Incident Summary

Officer Anderson spotted a fresh stolen vehicle and coordinated officers to block in the vehicle when it was stopped at a red light at Garland/Market, Officers used two vehicles to block in the suspect vehicle. Officer Anderson was behind the suspect vehicle when he backed up in an attempt to escape and struck Officer Anderson's vehicle. Officer Anderson directed the occupants to show their hands. The passengers complied but the driver leaned to the center console area with both hands as if he was trying to access a weapon. Officer Anderson drew his duty pistol and approached the driver's side quickly on foot while pointed in at the driver. A few seconds later the driver hugged the passenger and he could see he was not armed. Officer Anderson holstered his weapon and took the driver in custody. Officers Andersons actions were appropriate and within policy under the circumstances and based on his observations that caused him fear for his safety.







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On 5-2-14, at approx 1725 hrs, I was on routine Pro-Active Patrol in the area of Regal/Wellesley as are my duties on the Patrol Anti-Crime Team (PACT). As part of my job duties I had checked holding calls and was aware of a Vehicle Theft of a 1997 Maroon Honda Accord 4dr (WA/047WRP) holding in the Downtown Area. I was driving a Unmarked Patrol SUV which is equipped with lights and sirens and was wearing the uniform of the day at that time. A short time later I observed a similar make/model Maroon Honda Accord going N/B on Regal towards Wellesley. At that time I pulled in behind it and confirmed that it was in fact the reported stolen Accord as well as noted it was occupied by 4 people as it approached the Stop Sign at Wellesley.

There was medium-heavy traffic due to it being 1730 hrs on a Friday so the driver had to wait to actually get to Wellesley. Each time a vehicle ahead of the suspect made its way onto Wellesley the driver of the suspect vehicle would bring the vehicle RPM's very high and then move forward by one car length. This suggested to me that possibly the vehicle had a manual transmission and the driver was not familiar with driving such a vehicle.

I notified other PACT units in the area of my location and that I was following a reported stolen vehicle. Due to the dangerous nature of Traffic Pursuits it was my intent to wait to initiate a traffic stop until officers were closer to my location. Further we could possibly formulate a strategy to safely stop the vehicle in such a manner we could avoid a pursuit or dangerous fleeing vehicle.

The driver had turned E/B on Wellesley from Regal and was 'targeting' me in his rear view and side view mirrors, which suggested to me he was aware or concerned I was a Police Officer. He continued this action during the entire course of my following and my coordinating with other officers. The driver went E/B Wellesley through Haven and back N/B on Market. Then to W/B Broad and then Back S/B on Haven back through Wellesley, making a giant loop around the block. I continued notifying other officers via Patrol Radio of my direction of travel. The driver of the suspect

vehicle was driving in an aggressive manner, with lane changes and quick accelerations to move in traffic but at a controlled normal speed. It was obvious to me that he was trying to create a gap where he could make a quick turn without me being behind him and lose officers by changing directions. He was not driving in what would be considered a reckless manner however. I still had not activated any emergency equipment and we continued S/B where Haven merges with S/B Market approaching Garland. The driver was now in the curbside lane approaching Garland and a fresh red light. The suspect was the lead vehicle at the fresh red and Ofc Daniel notified me he was on Garland at Market.

I pulled very near (within 2-3 feet) to the suspect vehicles rear bumper with my lights and sirens activated simultaneously with Ofc Daniel's vehicle appearing in view in front of the vehicle. I had just put my vehicle into park and was preparing to exit my drivers door when I observed the suspect vehicles reverse lights come on. I heard the RPM's climb from the suspect vehicle and the vehicle back into me in a violent manner as if the suspect "dumped the clutch". This was obviously an intentional act that jarred me while still in the drivers seat of my vehicle. The suspect was obviously trying to create a gap where he could potentially escape in the vehicle and/or cripple my vehicle or myself to aid in his escape. I exited my vehicle and drew my duty issued sidearm as I did SO.

At that time the suspect had committed at least 2 felony's. He was obviously in possession of a stolen vehicle and had just committed an attempted 2nd degree assault by the intentional act of ramming my patrol vehicle. The driver had been obviously targeting my in his mirrors and despite not driving in a reckless manner he was driving in an aggressive frantic manner. Once the vehicle was stopped and I could exit the vehicle he immediately refused to show his hands despite commands to do so. I know my commands were heard in the vehicle due to compliance with the rear seat passengers. Fearing that due to his previous violent act of ramming my vehicle while I was still inside it and his refusal to place his hands in view I fear he may be accessing a weapon of some sort. We were in the curb lane and had it blocked, but there was a significant flow of traffic still traveling both north and south on Market as well as pedestrians in the area. I feared that if a weapon was presented by the suspect there could be numerous potential civilian victims.

I pointed my duty weapon in on the driver for approx 2-3 seconds at a steep angle as I cautiously approached the vehicle. At that time the driver was still glancing back over his shoulder at me and then reached over with both hands and appeared to hug the female passenger. I immediately lowered my weapon then holstered with the intent to take physical control of the driver once I saw both his hands and still had compliance from the rear seat passengers.

I opened the drivers door and immediately took the drivers left arm as I advised he was under arrest. I utilized a straight wrist twist lock to control the subject and told him to exit the vehicle. He

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immediately began to struggle to stay inside the vehicle. His right hand dipped out of view and was trying to access his right pants pocket area. He then began grabbing the arm rest area of the vehicle to keep from exiting the vehicle. I told him at least 3 more times to exit the vehicle, but he continued resisting and trying to gain further mechanical advantage to further his non-compliance. He continued struggling to stay in the vehicle and got his foot on the door jam therefore gaining further mechanical advantage and pushed himself back into the car. He was leaning back and was almost on the female passengers lap when I was able to gain control of both arms long enough to pull him completely out of the vehicle. He was guided onto the ground and into a prone handcuffing position. As we went to the ground a small (approx golf ball sized baggy) of a white powder substance bounced onto the ground. He was detained in handcuffs (dl) and escorted to a nearby patrol vehicle by another officer. The other officers identified him as Terran T McLain (3-16-95) and he was found to have 3 outstanding warrants for his arrest. His warrants were for Possession of a Stolen Motor Vehicle, Attempt to Elude and DWLS 2nd.

I removed the rear drivers seat passenger at that time, detained her in handcuffs (dl) and identified her as Felicia N Hearn (3-16-95). Once all subjects were detained from the vehicle I notified SPD Radio of such and requested a Supervisor.

At approx 1740 hrs I contacted the driver, McLain, who was seated in the back of a nearby patrol vehicle and advised him of the charges he was under arrest for. I then read him his Constitutional Rights, which he acknowledged. When asked if he wanted to waive his rights and answer my questions he said, "Yes and No". He continued with this "Yes and No" ambiguity after being told I needed a yes or no answer. Eventually he stated something similar to "I will talk to you but I want to talk to someone else first." I took this to mean he wanted to speak to an attorney so I broke contact and closed the vehicle door.

I then went to speak to Hearn who was handcuffed but standing on a the curb. Hearn had a (confirmed) misdemeanor warrant for her arrest and was advised that she was under arrest. I then read her Constitutional Rights which she acknowledged and waived by saying, "Yes, I want to cooperate." Hearn advised that she had only been in the vehicle for "3 minutes." Hearn stated that one of her girlfriends in the vehicle "sort of knew" the driver and they were just getting a ride to an unknown location further north on Regal. She then stated that she did not understand why he started making turns and then going in the opposite direction of their intended location. Hearn was later booked on her outstanding warrant.

Ofc Reese was downtown and was taking the original report from complainant. He advised that he had obtained permission to search the vehicle from the RO.

During the consent search of the vehicle I noted that there were 3 shaved keys in the vehicle.

One unknown make key on the drivers floor board and two on a key ring in the ignition. The key in the ignition was stamped as a Chevy key and the other was a Chrysler key. All appeared modified or shaved in some manner. At that time I determined PC existed to charge McLain with Possession of Motor Vehicle theft tools. I also confirmed that McLain was currently DWLS 2nd through WA DOL and PC existed for that charge as well.

Sgt Eckerlsey was onscene and advised of the PC for 2nd Assault, Possession of a STolen Motor Vehicle, DWLS 2nd, Possession of Motor Vehicle theft tools and Resisting arrest at that time. The substance from the baggy he dropped as he exited the vehicle was field tested (negative) for any sort of controlled substance. Ofc Yen took custody of McLain and transported him to jail to be booked for the 2 felonies and his outstanding warrants. I included the PC for the misdemeanor charges in the PC Affidavit for this incident. I was later notified by Ofc Yen that McLain had concealed a small baggy of methamphetamine in the backseat of Ofc Yen's patrol car. He was also booked for PCS Meth by Ofc Yen.

It should be noted that the front seat passenger, Samantha R Thomas (10-15-88) was found to have a (confirmed) felony warrant for her arrest. She was arrested and booked on the warrant by another assisting officer.

The son of the vehicle's registered owner arrived to take custody of the vehicle. There was a cell phone that did not belong to him and we were unable to determine ownership at the scene for the phone. I placed the phone, the shaved keys, the methamphetamine, the unknown white substance and some misc drug paraphernalia onto property.

In all McLain was booked for his 3 outstanding warrants, Possession of a Stolen Motor Vehicle, 2nd Assault and PCS - Methamphetamine. The PC for Resisting, Motor Vehicle theft tools and DWLS 2nd was included by affidavit.

A collision report was completed by another officer after the incident.

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On 050214 at approximately 1731 hrs, I heard Ofc JC Anderson (F34) advise he was behind an occupied stolen vehicle near Market & Broad. The vehicle was stolen earlier in the day from downtown Spokane. The stolen vehicle was reported as a Burgundy 1997 Honda Accord with WA lic 047WRP.

Ofc Anderson updated that he was following the vehicle SB on Haven. I was patrolling in the area of Empire & Crestline and began driving EB on Empire to get over to Market to assist Ofc Anderson if the suspect was to continue SB. I was driving SPD patrol car #369 which is fully equipped with emergency lights and audible sirens. I was also wearing my SPD issued PACT uniform of the day.

As I drove EB on Empire it turns in to Garland as you approach Market. I heard Ofc Anderson advise they were still SB passing the Safeway. I looked ahead at the Garland/Market traffic signal and could see the EB Garland light had just turned green. I then knew that the suspect was approaching a fresh red light at SB Market. I advised Ofc Anderson that I would attempt a block at the red light.

I slowed my car a bit and remained hidden behind the Panda Express which is located at the NW corner of Garland & Market. I could see the stolen vehicle approaching the red light and slowing in preparation to stop. There were no cars in front of it. I quickly drove east to the intersection and then north in front of the suspect who had brought the stolen car to a stop. I then utilized a blocking technique as it is my experience that often times suspects will attempt to flee in stolen cars.

I positioned my front push bars directly in front of the stolen car's front bumper without making contact. I could see there was a male driver, a front female passenger, and two rear female passengers. Once the suspect realized I was the police, he began moving around frantically in the car looking for an avenue of escape. I then observed him look behind him and despite Ofc Anderson's patrol Tahoe being located directly behind the suspect, the suspect driver still elected to put the car in reverse and attempt to ram his way out of the blocking technique. It is with absolute certainty that the suspect driver would have seen Ofc Anderson who had his emergency lights and his audible siren activated. The suspect clearly intentionally struck Ofc Anderson in desperation which showed his willingness to harm anyone who got in his way.

Due to backing so aggressively in to Ofc Anderson, this created some momentary space between my car and the suspect. I then quickly closed the distance as I could tell the suspect was trying to

get the car back in to drive to go forward. I softly placed my front push bars against the front bumper to prevent the suspect from gaining any momentum, or from causing even more damage. I was in superior position to minimize the stolen car's movements despite the suspect's reckless intent and desire to avoid apprehension.

Once the suspect realized he was successfully blocked, his behavior and attention went straight to the front female passenger. He began trying to hug her, kiss her, and started telling her he loved her. It was my feeling that he knew he was going to jail and was saying goodbye to his likely significant other.

The suspect's mindset was clearly unstable and unknown at this point, it was imperative to get him out of the car to ensure everyone's safety. I exited my patrol car and ordered all passengers to place their hands in the air as Ofc Anderson was attempting to engage the suspect driver, repeatedly telling him he was under arrest. I could see that the suspect driver was not obeying Ofc Anderson's commands and he was unwilling to exit the car. I crawled over the hood of the car to assist Ofc Anderson.

The suspect was resisting Ofc Anderson's efforts to extract him from the car. As I was moving closer to assist in the extraction, Ofc Anderson gained better control and the suspect was moving out of the car. He continued resisting as I assisted in guiding the suspect to ground and in to the prone cuffing position. To restrict his movement, I placed my right knee in the suspect's lower back while also gaining left arm control. Ofc Anderson was able to gain right arm control and safely place the suspect in handcuffs.

All passengers were detained by other Officers.

The suspect driver was identified as Terran T Mclain.

I requested a Corporal respond and take photographs of the incident and any damage. There appeared to be no damage to my push bars, nor did there appear to be any to the front bumper of the stolen car. There was obvious minor damage to the rear left bumper of the stolen car and to the front bumper of Ofc Anderson's Tahoe. Cpl Blessing responded and took photographs of the damage.

Ofc Brown-Bieber completed a WA St collision form documenting the collision caused by Mclain.

Sqt Eckersley had responded to the scene and was made aware of the incident and arrest/charges.
