

Summary:

Ofc J Kernkamp made a stop on a Bicyclist at North Foothills and Perry. The subject [later id'd as Kness] stated he did not have id and said his name is Chris Murphy. He was asked to spell his name and he spelled it Chirs and gave a DOB of 010783. Kness stated he was 24 years old which did not add up with the date of birth given. Kernkamp was unable to locate the subject in DOL or locally with the information given. He then told Kernkamp he could follow him to his address but could not give an address. Kernkamp determined that the subject was lying about his name.

Kernkamp went to place Kness in handcuffs and he took off riding his bike. He rode n/b on Perry past Euclid and ran the red light at Perry and North Foothills and rode into oncoming traffic. Kernkamp activated his emergency lights and siren following the Kness. Kernkamp was able to catch Kness at Madelia and Euclid where he had stopped. Kness told Kernkamp he did not want to go back to jail. Kernkamp told Kness he was under arrest.

Kernkamp ordered him to put his hands behind his back but Kness tried to take off again. However do to the icey conditions he struggled to ride away. Kernkamp stopped his partol vehilce and exited it while Kness was attempting to ride away. Kness rode into the front of the stopped unoccupied patrol vehicle and lost his balance. Kness was attempting to ride away but was struggling do to the extreme icey conditions. Kernkamp was able to catch up to Kness and tackled him to the ground while giving verbal commands of, "Stop Police.". Kness was placed in the prone cuffing postion and handcuffed.

Kness started complaining of injuring his right knee. Kernkamp requested medics and a supervisor.

I arrived and saw Kness lying on ground handcuffed, yelling how he could not straighten out his leg. He was rolling from side to side moving both of his legs.

I asked him what happened and he said the officer contacted him for not wearing a bike helmet and asked for his id. He said he told the officer he did not have any and the officer could follow him to his residence and he took off. I asked him why he did not stop when told to by the officer and he did not answer. He reluctantly said he lives at 2100 N Crestline. I told him that if that was the case then he was riding the wrong way. He said the officer hit him with his car.

I looked at the bicycle and the front of Kernkamps vehicle but did not see any damage to either. Cpl Hagar responded and took photos of the SPD vehicle #363, the bicycle and Kness. Medics arrived and cut Kness pants and long underwear to look at he right knee. I did not see any injuries to Kness's right leg. I stood by and watched the medics to their assesment and they advise they could not find any injury. Kness stated he had a prior knee injury. Kness was transported to to Holy Family hospital. They did not find any new injuries. Kness advised he had surgery on his right knee and may have re-injured it.

Kness was stopped for riding a bicycle without a helmet. He provided a false name and date of birth and rode off when instructed by the Officer to put his hands behind his back. Kness rode away from the officer and continued to try and get away after being told to stop. Kernkamp used his lights and sirens to give auditory and visual notice to Kness that he was being stopped. Kernkamp used a take down technique to remove Kness from his bicycle. He then used prone cuffing to take him into custody.

Officer Kernkamp conducted a traffic stop on Kness who was riding a bicycle recklessly and wasn't wearing a helmet. Kness who had a warrant lied about his name and took off on his bike. During the chase he made contact with the unoccupied patrol car and was later tackled by

Kernkamp to stop him. He later complained of a knee injury to his right knee that had been injured before. There were no signs of new injury and after a medical check up he was released. The force used by the officer was minimal and within policy.

On 2/2/14 at 1453 hours I observed a male riding his bicycle north bound on Perry from Illinois. The male was weaving through both north and south lanes of traffic as well as riding on the sidewalk on the east side of the road. I also observed the male was not wearing a helmet.

I stopped the male and contacted him at Perry/Buckeye. I asked his name. I saw that he was a middle aged male. He appeared to be nearing 40 yrs old. Initially when I stopped the male he stated his name as "Chris Murphy". I asked him how to spell Chris. He spelled it "C.H.I.R.S.. He gave his DOB as 01/7/83. I know by looking at him that he was older than what he was identifying himself as. I asked the male how old he was. He stated 24. I immediately recognized that he was well over 24 years old. And that he would be over 24 years old.

In addition with the information given. I was unable to find his information in DOL. With the name he gave, there was no local history. All of the above circumstances confirmed he was lying about his name.

He stated I could follow him home and that he had his ID there. He could not tell me where his address was. He later told me he lives at 2100 N. Crestline. I later determined he really lives 2006 E. Courtland #1 (lower level).

The male stated he did not have identification on him and that he had ID out of California and Oregon. Through those states I was still not able to locate a positive ID on him.

When I determined the male was lying about his name I figured he had warrants. Often times, wanted persons are deceitful about their name because they are trying to avoid going to jail. As I went to walk around my patrol car to place the male into handcuffs he started riding his bike at a fast rate of speed, north bound on the sidewalk. He was riding through snow and slush on the sidewalk and continued north bound on Perry, past Euclid, running the red light and riding into oncoming traffic. This caused traffic from both east and west bound lanes to come to a stop to avoid colliding into him.

The male then road his bike east across the median and north through the alley as I was trying to get him to stop. At this time I had ran back to my car and activated my patrol car's lights and sirens. The male road through the walkway of an apartment complex and then crossed Euclid south bound

again, still running from my patrol car.

The male road south on Madelia and continued to avoid my contact. Just south of Euclid on Madelia the male stopped on his bike and said, "I don't want to go back to jail." It was clear he was attempting to run from the Police.

I told him he was under arrest and gave him the verbal commands to place his hands behind his back. As I ran up to contact him, the male, later identified as Richard Kness, started riding his bike away from me again, at a fast rate of speed. I got back into my patrol car and saw that the male was struggling to keep his balance on the icy road conditions as he tried riding away again.

While my vehicle was stopped he road his bike parallel across the front of my car and collided with my stopped, unoccupied car. At this time I was standing at my door. This caused him to temporarily lose his balance however he was able to recover.

The male continued to try and ride south bound on Madelia towards Buckeye. Because of the time delay with him riding his bike into my patrol car. I was able to move around my patrol car and close distance on him. He still tried riding south bound, yelling, "I don't want to go back to jail."

I caught up to the male and continued to give him verbal commands, "stop, Police." He refused to stop. To avoid having him run into the yards and place citizens and homeowners in any danger I tackled him to the ground. Once on the ground I placed him into the prone cuffing position and handcuffed (DL). I informed the male he was under arrest. He identified himself as Richard Kness. He had a Felony Warrant for Possession of Stolen Property in the 1st Degree. I arrested, handcuffed (DL) and searched him.

In his right rear pocket was his Washington State ID.

Locally Kness has numerous contacts for theft and possession of stolen property.

Once in handcuffs Kness started complaining of a sore right knee. He stated he had surgery on it before and felt he may have re-injured it while running from the Police. AMR responded and transported him to Holy Family to be cleared for jail booking. He was cleared for booking without any new injuries.

Cpl. Hager responded to the scene and photographed the overall scene.

Sgt. Gately responded to the scene and contacted Kness. I informed him of the above.
