



On 04-08-14, at 1521 hrs., I was dispatched to a report of an assault at 2604 E. Sharp. Bryant Delzer reported that he was a care giver from "Aacres" and in the front lawn of that residence, with a client, Jared Collier. Collier was laying in the lawn, refusing to leave and was hitting Delzer in the legs. I arrived on scene and contacted them in the front yard. Ofc. Grant arrived to assist.

Collier lives at 2608 E. Sharp. The yard he was in belongs to Robin Swanagan. She met me as soon as I got out of my patrol car, saving that it was an ongoing problem with Collier, that she was tired of it and something needed to be done about it. Collier was sitting in the middle of her yard, playing with a Barbie doll, with Delzer standing over him. I asked Collier to walk out of the yard and to come talk with me on the sidewalk. He refused to. I asked a couple of more times, then entered the yard and walked over to them.

I told Collier that he couldn't be there and told him to get out of Swanagan's yard. He refused to do so, flipping me the bird and saving that he was going to throw his doll at me. I told Collier that he could go to jail for trespass if he refused to leave, but he would not. Ofc. Grant arrived on scene.

After telling Collier several more times, and telling him that he would go to jail, he got up and walked out of the yard. He slammed the gate behind him as he left. He began walking toward his house, on the sidewalk. As he passed by Swanagan, he struck her with a closed fist, in her left breast. Collier had his doll in that fist. Ofc. Grant and I witnessed the assault, as did Aaernetta Cornelious, Bryant Delzer and Jessica Valentine.

Ofc. Grant and I caught up with Collier while he was still on the sidewalk. I grabbed hold of Collier.

as did Officer Grant. Collier immediately began to struggle and try to break free. We moved Collier to the ground for cuffing. Collier fell to the ground and curled into a ball, with his arms underneath him. His upper body was on the lawn, with his legs on the concrete sidewalk. I was able to get his right arm out and behind him. I put a handcuff on it as Ofc. Grant worked to get Collier's left hand out. During this entire time, we were both telling Collier to give us his arm and to guit fighting, but he did not.

I could see Collier's left elbow, so I got my expandable baton and gave it to Ofc. Grant so that he could pry Collier's arm out. Ofc. Grant got the arm out and I finished handcuffing Collier. Collier continued to struggle and had to be held down, so we kept him on his stomach. He spat on my hand and kicked Ofc. Grant. I saw that Collier had a small amount of blood and snot coming from one of his nostrils. After a few minutes, Collier stopped fighting. We rolled him to his side, and minutes later into a seated position as he became more cooperative. Ofc. Grant called for a supervisor and Sqt. Ervin responded for the use of force. Sqt. Ervin photographed Collier.

We initially called for an ambulance, to have Collier transported to the hospital for a mental evaluation. Robin Swanagan was adamant that Collier be charged with the assault on her. After talking with his case manager, Joe Ryd, it was decided that Collier would be cited and released. Sgt. Ervin approved. Collier was trespassed from Swanagan's property and I issued him the citation for City Assault. I took the handcuffs off and he was released.

On the above date and time I responded to 3604 E. Sharp on a disorderly person. Upon arrival officer Brownlee was talking to a subject, playing with a pair of dolls sitting in the front yard.

Officer Brownlee asked the subject repeatedly, to leave the yard and go back to his home next door.

When Brownlee began to count down, the subject said okay, "I'm leaving" in a very frustrated voice.

As Jared Collier left the yard, he focused on the neighbor Robin. He reared back with a closed fist and hit her square in the chest right in the breastbone as he walked by her. Robin was somewhat startled but uninjured.

Officer Brownlee, and I saw this action and immediately went hands-on with the subject. Mr. Collier is a sizable individual is approximately 5 feet ten, and close to 200 pounds and has a lot of upper body strength. He was wrestled to the ground and placed in handcuffs. During the cuffing process, Mr. Collier began to hide his arms under his body so as not to be handcuffed. With the aid of an ASP we were able to remove his arm from under his body and apply proper prone cuffing technique.

Collier suffered no injury other than a pre-existing blood clot from his left nostril.

Subsequently Mr. Collier was trespassed from 2604 E. Sharp for his actions. He was also added to the trespass file for one year.

On 04-19-14, I was contacted by Lt. Walker reference an arrest report from 04-08-14. Lt. Walker asked that I outline the de-escalation process used to deal with the arrest of Jared Collier, a mentally ill person who lives at "Aacres" group home.

Initially, we were dispatched because Jared had gone into the fenced lawn of the next door neighbor, Robin Swanagan. Swanagan advised that it was a regular occurrence, that she was tired of it and wanted him out. She was actually quite upset about having to live next door to the group home and wanted it gone entirely. Jared was sitting in the front lawn and his caregiver, Bryant Delzer, was with him. As listed in my report, I first told Jared to leave the yard as I was standing outside the fence, on the sidewalk. I asked a couple of more times but Jared refused to leave. Next, I entered the yard walked over to him, closed distance and told him to leave, which he did not. I tried that a few more times, again with no result. Delzer described Jared as being autistic and having explosive anger issues, among other things.

My next de-escalation step was to explain to Jared that he was trespassing and the consequences he faced if he refused to leave. After telling him that he would be arrested and taken to jail, several times, giving him numerous "second chances", Jared agreed. He got up and walked out of the yard and turned toward his house. The original purpose of the call had been resolved through the use of verbal de-escalation. It was the next, unforeseen event that required an immediate "hands on" approach.

As Jared walked by Robin Swanagan, he reached out and punched her in the breast. I immediately took hold of Jared and took him into custody for the assault which occurred directly in front of me. Jared struggled, was taken to the ground and handcuffed. I used no verbal de-escalation techniques prior to taking hold of Jared, but told him to stop fighting repeatedly as he was being handcuffed and held to the ground.

Over the next few minutes, Jared became more and more cooperative, remorseful for his actions and was even crying. My intention was to obtain a booking exception and take Jared to jail. It was after talking with his case worker, Joe Ryd, that it was decided that he could be cited and released. Sgt. Ervin was included in this process.

He assured me that if left at the home, there would be no further issues with him. Given this information, I decided to cite and release Jared for the assault. I also told staff to call 911 if anything changed with Jared's behavior. To my knowledge, we received no such calls.

Officers Brownlee and Grant responded to 2604 E. Sharp reference an assault. This address is right next door to where Collier lives with his care giver. When they arrived on scene they found Jared Collier sitting in the front yard of that residence. Officers talked to Collier's care giver and discovered that Collier had hit the caregiver in the legs and that he was refusing to leave the property.

Officer Brownlee contacted Collier and told him that he had to leave the neighbors yard. He repeated this statement several times. Collier refused to leave and started flipping the officers off. Officer Brownlee told Collier that if he did not leave he would go to jail. Collier got up and walked out of the yard. He punched the female owner of the property in the breast. Both officers grabbed Collier and took him to the ground. Collier pulled to try and break free. The officers were able to get one arm handcuffed however Collier had pulled the other arm underneath him and would not release it. Officer Grant used an expandable baton and applied leverage on his arm to get it free. Once this happened the officers were able to get the other handcuff on.

Collier calmed down after a few minutes.

Mr. Collier was not complying with verbal directions. In fact he showed more hostility by flipping the officers off. Eventually he got up to leave as he was told. However as he passed the female he punched her in the breast. Having witnessed this assaultive behavior the officers grabbed on to Collier and took him to the ground. Collier is a strong individual that was developmentally disabled. The officers had two wrestle with him to keep him under control and eventually use a baton to leverage one arm out from under him. Collier had some road rash on his face around his nose and cheek area.

In this case the officers were dealing with a strong developmentally disabled person that was being aggressive and assaultive. The officers used minimal force to take this person into custody. They followed training and policy during this use of force.

Sgt. Dan Ervin
