Incident Summary

Ofc. Spiering responded to assist officers that were in foot pursuit of suspects from a shots fired call. The suspects had crashed their vehicle after driving recklessly through downtown trying to evade officers that were in the area. No officers were ever involved in a pursuit.

Ofc. Spiering located one of the suspects hiding in the Chili's restaurant at 207 W. Spokane Falls Blvd. In his report he said, "Due to the nature of the call originating from gunshots, I had my firearm drawn and at the low ready," as he entered Chili's. He saw a male sitting at a table that was holding a menu up and "breathing very heavily." When they saw each other, "The male dropped the menu and then his hands, moving his hand out of sight and under the table."

Ofc. Spiering wrote, "The H/M fit the description briefly given by officers as fleeing on foot from that vehicle, had been seen entering the same restaurant in which he was sitting, and was visibly out of breath as if from running. Upon seeing police, he had dropped his hands out of sight and right in front of him, and he was earing [sic] baggy clothing easily able to conceal a firearm(s)." He then pointed his firearm at the male's chest as a WSP Trooper was giving him commands to put his hands up.

The male complied and was taken into custody. He was booked on multiple Felony charges. No one was injured in this use-of-force.

This use-of-force is reasonable and within policy. Ofc. Spiering showed great restraint with this minimal use-of-force.

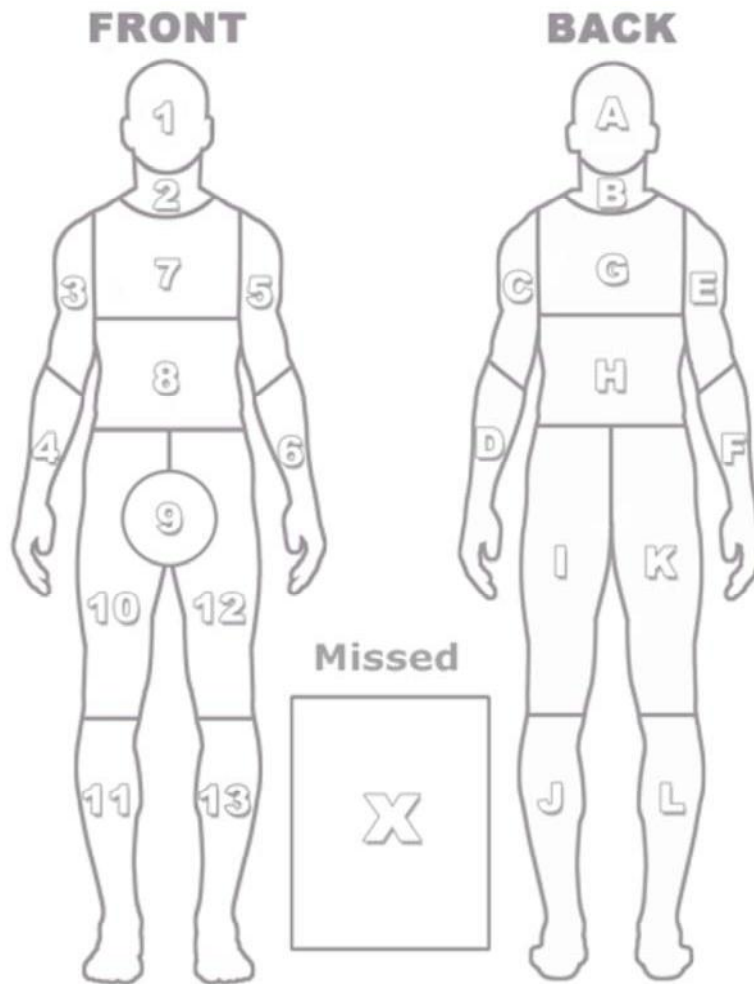

On 011414 at about 1122 hours, I responded to 1814 W Gardner, reference a report of a shot being fired in the alley behind 1814 W Gardner. Upon arrival the suspect vehicle was gone so I contacted complainant, #1a. She stated she was at her door which is very close to the alley when she heard a loud pop, she said, "It sounded like a small gun being shot." She then looked through her back gate and could see what she described as a H/M, medium build, wearing a black jacket and a long white t-shirt underneath. She said, "He was yelling, I shot it, I shot it!" She also saw feet on the other side of the vehicle but couldn't see the rest of the body and what appeared to be feet sticking out the driver's side passenger side. All she could see of the feet was that they were wearing white athletic shoes with red and black on the shoes. That the vehicle the H/M was standing next to, at the open driver's side door, was a newer, last few years, Infinity smaller SUV that was brown in color. That the vehicle left W/B in the alley then N/B on Elm.

I then talked to her husband #1a. He stated he came out after hearing the gun shot and saw the suspect vehicle leaving W/B in the alley. He also described it as a Brown newer Infinity SUV.

I contacted several neighbors, who all told me they heard one gun shot in the alley but didn't see anyone. They are #1a who was visiting at #1d, #1a and #1d.

In the alley both witnesses #1a and #1a showed me the tire tracks to where the suspect vehicle was parked in the alley and how what appeared to be fresh tracks went W/B down the alley. Ofc. Stewart and I checked across the alley from where the suspect vehicle was parked and found what appeared to be a freshly sitting shell casing. Cpl Ferguson responded and photographed the tire prints and shell casing. Ofc. Stewart collection the shell casing see his additional report.

I then transported witness #1a to identify the suspect. When we were across the street on Spokane Falls Blvd she immediately said, "Yeah thats him thats the Hispanic guy I saw by the drivers door." We then drove by the brown Infinity and she also stated that was the vehicle she saw in the alley when the shooting took place.

On 01/14/2014 at about 1125 hours, I responded to the area of Main/Browne to assist officers with a vehicle crash and shooting. An initial call had come in at [REDACTED] #1d of a gunshot, and vehicle taking off. Sgt. Vigesaa had located a possible suspect vehicle, and that vehicle took off from him at high rate of speed, crashing at Main/Browne. Two males had then fled on foot from that vehicle. One male was described as a B/M, the other a H/M with a dark hoody.

As I reached that area, I heard a unit advise that the H/M may have gone into the Chili's restaurant at 207 W. Spokane Falls Blvd., which is right where I was while enroute Main/Browne. I saw WSP trooper Spencer (#1152) running up to the front door, and joined him.

Spencer and I entered the restaurant. Due to the nature of the call originating from gunshots, I had my firearm drawn and at the low ready. As I entered the restaurant, a female employee at the front door pointed to the back of the restaurant towards the bathrooms. Trooper Spencer and I ran towards that area, and then saw a H/M wearing large black pea style coat and brown ball cap sitting at a table by himself. The male was holding a menu up, but was breathing very heavy and appeared out of breath. At about the same time I saw the male, he looked right at me. The male dropped the menu and then his hands, moving his hands out of sight and under the table.

The call I was assisting with was gunshots from an alley, and an associated vehicle fleeing police from that area. The H/M fit the description briefly given by officers as fleeing on foot from that vehicle, had been seen entering the same restaurant in which he was sitting, and was visibly out of breath as if from running. Upon seeing police, he had dropped his hands out of sight and right in front of him, and he was wearing baggy clothing easily able to conceal a firearm(s). I did not want to back away from the male and allow him to feel that flight was an option, due to the lunch crowd inside the restaurant.

I pointed my firearm right at the male's chest as Spencer was giving him commands to put his hands up. The male then did so, putting both hands up then dropping his right hand back under the table. I too yelled to get both hands up, and the male did so. Once I saw both hands were clear of weapons (after about 4 seconds), I returned my firearm to the low-ready position. I remained in that cover position as Trooper Spencer took the male into custody (handcuffed, DL). Spencer and I performed a pat-frisk for weapons, and during that frisk I could see several extremely large wads of

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cash forcing the male's front two pants pockets open. The male was later identified as Jesus Valencia.

I walked Valencia out to my patrol car, and there recovered the cash from his pants pockets, placing it into a clear plastic bag to keep it safe. I advised Sgt. Reynolds of the cash, and that I had pointed my firearm at Valencia. Valencia advised me that he had \$5000 cash with him. Cpl. Bartlett photographed the cash in the bag.

Several Show-ups were conducted with witnessed brought to my location to view Valencia. Each time, Valencia was standing outside the patrol car. Each time I placed his coat and hat back on, which is how he looked when contacted by police.

After positive identifications of Valencia, I spoke with Cpl. McCullough who advised me that PC existed to arrest Valencia for Drive By shooting.

I returned #1a to the scene.



They also added that Lloyd is an associate of two very violent gangs in Stockton. Stockton PD told me the two gangs are Flyboys and Smack Team. They advised individuals commonly swap gangs and intermix. Stockton PD advised Lloyd has a very violent history in CA.

I arrived in the area within about two minutes of the initial broadcast. The witness described hearing what sounded like a gunshot and a male saying, "I shot something". The witness described

I saw that the driver was a black male in his 20's, wearing a white shirt. When I reached Elm I saw that there were what looked like fresh tire tracks coming out of the west end of the alley. The tracks turn n/b and then e/b on Boone. I believed that the Infinity SUV was possibly the suspect vehicle.

At that point I heard Sgt. Vigesaa advise that he was behind the Infinity SUV as it was s/b across the Maple Street bridge.

I then responded to that area as Sgt. Vigesaa advised that the Infinity was e/b on Main. Sgt. Vigesaa advised that the vehicle had taken off on him and he was not pursuing.

The Infinity was involved in a collision at Main/Browne and two occupants had ran from the vehicle. Sgt. Vigesaa advised that he had detained one of the suspects in front of Fast Eddy's at Division/Spokane Falls Blvd. Sgt. Vigesaa advised that the second suspect had ran e/b towards the Travel Lodge.

When I arrived in the area I saw Trooper Spencer on foot near the travel lodge. A witness had given information that the male had ran w/b, towards Chili's restaurant. Another witness advised that the male had ran into the Chili's restaurant. Trooper Spencer and other Officers took the second suspect, Jesus Valencia, into custody inside the restaurant.

I responded to Sgt. Vigesaa's location at Spokane Falls/Division. I saw the male that he had detained, Lloyd Brice. This was the male I had seen driving the Infinity on West Boone.

I then responded to the collision scene and identified the Infinity as the same one I had seen on W. Boone.

n 01-14-14, at 1127 hrs., I assisted officers in the downtown core reference a drive-by shooting call. A gun had been thrown out of a vehicle and located at 331 W. Main. I responded there to secure the weapon.

I arrived and found SRO **#1a** standing by with the pistol, which was in the right lane of Main. **#1a** was driving by, heard the radio traffic and then flagged down by people who found the gun. **#1a** hadn't moved the pistol from its position. **#1a** did move the magazine, which was out of the pistol. He told me that it was originally in the center of the center lane, but he kicked it closer to the pistol so it would not get run over by traffic.

Cpl. Bartlett arrived to photograph and collect the pistol. He noted that it was a black, .40 cal semi-

auto pistol. There were no rounds in the pistol, in the magazine or the surrounding area.

I spoke with #1a who works at 331 W. Main. #1a was outside and witnessed the gun being thrown out of a vehicle. He described the vehicle as being a rust colored, newer SUV, possibly a Nissan Murano. He said the car was traveling very fast as it went by eastbound. The gun came out the passenger side window. #1a could only remember one of the vehicle's occupants was wearing a white T-shirt. He didn't know if it was the driver or passenger.

Pedestrians directed me to where a second pistol had been found in the street, a block west of my location. I responded and contacted witnesses in front of 421 W. Main. The witnesses were construction workers from a project below COPS Downtown.

#1a had been standing in a large construction garbage bin in the parking lane of the street, when he was struck in the back of the leg by an object. He looked down and saw a pistol magazine on the floor of the dumpster. He did not see the vehicle, but said he could hear the acceleration of an engine, eastbound. He looked around more and found a small black semi-auto pistol in the street, just outside the dumpster. Cpl. Bartlett photographed and collected the pistol and magazine. Again, there were no rounds located for the pistol.

#1a and #1a are also construction workers and witnessed the incident. They described the vehicle racing by as being dark blue. They described it as a small, modern SUV. Each saw the vehicle speed by and something being thrown out, later found to be a pistol. Neither could describe the occupants.

I was next sent to the downtown precinct, where I contacted witness, #1a #1a had already filled out a witness statement form for Sgt. Yamada. #1a told me that he was walking on Main near the Pita Pit (SW corner of Main/Wall). He saw a dark brown or copper, newer crossover vehicle speed by eastbound. He saw the driver throw something out of the vehicle, later realizing it was a pistol. (See witness statement for details)

#1a agreed to do a show up for me, so I transported him to two different locations for that. While en route, we drove by the involved collision scene. #1a saw a copper colored Infiniti SUV at the crash site and said he was positive that it was the vehicle involved. The first show-up location was on Spokane Falls, just west of Division. #1a could not positively identify that person, saying that he was not sure. We went to the second location, at Chilli's, with the same result.

On 011414 I assisted officer on a drive by shooting call and Hit and Run crash. (See additional officers reports)

I arrived at Chili's restaurant and assisted officer Lewis clearing the rear fenced area. After being advised that both males were detained, I assisted Lt. Olson at the crash located at Main and Browne.

There were several witnesses and not enough officers at the time to interview everyone, so I started writing down names and numbers for contact later: #1a and #1a I was able to talk to several witnesses that remained on scene: #1a and #1a I talked to each witness independently.

#1a : She was standing on the S/W corner of the intersection located at Browne and Main. She saw the suspect vehicle traveling E/B, on Main, at a high rate of speed. The vehicle wedged between two cars, which caused a crash and injuries, that were stopped at the signal. The suspect car came to a stop within the intersection. A black male, who was driving, ran toward the Main Market and a H/M passenger followed. The B/M was wearing a white t-shirt.

#1a did a show up with Sgt. Waters. See his additional.

#1a She was in the Chili's parking lot located just north and west of the intersection. She heard the crash, stepped up on her driver side, side-step to see what happened. She saw two males running from the vehicle. One was a B/M and the other W/M. She saw one wearing a t-shirt and baseball caps.

#1a : He was standing on the north sidewalk, on Main, JEO Browne. He heard the crash and saw two males running from the car. The B/M was wearing a baggy white t-shirt and jeans. He ran through the alley and jumped a fence near, Fast Eddies. The other was a H/M.

I tried calling the other witnesses that left. I was only able to reach, #1a He told me he was in his vehicle, on Main, JWO Browne, in the right lane. He heard the crash and saw a vehicle pulled up and stop. A H/M got out of the rear passenger seat and started running toward the corner market. He was holding his jacket pocket as if trying not to let something fall out. The driver, B/M wearing a white t-shirt, ran the same direction, in front of the H/M.

I had victim #1a sign a medical release form because he was being transported to SHMC for treatment, via a friend.

On 01-14-14 at about 1118hrs I was on patrol near the Public Safety Building when I heard a call broadcasted in reference to a shooting at 1800 W Gardner. The information was being reported that a brown Infinity was the suspect vehicle and had fled the scene.

A few minutes later, I observed the listed Infiniti SUV traveling SB on Cedar from Dean as I was traveling NB on Cedar. I observed that a BM with a white T shirt was driving. The vehicle had tinted windows and I couldn't see if there was any other passengers in the vehicle. I passed the vehicle and let the vehicle get out of view before I made a u-turn to follow the vehicle.

I notified radio and asked for a better description of the Infinity as I followed the vehicle from a distance. I was driving an Impala with hidden emergency lights and no other obvious markings and wearing the uniform of the day. The vehicle drove EB on Broadway from Cedar. The vehicle then turned SB on Monroe. I followed the vehicle from a few blocks back with heavy traffic between us.

The vehicle came to a stop for the red light at Main and was in the first position three lanes over from the west curb. I was in the 2nd lane from the west curb and about 4 cars back from Main. I was advising radio of my location when the suspect vehicle suddenly took off speeding through the red light while turning EB on Main at a high rate of speed. I didn't have any of my vehicles emergency lights activated and didn't see any other Police vehicles in the area.

I assumed the occupants picked me up when I was talking on the radio and knew they were being followed. I advised radio of the direction they were fleeing. I had very limited information about the shooting at this point. I watched the vehicle speed away EB on Main. When the vehicle was through Lincoln and a few blocks away I drove out onto Main to keep an eye on which direction they were traveling. Main was very busy at this time of day with pedestrian and vehicular traffic. I watched as the vehicle continued speeding EB on Main at what I visually estimated was 60mph blowing

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through red lights at each of the intersections. I was at several blocks back and traveling at regular speeds with no emergency equipment activated still because I didn't want to push them anymore.

I estimated that they were at about Browne and made my way up to that intersection. As I closed distance to Browne and Main I could see the vehicle was there and involved in a collision. I drove up to the location and asked the first witness I saw (female) and asked her if the subjects ran and which way. The witness pointed NE and advised there were 2 (including a BM in white T Shirt) so I sped up to Spokane Falls and Division.

I was driving NB on Division from Main and turned WB on Spokane Falls just as the 2 subjects were running up staircase onto the south sidewalk of Spokane Falls Blvd. Both ran EB on this sidewalk and spotted me driving up. The BM with white shirt stopped running and gave up without incident and the other subject HM ran back WB after seeing me. The other subject ran back to the area of the Travellodge and out of my sight. I detained the BM without incident (prone cuffing DL cuffed). This subject (Brice) was out of breath and sweating profusely

Several officers responded to assist and apprehended the other subject inside Chili's. All witness's advised that there were only 2 subjects in the vehicle. It sounds like the passenger HM was in the backseat therefore I couldn't see him when I passed them originally.

Their vehicle was seized pending a search warrant.

One of the citizens that was struck by their fleeing vehicle suffered a sore neck and back. 4 handguns were recovered from the route that the suspects fled on Main.

See other officers reports with witness statements and property that was seized including Guns, Clothing and a large amount of Cash.

At the time of this report, The BM-Brice was booked for Drive By Shooting and Felony Hit and Run and the HM-Valencia was booked for Drive By Shooting.

We anticipate more charges on both subjects when we receive criminal history returns for both and investigate the history of the Firearms.

The listed witness- #1a has been on foot in the area of Browne and Main. He heard the crash and watched the two subjects fleeing on foot. He followed them to the location that I apprehended Brice and stood by while I detained Brice.

The investigation is continuing.

I responded to Chili's restaurant to assist Ofc. Spiering and WSP Trooper Spencer. They had a witness advise them that the suspect went into the restaurant. When I arrived onscene they were handcuffing a male suspect. There was a black coat laying on the table and the male was in a light colored t-shirt, baggy blue jeans, and a light (tannish) colored baseball cap.

I asked the male what his name was and he said, "Jesus." I asked him what his last name was and he said he didn't want to talk to me.

I assisted Ofc. Spiering in escorting Jesus out to his patrol car. This was completed with dignity and respect. I could see a large bulge in each of his front pants pockets. I saw Ofc. Spiering remove a large bundle of cash from each pocket and place it in a plastic baggie. He then pat frisked him before placing him in his patrol vehicle.

Then I responded to the collision scene at Main and Browne and picked up a witness **#1a** **#1a** for a show-up. She said she heard the collision and saw 2 males running away. She stood up on the running boards of her truck to see better and called 9-1-1. I drove her to Sgt. Vigesaa's location just west of the corner of Spokane Falls Blvd and Division. She looked at Brice and said, "Yep, that's him. I'd say that's him." I asked her if he was the driver or the passenger. She said she thought she saw him running from the passenger side, but didn't see him in the vehicle.

We drove W/B to the north side of the Chili's restaurant. **#1a** looked at Jesus and said, "By the clothing I'd say yes." She said she didn't get a look at his face, but thought he was a W/M. She did recognize the clothing. She thought he was on the driver's side of the vehicle as he was running away.

Ofc. Spiering, Ofc. Lewis and I counted the money that was on Jesus person. It totalled \$10,400.

1. Being employed as a police officer with the Spokane Police Department and working in such capacity on 01-14-2014 at 1118 hrs.
2. Checking California Criminal History on both Valencia and Brice.
3. Brice being previously convicted of the following:
 - a. Possession/Purchase Cocaine Base For Sale on 12-19-2012.
 - b. Felony Evading with use of a gun on 12-19-2012.
4. Valencia being previously convicted of the following:
 - a. Possession of a Controlled Substance For Sale on 07-07-2003.
5. Contacting Stockton, CA Gang Unit who advised these convictions are equivalent to WA Possession with Intent to Deliver Class B Felony.

Due to the fact both Valencia and Brice were in possession unlawfully of 4 handguns and threw all four handguns out the window of their fleeing car, one of which was a Glock 10mm handgun, which matched the spent casing at the shooting scene of 1814 W. Gardner, and both Valencia and Brice being previously convicted of Possession of a Controlled Substance For Sale (California Code) class B Felony, PC exists for 4 counts each, (for each Handgun) Unlawful Possession of a Firearm 1st Degree.

It should be noted, where Valencia and Brice threw these handguns, there are commonly small daycare children walking the area with their caregivers to get exercise, not to mention the congested pedestrian traffic, it was obvious Valencia and Brice did not care even remotely to whom picked up their recklessly discarded handguns. Due to the quantity of handguns in the area, Spokane is very fortunate that all handguns were recovered and a terrible tragedy didn't occur from Valencia's and Brice's blatant disregard for human life.

Due to the fact Brice created a collision, causing injury, then immediately fled the scene failing to leave information or render aid, PC exists for Felony Hit and Run.



5. Contacting Stockton, CA Gang Unit who advised these convictions are equivalent to WA Possession with Intent to Deliver Class B Felony.
6. Completing the Affidavit of Probable Cause for this incident.

Witness #1a can testify to:

1. Being contacted by Ofc. Redmon to collect her statement.
2. Living at #1d which is just off the alley from crime scene.
3. Hearing a pop, that sounded to her, a single gunshot.
4. Looking through her fence and saw a newer Infinity smaller SUV Brown in color.
5. Seeing a H/M male medium build, dark hair, wearing a black jacket and long white t-shirt underneath.
6. Hearing the H/M suspect yelling "I shot, I shot it."
7. Hearing yelling and what sounded like crying then the H/M got into the driver's side.
8. Seeing feet on the other side of the vehicle but no faces.
9. Seeing two feet sticking out of the driver's side passenger seat wearing white athletic shoes with black and red on them.
10. Seeing the vehicle take off first W/B in the alley to Elm then northbound on Elm.
11. Positively identified the H/M in front of Chilis at Browne/Spokane Falls as the same suspect she saw in the alley, (During a Show Up)
12. Positively identified the SUV at the suspect SUV at Riverside/Browne, (During a Show Up).

Witness #1a can testify to:

1. Being contacted by Ofc. Johnson to collect her statement.
 2. Standing on the s/w corner of the intersection Browne/Main at approx. 1124 hrs on 01-14-2014, when she saw an Infinity SUV traveling east on Main at a high rate of speed.
 3. The Infinity SUV wedged between two vehicles causing a collision, then stopped.
 4. Seeing two males run from the vehicle.
 5. Identifying the driver as a Black Male wearing a white t-shirt.
 6. Identifying the passenger as a Hispanic Male.

Witness #1a can testify to:

1. Being contacted by Ofc. Johnson to collect her statement.
2. Being parked in the parking lot just north of the Main/Browne intersection at approx. 1124 hrs on 01-14-2014
3. Hearing a collision and witnessed two males running from the suspect vehicle.
4. Seeing one male run east while the other separated and ran toward Chilis.

Witness #1a can testify to:

1. Being contacted by Ofc. Johnson to collect his statement.
2. Standing on the north sidewalk on Main just east of Browne at approx. 1124 hrs on 01-14-2014.
3. Hearing a collision and saw two males running from the suspect vehicle.
4. Identifying one male being a Black Male wearing a white t-shirt, and the other was a Hispanic Male.

4. Identifying one male being a Black Male wearing a white t-shirt, and the other was a Hispanic Male.

Witness [REDACTED] #1a can testify to:

1. Being contacted by Ofc. Johnson to collect his statement.
2. Being on Main at Browne stopped for a red light at approx. 1124 hrs, on 01-14-2014.
3. Hearing a collision and seeing two males run from the suspect vehicle.
4. Seeing a Hispanic Male exit the rear passenger back seat then east.
5. Seeing the Black Male exit the driver's seat and run east.

Witness [REDACTED] #1a can testify to:

1. Being contacted by Ofc. Brownlee to collect his statement.
2. Seeing a Bronze colored Infinity SUV driving east on Main in the downtown area at approx. 1124 hrs on 01-14-2014.
3. Seeing someone from the vehicle throw a handgun out the window in the area of Pita Pit.

Victim [REDACTED] #1a can testify to:

1. On 01-14-2014 at approx. 1124 hrs, driving east on Main at Browne, stopped for a red light.
2. Being hit by an Infinity SUV.
3. Seeing the occupants of the vehicle, flee on foot.
4. The driver did not stop to leave information or render aid.
5. Being injured from the collision and having neck and back pain from the impact.

Sgt. Vigesaa can testify to:

1. Being employed as a Sergeant with the Spokane Police Department and working in such capacity on 01-14-2014 at 1118 hrs.
2. Hearing police dispatch advise of a shooting that just occurred at 1814 W. Gardner.
3. Being in the general area and seeing a vehicle matching the description south on Cedar at Dean.
4. The vehicle fleeing (after suspecting the suspects had a police scanner) east on Main from Monroe immediately following his radio traffic of being behind the suspect vehicle.
5. Seeing the driver, Black Male wearing a white t-shirt (Brice).
6. The driver sped away east on Main at speeds of 60+ MPH, in the downtown area highly congested with vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
7. At no time did Sgt. Vigesaa activate lights or sirens in his UC vehicle, however the driver continued to accelerate and blow through several red lights with no one attempting to initiate a traffic stop, confirming suspicions of a police scanner.
8. The vehicle came to a stop after causing a collision at Main/Browne.

9. Apprehending (Brice) on Spokane Falls Blvd/Division, while other officer apprehended Valencia at Chilis on Spokane Falls Blvd/Browne

Ofc. Bartlett can testify to:

1. Being employed as a Corporal with the Spokane Police Department, and working in such capacity on 01-14-2014 at 1125 hrs.
2. Responding to the downtown area to assist Sgt. Vigesaa with the apprehension of the suspects who just committed a Drive-by Shooting at 1814 W. Gardner.
3. Responded to Four different locations where the suspects had thrown handgun from the fleeing vehicle and taking photos of such handguns.
 - a. Main just west of Bernard photographing and collecting a Springfield XD .40. This handgun was laying in the street near the south curb line.
 - b. Main just west of Washington near a former Huppins business, photographing and collecting a Smith and Wesson M&P 9mm
 - c. Main and Wall southeast corner, photographing and collecting a Ruger P85 9mm.
 - d. Main (Riverpark square) photographing and collecting a Black Glock 10mm.

Ofc. Redmon can testify to:

1. Being employed as a Police Officer with the Spokane Police Department and working in such capacity on 01-14-2014 at 1118 hrs.
 2. Being dispatched to 1814 W. Gardner reference a shooting call.
 3. Upon arrival at the Gardner address, contacting witnesses for statements.
 4. Finding a spent shell casing at the Gardner address that was a 10mm casing on top of soil, with no dirt or debris, which appeared to have just been shot from a handgun.
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Cpl. McCollough can testify to:

1. Being employed as a Corporal with the Spokane Police Department and working in such capacity on 01-14-2014 at 1118 hrs.
2. Hearing police dispatch advise of a shooting that just occurred at 1814 W. Gardner.
3. Being in the area and seeing the SUV traveling east in the 1800 block of west Boone. Not realizing the suv was in fact the suspect vehicle at first, but did see Brice driving the vehicle immediately after the shooting occurred.
4. Positively identifying Brice after Sgt. Vigesaa apprehended him, as the driver fleeing the shooting scene.

Due to the fact both Brice and Valencia were in the same vehicle, and being together in the Infinity SUV at 1814 W. Gardner and recklessly discharged a firearm which created

a substantial risk of death or serious physical injury to another person and the discharge was either from a motor vehicle or from the immediate area of the motor vehicle that was used to transport the shooter or the firearm, or both to the scene, PC for Drive-by Shooting for both Valencia and Brice.

Due to the fact both Valencia and Brice were in possession unlawfully of 4 handguns and threw all four handguns out the window of their fleeing car, one of which was a Glock 10mm handgun, which matched the spent casing at the shooting scene of 1814 W. Gardner, and both Valencia and Brice being previously convicted of Possession of a Controlled Substance For Sale (California Code) class B Felony, PC exists for 4 counts each, (for each Handgun) Unlawful Possession of a Firearm 1st Degree.

It should be noted, where Valencia and Brice threw these handguns, there are commonly small daycare children walking the area with their caregivers to get exercise, not to mention the congested pedestrian traffic, it was obvious Valencia and Brice did not care even remotely to whom picked up their recklessly discarded handguns. Due to the quantity of handguns in the area, Spokane is very fortunate that all handguns were recovered and a terrible tragedy didn't occur from Valencia's and Brice's blatant disregard for human life.

Due to the fact Brice created a collision, causing injury, then immediately fled the scene failing to leave information or render aid, PC exists for Felony Hit and Run.
