranda Rights, which he understood saying "Yes I do sir," and waived saying, "yes," at 0943 hours.

I asked Hall how he came to have the vehicle, and he advised me the following:

He borrowed the car from a male he knows as "Jesse." He has known Jesse for about one year, but does not know him that well. That day, he was walking through the West Central neighborhood near the West Central Community center within the hour of Police contacting him. Jesse pulled up next to him in that vehicle, and offered him a ride. Jesse went to another residence that Hall did not know, and told Hall that he could borrow the car. Hall got into the driver seat, and drove away to go to McDonald's. Police then stopped him.

Hall said that the vehicle was running when Jesse arrived, and said that he never used the ignition or turned the vehicle off. Hall said that the keys to the car were in the ignition. Hall said that he did not notice what the keys were, or that they were shaved. He said he did not notice that the steering wheel of the vehicle was cut either.

Hall said that Jesse is an I/M, about 24 years old, and about 5'10" tall with a thin build. He said that Jesse does have cars, but has never let him borrow a car of his before. I asked Hall if he thought it was odd that Jesse let him borrow that car, and he said, "Kinda, yeah." Hall said that Jesse lives in West Central, within one block of "Bong's." He said that he has never been to Jesse's house, and could not point it out.

I recovered the keys from the ignition of the car, and saw that the key in the ignition had been shaved, and did not fit all the way in the ignition. There was only one other key on that ring, and it was a Toyota key. The steering wheel had been cut completely through the top portion of the wheel, and just holding onto the steering wheel I could feel it moving drastically.

Ofc. Lewis and I transported Hall to jail, where he was booked for Possession Stolen Motor vehicle, as well as the two warrants. Ofc. Lewis and I placed all items onto property.

On 100213 at 0935 hours I was riding with Ofc. Spiering in police vehicle #455. I was in full uniform. As we turned from W/B Indiana to S/B Lincoln I observed a white male driving a green Honda Accord stopped at a stop sign facing S/B on Lincoln at Indiana. The male appeared to be alone. I observed a Washington license of 551WKE being displayed on the front of the Honda. A stolen hit quickly returned on the vehicle license, showing a green Honda Accord as stolen. As this was happening the suspect had crossed Indiana and pulled into the McDonalds parking lot. He entered the drive-thru lane. Ofc. Spiering stopped directly behind the suspect in the drive-thru lane. Ofc. Spiering gave verbal commands to the suspect driver.

The suspect was identified as Aaron J. Hall.

According to the original stolen vehicle report the complainant advised that a search of the vehicle was authorized but towing was not. A search of the vehicle produced two small baggies of suspected marijuana, both found on the front passenger floorboard. Inside the car I discovered that the vehicle was started using a shaved Honda key. This key would not go all the way into the ignition but would start the vehicle. Also attached to the key ring was a shaved Toyota key. I also discovered that the steering wheel had been cut clean through.

Both license plates were still on the vehicle. Police radio attempted to contact the complainant but received no answer. A phone message was left.

The vehicle was left legally parked and locked in the parking lot of McDonalds, S/E corner of Monroe/Indiana.

Cpl Schaal took photos.

Two outstanding warrants for Hall were confirmed. Hall was transported to jail and booked on both warrants and for Possession of a Stolen Vehicle. Sgt. Reynolds was advised of the arrest and booking.

 - -he observed a shaved key being used to keep the stolen vehicle operating.
 - -he observed that the steering wheel had been severed.
