





On 040314 at approx 0815 hrs I called the victim regarding her stolen vehicle. She had called 911 to report it stolen. The victim stated the following: Her veh was parked on the street in front of the house she is staying with her husband. She woke up today and noticed her vehicle was missing. There was no broken glass on the street to indicate a window smash. The veh was locked and she and her husband each have their own set of keys to the car. No one else drives the veh and they

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have not given anyone permission to drive the car. The veh had a tool box and a few of her children's items.

I provided the victim with the incident #, my name and badge #. I advised SPD radio to enter the veh as stolen. At approx 0840 hrs I noticed a call at 5017 N Napa where the compl, [Ritchey], was advising there was a suspicious white mini-van across the street from her that does not belong to the neighbor that lives there. The van was parked on the grass strip and there was a male in the driver's seat that appeared to be passed out or asleep.

I responded to 5017 N Napa along with Ofc Zinkgraf. Zinkgraf advised when she checked on scene the veh license, [637WQV], and that there was a male in the driver's seat that appeared to be passed out or asleep. This was the stolen veh report I had just taken. I arrived on scene at approx 0854 hrs and observed the van. Ofc T Ponto arrived and it was decided that due to the males' appearance of being passed out, he would not hear our verbal commands so we would approach the veh and make contact with the driver.

As I approached the veh, I could see a large bicycle in back of the front seats. I could see the male behind the wheel of the stolen car. He was slumped over to his left and his head was against the door. His hands were hanging down by his feet and were not visible. I did not see anyone else in the vehicle. Ofc Zinkgraf knocked on the driver's door and told him to wake up. We were both yelling at him to wake up with no response. After numerous times knocking on the window loudly and yelling at him to wake up, he finally did wake up. He looked around as if in a daze. We had been identifying ourselves as police officer's. He was instructed to show us his hands which he did not comply. After numerous times of telling him to show us his hands he finally did. I saw that he was wearing black gloves. He held his hand out in front of him. He began looking at me, Ofc Zinkgraf and the space in front of his car as if he was trying to figure out if he could drive around Det Jolley's patrol car that was partially in front of the stolen veh. At this point, I believed the susp was going to attempt to flee the scene in the veh. I did draw and direct my sidearm at the susp and did tell him loudly to open his door. He stared at me and then at the car keys in the ignition. I repeated my commands at least 5 times before he slowly opened his door. I holstered my weapon and went around the veh to assist Ofc Zinkgraf in taking the susp to the ground to handcuff him. We were telling him to lay down on the ground and he went to his knees as if he was going to try to get up quickly. He was being very hesitant to obey our commands. I had arm bar control of the def's right arm as we took him into a prone cuffing position. I did handcuff the def, [d/I]. The def asked what was going on and I told him that is what I would like to find out. I did place him in the back seat of my marked patrol car, [398]. I had him sit with his feet out so that I could hear him. I told him that since he was not free to leave I would have to read him his constitutional rights before I could talk to him about the situation. I did read him his CR's which he said he understood and agreed to answer my questions. The def sustained a slight abrasion to his right knee that was slightly bleeding.

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I asked the def where he got the van and he stated the following to me: He was walking along in his shorts and came across a lady that told him, "Come over here and get warm in my van". She was getting ready for work. He described her as a brown skinned, short female in her late 20's. Det Jolley was present and listening to the def. I started talking with other officer's on the scene. When I returned a short time later I was listening to what he was telling Jolley. I told him that I had to interject in their conversation because I did not believe what he was saying. I told him he was lying about where and how he got the van as well as the bicycle in the van. I asked him to tell me the truth. He apologized for lying. He told me the following: He got the bike from a guy named Matt and payed him \$23.56 for the bike as a partial payment of \$150.00. He also gave him a SD card and a watch. He got the bike from Matt at the gas station at Hamilton and Indiana about 2 or 3 days ago. I asked if Matt lives in the apts right by there and he did not answer. He described Matt as being a little taller than him. He was sleeping at a friends house, woke up around one this morning and left. He said this was near Providence and Empire, [parallel streets]. He was riding the bike and the chain broke. He was waling the bike and saw the dome light on inside the car and found the door to be unlocked. He got inside the car and found the keys in the ignition. He knew it was wrong to take the car but he just wanted to get to his brothers house near Francis. "I knew it was wrong". He said he, "feels bad" and wanted "to at least give the owners some gas money". I told him they probably did not want to talk to him and he agreed it probably wasn't a good idea. He also said that he had come from his brother's house and was heading to his dad's house on Francis and provided the address on N Washington.

The veh owners husband responded to the scene and took possession of the veh. There were items in the car that did not belong to them and he removed them and gave them to Ofc Zinkgraf. Zinkgraf did put the items on property as evidence, including the bike. He stated that his wife probably did not know the keys were in a tray in the car.

Search incident to arrest, 2 .45 caliber bullets were found in the def's pants pocket. I put them on property as evidence as the def is a convicted felon and is federally no allowed to have ammuniton on his person. I did transport the def to jail where he was booked for Possession of a Stolen Motor vehicle as the def was in the listed stolen vehicle. I did call the local ATF office to report this incident. The def has been arrested for violent felonies involving guns in the recent past.

At jail the jail medical personnel were called to evaluate a cut the def's left side of his middle torso that extended to his hip area. The def said someone tried to stab him a few days ago and that the marks were from a knife. The marks did appear to be from a knife.

After booking the def into jail, I located a LE web site that lists stolen bikes in Spokane that do not have serial numbers. I found the bike the def was in possession to be on that stolen bike list. I located the report # that lists the bike as stolen, [032414, 14-90629]. I went to police property to view a video of the theft that the victim had turned into police for evidence. The video was somewhat grainy. I will be contacting another SPD officer in the appropriate dept to see if the video can be
