On 021014 at approx 2129hrs I responded to a Warrant call at 2211 E Central. While enroute, I read the call and viewed the suspect, Raymond Cordero's SPRS photo. While reading the call I learned the complainant David Emerson called in to report seeing Cordero enter 2211 E Central and hadn't left yet. Emerson was aware of Cordero's warrants and wanted to assist police. Cordero had a confirmed outstanding felony warrant for 2nd degree Assault.

Upon arrival, I took a position in the neighbor's back yard, so I could see the back of 2211 E Central as other officers knocked on the door. The back yard of 2211 was completely fenced by either a 6' or 8' chain link fence. The fencing was covered by tarps, making it hard to see into the yard. I was hesitant to position myself in the back yard because Cordero was suppose to have several aggressive dogs, so I remained in the neighbor's yard. Almost as soon as I got back there, Cordero opened the back door and let his dogs out. I was able to immediately recognize him from his SPRS photo. I didn't confront Cordero because I was still waiting for other officers to arrive as back up. Cordero went back inside.

A short time later, back up arrived and covered the front of the house. Marked SPD patrol cars were parked in front of the residence. Cpl Cordis, Ofc Lesser and Ofc Donaldson approached the front of the house and started knocking loudly and identified themselves as Spokane Police. I was all the way behind the house and I could clearly hear the loud knocking and announcements.

Ofc Lesser is a K9 officer as well. From the back of the house, I clearly heard K9 Lesser make several K9 announcements from the front of the house. I heard Ofc Lesser announce he was the Spokane Police K9 Unit, he told Cordero he was under arrest for confirmed outstanding felony warrants, and he ordered Cordero to peaceably exit the front of the residence. Ofc Lesser made this announcement several times. As Ofc Lesser continually made K9 announcements, I observed the back door open and Cordero ran out of it very quickly. Cordero was sprinting northbound through his backyard, towards the fence line separating his yard from the neighbor's.

I deployed SPD K9 Maximus for the following reasons;

Cordero had a confirmed, outstanding Felony warrant for 2nd degree Assault (with a deadly weapon).

Cordero posed a large risk to the public and to the responding/searching officers. Cordero had a violent past, which includes arrests for Felony Assaults, Assaults with deadly weapons, Domestic Assaults, Burglary, Drugs and more. Cordero had recently been arrested for the assault with a deadly weapon, so it should be assumed he would be armed again. He had not been searched and just fled from his residence, so odds were high he was armed.

Cordero knew the Police were there, and he must have heard the commands because he fled out the back door. Cordero exited the residence very quickly, and almost made it to the back fence line. He started to climb the fence to the neighbors yard. If Cordero would have made it into the neighbor's yard, it would have been more dangerous to track for him vs. getting him to stop in his own yard.

I assisted K9 Max over the 6' chain link fence and gave him the command to stop Cordero. By this point, Cordero was climbing on a small pile of debris and was attempting to climb onto a neighbors garage that was on the fence line. K9 max immediately caught Cordero and contacted him on his right leg, above the ankle and below the knee. Cordero immediately reached down and attempted to pry K9 Max's mouth off his leg. Cordero failed and finally stopped fighting with Max as I arrived. Cordero was cooperative and showed his hands were clear. I gave Max the command to release and he did so immediately. Cordero was detained (DL). I was approx 25 feet from Cordero as K9 Max contacted him, and he contacted him for approx 15 seconds.

I contacted a witness Kristin B Price, who is Cordero's girlfriend. She advised she was in the bathroom when the Police arrived. She heard all the announcements made by K9 D Lesser. She doesn't know why Cordero would run out the back door, because she thought he heard the announcements too.

Cordero was transported to Deaconess for treatment of his injuries. Injuries consisted of two small bruises on the middle finger on his left hand. Cordero also had several small punctures on the front and back of his lower right leg. By the shape of the injuries, it was obvious K9 Max held one contact location, even though Cordero admited trying to fight with K9 Max. He was treated and released, no stitching required. Injuries were photographed my Cpl Cordis. Sgt McNab was advised of the contact.

Cordero was transported to Spokane County Jail and booked on the warrant.

Incident Summary #14-43589

At approximately 2058 on 2/10/14, Emerson called police stating that Raymond Cordero was at E. 2211 Central Ave. Emerson was told to call police if Cordero showed up at the residence because he has warrants.

Dispatch confirmed that Cordero had a Felony Warrant for 2nd Degree Assault. They also confirmed that the E. 2211 Central address was on the warrant for Cordero.

Officer Gorman responded to the E. Central address with Cpl. Cordis, Officer Lesser and Officer Donaldson.

Officer Gorman arrived on scene before the other listed officers. He took a position in an adjacent neighbor's back yard with his K-9 partner Maximus. Officer Gorman described the target addresses back yard as completely fenced with 6 and 8 foot chain link. He also noted that several walls of the fence were covered with tarps making visibility very difficult.

While waiting for other officers, Officer Gorman heard and observed the back door open. Cordero opened the back door and gave the house pets a break. Officer Gorman immediately recognized Cordero from an observed SPRS photo prior to arrival. Officer Gorman did not contact Cordero at this time. He was still alone as other officers had not arrived yet.

Cpl. Cordis, Officer Lesser and Officer Donaldson arrived on scene. Officer Gorman advised them that he had observed Cordero in the home. Officer Lesser knocked loudly on the front door with Officer Donaldson and Cpl. Cordis. He identified them as police officers. Officer Lesser continued to knock and ordered Cordero to peaceably exit the home and that he was under arrest. There was no response. Officer Lesser then made K-9 announcements. He advised Cordero that he was under arrest and that a Police Dog was present and that he may be bitten if he did not comply. Officer Lesser repeated this announcement several times. Cordero still refused to come out peaceably.

Officer Gorman was still maintaining containment in the adjacent neighboring back yard. Officer Gorman advised that, although he was on the other side of the property, he could clearly hear Officer Lesser's announcements.

During the latter announcement Cordero exited the back door and ran N/B through his back yard towards an adjacent neighboring yard.

Officer Gorman deployed K-9 Maximus at this point for the following reasons:

- Crime:
 - Cordero had Felony Warrant for his arrest for 2nd Degree Assault (With a deadly weapon).
- Threats:
 - Cordero was fleeing through his own back yard giving him a distinct advantage of the terrain and potential improvised weapon locations. This fence line was mostly covered making the yard terrain full of unknowns.
 - o He had not been searched and was wanted on a warrant involving a deadly weapon.
 - Cordero had an extensive criminal history including violence: Felony Assaults, Assaults with Deadly Weapons, DV Assaults, Burglary and PCS.

- He was an athletic individual demonstrated by his ability to run fast and nearly negotiate a fence line.
- He was running towards an unsuspected neighboring property. This could put them at risk of being victimized by Cordero displayed by his efforts to escape detainment.
- Any time an officer is forced to negotiate an obstacle it puts him or her in a very vulnerable position if active resistance turns assaultive. (Climb Fences)
- Resistance:
 - Cordero actively resisted arrest by refusing to comply with multiple orders to exit the home and give up peaceably. He compounded this resistance when they force used to apprehend him was explained in detail. (K-9 Announcement)
 - \circ $\;$ He fled on foot towards a neighboring property.
 - He continued to resist apprehension as he attempted to free himself from Maximus' contact. (Explained later.)

Officer Gorman assisted Maximus over the fence and ordered him to apprehend Cordero. Maximus closed space as Cordero was begin to climb the north fence line and then onto the roof of the neighbor's garage. Maximus contacted the right rear calf area of Cordero stopping his efforts to flee. Cordero reached down with his left hand and attempted to pry Maximus' mouth off of the described contact. Cordero was unsuccessful and stopped fighting with the dog. Cordero was taken into custody without further incident.

Officer Gorman contacted Price who was inside the home during the incident. She stated that she heard all of the described K-9 announcements. She did not know why Cordero ran out the back door because she thought he heard the announcements as well.

Cordero was transported to Deaconess MC for treatment for the described K-9 contact. Cordero was treated for minor bruising on his left hand fingers and small punctures on the back of his right calf area. None of the injuries required stitches or significant treatment.

Cordero gave no statement to Officer Gorman.

He was booked on the 2nd Degree Assault Felony Warrant.

After interviewing involved officers and reviewing the documents of this incident I find that Officer Gorman's deployment of Maximus was within Department Policy, SOP's, State and Federal Laws and met Department expectations.
