INCIDENT DESCRIPTION:

Type of Application: Track
Original Call: Lt Hendren attempted to stop a vehicle and the driver fled on foot. The vehicle was confirmed to be stolen.
Suspect Actions: The suspect fled on foot from a stolen vehicle and led Lt Hendren on a short foot pursuit.
Est. Time & Distance of Contact (if known): Less than 5 seconds & approx. 5 feet.
Officer Safety Concerns/ Why was Canine used: Ofc Lesser decided to deploy his K-9, Rav, for the following reasons; There was probable cause to arrest the suspect for a felony. The suspect was actively resisting and evading arrest by fleeing. He had not been searched and it was unknown if he possessed any weapons. He had refused all verbal commands by Lt Hendren to stop and instead led him on a dangerous foot pursuit through several yards and over fences into a residential area at night. It was unknown to what extent of the crimes the suspect may have committed and he was definitely showing his extreme willingness to try and evade capture.

The actions of Ofc Lesser and K-9 Rav were effective, fell within Spokane Police policy, and met department expectations.

Patrol Support:

The actions of the Patrol Officers were effective, within Spokane Police policy, and met department expectations.

SUPERVISORY COMMENTS:

K-9 Supervisor Comments:

Officer Lesser responded to assist with locating a suspect that had fled on foot from a stolen vehicle. The suspect (Cruz) was last seen running into a residential area during the hours of darkness. Prior to deployment of K-9 Rav several K-9 announcements were conducted by perimeter Officers and Officer Lesser. Officer Lesser deployed K-9 Rav to search for and locate Cruz. K-9 Rav tracked, located, and apprehended Cruz by contact on his buttocks as he was hiding underneath a parked vehicle. Officer Lesser released K-9 Rav from the contact as soon as it was safe to do so. Cruz was taken into custody without further incident. Cruz admitted hearing the K-9 announcements given by the perimeter units.

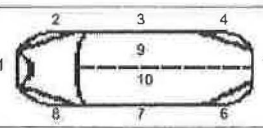

On 12/3/13 at about 0243 hours, I saw the tan Ford Ranger pickup bearing a Montana license plate at about Monroe and Mansfield. I turned off of Monroe to the east on a side street I believe was Mansfield. I saw the tan Ford was westbound on that same side street. I drove by the vehicle and

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saw it was occupied by a single, white male driver. I saw the vehicle continue westbound on that side street, across Monroe.

I recalled that there was a tan Ford pickup on the current list of stolen vehicles. I pulled up the list and saw the pickup on the stolen list had a MT license of 785490A. I turned around and attempted to locate the Ford pickup to see if it was the stolen vehicle.

I traveled down the side street to Jefferson. I looked to the north and saw the Ford pickup had been northbound on Jefferson and was turning back eastbound into the north alley of Montgomery. When I reached that alley I saw that the Ford pickup had been parked in the alley just west of Madison. The vehicle was parked, partially blocking the alley, in a odd place for a vehicle to be parked. It appeared that the driver was attempting to ditch the vehicle and flee on foot. The driver had exited and was starting to walk away to the southeast, out of the alley, toward Madison.

As I drove by the Ford, I confirmed that the plate was the same as the Ford pickup on the current stolen list. I pulled just beyond the pickup, to the end of the alley and saw the driver, later identified as Tyler Cruz, walking in a southeasterly direction, across the yard of the residence on the south side of the alley, facing Madison. I exited my patrol vehicle and announced I was the police and ordered him to stop. Cruz immediately dropped what was in his hands, as well as the backpack he was carrying, and he began to run. I was wearing a patrol uniform and driving a police vehicle that was equipped with push bumper and spot lights.

I yelled for Cruz to stop. I yelled again I was the police and that he was under arrest. Cruz did not stop and he ran southeast, across Madison and then eastbound on the north side of Montgomery. I advised Radio of the incident. I advised that Cruz was a white male wearing a red and white jacket.

Cruz continued to a residence just west of Monroe. He ran between the houses, jumping a fence and out of my view. I ran through another yard to the north alley of 1000 W Montgomery and could not see Cruz. Other units were arriving in the area and began to set up a perimeter. Officer Gobble responded to the location of my car and that of the stolen vehicle. He confirmed with Radio that this was the reported stolen vehicle.

Officer D. Lesser responded to the alley and we began a track of the suspect. Using the K9 we were able to track the suspect to his hiding location. We found Cruz, hiding under a van, in the yard of 1010 W. Carlisle (a block to the north of where I last saw him running). Cruz was still wearing the same red and white jacket that I originally saw him wearing. I saw his face and confirmed it was the same male that had run from me and the vehicle.

We directed Cruz to crawl out from underneath the van. His jacket had got caught on the undercarriage of the vehicle. He had to pull himself out of the jacket and then slide out from under the van. He was directed into a prone position. Due to the fact that he had fled from a stolen vehicle

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and then hid from officers, I did have my weapon out to cover Cruz to ensure he did not attempt to access a weapon and attack officers. I was using a draw and direct technique and had my weapon pointed at the ground near Cruz's position as I directed him into a prone handcuffing position. Officer Lyons responded to our location and assisted with handcuffing Cruz.

After Cruz was removed from the yard, I began to reach under the van to recover his jacket. At that time I saw a baggie of white crystal substance, lying on the ground, just to the northwest of where Cruz's head had been. This was well within his reach at the time we had found Cruz. It was obvious that Cruz had dropped the baggie in that location at the time of his arrest or just prior to the arrest. I requested a photo of the baggie before I collected the item.

Cpl. Busch responded and photographed the item. I recovered the baggie and his coat. The baggie appeared to contain crystal methamphetamine. I saw that the baggie was not dirty or wet and appeared to have just been placed in that location. Officer Lyons would later conduct a field test of that crystal substance and confirm it was methamphetamine. I turned that baggie and his coat over to Officer Lyons who placed the baggie on Property.

I returned to the location where Cruz first fled from me. In the yard where he dropped the items he was carrying I found his backpack and the keys to the stolen Ford pickup lying in that yard. I gave the keys to Officer Gobble who remained with the recovered stolen vehicle until it was towed. Officer Gobble advised that the vehicle's owner was notified by Radio of the recovery. He searched the vehicle based on the owner's consent and did not find any damage or items missing. Both plates were still on the vehicle.

Officer Lyons transported Cruz to Deaconess to be treated for the K9 contact. I responded to Deaconess and gave Officer Lyons Cruz's backpack. Officer Lyons advised me that he had also located some brown/black substance in a container on Cruz that later field tested positive for heroin. See Officer Lyon's report for further. Cruz also advised Officer Lyons that he wished to remain silent. At the hospital I observed that Cruz had several scabs on his face. They appeared to be sores related to prolific meth use.

After treatment, Officer Lyons transported Cruz to jail where he was booked for possession of a stolen motor vehicle, and two counts of possession of a controlled substance (meth and heroin). Cruz was also booked on an outstanding arrest warrant for the charge of 2nd TMVWOP.

I responded to the area of 1100 W. Montgomery to assist Lt Hendren who was in foot pursuit with a suspect that had fled from a stolen vehicle.

I arrived on scene and contacted Lt Hendren in the alley just north of Montgomery and west of Monroe. He stated he has last seen the suspect in the yard just to the south. I had a unit check the license plate and vin of the vehicle that the suspect had ran from and it was confirmed to be stolen.

As I was confirming this I could hear the K9 announcement being broadcasted over the perimeter patrol cars PA system. "ATTENTION IN THE AREA

THIS IS THE SPOKANE POLICE DEPT
SUSPECTS.. YOU ARE UNDER ARREST.
YOU ARE BEING TRACKED BY A POLICE
DOG. WHEN HE FINDS YOU HE WILL
BITE YOU...GIVE UP NOW!
ATTENTION CITIZENS IN THE AREA
STAY IN YOUR HOMES"

I decided to deploy my K9, Rav, for the following reasons. There was probable cause to arrest the suspect for a felony. The suspect was actively resisting and evading arrest by fleeing. He had not been searched and it was unknown if he possessed any weapons. He had refused all verbal commands by Lt Hendren to stop and instead led him on a dangerous foot pursuit through several yards and over fences. It was unknown to what extent of the crimes the suspect may have committed and he definitely showed his willingness to try and evade capture.

I placed Rav at the last known location that Lt Hendren had physically seen the suspect. We began to track north bound towards the alley. I could see that Rav was actively tracking based on his body language and breathing. We crossed the north alley of Montgomery and continued to track to the north.

We crossed Carlisle and then west on Carlisle and then back north through the houses. We entered a backyard and tracked back towards the east. We jumped a 4ft fence into the backyard of 1010 W. Carlisle. We tracked east around the garage and a van that was parked on the east side of it. As we were tracking past the van Rav suddenly stopped and dove underneath the van and contacted the suspect.

I heard the suspect yell. I looked under the van and as soon as I could see the suspect's hands were clear of any weapons I had Rav release the contact. The suspect was having some difficulty crawling out from under the van and had snagged his coat on a part of the under carriage.

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The suspect had to wiggle out of his jacket to get out from under the van.

The suspect was taken into custody by Ofc Lyons and Lt Hendren. It appeared that Rav had contacted the suspect on the right buttocks. The suspect was identified as Tyler Cruz and he showed to have a valid felony warrant for his arrest. A search of the area underneath the van where Cruz was hiding officers located a controlled substance (see their reports for further info).

Ofc Lyons transported Cruz to Deaconess. I noticed that when I got Cruz out of the backseat of the patrol vehicle he had multiple wounds on his face. I asked him if those were from hiding under the van and he said no. He stated that it was caused from him taking methamphetamine which then caused him to pick at his face.

Cruz's injuries consisted of several rakes on the right buttocks that were cleaned. I noticed that he had two scratches on his back which appeared to have been caused from scraping his back on the underside of the van. He also had a large scab on his left knee that was not caused by the k9.

Cpl Ennis responded and took photographs of all of Cruz's visible injuries. Sgt Kendall was also advised of the contact.

Cruz's injuries were cleaned and released to be booked.

Cruz stated he could hear the announcement being given over the public address systems of the patrol vehicles.
