On 020914 at just before 2023 hrs, I observed a silver 2 door Honda Accord WB on 2nd Ave approaching Altamont. I was stopped for a red light on Altamont at 2nd Ave. I was driving SPD patrol car #369 which is fully equipped with emergency lights and audible sirens. I was also wearing my SPD issued uniform of the day. The Accord made a left (SB) turn on to Altamont. This Accord looked familiar to me and I believed it to be the same vehicle that I had information was being driven by a local TOP offender in our community. The TOP offender was John J Beck (aka-Whiteaker). I was also aware that Beck had two outstanding Felony Warrants for his arrest.

I was able to see the rear license plate as WA lic AHU9341. I checked the plate through WA DOL and confirmed it was in fact the same Accord as noted above. The driver of the Accord turned in to the Zip Trip gas station at 302 S Altamont, failing to use the turn signal 100 feet prior to the turn in to the gas station. The vehicle also had a Failure to Transfer Title within 45 days violation.

A short time later I pulled in to the lot in preparation to conduct a traffic stop on the driver of the Accord due to the traffic infraction and my information that Beck was likely driving the Accord. I positioned my patrol car directly behind the Accord's rear bumper to prevent any attempted escape. I immediately could see what appeared to be frantic movement from the male driver. I moved up on the Accord quickly and drew my duty weapon to the low ready position (depressed muzzle pointed at ground). I could see in to the car well enough to identify the driver as John J Beck (042880). I observed Beck briefly place the transmission in to reverse to flee. However, he observed my patrol car blocking him and so he placed it back in park.

I began making several announcements of, "Spokane Police" & "John you are under arrest for your warrants." John appeared to be digging in his pockets making several furtive movements within the car as he began moving to the passenger seat and then back to the driver seat. It appeared he was either targeting me or looking for the best door to exit out of. After several back and forths jumping seat to seat, it appeared he was going to make it out of the passenger door. As I made it over to the

passenger door, he was able to quickly get out of the driver's door and run SW through the alley behind the Zip Trip.

Due to the snowy and icy conditions and having fallen multiple times lately during my patrol shifts, and because of the large head start that Beck had, I elected to notify SPD dispatch and set up a perimeter. I was also aware Beck had prior arrest(s) for firearm violations in addition to other cooperative individuals repeatedly claiming Beck is usually armed with guns. So I elected to set a perimeter and attempt a track with a K9 for obvious Officer safety reasons.

I took a brief position at 4th & Altamont in my patrol car in an effort to keep Beck locked down west of Altamont. K9 Lesser was nearby and responded very quickly. I joined him at the alley where I last saw Beck running WB. Meanwhile other SPD units were arriving and taking perimeter positions.

K9 Ofc Lesser and I began the K9 track of Beck. See K9 Ofc Lesser's report for information regarding the track and eventual K9 contact in the carport of 428 S Altamont where Beck was taken in to custody.

After the K9 contact, I was able to move to the north side of the carport and safely pull Beck under the tarp of the carport where I guided him to the prone cuffing position. I again stated, "You are under arrest." I placed him in handcuffs (dl). I asked him why he ran and he replied, "I didn't want to go back to jail." I escorted Beck to a waiting patrol car on 4th Avenue where he was searched ncident to arrest and eventually placed in the back of Cpl Oien's patrol car. Cpl Oien immediately transported Beck to Deaconess Medical Center to receive treatment for the K9 contact.

I re-walked the track looking for any potential items of evidence that Beck could have dropped or tried to hide. I did not locate any items. I returned to the Accord where it was legally parked in the lot of the Zip Trip. There was nothing further that could be done with the Accord from a law enforcement standpoint. The Accord was left secured in the lot.

Sgt Eckersley was onscene and made aware of the entire incident/arrest.

I responded to Deaconess where Beck was being treated. At no time during his initial treatment at Deaconess did he make any statements regarding trying to cooperate and give up peacefully prior to the K9 contact. This was consistent with the fact that as I was present during the contact, and never heard Beck make any attempt to make himself known and show himself to Officers to be safely taken in to custody.

A rotation of Officers is going to take place keeping Beck in custody until medical staff clear Beck for Jail booking. Beck will be booked on both valid and confirmed warrants. One being a DOC Escape Warrant and the other being a Felony PCS warrant.

I responded to 3rd and Altamont to assist Ofc Daniels who had a suspect run from him on foot west bound in the alley just south of 3rd and Altamont.

While enroute it was confirmed that the suspect, John Beck, had two confirmed felony warrants. One of the felony warrants was a DOC Escape warrant with a no bond. The original charges were Trafficking in Stolen Property and Possession of a Controlled Substance with intent to Deliver. The second felony warrant was for Dangerous Drugs.

#3a

I arrived on scene and contacted Ofc Daniels. He stated he had seen Beck at the Zip Trip at 3rd and Altamont in the parking lot. He pulled in behind him and approached the car. Ofc Daniels said he had Beck at gun point and at first Beck attempted to back up and flee in the car but could not ecause Ofc Daniels car was blocking his escape. While inside the car Beck repeatedly was digging in his pockets.

Ofc Daniels said the Beck eventually got of the car and fled on foot west bound in the alley. I decided to deploy my K9, Rav for the following reasons. Beck had two confirmed felony

warrants for his arrest. He had refused all commands given to him by Ofc Daniels to include that he was under arrest and at first attempted to flee in his vehicle and eventually ran on foot west bound in the alley. Beck had not been searched and it was unknown if he possessed any type of weapons. Beck had been arrested in the past for Unlawful Possession of a Firearm and Possession of a Stolen Firearm. I asked Ofc Daniels what Beck was wearing and it was a bulky coat. The same coat that Beck was reaching into while he was in the vehicle when Ofc Daniels was given him commands.

Beck was actively resisting and attempting to evade arrest. It was unknow to what extreme he would go to evade capture and could place the general public at risk along with searching officers.

I placed Rav at the last known location of the track. I gave a K9 announcement warning. I also checked with radio to ensure that they had sent out the K9 warning announcements to the perimeter units and they had. "ATTENTION IN THE AREA

We began tracking west bound in the alley and then back eastbound on 4th. Ofc Daniels spoke with a neighbor who had last seen the suspect running along the west side of a duplex going southbound mid block. As soon as we entered that yard I could see that Rav was actively tracking based on his body language and breathing. We continued south across the alley and I could confirm that Rav was on the track based on the fresh footprints in the snow.

We continued to track out to 5th Street and around the front of the house to the east side. Rav jumped a small fence and then jumped another fence that led us into the back yard of 428 S. Altamont. We tracked along the west side of the car port and then into the car port itself. I shined my flashlight into the car port and didn't see anyone. Rav went along the driver's side of the vehicle and when he went around the front I heard the suspect, Beck, start to yell. It appears that Beck was crouched down to avoid detection.

I turned my flashlight on and told the suspect to show me his hands. Beck continued to yell and thrash around. I told him a couple of times to stop flailing and to stop fighting the dog. As soon as I could see that his hands were clear I moved up along side the vehicle and had Rav release the contact. The area we were in was so confining that Ofc Daniels could not help take the suspect into custody. I had him go back outside and come in from the back and took Beck out the back underneath the tarp and Ofc Daniels took him into custody.

I estimated that Rav was on the contact for approximately 5-10 seconds and a distance of about 20 ft.

We walked Beck out to the street and Cpl Oien transported Beck to Deaconess Hospital.

I responded to Deaconess to check on Beck's injuries. His injuries consisted of several punctures and rakes. It appears that during the contact and struggle Beck turned his leg causing what appeared to be a laceration (about 4-5 inches) on the inner right calf exposing the calf muscle. He also had a smaller laceration on the top of the right shin bone. He had what appeared to be a puncture on the top of the right outside shin area and two more punctures on the back of the calf towards the knee. He also had what appeared to be multiple rakes on the front of the lower right leg below the knee.

The doctor at Deaconess determined it would be better to take him into surgery to clean up the contact and then stitch it.

While at the hospital I asked Beck why he didn't just give up when he heard us coming and he said he did. I asked him if he heard the K9 warning announcement and he said no. However when I went back and looked through the CAD history it showed that Ofc Dunkin, D372, made the K9 warning at 2037 hours at 5th and Altamont. We did not located the suspect till 2042 hours at 428 S. Altamont which was less that 25 yards away from D372 who was parked in the intersection and had given the announcement. That gave Beck a full five minutes to walk less than 25 yards and surrender to the police car with it's emergency lights activated.

At no time did Beck make any statements before being located by the K9.

Sgt Kendall and Sgt Eckersley was notified of the K9 contact along with Lt Sprague. While at

END OF ADDITIONAL REPORT

Incident Summary:

At approx. 2023 on 2/9/14 Officer Lesser responded to the area of 3rd and Altamont to assist Patrol Anti-Crime Team member, Officer Daniel.

Officer Daniel Observed a vehicle that is known to be driven by Whiteaker (AKA Beck). Whiteaker is known to the PACT Team and is listed as one the communities "Top Offenders". Ofc. Daniel was also aware that Whiteaker had two outstanding Felony arrest warrants. The vehicle pulled into the Zip Trip parking lot at 3rd and Altamont.

Wearing his uniform of the day, Ofc. Daniel positioned his patrol vehicle with his emergency lights activated behind Whiteaker's vehicle. Ofc. Daniel detained the driver for some minor traffic violations and because he had information that Whiteaker was likely driving the vehicle. He parked in close proximity to the vehicle eliminating any attempts for the driver to back up and evade arrest in the vehicle. Mobile resistance poses great risk to the subject, officers as well as the community.

Ofc. Daniel was now close enough to recognize the driver as Whiteaker. He exited his patrol car and yelled to Whiteaker, "Spokane Police. John you are under arrest for your warrants." Whiteaker began digging and moving about the front passenger compartment in what Ofc. Daniel described as "Frantic movement". He also observed Whiteaker reaching into his coat pockets as he refused to comply with commands. Ofc. Daniel drew his firearm at the low ready. Whiteaker was moving back and forth between the front driver and passenger seats. At one point he placed the car in reverse possibly preparing to escape with the vehicle. Ofc. Daniel's tactics eliminated this option for him.

Whiteaker managed to climb out the front driver's door of the vehicle and flee S/W around the west side of the business down an alley.

The area Whiteaker chose to escape into was dimly lit, covered with snow and contained numerous hiding and ambush locations. He was also aware of Whiteaker's criminal history which contained firearms violations. Ofc. Daniel advised dispatch to set up a perimeter so that a K-9 tracking team could be utilized in locating Whiteaker.

Ofc. Daniel moved his vehicle to 4th and Altamont in an attempt to help contain Whiteaker.

Ofc. Lesser arrived on scene and was briefed on the incident by Ofc. Daniel.

Ofc. Lesser deployed K-9 Rav for the following reasons:

- Crime:
 - Whiteaker had two confirmed Felony warrants for his arrest. (DOC Escape and PCS)
- Threats:
 - Whiteaker had an extensive criminal history to include unlawful possession of a firearm and possession of a stolen firearm.
 - Whiteaker had made numerous "Frantic movements" during his resistance described by Ofc. Daniel. These movements could have involved arming himself especially the description of putting his hands in his pockets during earlier resistance.
 - Whiteaker had not been searched. It was unknown if he was armed with firearms, edged or improvised weapons.

- The area he chose to flee into contained numerous hiding/ambush locations with little to no lighting.
- The ground was covered with snow and ice making slip and fall hazards very dangerous and putting officers in a vulnerable position.
- The direction he ran is primarily residential posing great risk to the unaware public.
- Resistance:
 - Whiteaker refused to comply with Ofc. Daniel's attempts to detain him.
 - o He attempted to flee in the vehicle only stopped by Ofc. Daniel's vehicle positioning.
 - He fled on foot away from Ofc. Daniel who was wearing a police uniform and driving a police vehicle.
 - He continued to resist by not complying with Ofc. Lesser's K-9 Announcement or the multiple other announcements made by perimeter officers over vehicle PA.
 - Ofc. Lesser also noted that one of these PA announcements was made within 25 yards of Whiteaker's hiding/ambush location 5 minutes before being located. More than enough time to exit this hiding/ambush spot and give up.

Ofc. Lesser placed Rav in Whiteaker's last known location. Rav tracked S/B and then slightly E/B. Rav located Whiteaker hiding behind a car near a fence and large tarp at S. 428 Altamont. Ofc. Lesser described this area as extremely confined. There was only room for the suspect, Ofc. Lesser and Rav. Rav had made contact with Whiteaker's lower right calf area. Whiteaker was yelling and thrashing around. Ofc. Lesser ordered Whiteaker to show his hands and to stop fighting the dog. Once Ofc. Lesser observed Whiteaker's hands were clear he ordered Rav to release the contact which he did immediately.

Due to the tight quarters Ofc. Daniel had come in from a different location where Whiteaker was taken into custody without further incident.

Ofc. Lesser estimated that contact duration was 5-10 seconds.

Whiteaker was transported to Deaconess MC for treatment due to K-9 contact. Ofc. Lesser advised that there was 4-5 inch laceration to his calf exposing the calf muscle. This injury was out of the norm to the majority of K-9 contacts. Ofc. Lesser described potential contributing factors. The tight quarters, Whiteaker's thrashing and resistance during the contact and that it appeared that Whiteaker had turned his leg against the K-9 contact causing the laceration.

Deaconess MC chose to keep Whiteaker at the facility so that they could properly treat him. Whiteaker was released and booked on a later date after treatment.

Whiteaker stated that he heard the tracking team approaching but he denied hearing any K-9 announcements. Even the announcement made within 25 yards of his location over a police vehicle PA.

After speaking with the involved officers and reading the incident documentation I find that Ofc. Lesser's deployment of K-9 Rav was within Department Policy, State and Federal Laws and met Department expectations.
