Summary:

Officers were dispatched to a stabbing at 411 E. Wabash. It was a duplex. Servicemaster was

moving furniture into the address, which was located in the basement level of the residence. The resident, Claude E. Royals was giving the Servicemaster employees instructions on where to put items. Andrew Stanley was one of the Servicemaster employees. Stanley and another employee were moving a couch down the stairt into the apartment, when Royals came up behind Stanley and stabbed him in the back. Royals said nothing and there was no indication he was upset. Stanley and the other employee were able to get out of the apartment without further harm. Officers McMurtrey and Brasch arrived and went to the North side (back) of the residence. The sliding glass door on the North side was open. Officer McMurtrey could hear a male moaning in the bathroom, which was on the East side of the house. He looked through the open window and saw a male that matched the suspect description sitting on the toilet. The suspect was missing his bottom teeth and his right eve. The male had a rubber band, about an inch thick, wrapped around his right arm. It appeared he was injecting something into his arm. Officer Brasch and McMurtrey both ordered the male out of the apartment and told him he was under arrest. The male refused and walked out of the bathroom. Royals disappeared into another room for a short time. Both officers went to the sliding glass door and could see the male walking toward them with a silver object in his right hand. The apartment was dark, so they could not see what the object was. Officer McMurtrey ordered Royals to put his hands up and ordered Royals to get on the ground. Royals refused and stepped outside the sliding glass door toward the officers. Officer McMurtrey was above Royals on a three foot high concrete wall. He drew his hand gun and pointed it at Royals as Mcmurtrey could not identify what was in Royal's hand. Royals could have accessed a weapon when he disappeared into another room. Royals was again ordered to get on the ground. Royals refused and stood at the doorway. As Officer McMurtrey was giving commands to Royals, Officer Brasch covered Royals with his shotgun. He could not tell what Royals had in his hand. The shotgun was in a depressed position, but because of his position above Royals, it was pointed toward Royal's lower extremities. Officer Mcmurtrey holstered his handgun and drew his taser. Royals was warned he would be tased if he did not get on the ground. Royals again refused to comply. Officers could not allow Royals back into the apartment. Officer McMurtrey fired his taser. One probe hit Royals in the left chest and the other probe in the upper left abdomen. Officers Brasch and McMurtrey were able to handcuff Royals after Royals continued to resist. Medics checked out Royals and removed the probes. Royals had just stabbed someone and neither officer could not tell what Royals had in his hand. Royals was refusing to follow commands. Officers McMurtrey and Brasch used appropriate use of force throughout the contact.

Officer McMurtrey's use of force was reasonable and within policy. Officer McMurtrey wrote a very well detailed report. Taser recommends avoiding deploying in the "head from heart" area. One of the probes did strike the subject in this area. One thing that should be included in reports when this does occur is why/how this happened. I've cc'ed this to Sgt. Huddle and Lt. McCabe to remind Officer McMurtrey of this.

Officer Brasch's use of force was reasonable and within policy.

On 100113 at about 1605 hrs I responded with several other officers to 411 E Wabash on the report that a male had been stabbed in the neck by another male. The caller advised that the suspect had left the scene.

I arrived on scene and saw several subjects standing outside who were wearing Service Master worker shirts. I observed that one had blood on his chest and was speaking with Sgt Huddle.

I contacted Mark Knapp, one of the Service Master workers. Knapp advised he was at 411 E Wabash moving the residents out of the location. Knapp said he was working with Andrew and Blake, later identified as Andew Stanley and Blake Johns. He said that he and Andrew were carrying a couch down the stairs toward the exit with Andrew at the top of the stairs and he on the bottom. He said that suddenly "Blake velled and Andrew fell backward." He said he did not see what happened but suddenly saw Andrew with blood on him "and he said he'd been stabbed." He said he did not see who stabbed Andrew and did not see a weapon. He also said he heard no arguing or yelling prior to seeing Andrew fall backward.

Before I could contact Johns Sqt Huddle advised that the suspect was inside the apartment and Ofcs. McMurtrey and Brasch were inside with him. I ran toward the back of the apartment when I heard Ofc. McMurtrey say "he's shooting up in the bathroom and refusing to come out." I then saw Ofcs. McMurtrey and Brasch standing at an open window at ground level and talking to someone inside. I then saw a male emerge from a sliding glass door at which point a van pulled into the back driveway. A female got out of the van and yelled, "What's going on?" as she rushed to where the officers were standing with the male. I told the female to stay back but she continued advancing toward the officers. I then placed her in handcuffs and pulled her back from the officers as they dealt with the male.

The female identified herself as Jennifer Swan. She said the male is her bovfriend "and he was in a car accident a few days ago and has a head injury. He didn't get treated and has been crazy the last few days." She said she did not witness the incident and had no idea what would have caused the male to attack Stanley.

Ofcs. McMurtrey and Brasch took the male, identified as Claude Royals, into custody. Ofc. Ralieigh took custody of a box cutter at the scene (see their reports).

I contacted Stanley. I observed what appeared to be a small puncture wound on the front of his chest just to the left of his sternum. I asked him if he had any other injuries and he showed me a small puncture wound on the back of his neck just above his shoulder blades. He also showed me a scrape on the left side of his torso above his waist and blood on his right index finger. He advised that all of the injuries were from being assaulted by Royals. Cpl Beckley had already photographed Stanley's injuries.

Stapley advised he was at the apartment moving the residents out. He said that he was at the top of the stairs helping Knapp move the couch outside. He said he suddenly "felt like I got injected or something in my back. I felt a sharp pain and then a rush of some kind." He said he then saw the male who had been at the house "and he was acting fine while we were there." He said he saw the male holding "a 3"-4" flat blade of some kind." He said that he had no idea why the male attacked him. He said that there was no argument of any kind and no warning from the male that he

was angry at him for any reason.

I looked closer at Stanley's injuries and saw that the marks were very small. I asked him if he thought the male may have used a syringe to stab him and he said, "I don't know." I asked him if he thought the "rush" he described could have been from drugs and he said, "I don't think so." He also advised that he had no idea how he received the injuries to his chest, side or finger. Stanley was then transported to Sacred Heart Hospital's emergency room.

I advised Ofcs. McMurtrey and Brasch to book Royals for 1st degree assault (see their reports).

I contacted Stanley at SHER. I gave him a crime victim card with the report number and he signed a medical release form (see attached). The doctor who was tending to Stanley told him it appeared that the object did not pentrate his chest cavity.

On 100113 at approximately 1606 hours, Officer P. Brasch and I were a two man patrol unit in department uniform and a marked police vehicle.

While responding, we received information that a male was stabbed in the neck by a homeowner. The suspect was described as a white male, about 5'9" wearing a blue shirt. He was reported to be missing one eye and he had no bottom teeth.

Upon our arrival, Sgt. Huddle advised the suspect just moved in to 411 E Wabash.

Officer Brasch and I walked to the back of the residence. I noticed the front door was propped open, as well as the back sliding glass door.

The address 411 E Wabash is a duplex house. It shares an address with 409 E Wabash. I talked to a male in 409, who informed me that the bottom level is all 411, his house is the entire top floor. The bottom unit is set in a half-basement, making all windows near ground level and easily seen into.

I entered the back yard looking for the described suspect.

I could hear moaning in the bathroom of the residence. The bathroom window is about 18"x 18" and was about waist high to me. The sliding window was open, I was able to see through the screen using my flashlight. I observed a male in a blue shirt sitting on the toilet. He was groaning. He

looked up toward my flashlight, and I could see that he was missing his bottom teeth. The male had a blue rubber band, about one inches thick wrapped around his right arm. It appeared to me that he was injecting something into his arm.

Fearing the suspect was destroying evidence, I removed the screen to establish contact. I could clearly see the male was missing his right eye.

Officer Brasch and I both ordered the male to come out.

He repeated, "Hold on", "Fuck you". We informed him he was under arrest an ordered him to come outside. He replied, "I know".

He left the bathroom and disappeared in to the house for about thirty seconds. I moved to the open sliding glass door, which gave me a view of the kitchen, living room and hallway. I knew by looking into the front of the house, that the suspect would have had to have walked into the bedrooms, not toward the kitchen where I was yelling at him to surrender.

The male then appeared and walked towards the door. I could see that he had a silver object in his right hand. I could not identify the object clearly in the dark house.

I yelled at him to put his hands up, which he did not comply. He held his hands at his sides and walked to the door threshold. I ordered him to lie on the ground outside the door. He stepped outside and stopped. I still could not identify what was in his hand.

I was above him on a three foot high concrete wall. I had by department issued .45 caliber pistol drawn and directed towards him.

At that time, I was investigating a violent assault involving a deadly weapon, a knife. The victim was reported to have been stabbed in the neck. The male in the house matched the description of the suspect, which was a highly unique description. The male was uncooperative to our verbal commands to surrender in the house. He swore at us and stayed in the bathroom. He then disappeared into the house for a sufficient amount of time to access a weapon. The house and suspect were unsearched and I was concerned he was able to access any number of weapons. He had a silver object in his right hand, which in the lighting and distance, I was unable to identify.

I again ordered the suspect to lie on the ground. He took a step back to the threshold and said, "Fuck you". He was warned that we would use a K9 to effect his arrest. He replied, "Fucking send him in, I'm ready".

At that time, I holstered my firearm and drew my department issued X-26 Taser. I illuminated the laser, directed it to his left shoulder and gave him a clear verbal warning, "Get on the ground or

you'll be Tased".

The male stayed at the threshold, with his hands at his sides and did not move. He did not surrender, or cooperate with my verbal commands. I had a short and narrow opportunity to effect the arrest of the suspect in the doorway. I was not going to allow the suspect back in to the house, which he had already taken two steps back in what appeared to me as an effort to retreat inside. There were numerous civilians, as well as unarmed emergency personnel in the area. Based on the allegation that the victim was unknown to the suspect, I believed him to be a danger to residents and others in the area.

At that time, I determined it was necessary to arrest the suspect. He was unsearched, reported to have stabbed a person in the neck and uncooperative. It was likely to me he was still armed with a weapon and I could see a silver object in his hand. I deployed the Taser probes, which struck him in the left chest and upper left abdomen. I initiated a single five second cycle.

Officers Brasch and Raleigh simultaneously moved in and took control of the suspect. I assisted as we attempted to place him in to handcuffs.

He landed on his back and brought his arms in to this waist. He flexed his arms and would not placed them behind his back as directed. He was warned numerous times to stop resisting, which he did not comply.

We were able to detain the male in handcuffs. Medics evaluated him alter being Tased. I informed Sgt. Huddle of the use of force. The silver object in his hand turned out to be a laser pointer, a knife was discovered in his pocket.

While escorting the male to our patrol car, I advised him of his constitutional rights per the department typed note card. I asked him if he understood his rights, he replies, "uh, no". I asked no more questions other than an attempt to positively identify him.

I later interviewed a witness. Netric Doucette. She stated she had just returned home after the stabbing. She saw the suspect, whom she identified as the downstairs neighbor that just moved in. She heard the suspect talking to another neighbor about the stabbing. She heard him say, "He didn't do what I told him to do, thats why I did it".

I returned my Taser to Sgt. Huddle's office to be downloaded.

On 100113 at approximately 1606 hours, Officer McMurtrey and I were a two man patrol unit in department uniforms and a marked patrol vehicle.

While responding, we received information that a male was stabbed in the neck by another male. The suspect was described as a white male, about 5'9" wearing a blue shirt, in his late 40's with "lighter brown longer buzz cut hair". He was reported to be missing one eye and he had no bottom teeth.

SPD Radio advised that it was unknown where the knife was at. The male was said to have been seen leaving north bound.

Upon arrival, Sqt. Huddle said the suspect had recently moved into the duplex at 411 E. Wabash. I observed the front door to the residence was open and there was a brown couch lying in the entryway.

The residence was on the ground floor and all of the windows were at knee level to me. Officer McMurtrey and I walked north bound through the yard towards the back door. I had deployed a department issued shotgun from the patrol vehicle.

I observed that one of the windows was opened and the sliding glass door was open. I walked past the open window and thought I heard noises coming through the screen.

I continued past the window and informed Officer McMurtrey that I heard noises, by gesturing with my hand towards my ear and pointing to the window.

I was concerned the suspect might be hiding in the yard or behind a small car port. I continued around the yard and cleared the car port area of any people.

I walked back to Officer McMurtrey, who was at the small window the noises had been heard. I could see a figure inside the room, which turned out to be a bathroom.

We tore the screen off of the window so we could see the male clearly. I observed the male was

sitting on the toilet.

The male appeared to match the description of the stabbing suspect. The male was not following our commands to stand up and pull his pants back on.

I advised the male he was under arrest, to which he stated, "I know!". The male was moaning while he sat on the toilet and refused to stand up.

I informed the male he was under arrest again and to move to the slider door and exit the house. I told the male to exit the house with his hands up and make sure he had nothing in them.

The male yelled at me, "Back up and give me some space."

The male stood up from the toilet and pulled his pants up. The male did not wipe and it did appear that he had defecated in the toilet. The male left the bathroom.

The suspect did not exit the slider as I had directed him. I asked Officer McMurtrey, who had moved to stand so he could see into the slider, if he saw the male. Officer McMurtrey said he could not see the suspect and he had not come into view since leaving the bathroom.

I yelled into the house that a K9 was en route and we would be sending it into the residence. I told the male, "He will find you and he will bite you. You are under arrest."

The male yelled out to me, "Fucking send them in I'm ready." We made more commands to the male to come out the slider with his hands in the air.

The male finally came to the slider and stepped out onto a cement pad, by the back stairs (four or five steps).

I observed the male had a silver object in his right fist. I could not tell what the object was and was in fear that it might be the knife he had used in the assault.

Officer McMurtrey began giving the male commands to drop the object and get onto the ground. I covered the suspect with the shotgun and was directly to Officer McMurtrey's left.

Because of the violent nature of the assault and the fact that the male had refused to comply with any commands, I was concerned both for my safety and the other officers and civilians on scene. The male had stayed in the house, after he left the bathroom, and had plenty of time to access more weapons.

I let Officer McMurtrey continue to deliver commands to the suspect, as I focused my attention on

the unknown object in his right hand. I kept my shot gun in a depressed position and was ready to bring it up and onto target should I need to deliver lethal force to the suspect. The barrel of the shotoun was focused on the suspect's lower extremities. I was concerned the male might try and rush Officer McMurtrey or myself.

The male refused to drop the object, or to get onto the ground. It appeared he was moving back towards the residence, which had not been cleared and held many unknown threats.

I heard Officer McMurtrey warn the suspect that he was going to be Tased. The suspect was swearing at Officer McMurtrey and refused to drop the object.

I observed the Taser being deployed and saw that the suspect had fallen back into the residence. Knowing that I only had a short time to cover that distance and take the suspect into custody, I ran down the steps and entered the back slider.

The suspect was on his back and had his hands up as if reaching out towards me. I grabbed onto the suspects left wrist and began to roll him over onto his stomach. The suspect pulled his other arm (right) towards his waist band as I was rolling him over.

I placed the suspect's left hand behind his back and forced him to stay onto the ground. We were now on the outside patio. The male was screaming and violently resisting our attempts to place him into custody.

The suspect refused to let us get his right hand out from his waist band area. I was concerned the suspect was either accessing a weapon, or trying to conceal the object that had been in his hand.

Officer Raleigh and Officer McMurtrey assisted me in placing the suspect into handcuffs and detaining him. I observed the object the male had been holding. It was a silver colored laser pointer about three inches in length.

I patted the suspect down and felt what I could tell was a folding knife in his right hand pants pocket. I removed the knife and observed a blue handled folding knife with "Irwin" written on it. The knife was the kind that holds a razor blade, that can be removed. The razor blade was no longer in the knife.

Officer McMurtrey and I had the suspect, was identified as Claude Royals, treated by medical personnel. As we were walking Royals to our patrol vehicle, Officer McMurtrey advised him of his Constitutional Rights. Royals refused to acknowledge that he understood his rights. We did not ask Royals any questions.

We transported Royals to SCSO Jail. While we were en route to jail I asked Royals if he was going

On 100113 at approximately 1605 hours, I responded to the residence located at 411 East Wabash Avenue in the City/County of Spokane, WA along with several other officers of the Spokane Police Department reference a possible stabbing call for service.

While enroute, Spokane Police Radio advised the complainant, later ID'd as Blake was calling Spokane 911 to report the fact a male had just been stabbing at the location. Blake advised the homeowner had stabbed an employee in the neck and was thought to have fled the location leaving out the door and walking northbound from the residence.

Spokane 911 further stated the male suspect was described as being an adult white male wearing a black shirt and blue jean pants and had lost one of his eyes in an unrelated injury.

Upon arrival in the area of the stabbing incident, I established a perimeter position at Queen Avenue and Lidgerwood Street in an attempt to contain and locate the male suspect before he was able to flee the area.

I later heard as Ofc Brasch stated he was able to locate and contact the male suspect in the basement bathroom of the residence located at 411 East Wabash Avenue. Ofc Brasch stated the male suspect, later ID'd as Claude E Royals was refusing to come out of the residence and could possibly still be armed with the knife he used in the stabbing incident.

I contacted Ofc Brasch in the rear of the residence at 411 East Wabash Avenue at which time I observed as Ofc Brasch had verbally contacted Claude and ordered him to exit the residence out the rear sliding door.

I observed as after approximately one two minutes of delay, Claude finally walked out the rear sliding door of the residence and stood just outside the doorway with both his hands down by his side and near his pants pockets.

I heard as Ofc McMurtrey verbally contacted Claude and instructed/ordered Claude to show officers his hands and put them up above his head. I observed as Claude refused to follow Ofc McMurtrey's commands and stared at Ofc McMurtrey and stated, "Fuck you."

Not knowing if Claude was still armed with a knife or sharp object of some sort, I observed as Ofc McMurtrey again ordered Claude to show his hands and place his hands above his head or he

would be tased. I observed as Claude again refused to follow any commands and stood just outside the doorway in complete defiance as he refused to obey any orders Ofc McMurtrey gave him.

I witnessed as Ofc McMurtrey applied a probe taser application to Claude striking him in the front of Claude's chest with the probes. I observed as Claude curled his arms inward and tensed the rest of his body as he fell back into the doorway of the residence screaming in pain.

Ofc Brasch, Ofc McMurtrey and I physically contacted Claude at which time we detained Claude by placing him in handcuffs (double-locked) without incident.

I requested medical technicians of the Spokane City Fire Department respond to the location to remove the taser probes, which they did without incident.

I observed as Ofc Brasch removed a blue handled folding "Irwin" razor knife from Claude's person.

I assisted Ofc Brasch and Ofc McMurtrey arrest and detain Claude and escort him to their Spokane Police Department patrol vehicle where they placed him in the back seat of the vehicle.

I later transported the Irwin folding knife and taser cartridge and probes on the Spokane Police Department Property facility to be held as evidence. (See also Spokane Police Department Property Report #13-332719)

I later completed this informational additional incident report documenting my contact with the parties involved and observations regarding the stabbing incident and cleared the call.

On 10/01/13 at about 1610 hours, I responded to the area of 411 E Wabash, to assist officers who were out with a stabbing. Upon arrival I responded to the rear of the house to assist Officers Raleigh, McMurtrey and Brasch. When I arrived it appeared a taser application had just been applied to the def Claude Royals. I could hear Ofc. McMurtrey giving clear directions to the def to stop resisting and to place his arms out. It appeared the def wasn't complying so I was able to pull his right arm out and handcuffs were applied to the def. I then spoke to two witnesses who were in front of the location, Jeremy Ownby and Blake Johns.

Johns told me he and the victim work for Service Master of N. Idaho. Today they were moving a customer's furniture that had been serviced for smoke damage to 411 E. Wabash. That the customer/Def Claude Royals, appeared agitated and was first seen taking some of Service Masters packing blankets and hiding them inside his apartment in a closet. That they didn't confront the def

about the blankets and continued to move his furniture into the apartment. That when both Johns' and the victim were moving one of the last pieces of furniture, a coach, into the basement apartment the def attacked the victim. Johns stated he was at the top of the stairs holding the coach and the victim was at the bottom. That through a small opening on the side of the coach he saw the Def come out of nowhere and hold what appeared to be a box cutter to the victim's neck and appear to stab him, without any provocation or even an argument. That the victim started to scream and ran away from the def to the back of the apartment and he ran out the front to call police. He described the def as a W/M 45-50, short cut hair, with an eye missing and wearing a dark t-shirt and blue jeans. While I was talking to Johns' the def was walked from the back yard of 411 E Wabash and he said, "That's the guy, thats the guy who stabbed my partner."

I then contacted witness, Jeremy Ownby, a neighbor who lives behind the def's apartment at 414 E Olympic. He stated he saw the victim and his co-workers moving furniture into 411 E Wabash. Then around 4:00PM he heard screaming coming from 411 E Wabash and came over and saw the def Robayls in the backyard. That the def looked crazy and said, "He wouldn't listen to me so I stabbed him." That he saw in the def's hand a small, possibly a folding knife or box cutter, with a small blade. That he felt it was red in color but wasn't sure since it was, because it was in the def's hand and it could have been blood on the knife. He described the def as a W/M 50, with what appeared to be an eye missing, wearing a dark t-shirt and jeans. That the def went back into the apartment after a few seconds and then the police arrived.

That he saw several police at the back of 411 E. Wabash and could hear them calling for the def to come out. That when the def was at the back door he heard the police warn him to show his hands or he would be tased. That he saw the def tased by the police then go to the ground where he heard officers tell him to stop resisting and to pull his hands out. That he then saw the def handcuffed. He said, "They did a good job that guy (def) wasn't listen to them at all."

I responded to 411 E. Wabash on a stabbing call. I was first on scene and contacted the victim, Stanley Andrew. He said he was working for the moving company that was moving people into 411 E. Wabash. He said there was a male helping them move the furniture in. Andrew was carrying a couch down the stairs when the male came up behind him and stabbed him in the back. He had no idea why the male did that. Andrew said the last he saw the male was in the back of the duplex.

We were able to determine the male was the one moving into the address and that he was in the apartment. Officers McMurtrey and Brasch went to the rear, North side, to see if they could make contact with the suspect.

A few minutes later I heard Officers giving commands to someone on the North side of the duplex. I ran back and saw they had the suspect, Claude E. Royals, in custody. Medics attended to Royals and removed the taser probes from him. I verified with the witnesses that Royals was the person who had done the stabbing. They viewed him as he walked to a patrol vehicle. He was very distinctive, as he had one bad eye and was missing his lower teeth.

I briefly spoke with a media person on scene and advised Lt. Cowles of the situation. I phoned Capt. Cummings and advised him of the call. I drove to the Public Safety Building and downloaded the information from the taser.
