





I observed a male sitting in the doorway of 112 W Pacific. The entrance is on a raised loading dock type structure and there have been numerous reports of trespassing. The representative of the property owner, William Barany has requested police arrest anyone trespassing on the property. There are several No Trespassing signs clearly posted on the building.

I stopped my fully marked patrol car and advised the male, later identified as Benjamin Oien, that he was trespassing. I was wearing full duty uniform with badge, Spokane Police shoulder patches and duty belt. Oien responded with "Fuck You". He got up and walked in a circle a couple of times mumbling to himself. He started to walk west on the loading dock and I told him he was not free to leave.

Oien appeared to be under the influence of something and I thought he was going to flee on foot. I continued talking to Oien, trying to stall while my backup was responding. Oien refused to identify himself and only responded with "You know who the fuck I am".

Oien then threw a backpack he was carrying on the ground. As he took it off his shoulder he pulled an approximately 18 inch of piece of steel rebar from it. He held the rebar in his right hand and began to raise it. I told him he did not want to do this and to drop it. I unholstered my pistol and as I was drawing Oien threw the rebar into a corner of the entryway. The rebar was still easily accessible for Oien, as it was just a few feet away.

It was even more apparent that Oien was under the influence and was not thinking clearly. I was concerned that Oien was going to pick the rebar back up. I told him was under arrest and to face the building. He complied and I ordered him to place his hands behind his back. I re secured my pistol in my holster and approached Oien.

I took hold of his left arm and he immediately tensed up. I again told him he was under arrest. He said "Fuck this, I hate you guys" and threw his right elbow back. He struck me on the right side of the head with his elbow and tried to pull away.

I applied a lateral neck restraint and told Oien to stop resisting. He had not been searched, was wearing baggy clothing and I was by myself. We were on an approximately three foot tall loading dock structure. I was concerned that we could fall off if I did not quickly control Oien's movements. I believed that if we fell it would likely significantly injure one, or both, of us.

Oien continued trying to pull away from me. He threw several right elbows striking me in the right rib area. Oien and I fell to the ground. He was face down and I was on his back. He tried to push himself up, lifting his chest approximately six inches off the ground with my full weight on him. He was unusually strong for his stature and I believed this to be because of whatever he was under the influence of.

Oien continued to try to escape. I felt him pulling on my taser, which was on my left leg. Oien was throwing his head back trying to strike me. I had my head close to his and he was unable create enough space to injure me. He was able to pull my radio shoulder mike from my lapel.

As he continued to thrash about, I had to apply enough pressure to control his upper body.

Just as Officer D Storch and Reserve Officer Hall arrived on scene Oien was rendered unconscious. He was unconscious for no more than ten seconds. Officers Storch and Hall each took one of Oien's arms.

With three officers present I released the neck restraint, as I believed we would be able to handcuff Oien without it. Oien regained consciousness and Officer Storch and Hall were unable to control his arms or get him handcuffed. I reapplied the neck restraint, but Oien did not lose consciousness. I was able to control him until several other officers arrived to assist.

Oien was handcuffed (DL), but continued to resist. He was violently pulling on the handcuffs and attempting to kick officers. I requested medics to check Oien and a supervisor.

Oien had a chewing tobacco sized can in his pants pocket. Inside the can was small plastic baggie that contained a crystal like substance in it.

I also noticed an uncapped syringe needle protruding through his right front pants pocket. Due to the danger of being stuck with the uncapped syringe, his pants pocket was cut to safely remove it.

Oien sustained a cut in his mouth and began spitting blood at officers. We applied a spit hood and were forced to leg restrain Oien. He also sustained an abrasion on his right cheek during the arrest-

Officers R. Lesser and Killian took possession of the tobacco can and contents.

I photographed the Oien and the scene while waiting for medics. I also photographed his backpack and contents. Inside th backpack was a realistic looking BB gun and a yellow bandana.

Oien was uncooperative with medics. After he was checked he was rolled onto a blanket and placed in my patrol car. Officer C Jones and I transported him to Deaconess. Oien complained that he was not injured and did not want to go to the hospital. He repeatedly told me he just wanted to go to jail.

After he was cleared by hospital staff Officer Jones and I transported him to jail. He was booked for Third Degree Assault and Possession of a Controlled substance. At jail I attempted to take more photographs of Oien. He was uncooperative and attempted to block the camera with his hand.

On 4-3-2014 at approximately 1738 hours I responded to 112 W. Pacific Ave to assist Officer Bartlett. While enroute Corporal Bartlett requested for officers to 'step it up'. Upon arrival Reserve Officer Hall and I found Officer Bartlett lying on top of a male who was face down on the concrete ground. I could see Corporal Bartlett had his arm around the subjects neck in a 'lateral neck restraint'. The subject was still not complying with commands to put his hands behind his back.

I grabbed a hold of the subjects right arm. After Corporal Bartlett applied the lateral neck restraint I was able to get a handcuff on his right wrist and put his arm behind his back. As I was attempting put the handcuff on his left wrist the subject came too and pulled his right hand back to his right side, balled up his fist and tried to pull his arm under his chest. He was told several times to comply and put his hands behind his back. The subject was flailing his feet back towards officers and still not complying. I continued to hold onto the subjects his right wrist as Corporal Bartlett applied the lateral neck restraint again. I was still struggling to get the subjects right arm back behind his back when other officers arrived to help. With the help of a couple more officers we were able to get the subjects in handcuffs.

#### **Investigative Summary**

Cpl Bartlett lawfully contacted a male at 112 W Pacific who was trespassing. The male was later ID's as Benjamin Oien, a TOP offender. See Bartlett's report for details on the initial contact. Bartlett told Oien he needed to leave as Oien was committing the crime of trespassing. Oien refused saying "fuck you."

Oien waked in circles then started to walk away. Bartlett told Oien he was not free to leave and attempted to ID Oien.

Bartlett tried to stall while he waited for backup as it seemed to him Oien may attempt to flee on foot. Bartlett noted that Oien appeared to be under the influence of a substance and not thinking clearly.

At one point Oien took off the backpack he was wearing and dropped it to the ground. While Oien did this, he pulled an 18 inch piece of rebar from his backpack with his right hand. Bartlett drew his firearm while telling Oien, "you don't want to do this" and "drop it." Oien dropped the rebar to the ground and obeyed Bartlett's commands to turn and face the wall. Bartlett holstered his firearm and did not point his firearm at Oien.

Bartlett approached Oien to place him in handcuffs. Bartlett told Oien he was under arrest. Bartlett attempted to take control of Oien's left arm and Bartlett could feel Oien tense up. Bartlett told Oien again that he was under arrest and Oien replied, "Fuck this, I hate you guys." After Oien said this, Oien used his right elbow to strike Bartlett on the right side of his head, assaulting Bartlett.

Bartlett applied a Neck Restraint Control hold and told Oien to "stop resisting." Oien continued attempting to pull away from Bartlett and assaulted him several more times by elbowing him in the right rib area. They both fell to the ground and Oien began to push himself up while Bartlett was on his back. Oien was able to push Bartlett about six inches off the ground.

During this struggle Oien was trying to head-butt Bartlett and Bartlett could feel Oien pulling on his Taser. Bartlett continued to apply arm pressure to Oien's neck while in the Neck Restraint Control Hold and Oien lost consciousness. Bartlett did this for the following reasons:

- Oien appeared to be under the influence of a mind altering substance.
- Bartlett was the only officer attempting to control Oien.
- They were on a raised loading dock which was about 3 feet off the ground and both of them would be injured if they fell.

- Oien had been told he was under arrest and he had not been searched.
- Oien pulled an 18" piece of rebar and held in his right hand in a manner consistent with using it to strike Bartlett.
- Oien was physically resisting arrest.
- Oien assaulted Bartlett by elbowing him in the head and rib area.

As Oien lost consciousness, Storch and Hall arrived on scene. Bartlett let off on the hold and as Oien regained consciousness, he resisted Storch and Hall's efforts to get him handcuffed. Bartlett held on to Oien's neck until several more officers arrived and were able to get him handcuffed. Oien did not lose consciousness a second time.

When Storch arrived on scene, she saw that Bartlett had a male in a Neck Restraint Control Hold and she could hear him issuing commands. As Oien lost consciousness, she was able to handcuff his left wrist but when he regained consciousness, he pulled his right hand under his body. With the help of other officers they were able to get him handcuffed.

Lt Meidl and Director Schwering arrived on scene and spoke with Bartlett about the use of force.

Bartlett took photographs of Oien and the scene. Oien had an abrasion on his right cheek and a cut in his mouth. Oien was spitting blood at officers so a spit mask was put on. Spokane Fire Fighters attempted to evaluate Oien at the scene but he was still resisting and kicking at officers after he was handcuffed. He was transported to Deaconess Hospital and evaluated by medical staff.

Oien was booked for 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Assault and Possession of a Controlled Substance.

Bartlett's injuries were scrapes and bruises on both of his hands and wrists as well as both knees. His injuries were photographed.

This use of force was within department policy 300.3.4 (b) because:

- The subject is violent or physically resisting.
- The subject, by words or actions, has demonstrated an intention to be violent and reasonably appears to have the potential to harm officers, him/herself or others.
