Incident Summary

Officer Rosenthal briefly pointed her firearm at a suicidal subject who was holding a knife to his throat. The subject with the knife was in close proximity to the officers creating a situation that could have easily turned lethal had he not complied. After reviewing attached reports, CAD history, and speaking with officers, I found officer Rosenthal's actions to be reasonable and within department policy.

There were a total of seven officers involved in the incident. Three officers wrote a report and officer Rosenthal was the only one who reported pointing her firearm at the subject.

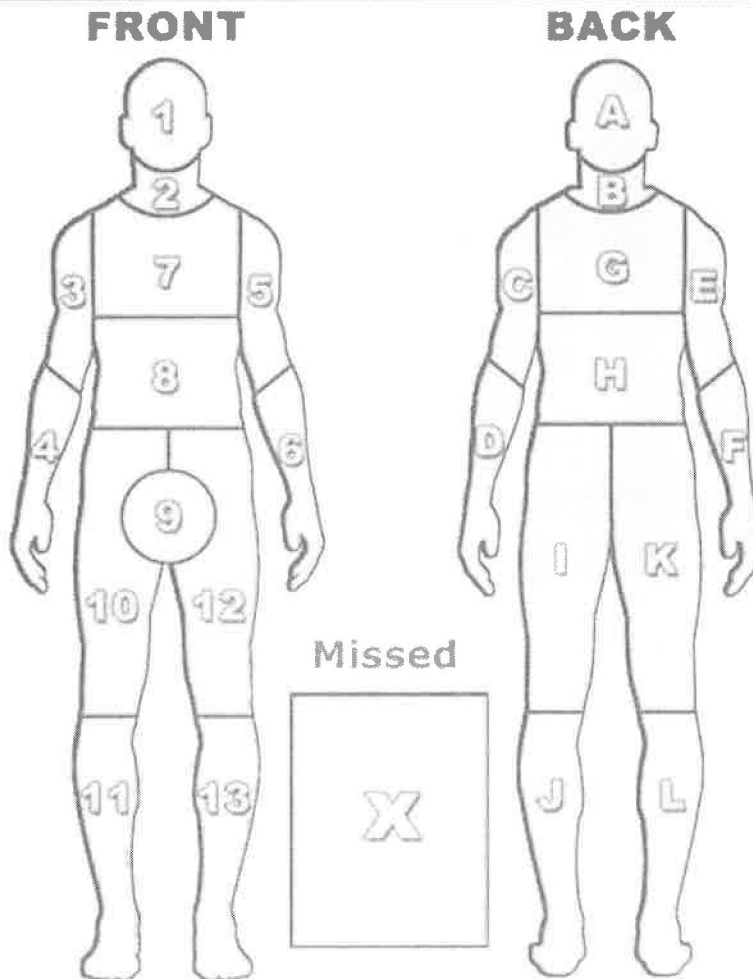

On 03/02/14 at approximately 1855 hrs, I responded to 108 S State St for a report of a suicidal subject. The call notes stated the complainant, **#14** called to report he was "feeling like harming self" and was armed with a pocket knife and a gun.

While we were en route, dispatch updated us that the male stated he had a .22 but "the knife will take care of everything." He said he was upstairs in apartment #409 and there was a male in the room with him. Dispatchers could also hear a female in the background.

Once we arrived we were let into the building by a resident. We responded to the 4th floor but discovered apartment #409 did not exist. We checked the 4th floor and went back to the first floor to do a sweep of each floor. Officers Meyer, Donaldson, Johnson, Stewart, Rosenthal and Briggs were on the first floor in the process of contacting the manager when a male exited the elevator.

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I saw the male had a knife held to his neck and he was ordered to drop it. He immediately dropped it on the ground and we took him into protective custody without incident. My weapon remained at the low ready position throughout the incident.

I identified the male as [REDACTED] #14 by his WA ID card. [REDACTED] #14 told me he "has been tired for a long time" and was "having a mind crunch." He did not have any visible injuries and he told me he never had a gun but said he did to "increase the urgency."

[REDACTED] #14 told me he is an Army veteran and has PTSD. He said he can't live with the pain anymore and was afraid if he didn't get help he would end up killing someone. [REDACTED] #14 told me he is ready to get help and he "can't handle all the pain."

I transported [REDACTED] #14 to Sacred Heart Medical Center ER to be evaluated by mental health personnel. He said he wanted to enroll in a program to get him help with his mental and physical health. I checked him into the psych triage area.

This report is for information only. Officers Johnson and Rosenthal contacted the occupants of the actual apartment, #405. See their additional reports for their statements.

I contacted Justin Baugh in apartment number 405. He said he **#14** had been fine for several hours and then appeared to have a mental health problem. He took a knife out of his pocket and held it to his throat saying he wanted to be committed to the hospital and did not want to live anymore. He moved the knife from his neck to his stomach several times while saying he wanted to die.

On 030214 at 1855 hrs, I responded with several other officers to 108 S State street #405 reference a suicide attempt call. Enroute, the complainant, #14 reported he felt like hurting himself, had a pocket knife and a gun.

Upon arrival, we were initially told he was in #409 but we discovered there was no apt. 409. We were all on the first floor right in front of the elevator and had just decided to go floor to floor to look for the right apartment when the elevator door opened. A large black man exited the elevator holding a knife to the right side of his throat.

Someone yelled "knife!" so I drew my gun and pointed it at the male subject. Once he dropped it which was right away, I lowered my gun to low-ready position, then secured it in my holster.

The male, identified as #14 #14 and our complainant, was detained in handcuffs. There was a female in the elevator behind him. She told me her name was Amber Morgan. When I went to the 4th floor with her, I interviewed her in the hallway while other officers cleared her room, #405.

Amber seemed shaken up but relieved it was over. She stated she has known #14 for about a month and he did not live there. He was a transient she had allowed to come in to her apartment last night to stay warm. Her boyfriend, Justin Baugh, was also in her apartment.
