Reviewer comment:

Two subjects contacted on foot gave false names to police. One of them had a felony warrant, learned after they had left. K-9 track was done to locate the male suspect, with multiple announcements given over several patrol car PA systems. Track was commenced, and located the female instead, hiding in a window well. K-9 contacted her pant leg only. It was determined that she also had a warrant, and was arrested for it. Use of K-9 was appropriate and effective, even though initial track was for the other wanted suspect.

Application of K-9 was within policy, case law and use of force guidelines, with no injury resulting.

Reviewer comment:

The initial K9 track was for the wanted male suspect. The female, who was also hiding at the same time the officers were searching for the male, had many opportunities to make her presence known to the police to either turn herself in (since she was also wanted) or to simply let them know that she was there to avoid contact with the K9. The female suspect did neither and continued to behave as one would expect from a person trying to secrete themselves from law enforcement. She had an outstanding DOC warrant for her arrest and is also considered a Repeat Offender. Her pant leg was torn by the K9 contact but was not injured. The deployment and use of the K9 was within policy and appropriate.

**INCIDENT DESCRIPTION:**

**Type of Application:** Track

**Original Call:**

Ellis and a male gave false names to Officer's Ames and Yinger and then walked away and disappeared into the dark of the night. This was a residential neighborhood. They were able to determine the male had a valid felony DOC escape warrant. The original charge was for the violent crime of assault 3<sup>rd</sup> degree.

**Suspect Actions:**

The suspects fled on foot. Ellis failed to give up after numerous announcements were given by Officer Hamilton and over the PA systems of the perimeter units. Ellis still failed to give up after seeing Ofc. Hamilton and his K-9 work past her once, only to return and locate her.

**Est. Time & Distance of Contact (if known):** Less then 1 second and about 8' away.

**Officer Safety Concerns/ Why was Canine used:**

The Officers were looking for the male that Ellis fled with. The reason the canine was used to attempt to locate the subject was as follows:  
 The suspect had a valid felony DOC warrant. The original charge was for the violent crime of assault 3<sup>rd</sup> degree.  
 The suspect was actively fleeing on foot.  
 The suspect posed an immediate threat to the searching Officers. He has a lengthy violent criminal history. He is a convicted felon, listed as a Repeat Offender, has prior arrest for Assault 2nd, Riot with a deadly weapon, Assault-DV, Assault 1st, Burglary 1st (armed), and Possession of a Dangerous Weapon. These were just a few of the charges he's been arrested for in the past. The suspect was also putting the general public and local residents in danger. The suspect and Ellis had disappeared into the dark of the night in a residential neighborhood and were on foot. It was unknown what their intent was or how desperate they were at the time.

Officer Hamilton responded to assist with locating a suspect (Pawley) wanted for a DOC warrant stemming from an Assault 3<sup>rd</sup>. Unbeknownst to the Officers, the subject that was with Pawley at the time of the initial contact was also wanted (Ellis). Officer Hamilton went to the last known location of the suspects and made a K-9 announcement prior to the deployment of K-9 Leo. Several K-9 announcements were made by perimeter units as well. K-9 Leo was deployed to search for the suspect. K-9 Leo tracked, located, and apprehended Ellis who was hiding in a ground level window well. K-9 Leo contacted Ellis's pant leg only. Ellis was taken into custody without further incident. K-9 Leo was unable to locate Pawley.

On 10-02-13 at about 0200 hours, I heard Officer's Ames and Yinger in the area of Hogan and Marietta looking for a male with a DOC warrant that had walked away from them and disappeared into the dark of the night.

I responded with K9 Leonidas (Leo). We are a WAC certified police patrol dog team. We are also accredited with the Washington State Police Canine Association (WSPCA). I am accredited as a Master Handler. Leo and I have been a team for nearly 5 years. He is my second working dog in my 9 years of being a canine handler. I am also a Master Trainer with the WSPCA.

I responded in a fully marked "Spokane Police K9" car. I was wearing the uniform of the day. Leo was wearing a harness with "POLICE" marked along both shoulders and a Spokane Police patch affixed to the left side of his chest. We were clearly identifiable as Spokane Police.

I spoke with Ofc. Ames at the scene. He told me they had been looking for a couple that were involved in a DV earlier in the night. The couple had warrants and had left on foot prior to their arrival. He told me they contacted a male and female. The two apparently verbally identified themselves and then walked off, S/B on Hogan. They were able to determine the male gave a false name. His real name was Jeremy D. Pawley and he had a DOC warrant.

SPD radio confirmed with DOC that the warrant was valid. The original charge was for 3rd degree assault.

There was another officer in the area looking around while I was out on foot. I asked him to go a block or two to the south and make a K9 announcement. I got Leo out and yelled the following announcement, "Attention in the area, this is the Spokane Police K9 Unit! Jeremy, you are being tracked by a police dog. You need to give up now or if my dog finds you he might bite you! You are under arrest."

There was no response so I track for the fleeing suspect for the following reasons:

- The suspect had a valid felony DOC warrant. The original charge was for the violent crime of assault 3rd degree.

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- The suspect was actively fleeing on foot.

- The suspect posed an immediate threat to the searching officers. He has a lengthy violent criminal history. He is a convicted felon, is listed a Repeat Offender, has prior arrest for assault 2nd, riot with a deadly weapon, assault-DV, assault 1st, burglary 1st (armed), and possession of a dangerous weapon. These were just a few of the charges he's been arrested for in the past. He was also putting the general public and local residents in danger. He had disappeared into the dark of the night in a residential neighborhood and he was on foot. It was unknown what his intent was or how desperate he was at the time.

I was told that the female he was with, was seen walking away with him when they walked out of the officer's sight.

After I yelled my announcement, I cast Leo in the area south of Marietta on Hogan. Leo began tracking S/B down the street then E/B through the second yard south on the east side of Hogan. Leo located a coat stuffed between some bushes next to the house. We continued tracking E/B to the alley, worked S/B to Jackson, crossed the road in the alley then worked S/E through some yards. We got to the south side of 2441 N. Madelia and worked our way back W/B to the alley again. We worked our way back to the south side of the house. Just as I lit up the area with my flashlight, Leo located the female stuffed up and hiding in a ground level window well of the house.

This area between the houses was very dark and flashlights had to be used to see anything. Leo barely made contact with the female suspect's pant leg. She had secreted herself in such a way that it was obvious she was trying to avoid being captured or contacted by the police.

She verbally identified herself as Jessica A. Ellis and had once again given a false name. It was determined she was actually Erica A. Ellis. Ellis had a confirmed DOC warrant and too was a listed Repeat Offender.

This was not Ellis' residence and she was the female that fled with Pawley. Ellis wasn't cooperative in helping us locate Pawley.

I continued to search the area and yards but was not successful in locating Pawley.

On 10/02/13 around 0158 hours Ofc. Yinger and I were working as a two-officer patrol unit, and traveling E/B on Marietta towards Perry. We then observed a male and female subject walking E/B ahead of us on Marietta, who resembled a couple we had been looking for earlier in the evening.

Ofc. Yinger and I responded to 3915 E. Upriver around 2142 hours (Reference Report Number 130333039), where a male and female had been arguing out in front of the residence.
