Incident Summary

As noted in his attached report, Ofc. Wilkinson was trespassing Luke Mickle from a storage shed for the property owner who had complained to 9-1-1. Mickle was uncooperative and twice reached into his backpack. Each time he pulled out a folding box cutter and opened it, revealing the blade.

Ofc. Wilkinson drew his gun and pointed it at Mickle each time and warned him to drop the knife. Mickle complied and after the second time he laid on the ground as directed and was handcuffed. During handcuffing he kicked Ofc. Wilkinson and continued to be combative.

I arrived after several other officers. They had applied a loose leg restraint and were continuing to hold Mickle on the ground. They were waiting for a blanket with which to carry Mickle to a patrol car.

Mickle continually tried to kick at officers. He continually yelled that he was being mis-treated and we had no authority to arrest him.

I watched as officers safely carried Mickle to a patrol car and placed him in the back seat without further incident. He was transported directly to jail by a two-officer unit. He was charged with THIRD-DEGREE ASSAULT.

Mickle had dirt on his face, arms and legs plus a slight abrasion on his face from prone handcuffing. He appeared intoxicated.

I discussed this incident with Ofc. Wilkinson who added that he saw a half-empty bottle of alcohol (Fireball) in the shed where Mickle had been sleeping.

Wilkinson confirmed that no one else was present during the incident besides himself and Mickle.

Due to arrestee's behaviour it was not possible to do an adequate interview with him.

This was an appropriate use of force in a potential life threatening situation.



On Friday March 7, 2014 at 1932 hours I responded to 1909 E. Sinto Ave to the report of Trespassing. The complainant, Rhonda Marchand, reported that a male was sleeping in a storage shed attached to her apartment.

When I arrived on scene I contacted Rhonda. She told me that she had noticed that someone had been sleeping in the storage shed attached to her apartment. She lived at the apartment and stated that she had the authority to trespass people from the location. She then advised me that the Storage shed in question was attached to the apartment building but it did not have access to any of the apartments.

I then went to the Storage shed and opened the door. I observed a male who identified himself as Luke Mickle sleeping in a sleeping bag. There were three bags lying on the floor of the shed. I roused Luke from his sleep and advised him that he was not supposed to be in the shed. I informed him that he was trespassed from the location and he would have to leave immediately. He informed me that he was not going to leave. Luke then began digging in his back pack. I thought he was reaching for a pair of pants because he was clothed in only boxers when I contacted him. I shined my flashlight in the bag so that I could see what Luke was attempting to access. I then observed that Luke pulled a Folding Box Cutter out of the bag. Luke then opened the Box cutter.

Based on the ability of the Luke with the Box Cutter to cause serious injury and even death to my person, I immediately drew my service pistol and pointed at Luke. I then ordered Luke to "drop the Knife." Luke then placed the Box Cutter on the ground. I lowered my pistol to the low ready position but kept it drawn. Luke then reached in his bag and accessed a second folding knife. He then opened the second Knife. I raised my pistol and pointed it at Luke's

Chest. I again gave the order to "drop the knife." Luke then stated "are you serious." I advised Luke that if he did not drop the knife immediately I would be forced to shoot him. Luke then dropped the knife. With my pistol pointed at Luke, I ordered him to step out of the shed and directed him to lie on the ground in the prone position. Luke stepped out of the shed and laid down on the ground directly outside the shed. I ordered Luke to place his hands behind his back. Luke again complied and placed his hands behind his back. I then quickly holstered my firearm and proceeded to use a prone cuffing technique to secure Luke in Handcuffs. After I secured and double locked the handcuffs I stood up and ordered Luke to remain on the ground while I waited for my backup unit. While I was waiting Luke quickly rotated to his side and began to stand up. I then used my body weight to force him back to the ground. I then used my knee on the back of Luke to hold him to the ground. While I was holding Luke down, he swung his left leg up and kick me. The kick struck me in the left side of my torso. I was not injured during the attack.

Then other units arrived on scene and assisted me in securing Luke in Leg Restraints. Luke was then transported to the Spokane County Jail where he was booked for third degree assault. It should also be noted that I had probable cause to arrest Luke for Trespassing in the first degree. During the booking process Luke did not cooperate with the Spokane County Jailors and failed the booking process.

I then had CPL Adams take photographs of the two knives lying on the ground where I contacted Luke. I then collected the knives and placed them on property as evidence.

I also completed a PC Affidavit to support my findings.
