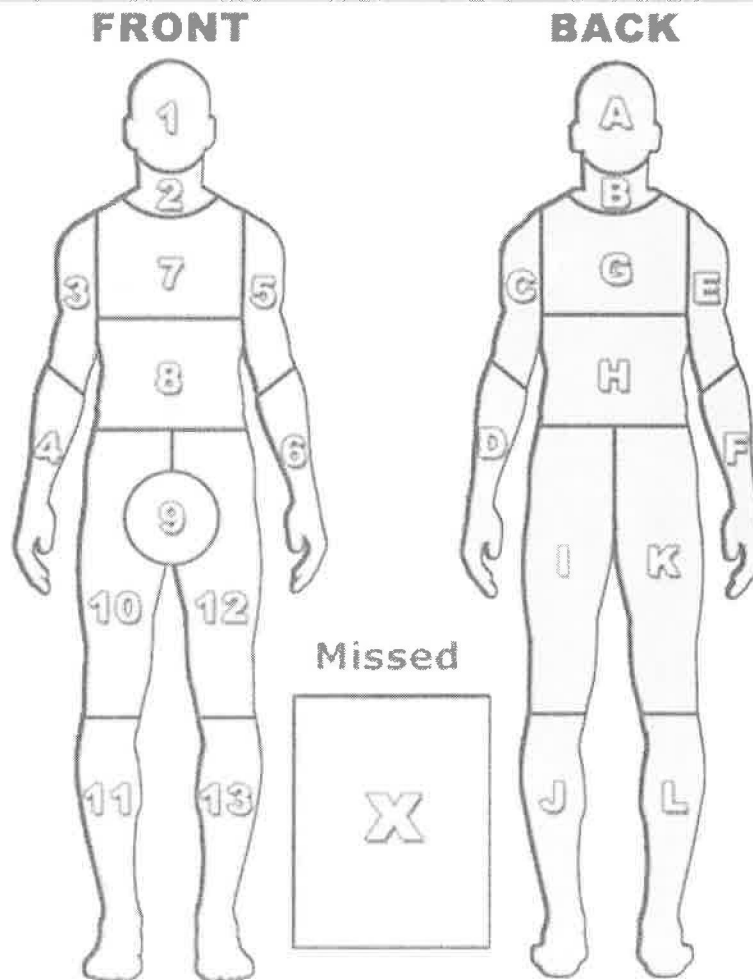





On 03-10-14 at about 1933 hours, I responded to a theft report at 1121 E Gordon. Seth Henkel called from the location reporting that his brother had stolen his firearms and left what he thought was a suicide note.

I contacted Seth at the location. Seth identified his brother as Cody Henkel. Seth told me that his brother was a former drug user who may have recently relapsed. Seth explained that his brother was having serious life problems and had been evicted from his home and separated from his girlfriend. They have children in common and there were child custody issues. Seth had allowed his brother to move in with him temporarily on about 03-07-14.

On about 03-08-14 Seth and his wife, Sarah Ferderer left for the weekend out of town. They returned today at about 1500 hours. Seth told me that his brother had left a note at the location. The note disturbed him because it had many apologies in it. The note also indicated to Seth that, "Clearly your going to find some stuff gone." It did not make any specific statements of self harm, but did state that, "I pray my next use kills me." Along with apologies to Seth, the note contained apologies to his parents and children.

Seth told me that he found he was missing 2 pistols, a shotgun, a laptop computer, cell phone, Playstation 3 and his wife's wedding ring. See attached property list. The missing firearms were a Sig Sauer .40 cal pistol. A Taurus .40 cal pistol, and a Winchester 12 gauge shotgun. The firearms were stolen with ammunition.

Seth Henkel and Sarah Ferderer did not find any evidence that the home had been broken into of burglarized by an unknown person.

Seth was obviously concerned for his brother's welfare based on the note that had been left behind. He told me that his brother was driving their parents blue 1999 Pontiac Grand Am. He did not know his brother's current location and believed he may be leaving town.

Based on the stolen firearms, concern for Cody's mental state, and a known vehicle, I had a county wide broadcast sent out to locate him.

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I then checked the County Pawn Database for pawn history of Cody Henkel. I found that he had pawned a Winchester 12 gauge shotgun and Taurus .40 cal pistol on 03-09-14. The guns were pawned at Pawn 1 in Hillyard. I also found that at least 3 pieces of jewelry were pawned. The description was not good enough to determine if one of them was Ferderer's missing wedding ring.

I advised Seth Henkel of the location of his firearms and the jewelry. I requested that he go to the pawn shop tomorrow and call police to have the items placed on hold.

Seth Henkel and Sarah Ferderer told me at that time they were willing to prosecute Cody Henkel for the theft.

At about 2252 hours, Cpl Dahle located the Pontiac Grand Am near Illinois and Hogan. Cody Henkel was in the driver seat and the only occupant in the vehicle. He detained Cody Henkel at that time. He advised Henkel of his constitutional rights. Cody Henkel invoked his right to remain silent.

I determined there was PC to arrest Cody Henkel for 2 counts of theft of a firearm and 2 counts of trafficking in stolen property. Based on the 2 firearms that were stolen and pawned. Officer R Meyer transported and booked Henkel into the Spokane County Jail.

I remained with vehicle. I applied for and was granted a search warrant for the remaining property reported missing by Seth Henkel and Sarah Ferderer. At about 0020 hours, the warrant was signed electronically by Commissioner Ressa.

Sgt McNab, Cpl Dahle, and I executed the search warrant. We did not locate any of the stolen property. I provided Johnny Henkel the vehicle owner with a copy of the warrant, a copy of the list indicating no property was taken, and a copy of the return of service. The items were given to Johnny Henkel when he came to out location to pick-up his vehicle.

No damage was done to the vehicle when serving the search warrant. It had been left unlocked. A small lock box in the truck of the vehicle was damaged when the warrant was served. It was a plastic lock box of size and shape used to hold pistols. It was forced open as a key was not available. Nothing of evidence was found in the box.

I placed the original note left at Seth Henkel's home on SPD property as evidence. A copy was attached to this report. A copy was also provided to jail staff as it indicated possible threats of self harm.

I then was on routine patrol at approximately 2252 hours, in the area of Hogan/Illinois. I observed a suspicious vehicle backed into a parking space to the NE of the zip trip. The vehicle was in an area that made it hard to see, but was still very near the zip trip. There has been an increase in robbery incidents over the past several months. I was suspicious that the vehicle may be parked for a quick get away.

I drove into the lot and shined my patrol spotlight at the vehicle. I noted that there was a single occupant sitting in the driver's seat. The vehicle was a blue Pontiac GrandAm. I could see that the front license plate was WA.101ZNW. I recognized the vehicle/license plate from the earlier broadcast.

The driver of the vehicle then leaned forward and reached under the front seat of the vehicle. I immediately exited my patrol vehicle, and drew my sidearm to a low ready position. I then ordered the male driver to show his hands. The driver complied with this command. I approached the vehicle, and the driver leaned over and reached towards the passenger seat. I could see what appeared to be a large knife between the center console and the passenger seat.

The vehicle had been broadcast as an Officer safety vehicle. The suspect in the incident was reported to have stolen multiple firearms, and was possibly on drugs and suicidal. I was concerned that the male may access the knife I could see, or a firearm that I could not see. I pointed in with my duty weapon and ordered the male to, "Keep your hands up." The male complied with this command. I brought my weapon back to a low ready, then ordered the male to step out of the vehicle. The male complied with this command. I then holstered my duty weapon, and then male was handcuffed (dl) and detained without incident.

The male was identified as the suspect listed in the earlier broadcast (HENKLE, CODY J 062986). Henkle asked why he was being arrested. I informed him that there I had been advised that there was probable cause to arrest him for theft of a firearm. Henkle stated, "There are no guns in the vehicle."

I advised Henkle of his constitutional rights by reading off a department issued card. Henkle stated that he understood, but did not wish to make a statement.

Officer Kirby was the primary investigator in the theft of the guns. Officer Kirby responded to the scene at this time. See his additional for details.
