Incident Summary

Suspect Jay Laine was reported to have committed a DV assault against a female who had called 911 asking for help. While en route officers were told Laine had six felony warrants. Cpl. Blessing spotted Laine riding a bicycle away from the area of the incident. She ordered him to stop. Laine stopped briefly, got off the bike and ran on foot into an alley.

Once backup arrived, Cpl. Blessing and others officers began a search of the alley and adjacent yards. Laine was found hiding under an awning adjacent to a garage. The area contained miscellaneous junk including hand tools that could be used as weapons. He refused initial commands to come out from behind a large piece of plywood that he had hidden behind.

He refused to show his hands and continuously moved them to near his waistband or reached for things on the floor that could not be viewed by officers.

After repeated refusals to show his hands, Cpl. Blessing drew her pistol and pointed it toward Laine. Officers gave several more commands for Laine to show his hands and exit before he finally obeyed. Cpl. Blessing holstered her weapon after Laine came out and his hands were visible.

Cpl. Blessing's actions were consistent with policy and good officer safety.

I was a block away from the call so I put myself on it. I started to check the area when I saw the described male, Jay Laine, walking his BMX bike NB in the alley behind the 5000 blk of N Magnolia in the east alley.

I advised dispatch and started down the alley in my marked Ford Explorer patrol car quickly. I pulled up close to him so we were approx 5 ft apart with my window down. I told him to let go of the bike and sit down on the ground. Laine was immediately argumentative asking what I wanted. I told him I am the police, I told him to sit down, and I was investigating an possible DV.

Laine dropped the bike and ran WB through a yard (5014 N Magnolia). I got out and started to chase but he was close to the front gate. There were 2 people in the backyard who started for the male but I told them to let him go, I didn't want them hurt as I drove off NB. I drove around to the front and did not see him. A small child pointed to the south alley of the 1700 blk of E Queen and yelled he ran that way.

I asked the child for a description to make sure it was the same male and the child said grey sweatshirt and blue back pack which was what Laine was wearing. Patrol officers quickly had the 1700 blk of E Queen locked down and I knew he had to be hiding in the alley. Radio advised Laine also had 6 confirmed felony warrants.

Ofc M Kernkamp, Ofc D Harvey and I started to walk the alley, checking yards and under cars. Ofc Harvey was a little to the west of us when Ofc M Kernkamp and I checked a garage behind 1736 E Queen. The garage door was locked but there was an open awning area which had items stacked. Ofc M Kernkamp pulled back a large board, yelled and immediately backed up to where I was standing.

She yelled "show me your hands" but Laine did not immediately obey. He started to show his hands but pulled them back and messed around his waistband along with something on the ground. We repeatedly yelled, to "show us your hands and step out behind the wood board, but he ignored us. I pulled out my handgun and pointed it at the board Laine was behind since I wasn't sure if he was trying to grab a weapon or hide something.

It took him 1-2 minutes to obey orders and step out behind the board. Once he stepped out with his hands up and I could see they were empty, I holstered my weapon. He was handcuffed (DL) by Ofc M Kernkamp and Ofc Harvey. I checked the area he was hiding in and located his blue back pack under a plastic cover.

I told Laine he was under arrest reference his felony warrants and for obstructing since he interfered with my investigation. Ofc D Wells had been sent to contact the victim, Denise Trujillo, to see if we had DV charges but there was no answer at her house (1903 E Wellesley), no answer on her phone, and she wasn't at Napa/Wellesley.

While in the alley, I was contacted by the owner of the garage, Carl Westbrook, which Laine had been hiding next to. He stated he had no idea who Laine was and he did not give him permission to hide under his garage awning where he stores things. I retrieved the BMX bike Laine had ditched and handed it over to Ofc B Brown-Bieber since he was going to transport Laine to jail.

Laine was booked into jail on his warrants and cited for obstructing/2nd Criminal Trespass.
