Incident Summary

Multiple officers responded when 9-1-1 rec'd a call that two males were arguing over a road rage incident and one was now threatening the other with a gun. Arriving officers found the males arguing loudly with each other. One, later identified as Loren Toney, Jr., was holding a Glock pistol in his hand.

Ofc. Quarles, with knowledge that witnesses told 9-1-1 the armed man had pointed his gun at the second man, and recognizing the threat posed by this male, pointed his rifle at the suspect and ordered him to drop his gun. Quarles had to order him to drop the weapon twice more before he finally did so. Quarles then lowered his rifle to the low ready position until the suspect's handgun was secured by another officer.

The second man was identified as Todd Bates,

Officers separated the two men and conducted interviews with both along with witnesses.

I spoke with Mr. Toney, Jr., who was extremely agitated. He appeared intoxicated and admitted to drinking, "Two beers." His father, Loren Toney, Sr., later told me that Loren, Jr. had been drinking all day. Loren Toney, Jr. was very difficult to speak with due to his condition. He frequently interrupted me and any other officer who tried to speak with him. He refused to accept any responsibility for his actions and thought it perfectly logical to leave the safety of his home to bring out a gun over an allegation of speeding. He cited the root of speeding vehicles to be two drug houses nearby and blamed the police for not taking down the alleged drug dealers. He had no questions or concerns about Ofc. Quarles pointing his weapon at him.



On 06/01/2014 at approx. 1908 hours I was dispatched to a person with a weapon call at 5816 N. Lincoln. Dispatch advised a male was pointing a gun at another male in the street and they were arguing because the other male was driving too fast.

Upon arrival in the area I observed one male standing in the street with his shirt off and a vehicle parked sideways in the middle of the road. I observed another male standing in the yard on the west side of the street. He had a black semi automatic handgun in his right hand. I had my patrol rifle. Due to the male having a gun and I had already been advised by radio that the male with the gun had already pointed it at someone, I pointed my rifle at him and yelled at him to put the gun down, to gain compliance and get him to drop the weapon. He argued with me and told me he was the good guy. I kept my gun pointed in and again advised him to put the gun down. After telling him three times, he finally dropped the weapon in the yard. I then lowered my weapon to the low ready and directed him away from the weapon.

Upon arrival I was dealing with a possible crime of Assault 1st because he had already pointed the weapon at someone. He was still armed upon my arrival, and was still non complaint when I gave my first command for him to drop the weapon and there were many other citizens, including children on scene. Based on the above listed circumstances, I felt it necessary for me to point my weapon at him to gain compliance.

I advised him to sit on the curb near me and he complied.

I then contacted the male who had the gun pointed at him. He was identified as Todd D. Bates. He stated the following about the incident; he was driving by the area at a normal rate of speed when a male was standing in the yard and yelled at him to slow down because there was kids in the area. Todd stated he stopped his car and the male already had a gun in his hand. Todd stated the male then began threatening him and his children. At one point the male pointed the gun at him.

Todd stated when the male pointed the gun at him, Todd became angry and got out his vehicle and told him, "whats up? Shoot me then". Todd then took off shirt and challenged the male to fight.

Todd stated the male did not come out of his yard, but did point the weapon at him and threaten him.

Lt. T. Hendren responded as well. It was determined that based on the circumstances, no arrests were made.

On 06/01/2014 I (Officer Groom) was dispatched to 5816 N. Lincoln in Spokane WA, reference a person with a weapon. It was reported that the neighbor's had a male at gun point for driving too fast in the neighborhood.

I arrived on scene around 1914 hours and contacted Loren Toney. Loren was the individual that had pulled the gun on the male that was driving too fast in the neighborhood.

Loren explained that the following happened:

He has lived at his residence located at 5811 N. Lincoln for the past 3 years. He lives there with his wife and kids. He was in the front yard with his father when a car drove by his house at about 40 MPH. Loren yelled at the car to slow down.

The car continued down the street about 4 blocks and then turned around. Loren saw the car turn around and this alarmed him. The car pulled just past his house and parked in the center of the street. Loren was worried about his family so he went into his house and grabbed his gun (a Glock pistol.)

Loren returned to his front yard and had the gun down to his right side. The male that was driving the car got out of the car and began yelling at him. The male was trying to fight him and this worried Loren. Loren explained that he cocked the gun, but left it down to his side. The male kept antagonizing him. The male took his shirt off and told Loren "put the gun down bitch".

Prior to my arrival, Officer Quarles had arrived and ordered the subject with the handgun to drop the gun, which he did. Officer Quarles requested that I secure the weapon which was lying in a yard on the west side of the street.

I located a black, Glock automatic handgun, that was unloaded, with a magazine that contained multiple rounds, lying next to the handgun. I collected both items and held onto them during the investigation.

I contacted a witness to the incident, Loren Toney (Sr.). Loren advised that he was visiting his son Loren who lives on the block. He advised that he observed a vehicle (WA 366WKB) driving at a high rate of speed southbound on Lincoln by his son's home. He estimated the vehicle's speed at 30-40 mph in the 25 mph residential area. He said that his son yelled at the driver, Todd Bates, to slow down. He said that Bates continued south but turned around and drove back by the home northbound on Lincoln.

Loren said that Bates began to threaten his sone saying "I know where you live" and "I am gonna come back." He said that Bates got out of his car and began to "puff up." He explained that Bates was posturing as if he was going to physically fight his son.

Loren stated that his son, who has a permit, retrieved his handgun and walked out into his yard to confront Bates. He claimed that his son never pointed the gun at Bates during this confrontation. Shortly after this confrontation Officer Quarles arrived on scene.

After speaking to all of the parties involved as well as the witnesses to the event, it appeared that both Bates and Loren (Jr.) were acting disorderly. There was an allegation that Loren briefly pointed his gun in the direction of Bates but this was after Bates had made threats to Loren, taken his shirt off and began to approach him as if to physically fight with Loren. It should be noted that Bates was physically much larger than Loren and posed a significant threat of harm to Loren if he attempted to physically fight with him.

None of the parties were arrested at that time as it was a mutual disorderly situation. I spoke with Loren (Jr.) prior to returning his gun to him about the poor decision he made to grab his gun and confront Bates. He admitted to me that he had gone into his living room to get the gun before exiting the home to confront Bates in his yard. I advised that the best course of action was to return to his home, call 911, and remain inside with his family until officers arrived. It should also be noted that Loren admitted to consuming alcohol prior to the incident. I had an officer give the gun to Loren's wife (unloaded) and I gave Loren his magazine prior to leaving.

on 6/1/14, at about 1908 hours, I responded to 5800 N Lincoln reference a possible road rage incident in which one person was pointing a handgun at another person.

Upon arriving, officer Quarrells and Lt Hendren were already on-scene. After the handgun was secured, I spoke with the original complainant, Rebecca Davila. Her boyfriend, Tompall Nichols, had also witnessed part of the confrontation.

Davila told me she was in the backyard when she heard a car (later determined to be driven by Bates) drive southbound in front of her residence. She said the car sounded loud like it was driving above the speed limit. She estimated the speed at 30 to 35 MPH. She then heard a male yell at the car, "Slow down!"

It was guiet for several minutes when she started hearing yelling in the front street. She looked out front, as did Nichols. They saw the neighboer arguing with Bates (Bates had obviously returned). They saw Bates out of the car with his shirt off. The neighbor, who was standing on his vard, had a handgun down by his side. Bates moved closer to the neighbor, who briefly pointed the handgun at Bates before lowering it. Both Davila and Nichols heard the neighbor tell Bates that there were children in the area while they were arguing.

Nichols said Bates was yelling at the neighbor and talking "like he was in a gang."

Prior to speaking with the complainants, I heard Ofc Quarrells talking with Bates. Bates admitted that he got out of the car, ripped his shirt off, and told the neighbor, "Shoot me, bitch. Shoot me right there" (pointing to his chest over his heart).

I overheard the neighbor say that Bates had threatened to return later and burn his house down.

Indications are that the neighbor stayed in his yard and pointed the handgun at Bates after Bates exited the car, ripped his shirt off, and started to move towards the neighbor.
