

On 041714 at 1802 hrs, Ofc. Rodriguez and I responded to 2211 W Wellesley, the McDonald's, reference a Robbery call. Enroute, we were advised the McDonald's was robbed just one minute before. The complainant, Tyler Christenson stated the suspect robbed the drive through while they were in-line. They were following the suspect vehicle plate number B75191S, described as a silver Ford F150.

Upon arrival, the suspect and complainant were gone. Ofc. Rodriguez was on-scene interviewing the victim at the drive-through, Miranda Weddle. I contacted another employee, #2d and interviewed her separately. She stated she was near the drive through window getting catsup when she heard Miranda scream, "we're being robbed!"

went over to see what was happening and saw a short male "jumping through" the window. He grabbed the register, and jumped back with it. Some money went flying. The suspect left with the register. #2d did not see a gun or any other weapon displayed, and she did not hear the suspect say anything.

She described the suspect as a short, white male wearing a black ski mask over his face with only his eyes showing. She could see his white eyelids. He wore a dark gray sweatshirt with a hood. He wore gloves.

Another employee advised me the witnesses had returned to the store and pointed out who they were. I went to the front and saw a male and female waiting to talk to me. They identified themselves as Tyler Christenson and his girlfriend Leticia Bleek. Ofc. Rodriguez interviewed Leticia separately outside while I interviewed Tyler.

Tyler stated he and Leticia had just pulled up to the speaker to order in the drive-through. Leticia

was driving and he was in the front passenger seat. There were no cars ahead of them. Suddenly the suspect ran past them and around the corner of the building ahead of them. A few seconds later the same suspect ran back around the corner carrying the register.

Tyler could not view the drive-through window from the speakers because it was around the corner of the building. The suspect ran to a pickup truck in the parking lot behind them. Tyler pointed to show me where he saw the truck parked next to an RV in the lot. He saw the suspect go to the front passenger side of the truck and hand the passenger the til through the window. The suspect went to the rear of the truck, opened the cover, climbed inside the bed, and closed it again. The truck left westbound through the lot to the Safeway gas station.

Tyler stated he called 911 to report the robbery, and they drove off through the lot after them. The suspects left westbound on Wellesley, northbound on Alberta to the alley behind "JB's Bottleworks" at Rowan. At Milton/Rowan, the suspects drove westbound past them. He got a better look at the occupants at this time because they past right in front of them. The suspects were speeding and they lost sight of them at central/"A" street.

Tyler stated when the truck past in front of them was when he saw who the occupants were. The back windows were tinted, but he saw a female driver and a male front passenger. He described the driver as a white female, mid-20's, blond hair pulled back with a headband. She wore glasses, and a dark sweatshirt.

The passenger was a white male with possibly a tan, mid-20's, average build, shorter full beard, and wearing a white t-shirt.

The suspect who did the Robbery, Tyler described as a thin white male, mid-20's, wearing a black ski mask with just eye holes, a dark blue sweatshirt with a hood up over his head, and blue jeans.

I viewed the video surveillance footage from the view of inside the drive-through window. It was clear, and showed the back of Miranda as she helped customers. She was assisting a drive through customer when a male suddenly appeared in between the driver and Miranda. Miranda instantly jumped to the left and disappeared from view. The suspect leaned over into the open window with his upper body. He reached over, with his right hand and turned the key in the register. When the till drawer opened, he reached in with both hands and pulled out the plastic insert. The suspect leaned back out of the window, turned to the left and was gone with the till.

I saw the suspect was wearing a dark colored sweatshirt, with a white shirt underneath. He wore jeans, and a black mask over his face, and white work-type gloves. I did not see any weapons in his hands or on his belt line when he leaned over.

I collected the copy of the surveillance footage on a DVD. I also collected the insert from the till from Ofc. Heuett. It was in a paper bag ready for transport to Property as evidence. Ofc. Rodriguez gave me a DVD he acquired from WalMart as evidence.

I contacted witness Laurie Roberts, via cell phone. She was the driver of the vehicle in the drive through when the robbery occurred. She stated "chit chatting" with the cashier in the window and was handing her the debit card when the "guy was right there." The suspect put his arms through the window, and pulled the drawer through the window. He was not facing Lauri so she did not see what exactly he did inside and she could not see his face.

Laurie described the suspect as little, about 145 lbs, a dark gray sweatshirt, and dark pants. He did not say anything and she did not see any weapons.

I drove Tyler to a show-up location at Woodside/Northridge Ct for the female suspect detained, Jessica SCHWARTZENBERGER. I advised him this may or may not be our suspect. He remained in my patrol car. It was dark outside but the street lights were on but I also used my spotlight to illuminate the area, Jessica and the officers so Tyler could see them better. Jessica was not handcuffed. Tyler stated immediately," She is the driver, 99% positive."

Then I drove Tyler to 6701 N Country Homes Blvd for another show-up of our second suspect detained there by officers, Thomas Craigen. I advised Tyler this may or may not be our suspect. It was dark but the street lights were on. I used my spotlight to illuminate the Thomas, the officers and the area. Thomas was handcuffed. Tyler asked for Thomas to turn to the left so he could view his right profile. He stated, "That was the front passenger, 95% sure."

I drove Tyler back to McDonald's so they could go home. I contacted the manager, Danielle Berger inside. She told me \$397.16 was stolen from the business.

I responded to the Gardner Building where I contacted Det. Hollenbeck and Det. Lebsock. I gave them the till insert and the two DVD's. The two suspects were being interviewed at the building when I arrived. I was advised the suspects were going to be booked for Robbery 2nd degree. I cleared with this report. See Det. Hollenbecks's report and affidavits, and Ofc. Rodrguez' additional report.

On 041714 at approximately 1802 hrs, I responded to the area of McDonalds at 2211 W Wellesley for a report of an armed robbery at the restaurant. The call notes stated a witness called to report the drive-thru window at the location had just been robbed.

While I was in route, SPD Dispatch gave updates on the suspect vehicle's location. The vehicle was last seen in the area of Rowan/A St and I checked the area for approximately 30 minutes but did not see any sign of the vehicle.

At approximately 1847 hrs, Officers Matthew and C. Johnson advised they located the suspect vehicle at Woodside/Belt in the Five Mile area. I responded to the area to assist with setting up a perimeter. I took a perimeter spot at 6701 N Country Homes at an apartment complex. Several residents there reported witnessing a male matching the suspect description running around the area. They described him as a WM wearing dark pants, a white t-shirt, and a black jacket.

Officer Watson and I did a quick check around the building and did not see anyone. We went back to the parking lot to wait for the K-9 track to come through. I was at my patrol car and, as Officer Watson was walking across the parking lot he appeared to see something in the nearby bushes. He began giving commands and I saw a flash of a white t-shirt in the bushes. I saw the individual put his hands behind his back. The male was almost completely concealed in the bushes except for part of his shirt.

Corporal Ferguson and Sgt McNab arrived to assist and we took him into custody, handcuffed (DL). I patted him down for weapons due to the nature of the crime and the report of a gun being involved in prior incidents.

Detective Hollenbeck responded to the location and requested I stand by with the suspect who was seated in the back seat of my patrol car. I stood by while witnesses were brought to the scene for a show up. I assisted with the show up and then transported the suspect to the detectives building to be interviewed.

I stood by while the suspect, Thomas Craigen was interviewed by detectives. Once they were finished, I transported him to SCJ and booked him in on one count of 1st Degree Robbery.

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On 04-17-14 at 1800 hrs I was taking photographs at a DOA on E. 36th when the robbery call at McDonald's was broadcast. When I completed the scene on E 36th I drove to the area of Five Mile to assist in the perimeter. When I arrived Officer Stroshal spotted someone walking near the apartments at 6525 N Austin St. I went to the apartments and discovered it was a woman walking her dogs.

I took a perimeter position on the north side of the apartments on Austin St. The units involved in the K-9 track were coming down the hill. They asked if I had bolt cutters. I got the bolt cutters from my trunk and gave them to Officer Watson. Watson cut the chain link fence so the units could continue the track back up the hill.

Watson returned the bolt cutters to me and headed to his car which was below me off Country Homes. A short time later I heard Officer Watson broadcast that they had a suspect and they needed another unit. I went down the hill to his location. Watson and Officer Gobble were addressing a subject in the shrubs on the north side of 6701 N Country Homes.

Officer Watson told me that the suspect was showing his hands and we needed to secure the suspect. The suspect was on a retaining wall about four feet high and he was about two feet into the bushes. He was on his left side and his hands were visible.

I grabbed his hand and the back of his pants and with Officer Gobble help pulled the suspect back towards the

edge. Officer Gobble handcuffed the suspect. I patted the suspect down for weapons that he could easily access. After he was clear we pulled him down from the ledge. As we pulled him down I lowered his legs to prevent him from falling. We stood him up and completed a search before Officer Gobble placed the suspect in the car.

ATTEMPTED

Officer Watson told me there was a set of keys near the bushes where the suspect had been hiding. I went to my car to retrieve my camera to photograph the keys before they were collected for evidence. My path intersected Martin's who was coming out of Therapeutic Bliss. Martin told me that she had two clients that had seen the suspect running down the hill. She said one customer said the suspect had gone back up the hill. Another customer said the suspect ran around the north side of the building. Martin said she did not see the suspect.

I photographed the area where the suspect was arrested when Cpl Bartlett told me he had already photographed the keys. I went up the hill to Austin St to photograph the fence that was cut.

I drove to the 6701 N Country Homes location and checked with Sgt McNab on what else was needed. Members of the media had gathered on the sidewalk directly below the business. We were planning on bringing witnesses to do a show up. I talked with the media and got them to agree not to video the witnesses or the suspect out of the car for the purpose of not compromising the investigation. I talked the media until Lt C Meidl arrived to give them a statement. Lt Meidl said an announcement had been put out to the media that the briefing would be at the car wash to the south. I drove to the car wash and advised Meidl that nobody was there.

I cleared the area and returned to the station.

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On 041714, at approx. 1823 hrs, I arrived in the area of Rowan and Alberta behind JB's to assist units looking for evidence in a robbery at McDonald's. The suspects and suspect vehicle (silver Ford pickup) were just seen behind this business in the west alley.

It was raining, overcast and dusk with fading daylight.

While I was in the detective's office this morning, I overheard Sgt. Roys talking to one of the Crime Analysts about the 2 robberies in the past 2 days. I understood there a gun used in at least one of the robberies. The suspect vehicle described was a silver Ford F150 pick up.

Also, many robberies involve the suspect or suspects using a gun.

I was next assigned to check the areas and streets to the south and west for the suspect vehicle.

At approx. 1847 hrs. I heard officers were in foot pursuit of the robbery suspects. I drove to the area of 6701 N Ash to take up a perimeter position and saw several citizens waving me and Ofc. Gobble down. At approx. 1854 hrs. I made the K9 announcement over my patrol cars PA while parked in the parking lot at this location.

I contacted a witness, Stacy Siekerman, at this address. She told me she saw a white male, wearing a dark hoodie and jeans, hiding in the trees just behind this address. Stacy said she heard sirens and saw lots of police cars in the area. She told me she thought this male must be hiding from the police. Stacy was inside the

business on the second floor and saw the same suspect run to the north behind the business then up the hill to the west.

Goble and I checked the immediate area around the building. I located several GM car keys and possibly a post office box key on a dirt path at the north east corner of the business property.

Officers searching with the K9 requested bolt cutters and a fence to be cut so they could follow a trail. I cut a portion of the fence at 6806 E Bluff Ct.

I returned to the business at 6701 N Ash. As I walked from the entrance of the building back toward the location of the keys, I noticed a small white article of clothing deep in the bushes along the north property line. I immediately realized this was a person balled up and laying on their side hiding.

I identified myself as police and ordered the person to show their hands. As I got closer and gave commands for the suspect to put their hands behind their back, I could see the suspect had on a black hoodie, blue jeans and tennis shoes.

Because of the information I heard on the previous recent robberies and the possibility a gun was used and the matching suspect vehicle (silver Ford pickup) in this robbery, I felt a gun was very possibly involved in this incident. Robbery is a violent crime. This suspect was just involved in a robbery at a business. He had just fled from the robbery suspect vehicle while actively being pursued by police. The suspect was hidden so far in the bushes only a very small portion of his clothing around the small of his back was visible. The suspect was balled up, facing away from me while hiding in the bushes. He initially did not respond to my commands for him to show mw his hands. I yelled at him at least 3 times, from approx. 10 feet, to show me his hands. I could not see his or her hands or whether or not this person had immediate access to a weapon and I was initially alone in confronting this suspect. Because of the suspect's actions and lack of initial cooperation as stated above, I drew and pointed my gun at the suspect while directing him to show me his hands.

Ofc. Gobble and Cpl. Ferguson assisted me in getting the male suspect out of the bushes safely. The suspect denied medics and indicated he was not injured by shaking his head "No" when asked.

I briefed Sgt. Mcnab of the incident.

Officer Watson was confronting a suspect in a robbery. The suspect was hiding underneath bushes with his back facing Officer Watson. The suspect's hands were not visible. Due to the nature of the crime, it was reasonable to believe that the suspect was armed and dangerous. Officer Watson gave the suspect commands to show his hands which he initially did not respond to. During this time of non-compliance, Officer Watson briefly pointed his firearm at the suspect while giving verbal commands.

After reviewing the attached reports, CAD history, and speaking with officers, I determined that Officer Watson's actions were reasonable and within department policy.
