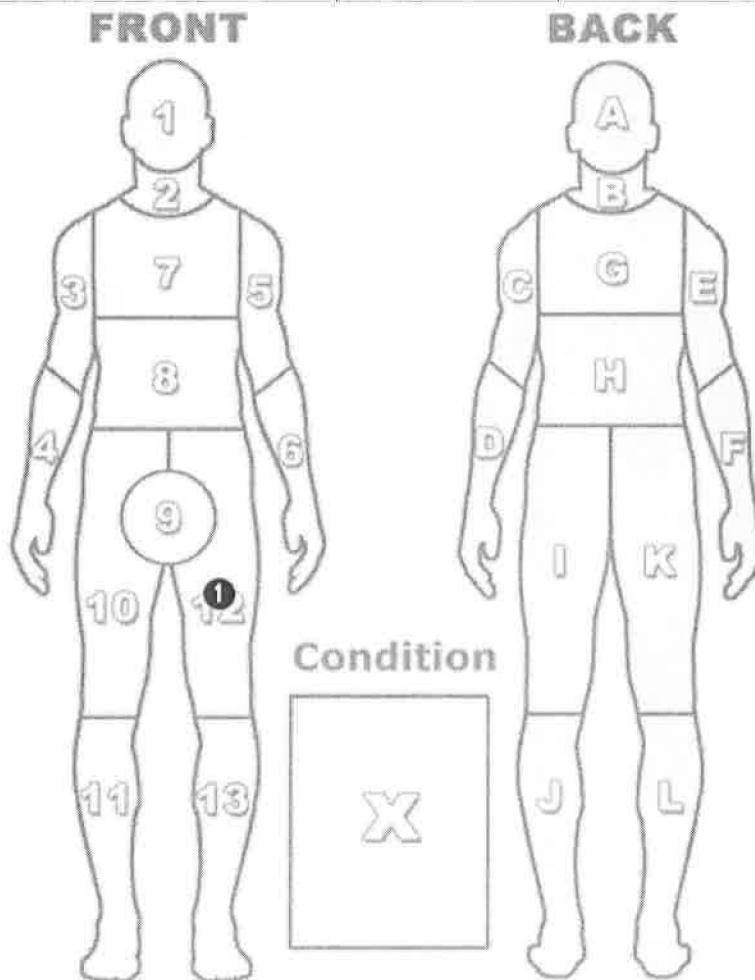

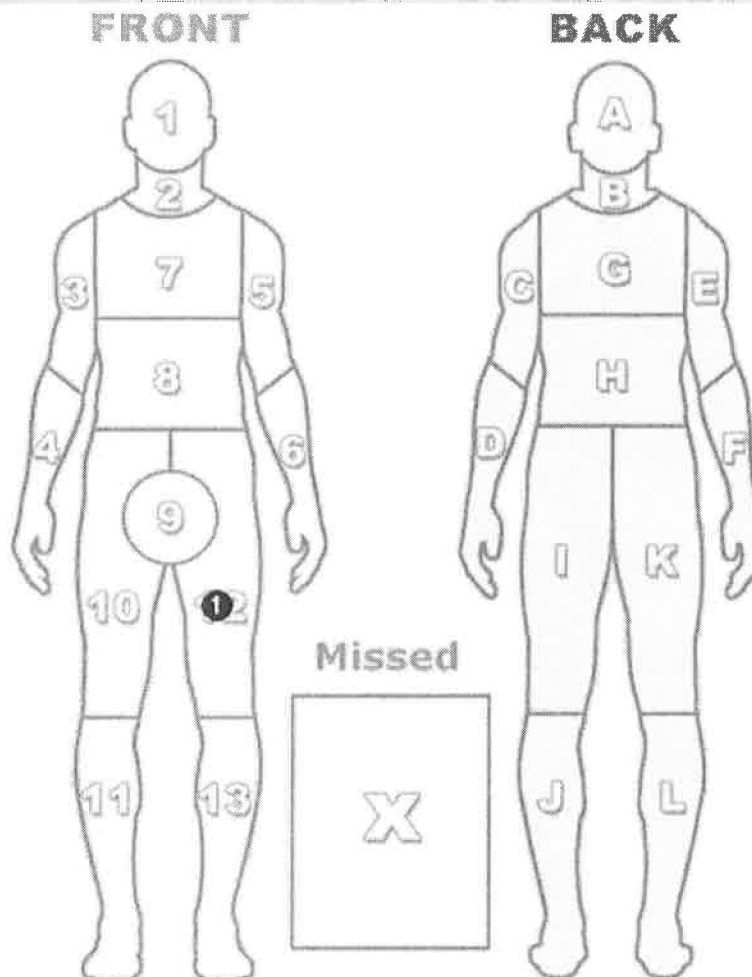

Report Narrative

On 060414 at approx 2230hrs I responded to 6120 N Lidgerwood to assist other Officers with a DV. Upon arrival I contacted Cpl Cordis, who advised there was probable cause to arrest the suspect in the DV, Trevor Hastings, for a minimum of City Assault DV. Cpl Cordis advised the victim was Hastings' sister, and she had significant injuries to her face. If the injuries to her face were as serious as they look, the charge of City Assault DV could rise to a felony level.

As the initial responding Officers arrived on scene, they observed Hastings running from the scene. From the parking lot of the apartment complex at 6109 N Lidgerwood, Hastings ran eastbound across Lidgerwood, through a parking lot and into the alley east of Lidgerwood. Once in the alley, Hastings turned north and ran out of sight. Cpl Cordis and Ofc Brooks ran after Hastings, but by the time they got to the alley Hastings was out of sight.

I deployed SPD K9 Axl for the following reasons;

Severity of the Crime-

There was Probable Cause to arrest Hastings minimum of City Assault DV. Once the extent of the victim's injuries are known, the crime will most likely become a felony domestic assault.

Threat posed to Public and Responding Officers-

This crime took place in an apartment complex. As Officers interviewed the victim and witnesses, numerous residents were walking around. Hastings had already shown that he was violent person by causing significant facial injuries to his own sister. It's unknown to what extent Hastings would go to in order to evade arrest, and if he would harm any more innocent people while attempting to evading arrest. His mother and other family were still at the apartment, and it was unknown if Hastings would return after Officers left and continue the fight.

Hastings posed a large risk to pursuing Officers well. Hastings was familiar with the area, and there were many, many locations that would serve as ideal sites for an ambush on searching Officers. Hastings had not been searched, and it was unknown if he had any weapons in his possession. Hastings has a criminal history of Robbery and felony assaults, so he has a consistent pattern of violence.

Suspect is Actively Resisting or Evading Arrest-

Hastings stayed at the scene of the crime and continued fighting until Police arrived. As soon as the first Officers arrived, he fled on foot in an attempt to evade capture. Hastings refused to stop, even after officers gave several commands to. Without the use of the K9, Hastings would most likely evade arrest that night.

Prior to the start of the track, the 'K9 Announcement' was sent to perimeter cars. I could hear several Officers making announcements over their vehicle PA's. I also made an announcement prior to starting the track. I announced, "Attention in the area! Spokane Police K9 Unit! We are tracking with a Police dog! Surrender now or you will be bit by the K9!" There was no response.

I placed K9 Axl on the last known location of the suspect, right in the alley east of Lidgerwood. I gave Axl the command to track and he did so immediately. We tracked north in the alley to the entrance of the apartment complex courtyard. We entered the courtyard and continued

northbound. The track led us to the northern most part of the courtyard, then back out to the alley. Once in the alley, K9 Axl started showing signs that the suspect was close. We worked our way to the east side of the alley, just at the northeast corner of 6120 N Lidgerwood. K9 Axl showed a large change of behavior towards the vacant lot across the alley to the east of the complex.

Just as we entered the vacant lot, K9 Axl showed high interest in an area underneath a large tree. The tree was next to an older wooden fence section that separated the lot from the alley. Using my flashlight, I was able to see Hastings laying on his back under the tree. He was between the tree and the fence, and he partially covered himself in leaves. I was able to match his physicals, and his clothing matched. I had K9 Axl heel to my side and I gave four loud, clear announcements to Hastings. I announced "Attention in the area! This is the Spokane Police K9 Unit! Trevor Hastings, you are under arrest! Come out now or the K9 will bite you! Trevor, give up now and come out!" Cpl Cordis and Of Pegram were at my side during the announcements. K9 Axl didn't bark during or after the announcements and we paused at least 30-45 seconds between and after.

Hastings refused to surrender peacefully. Even after all the announcements, He still layed under the tree covered in leaves. Hastings posed a larger risk to Officers now. It was obvious he was not giving up, and if K9 Axl was not used, the arrest team would have to crawl under a tree and attempt to physically arrest him. His hands were not visible and it was unclear if he was armed and attempting to bait Officers into a close quarters ambush.

K9 Axl was released from approx 10 feet from Hastings, and given the command to contact. He did so immediately. The contact was on Hasting's upper left leg. As soon as K9 Axl made contact, Hastings sat right up and grabbed K9 Axl's mouth. I ordered Hastings to release the K9, and he did after several commands. Once he let go, I gave K9 Axl the command to release and he did to immediately. K9 Axl contacted Hastings for approx 5 seconds. Hastings held his hands above him, but he still refused to crawl out from under the tree. Cpl Cordis and Ofc Pegram had to physically drag him out from under the tree in order to detain (DL) him.

Medics responded to the scene and looked at the contact location. They placed a gauze band on it and cleared him for the drive up to the hospital. He was transported to Deaconess.

Once at Deaconess, his injuries were cleaned and photographed. His injuries consisted of several rakes and compression marks that broke the skin but weren't bleeding. Cpl Cordis advised the victim's injuries were substantial, and Hastings would be arrested for Assault 3rd DV. PC also existed for Resisting Arrest, due to the fact that he fled from initial responding Officers, then later refused to surrender to the multiple commands I gave him as he hid under the tree.

While at Deaconess, I attempted several times to ask Hastings about the incident and about the K9 contact. Hastings continually yelled profanities at me and flipped me off. When other Officers asked him questions, he would answer a couple questions before flipping them off. At one point, Sgt Kendall asked if the dog performed ok. Hastings replied that the dog (K9 Axl) did great and did his job correctly.

He was cleared from Deaconess and booked into Spokane County Jail.

On 6/4/14 at approx. 2220 hours I was dispatch to assist with a Domestic Violence dispute at Apt # 201, 6109 N. Lidgerwood St. Officer Brooks was already on scene and Dispatch had already indicated that there were two males that had ran from the scene and K9 was already enroute.

As I arrived on scene at approx. 2230 hours I immediately tried to assist Ofc. Brooks and another officer who were trying to control Megan D. Stout, the daughter of the complainant Allana M. Hastings. I instantly saw the extent of Megan's injuries; she had a large, swollen shut left eye and had blood on her nose and upper lip area. Megan was violently and aggressively thrashing around and screaming at all of us officers that were on scene. While those officers took her into custody, I spoke with the complainant, Allana, to find out what happened.

Allana initially told me that her daughter, who had been drinking and smoking pills and marijuana, had asked to speak with her and then proceeded to tell Allana that she was going to commit suicide out of "remorse" for bad things that had happened to her in the past. When Allana tried to talk her out of it, she said that Megan suddenly went out of control and starting assaulting her. She said that Megan hit her in the mouth and grabbed her around the throat. I could see a small abrasion on the right side of her neck going left to right and her lower lip was swollen with a small cut on the inside of it. These areas were consistent with those types of attacks.

Allana then said that the noise from her and Megan woke up her son Trevor, who came into the room and tried to help his mother get Megan under control. Allana then said that is when she had an opportunity to get outside to call 911. Just a few moments after she called, Trevor came outside and down into the parking lot where Allana was at. It was then she said two unidentified males approached Trevor and one of them swung a punch at him, knocking him to the ground. She said Trevor got up and followed the man across the street to the east where they disappeared out of her sight. She said police arrived just moments after.

Ofc. Brooks was first on scene (see his report) and can account to what he encountered when first arriving on scene.

After speaking with Allana, I then helped get Megan out of a patrol vehicle to transport to Holy Family Hospital to get her injuries looked at. At this time she was still very uncooperative and aggressive towards every police officer and repeatedly called us all "niggers" and that she would sue us all. It took several officers/EMS personnel to safely strap Megan down for transport. During this time Megan started making statements like, "My fucking brother hit me!" over and over again.

Before going to the hospital to contact Megan there, I finished up my interview with Allana. She said that she wanted her daughter to get in trouble for attacking her, but then simultaneously wouldn't

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allow us to take pictures of her injuries or come into her apartment to take pictures of a table. This table is what Allana claimed might have caused the swollen eye as Megan may have fallen against it during the initial struggle. During this second contact with her I noticed that she started acting very differently by trying to act as if this incident wasn't that big of a deal and that the police weren't focusing on important things.

When we informed her that seeing the table and taking pictures of her injuries would help for a thorough investigation, she proceeded to show a clear disdain for Law Enforcement and made several claims that we never do anything and that we're just wasting time and aren't listening to her. Around this time I was informed that the K9 track had found Trevor and he was in custody.

I provided her with a crime victims card and options for pursuing a No-Contact Order or contacting a DV Advocate.

I then went to Holy Family Hospital to see the condition of Megan. She had been sedated prior to my arrival since she continued to be out of control with the hospital staff.

I was informed that she had made statements to the hospital staff that she had been drinking and then showed her brother her tattoo on her hip. This is when Trevor put his hand down her pants and grabbed her "pussy". When she resisted, she implied that this is how she received the swollen eye. RN Scott Cosner wrote a statement about her remarks which I later turned into the Records Division. I informed the hospital that she had also made suicidal statements and needed psychological help. Cosner also said Megan's eye injury was serious enough to cause fractures to her eye-socket, but additional evaluations would have to reveal that. He added that the injury was significant enough that her eye was swollen shut and would cause substantial pain that would take considerable time to heal.

Ofc. Mohondro went to Deaconess to contact Trevor, who was being treated for injuries resulting from his arrest.

From the injuries that I saw on Allana and the statements that she made, I had probable cause to charge Megan with City Assault DV. However due to her condition, she was not able to be booked for an indeterminate time and was not going to be released from the hospital. I completed a summons for the above charge.

Also, from the statements Megan had made about Trevor assaulting her, combined with the description of her injuries, I had probable cause to charge Trevor with Assault 3rd Degree DV.

Ofc. Mohondro transported Trevor to the Spokane County Jail and booked him on the Assault 3rd DV charge. There was also probable cause to charge him with Resisting Arrest as based Ofc. Gorman's report.

On 06/04/2014 I responded to 6109 N Lidgerwood St #201 for a report of a domestic violence. The complainant informed dispatch that her intoxicated daughter hit her and pulled her hair. The complainant also informed dispatch that her son was trying to hold her daughter down.

When I arrived, I noticed several individuals in the parking lot screaming at each other. I noticed one unknown male walking eastbound near an apartment complex on the east side of the road without a shirt. A unknown female later identified as Allana Hastings attempted to follow the male and screaming "Get him!". I stopped Allana from following the male as I attempted to calm the chaotic scene. The male made a left turn and walked northbound. I attempted to contact the male but lost sight of him.

I went back to the parking lot to speak with Allana and was interrupted by a another unknown female who emerged from an apartment who was later identified as Megan D. Stout. Megan was yelling "I'm going to kill you!". I noticed Megan's left eye was closed shut from what appeared to be trauma to her left eye and blood on her face. I attempted to calm Megan down as she screamed repeatedly. Megan was in a rage and did not want to listen to my commands. Megan instantly ran back into her apartment and stated "I'm going to kill him!". Allana accompanied me to the apartment and opened the front door which Megan locked. I contacted Megan inside of the apartment. Megan screamed "Look what he did to me! I need to go to the hospital. Help me!". I attempted to calm Megan as I called for paramedics to respond to the scene.

While waiting on paramedics, I asked Megan to explain what happened to her. Megan still screaming

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stated "My brother punched me!". On several occasions Megan stated "Trevor hit me! Trevor hit me!". Megan began flopping on the ground and flailing around. Due to Megan's actions, I decided to place her in my handcuffs (DL) until paramedics arrived for both of our safety. I sat Megan on the sidewalk while paramedics were enroute. Megan attempted to get up on several occasions while screaming "I'm going to kill him!". At this point, I placed Megan in my patrol vehicle as there were several individuals starting to crowd the scene.

Paramedics arrived on scene to evaluate Megan. I was informed that Megan was going to be transported to Holy Family Hospital for her injuries.

Ofc. B. Fabian arrived on scene and spoke with Allana about the incident. Refer to Ofc. B. Fabian's report for further details.

I contacted a witness who I verbally identified as James D. Stoudt. I asked James what did he witness. James stated the following (paraphrased): James and his father just returned home from work when they heard a female screaming. James' father ran to where he heard the female screaming and noticed two males fighting. James heard Megan scream "My brother hit me!". James then noticed two males fighting in the parking lot. The males both left eastbound through an apartment on the east side of the road. James did not have anything else to add about the incident.

On 060414 ofc Brooks and I went to 6109 N Lidgerwood reference a dv. Allana Hastings was calling in saying that her daughter Megan Stout was suicidal and being assaultive. She also said her son Trevor Hastings was trying to hold her down.

Upon arrival we found several people out in the parking lot. Allana and Megan were running around screaming. Allana and some others were pointing to the east saying that males ran that way. At that time we had no idea what they were talking about. Then Allana started going that way saying her son was getting beat up. I could see on Allana that she had dried blood around her mouth. Megan was running up and down the stairs and in the parking lot screaming to Allana that her son, Megans brother, beat her up and that she is going to kill him.

I contacted James Stoudt who said that he and his son had just got home and heard a female screaming. When they went to help he found a young male and female. The w/m, Trevor Hastings, was accusing him of beating up his sister. James said another male came up to see what was going on. The other male was saying something about not hitting women. Trevor started accusing him of assaulting his sister and then went toward the male and tried to hit him. The male stepped back, missed being hit and then punched Trevor in self defense. The male walked away walking e/b to the other apartment complex followed by Trevor. Trevor tried to hit the male again and got knocked down again. Allana then ran over there when Trevor got back up and tried following the male again.

She was screaming at us that her son, Trevor, was getting beat up. She started walking over. At this time I saw a male look from behind the east side of the apartment complex. When ofc Brooks

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and I went over we could not find the male. I had a perimeter set up to the north and east.

Based on what we had heard and what ofc Brooks was told I believed Trevor was our suspect in assaulting his sister. Officer Brooks went to try and talk to Megan. I heard her start screaming at him as he was trying to calm her down. I went up to help him as Megan was screaming at Allana that she let Trevor beat her up and that she was going to kill him for what he did. I could see that Megan had numerous injuries on her face. Her left eye was extremely swollen and purple, she also had blood coming out of her mouth and nose.

K9 officer Gorman arrived and we began a track. I told him based on our evidence Trevor was a suspect in assalting Megan. At one point we were in the alley east of 6120 N Lidgerwood. Officer Gorman stopped and made at least three announcements, calling Trevor by name, warning him the area would be searched by the police dog. When he searched the area the k9 found Trevor. We placed him in handcuffs and waited for a transport car.

I took photos of the area where Trevor was discovered. I went to Holy Family and took photos of Megan then up to Deaconess and took photos of Trevor including his left thigh where the k9 made contact.

On 060414 I responded to the area of 6109 N. Lidgerwood to assist other officers on a DV assault call. Upon arrival I contacted Ofc. Gorman who was about to start a K9 track in search of an assault suspect (Trevor Hastings).

I accompanied Ofc. Gorman on the track as his cover officer. In the alley east of 6120 N. Lidgerwood I heard Ofc. Gorman make several verbal announcements towards an area concealed between a 6 foot wooden fence and a large tree. Ofc. Gorman identified the suspect by name (Trevor) and advised him he was under arrest. Ofc. Gorman identified himself as a Police K9 Unit and ordered the suspect to come out or the K9 would find him and bite him. There was no response to any of Ofc. Gorman's announcements. Ofc. Gorman deployed the K9 into the area and Hastings was located, hiding on the ground behind the fence and concealed under the foliage of the tree.

I assisted Cpl. Cordis in placing Hastings into handcuffs and walking him into the alley. Hastings yelled profanities at officers and refused to stand up while he was being searched. It should be noted that at one point Hastings appeared to "pass out" and acted as if unconscious for a few seconds. He then resumed yelling profanities at officers. I requested medics at that time and they responded to check on Hastings.

On 06/04/2014 at about 2223 hrs Ofc Everly and I responded to the area of 6109 N. Lidgerwood St. to assist other Ofcs. on a report of domestic violence. The suspect left the location so Ofc. Everly and I remained a perimeter position at E. Dalke Ave./N. Addison St. while a K9 was deployed.

At 2256 hrs. it was advised by Ofc. Gorman that the suspect was in custody in the alley at 6109 N. Lidgerwood St. Ofc Everly and I responded there to transport the suspect, later identified as Trevor D. Hastings to jail.

Upon arrival, Hastings was lying on the ground in the back yard of a vacant house in handcuffs. Hastings wasn't wearing a shirt or any shoes. He was complaining that the K9 "bit him" and saying he didn't do anything. I escorted Hastings to my patrol car and began to search him incident to arrest. I asked Hastings if he had anything sharp in his pockets and he said something similiar to reach in and find out. I told Hastings to tell me if there was and he said there might be a razor blade in his pocket. He said something about being a painter so that's why he would have a razor. Hastings was continually complaining about the K9 contacting him and saying he didn't do anything. Hastings said he couldn't walk and his leg hurt.

I searched Hastings' right front and right rear pockets. During my search, Hastings stopped ranting and yelling suddenly. He closed his eyes and became dead weight and almost fell to the ground. I caught Hastings as he was falling and lowered him to the ground in a sitting position. Hastings appeared to be unconscious but was breathing. I could see Hastings' eyelids were twitching. Medics were requested to respond to evaluate Hastings.

Hastings regained consciousness as I held him up in a sitting position. He seemed confused for a moment and asked what happened and where he was. He started complaining about the K9 contacting him again and saying his leg hurt. Ofc. Everly asked Hastings about him passing out and if he was okay and he started yelling at Ofc. Everly, saying he was "talking shit" among other things. Hastings said he knew where Ofc. Everly lived because he had painted his house. Ofc. Everly said that wasn't true and Hastings said "well I painted your wife's house then." Hastings continued to rant about his leg and saying the police beat him up.

Medics responded to evaluate Hastings. I stood him up with the assistance of a paramedic. Hastings refused to stand so they could evaluate his injuries and made himself dead weight, forcing myself

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and a Spokane Fire paramedic to hold him up. While medics were asking Hastings questions about his identity and any medical conditions, Hastings continued to yell at officers and medical personnel, refusing at times to answer their questions. Medics bandaged Hastings' injured leg where the K9 contacted him. AMR responded to transport Hastings to the hospital. Hastings continued to yell at Ofc. Everly, Ofc. Gorman, and Cpl. Cordis calling them a variety of obscene names.

AMR transported Hastings to Deaconess Hospital. Because of Hastings' belligerent behavior and refusal to cooperate, we decided to leave him in handcuffs. I rode in the ambulance with Hastings because he was handcuffed during transport.

Inside the ambulance, I advised Hastings of his constitutional rights and asked him if he understood. He said he heard me. I asked him again if he understood them and he said "nope".

Hastings started talking about his dislike for the police- particularly the officers involved in this incident. He said he got pulled over once and the officer harrassed him. Hastings said something similiar to he put the officer in his place and told him to stop "talking like some down south nigger."

The AMR paramedic, Cody R. Plancich started asking Hastings questions for his paperwork such as Hastings' name and date of birth. Hastings got belligerent with the paramedic and told him to "shut the fuck up" because he didn't want to talk to him. He called the paramedic a "bitch" and told him to stop talking to him. He kept saying Plancich was "fucked up" and not as tough as he thinks he is.

I explained to Hastings that AMR was there to help him and that they needed him to answer their questions. I told Hastings to quit calling them names and using obscene language and he told me (referring to the female ambulance driver) "you're just as fucked up as this dumb fucking bitch driving." Hastings looked at me and started smiling. He said something like I know you, and then said "I know where you live, I painted your house." I told Hastings my house has never been painted and he said "then I know where your fucking parents live." I told Hastings he had no idea where I live. I asked Hastings if he was trying to intimidate me. He said no, he just knows where I live and smiled and laughed.

Hastings continued to yell "fuck" and that he was going to sue Spokane County and the Spokane Police Department for "beating him up" for no reason. He kept asking me why I threw him on the ground so I informed him I was not there when he was arrested. He called me a liar and I told him I arrived after he was already handcuffed. He mumbled something under his breath and said, "you're going to end up fucking dead." He said something about me thinking I'm tough because I carry a gun. I asked Hastings if he was threatening me and he said, "fuck you" and said he didn't do anything wrong.

We arrived at Deaconess and I handcuffed Hastings to the hospital bed because of his irate behavior and the nature of the statements he made to me in the ambulance. Medical staff evaluated

Hastings' injuries. Ofc. Gorman and Cpl. Cordis arrived. Hastings continued to yell expletives in the ER and talk about how he was contacted by a police dog. He ascertained that he had done nothing wrong. He said his sister was the one "acting crazy" and he just left to get away from her. He asked why he was the one that got arrested when his sister was the one beating up his mother.

Cpl. Cordis photographed Hastings' injuries in the ER. The entire time, Hastings was yelling at Ofc. Gorman calling him names like "pizza nose" and continually saying "fuck you" to him. Ofc. Gorman didn't respond, so Hastings started to flip him off over and over again. He continued doing so until Ofc. Gorman left.

I spoke to Plancich again and asked him if he heard what Hastings was saying to me about knowing where I live in the ambulance. Plancich said he heard everything. I asked if he heard what Hastings mumbled before he said "you're going to end up dead" but he did not. He did hear Hastings tell me I would "end up dead" and what he was saying about knowing where I live.

Medical staff at Deaconess treated Hastings' injuries and released him. I handcuffed Hastings behind his back and stood him up to transport him to the Spokane County Jail. He started complaining, saying he thought he also got bit by the K9 on his "ass". Hastings never mentioned any injuries on him other than the bite on his thigh and the injury to his finger until we were getting ready to take him to jail. A nurse came back to Hastings' bed and checked the area he said hurt. There were no injuries there. He said there was a bruise on his right hip. I looked at Hastings' right hip where he pointed and did not see any injuries.

I escorted Hastings to my patrol car and placed him in the back seat. I transported Hastings to the Spokane County Jail where he was booked for 3rd Degree Assault.

On 060414 at approx 2230hrs I responded to 6120 N Lidgerwood to assist other Officers with a DV. Upon arrival I contacted Cpl Cordis, who advised there was probable cause to arrest the suspect in the DV, Trevor Hastings, for a minimum of City Assault DV. Cpl Cordis advised the victim was Hastings' sister, and she had significant injuries to her face. If the injuries to her face were as serious as they look, the charge of City Assault DV could rise to a felony level.

As the initial responding Officers arrived on scene, they observed Hastings running from the scene. From the parking lot of the apartment complex at 6109 N Lidgerwood, Hastings ran eastbound across Lidgerwood, through a parking lot and into the alley east of Lidgerwood. Once in the alley, Hastings turned north and ran out of sight. Cpl Cordis and Ofc Brooks ran after Hastings, but by the time they got to the alley Hastings was out of sight.

I deployed SPD K9 Axl for the following reasons;

Severity of the Crime-

There was Probable Cause to arrest Hastings for a minimum of City Assault DV. Once the extent of the victim's injuries are known, the crime will most likely become a felony domestic assault.

Threat posed to Public and Responding Officers-

This crime took place in an apartment complex. As Officers interviewed the victim and witnesses, numerous residents were walking around. Hastings had already shown that he was violent person by causing significant facial injuries to his own sister. It's unknown to what extent Hastings would go to in order to evade arrest, and if he would harm any more innocent people while attempting to evading arrest. His mother and other family were still at the apartment, and it was unknown if Hastings would return after Officers left and continue the fight.

Hastings posed a large risk to pursuing Officers as well. Hastings was familiar with the area, and there were many, many locations that would serve as ideal sites for an ambush on searching Officers. Hastings had not been searched, and it was unknown if he had any weapons in his possession. Hastings has a criminal history of Robbery and felony assaults, so he has a consistent pattern of violence.

Suspect is Actively Resisting or Evading Arrest-

Hastings stayed at the scene of the crime and continued fighting until Police arrived. As soon as the first Officers arrived, he fled on foot in an attempt to evade capture. Hastings refused to stop, even after officers gave several commands to. Without the use of the K9, Hastings would most likely evade arrest that night.

Prior to the start of the track, the 'K9 Announcement' was sent to perimeter cars. I could hear several Officers making announcements over their vehicle PA's. I also made an announcement prior to starting the track. I announced, "Attention in the area! Spokane Police K9 Unit! We are tracking with a Police dog! Surrender now or you will be bit by the K9!" There was no response.

I placed K9 Axl on the last known location of the suspect, right in the alley east of Lidgerwood. I gave Axl the command to track and he did so immediately. We tracked north in the alley to the entrance of the apartment complex courtyard. We entered the courtyard and continued northbound. The track led us to the northern most part of the courtyard, then back out to the alley. Once in the alley, K9 Axl started showing signs that the suspect was close. We worked our way to the east side of the alley, just at the northeast corner of 6120 N Lidgerwood. K9 Axl showed a large change of behavior towards the vacant lot across the alley to the east of the complex.

Just as we entered the vacant lot, K9 Axl showed high interest in an area underneath a large tree. The tree was next to an older wooden fence section that separated the lot from the alley. Using my flashlight, I was able to see Hastings laying on his back under the tree. He was between the tree and the fence, and he partially covered himself in leaves. I was able to match his physicals, and his clothing matched. I had K9 Axl heel to my side and I gave four loud, clear announcements to Hastings. I announced "Attention in the area! This is the Spokane Police K9 Unit! Trevor Hastings, you are under arrest! Come out now or the K9 will bite you! Trevor, give up now and come out!" Cpl Cordis and Of Pegram were at my side during the announcements. K9 Axl didn't bark during or after the announcements and we paused at least 30-45 seconds between and after.

Hastings refused to surrender peacefully. Even after all the announcements, He still layed under the tree covered in leaves. Hastings posed a larger risk to Officers now. It was obvious he was not giving up, and if K9 Axl was not used, the arrest team would have to crawl under a tree and attempt to physically arrest him. His hands were not visible and it was unclear if he was armed and attempting to bait Officers into a close quarters ambush.

K9 Axl was released from approx 10 feet from Hastings, and given the command to contact. He did so immediately. The contact was on Hasting's upper left leg. As soon as K9 Axl made contact, Hastings sat right up and grabbed K9 Axl's mouth. I ordered Hastings to release the K9, and he did after several commands. Once he let go, I gave K9 Axl the command to release and he did to immediately. K9 Axl contacted Hastings for approx 5 seconds. Hastings held his hands above him,

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but he still refused to crawl out from under the tree. Cpl Cordis and Ofc Pegram had to physically drag him out from under the tree in order to detain (DL) him.

Medics responded to the scene and looked at the contact location. They placed a gauze band on it and cleared him for the drive up to the hospital. He was transported to Deaconess.

Once at Deaconess, his injuries were cleaned and photographed. His injuries consisted of several rakes and compression marks that broke the skin but weren't bleeding. Cpl Cordis advised the victim's injuries were substantial, and Hastings would be arrested for Assault 3rd DV. PC also existed for Resisting Arrest, due to the fact that he fled from initial responding Officers, then later refused to surrender to the multiple commands I gave him as he hid under the tree.

While at Deaconess, I attempted several times to ask Hastings about the incident and about the K9 contact. Hastings continually yelled profanities at me and flipped me off. When other Officers asked him questions, he would answer a couple questions before flipping them off. At one point, Sgt Kendall asked if the dog performed ok. Hastings replied that the dog (K9 Axl) did great and did his job correctly.

He was cleared from Deaconess and booked into Spokane County Jail.
