Summary:

On 10-25-2013 at about 2353 hr. Officer Widhalm and Officer Van Tassel responded to an argument call at 834 W. 12th. Officer Widhalm arrived and went to the back of the residence as Officer Van Tassel went to the front of the residence. At the back of the residence Officer Widhalm could hear a subject in the residence cursing at others, asking for his keys. Another male was yelling at a subject to stop and leave her alone. A male then told someone not to drive because he would kill someone. The voices became louder and then he heard a physical altercation. Officer Widhalm called for Officer Van Tassel.

The back door of the residence was open and Officer Widhalm saw Nestor Guzman hitting Miles Mikklesen in the face. Mr. Mikklesen was holding on to Mr. Guzman's shirt trying to duck down. The situation was tense, uncertain, and rapidly evolving. Officer Widhalm entered the residence and announced himself as a police officer. He ordered the subjects to stop fighting and get on the ground. He took out his Taser and held it down at his side.

Mr. Mikklesen responded by getting on the ground. Mr. Guzman continued standing and faced Officer Widhalm. Officer Widhalm ordered him again to get on the ground and he did not comply. The occupants in the residence pleaded with Mr. Guzman to get on the ground and Mr. Guzman did not. Officer Widhalm activated his Taser and pointed the laser light at the ground. He again ordered Mr. Guzman to get on the ground. Mr. Guzman just stared at Officer Widhalm. Officer Widhalm then pointed his Taser at Mr. Guzman and warned him he was going to be Tased if did not get down on the ground. Officer Widhalm told Mr. Guzman he did not want to use his Taser and that it would hurt. Other occupants of the residence were telling Mr. Guzman to comply. Mr. Guzman continued to willfully disobey Officer Widhalm's lawful commands. Mr. Guzman then balled up his fists. Seeing Mr. Guzman ball up his fists and not following lawful commands, Officer Widhalm discharged his Taser in prong mode for the following reasons: Crime: Officers responded to an argument call at a residence and found two subjects physically fighting. The situation appeared to be a DV. Mr. Guzman refused to follow lawful commands and was obstructing Officer Widhalm.

Threat Factors: Officer Widhalm was in a residence with an unknown number of people. Mr. Guzman had assaulted one person and was now standing in front of Officer Widhalm, who was giving him lawful commands to get down, and he willfully refused. Officer Widhalm, displaying his Taser, advised him he would be Tased if he did not follow commands, and Mr. Guzman disregarded this show of force and balled up his fists. Mr. Guzman had not been searched and could possess weapons that could hurt or harm the officer.

Resistance: Mr. Guzman willfully refused to follow lawful orders to get on the ground. He refused requests from other occupants on the residence to get down on the ground. While facing Officer Widhalm he balled up his fists, displaying a continued assaultive behavior. Officer Widhalm deployed his Taser in dart mode, striking Mr. Guzman in the right upper shoulder

and on his coat near his bellybutton area. Mr. Guzman fell to the ground and he was detained in handcuffs.

Medics responded and removed one dart that struck Mr. Guzman in the shoulder. Officers investigated the assault at the residence. Mr. Guzman had assaulted Mr. Mikklesen; however, he refused to press charges. There was no DV relationship between the two men. Mr. Guzman was arrested for obstructing.

I talked to Mr. Guzman while he was sitting in the back seat of a patrol car. Mr. Guzman indicated he had been out drinking this night. He stated he had 5 hard alcoholic drinks in a three hour period. His speech was slurred and he repeated himself numerous times. He stated he had been fighting with Mr. Mikklesen when the officer entered the house. He stated the officer then Tased him. He said he was not "discooperating" with the officer and "I deserved everything that happened to me tonight." Mr. Guzman had a cut on his lip and I asked how that occurred. Mr. Guzman stated he fell on the sidewalk when he got back from the bar. The only other injury I could see on Mr. Guzman was from the Taser probes. Photos were requested.

Seeing how the chest is not a primary aiming point for the Taser in probe mode, I talked to Officer Widhalm about this. He indicated he was unable to get to the subjects back as he was facing him, balling up his fists. The only other target area, besides his groin, was his chest. He felt he could not transition to an impact tool because he was within about 5 feet of Mr. Guzman and this would open him up to an assault, as the situation was tense, uncertain, and rapidly evolving. He then aimed and deployed his Taser to the far right side of his body, creating the greatest hart to dart distance.

The Taser device is intended to control a violent or potentially violent individual, while minimizing the risk of serious injury. Mr. Guzman was assaulting a subject and Officer Widhalm intervened. Officer Widhalm gave lawful commands for him to get on the ground and Mr. Guzman willfully disobeyed those commands. Officer Widhalm gave a warning that a Taser would be deployed, displayed the Taser, and again ordered Mr. Guzman to the ground. Mr. Guzman continued to willfully disobey. Mr. Guzman then clenched his fists while facing Officer Widhalm. Mr. Guzman was demonstrating, by action, the intent to be violent or to physically resist, and reasonably appeared to present the potential to harm the officer, or others. Due to the dynamics of the situation Officer Widhalm was not able to target the lower center mass of Mr. Guzman, as Mr. Guzman was facing him. Officer Widhalm deployed his Taser in a manner to create the greatest hart to dart distance he could, given the situation. Mr. Guzman. Officer Widhalm's actions were objectively reasonable based on facts and circumstances known to him at the time he deployed his Taser. Officer Widhalm acted within department guidelines and state law.

Reviewer comment:

Officer Widhalm had witnessed an assault and was confronting and attempting to detain both subjects involved, for investigation. Due to the assaultive behavior, Officer Widhalm brought out his taser and held it to his side when giving commands to stop and get on the ground. One subject complied and the other did not. Even after the laser was turned on and then pointed at the subject, he refused to comply. The subject then balled up his fists, making Officer Widhalm believe he was going to be assaulted by the subject.

Policy states that the taser may be used for the following circumstances: (a) The subject is violent or is physically resisting.

(b) The subject has demonstrated, by words or action, an intention to be violent or to

physically resist, and reasonably appears to present the potential to harm officers,

him/herself or others.

The subject's actions satisfied both a and b options on the use of the taser. Officer Widhalm applied the taser probes and initiated one cycle. The taser was effective and allowed Officer Widhalm to take the subject into custody.

The placement of the taser probes was in the torso area; one landing on the front of the right shoulder and the other in the area of the belly button. The chest area is not the most favorable target for the probes but Officer Widhalm attempted to move the targeted area as far to the subject's right side as possible. Officer Widhalm also monitored the subject until medics arrived and were able to assess the subject's condition.

This use of force was reasonable and falls within the policy guidelines. It should also be noted that the day following this incident a training memo was sent out regarding the taser target areas, making reference to the "heart to dart" distance.

On 102513 at approximately 2345hrs, Brenda Yates called to report that subjects in a two-tone blue Chevy pickup with two males and two females parked across the street from 824 W 12th and went into that address. The group was yelling at each other.

Officer Vantassel and I responded in full uniform, complete with police badge, patches, duty belt, firearm, handcuffs, radio, etc. When I arrived I was on 12th Ave, about 200 feet from the house and could hear males yelling. I walked up to the house and from the walkway could see two males inside arguing. I then saw a female inside and a male was yelling at her. She appeared to be trying to stay away from the male. I was unable to make out faces through the window.

While I waited for Ofc. Vantassel I could hear one male yelling something similar to, "fuck you, give me my keys I'm leaving." Another male yelled for him to stop and leave her alone. The first male said he was leaving and the others in the house pleaded with him not to drive. One of the males told the first male that he was going to end up in jail. The first male was just cursing and I could see the female trying to stay off in the dark by what appeared to be the dining room. All of a sudden the subjects moved quickly towards the back of the house and they started yelling louder. One male told the first not to drive because he would kill someone. The voices were louder towards the back of the house and it sounded like the back door was open.

I came around the corner and heard cursing followed by banging noises. It sounded like a physical altercation had started. I called for Ofc Vantassel to come around back and went to look inside. The back door was wide open and two males where physically fighting. I observed one male, later identified as Nestor Guzman repeatedly punching the other male, later identified as Miles Mikklesen in the face. Mr. Mikklesen was holding onto Mr. Guzman's shirt and trying to duck his head down. I announced myself as a police officer and ordered the two to stop and get on the ground. I took out my taser and held it down by my waist.

Mr. Mikklesen immediately got on the ground but Mr. Guzman continued to stand and face me. His shirt was off but he was wearing a coat that was hanging open at the front revealing his bare chest. I ordered Mr. Guzman again to get on the ground but he still would not comply. The other subjects

pleaded with him as well to get on the ground but Mr. Guzman just stood there starring at me. I turned on my taser and displayed the laser light on the ground. I told Mr. Guzman again to get on the ground. He just staired at me some more.

I pointed the taser at Mr. Guzman's chest and warned him that I was going to tase him if he didn't get down on the ground. The other subjects were telling him to listen to me. I told Mr. Guzman that I didn't want to have to use the taser on him and that it would hurt. I again ordered him to get on the ground. This time Mr. Guzman not only refused, he started to ball both fists like he wanted to fight.

At this point I had the following information:

1) There has been an argument that turned into a physical confrontation with Mr. Guzman assaulting another person in front of me. This incident also appeared to be a DV situation which would require an arrest for the assault if the two males were roommates.

2) Mr. Guzman had not been searched and could possess weapons that could harm or kill me, the other occupants of the house, other officers, and, if he were to get out of the house, other citizens.

3) Mr. Guzman was refusing my lawful orders for him to get on the ground, he was balling his fists like he was ready to assault me, and I couldn't leave him alone and let him continue assaulting the other occupants and drive away intoxicated.

With this in mind, I determined it necessary to deploy my taser on Mr. Guzman to stop his assaultive behavior with minimal risk to him and all involved. Mr. Guzman's back was to the wall and it would not be safe for me to get behind him to deploy my taser into his back as I would prefer. He also had a thick coat on, which makes it difficult for the probes to penetrate and work effectively. The the only area I had to target without possibly hitting his groin, was his chest. To transition to any other form of defense would only open me up to this assault as we were only about five feet apart. I could see no other options at that point and with what I interpreted as an imminent threat of assault, I fired the taser at his chest. To obtain the greatest heart to dart distance, I aimed as far to the right side of his body as possible.

One probe struck near his right shoulder and the other struck on his coat, near his bellybutton. The taser initially didn't seem to work and Mr. Guzman started to move. All of a sudden Mr. Guzman tensed up and started to fall to the ground. I later determined that the probe near the bellybutton had not penetrated the skin and was stuck in the coat. It appeared that when Mr. Guzman started to move, the probe layed against his stomach and completed the circuit.

The taser completed its 5 second cycle and I assured Mr. Guzman that he would be okay. I told him to put his hands behind his back and he complied. I had Mr. Guzman roll onto his side so he wasn't laying on the probes. That was when I saw that the probe which stuck in the coat near his belly

button was barely staying in the coat fabric. The probe by the shoulder was stuck through the coat and into his skin. I had other officers call for medics to come take the prob out. Mr. Guzman was slurring his speech and reeked of alcohol. His eyes were droopy and bloodshot.

I told Mr. Guzman he was under arrest for Obstructing. I told him I was going to read him his rights and he told me he knew them. He recited the rights almost word for word before I actually read them to him. I then read Mr. Guzman his rights from a department issued CR card. Mr. Guzman stated he understood them and would answer my questions. I asked him to tell me what happened and in summary, he gave me the following statement: He and Miles, his friend of about 10 years were at the Baby Bar downtown with his boss and girlfriend. He and Miles got into an argument and he was trying to talk to him. He said he was from the Tri-Cities and where they handle things by fighting. He thought Miles could handle him and he had no intention of hurting Miles.

I asked Mr. Guzman why he didn't get on the ground when I repeatedly told him to. He told me he was confused and did not intend to "discooperate" with me.

Mr. Mikklesen did not want to pursue charges of assault against Mr. Guzman. Mr. Guzman's girlfriend said he was trying to get his keys from her before police showed up and he was being very aggressive towards her to get them back. She said Mr. Guzman never assaulted her though. She told me that Mr. Guzman was so drunk he fell on the sidewalk when they got back form the bar and he cut his face. There was blood on his face when I contacted them and she said this was from his fall, not the fight between him and Mr. Mikklesen.

I transported Mr. Guzman to the Spokane County Jail and while driving there he continually apologized for the way he acted. I booked him for Obstructing an Officer. I issued criminal citation 3Z0768656 for the charge.


