



Incident #14-247042 907 E. Bridgeport 7/27/2014

Officers responded to 907 E. Bridgeport on a burglary call where a male had entered a residence with a handgun and refused to leave. He was hallucinating and said someone was trying to get into the house. A female lived there with her child. He got her shotgun and locked himself in her bedroom. The female was able to get out of the residence with her baby. The suspect, later identified as $\frac{#14}{100}$ lived at 903 E. Bridgeport. He had barricaded himself in the house and was armed. Officers were able to get the upstairs tenant out safely.

The bearcat was brought to the scene and parked in the street in front of 907 E. Bridgeport. Officers attempted to contact Dreher, but he refused to answer or come out of the residence. While on scene officers heard a gunshot from inside the house. After the shot they heard Dreher moving around in the house. Dreher was uncooperative and demonstrated he was willing to fire his weapons. He appeared to be confused and paranoid.

Officer B. Palmer and Sgt. J. Reynolds were on perimeter in the front of the house. Suddenly, unexpectedly, Dreher came out the front door. Both Officer Palmer and Sgt. Reynolds were closest to Dreher and had their patrol rifles. They were both unsure if Dreher was armed or not. They both pointed their rifles at Dreher until he followed commands and they were both sure he was unarmed. He was taken into custody without incident.

Given all the facts of Dreher's mental state and his willingness to fire weapons, officers were justified pointing their weapons at him until they knew he was unarmed and he complied with commands.

We found he had fired 5 rounds from his handgun at 903 E. Bridgeport before going to 907 E. Bridgeport.

On 7-27-14 at approx. 0718 hrs I responded to 907 E Bridgeport reference a possible burglary.

Information was relayed that a neighbor #14 had come over to warn victim Krahn, Sharon that someone was at her door.

Sharon armed her self with a loaded shotgun. She is concerned about the neighbor, she thinks he is "crazy".

Sharon was in the bedroom now saying neighbor was "cornering" her.

Sharon was able to leave the bedroom to secure her dog in another room, neighbor now has Sharon's gun, because he told someone was trying to get into her house.

Sharon was taking her baby and leaving out the front door.

As I was approaching the house from the west, I heard radio advise that the neighbor now had Sharons shotgun, the front door opened and Sharon came out with her baby #2d in her arms.

We quickly retreated to the west side of 903 E Bridgeport.

Sharon advised her neighbor #14 came to her door armed with a hand gun saying someone had been trying to get in her front door.

Sharon said the slide on the handgun was back and she could see it was not loaded.

Sharon said #14 lives at 903 E Bridgeport with a female named Lora.

Sharon said she grabbed her loaded shotgun for protection thinking someone was trying to get in. Sharon said then started acting really weird/paranoid and scaring her. Sharon said she calmed him down and told him she was going to put her dog in another bedroom because he would not stop barking.

Sharon said share had been sleeping in her bed with her, so she grabbed her and as she left the bedroom shut the door.

Sharon said she then came out the front door.

Sharon was visibly upset/scared and shaking.

Sharon advised there was a room mate Natalie upstairs in her house that has its own separate apartment.

Officer Gately was able to make phone contact with her and she was able to safely exit the house.

While setting up containment on the residence, myself and officer Bishop were in the back yard of 903 E Bridgeport where we could see the back door through a tall 6' cedar fence. While there we heard what sounded like one gun shot coming from inside the residence. The dog continued to bark most of the time we were there.

We also heard loud banging coming from inside the residence [907].

Officer Bishop made several loud verbal announcements telling **#14** to come out, **#14** did not respond.

At approx. 0815 hrs with no warning #14 exited the front door, he was taken into custody without incident.

#14 was sweating profusely, his hair, shirt were soaked with sweat. #14 made the statement that he had "several guns on his person", I searched #14 he only had a cell phone in the left pocket of his shorts.

said there people in the house in the corner, #14 also said he had fired one shot in the house at some one that was in the "wall".

also aid he had fired several shots from the handgun inside 903 E Bridgeport at people who had broke in.

There was no sign of anyone else in either residence.

Police cleared 907 E Bridgeport, there was no one found inside, however the refrigerator was tipped over onto its side against a water cooler in the kitchen. The food from inside the refrigerator was

dumped out all over the kitchen floor.

The bedroom that the first second on the joining wall to the kitchen they share a common wall. In the bedroom is a dresser and stand on the joining wall to the kitchen, in the SE corner of the bedroom on a dresser was a small flat screen TV, this now had a large hole in it where the first had shot the TV with the shotgun.

See officer Bishops report reference collection and placement of the handgun, shotgun and shotgun shell casing.

Talking with Sharon she was undecided if she wanted to pursue charges against #14 realizing that he must have been having some kind of mental break down.

We had received permission from Lora Erickson 903 E Bridgeport to check her residence for any possible victims or damage. Lora had also advised she did have a loaded handgun in her bedroom closet, she was on her way home from Wallace Idaho.

Myself and several other officers cleared her residence, in doing so we observed several [5] shell casing on the floor in a small area that goes into a bathroom and what we later learned was #14 bedroom.

There was a bullet hole into the bathroom door knob, one into th ironing board closet on the east wall of the kitchen, another one on the north edge of the this same kitchen wall that appeared to be angled up exiting approx. 6' up on the exterior living room wall. There was another bullet hole from this same area into the arm of the couch and a pillow on the couch exiting the exterior wall at approx. 3'-4' feet from the floor. Then there was another bullet hole in the upper molding around the ceiling of the exterior living room wall that exited into the upper exterior porch roof.

It should be noted that one of these rounds did exit the exterior wall hitting the outside of the residence directly across the street at 904 E Bridgeport this round did not enter this residence.

I was unable to collect any of the slugs.

The hand gun casing were collected and placed on property along with the guns.

Due to the damage inside the residence of 903 E Bridgeport Lora does want to pursue charges of Malicious Mischief DV.

#14 should also be charged with discharging a weapon in the city limits.

While waiting at the hospital with to be medically cleared before transporting him to jail, he told me the following.

#14 says he does not remember what time of day this all started, however he thinks it was

evening as he believes it was dark outside.

said he first noticed the back porch light on and thought this was odd as it is not usually on. said he went outside to investigate and saw that the outside basement door was open, he says he called Lora about this. **111** He did not see anyone. When he came back in the house he discovered his new prescription medications Adavant and Hydrocodone were missing from his bed side table draw. **111** Believed someone was in the house, this is when he saw two unknown males one in the kitchen and one in Lora's bedroom.

said he went into Lora's bedroom to see where this male went, he did not see him so he started pushing the bed into the corner. said the male was under the bottom bunk and he was under the top bunk. said he reached into the closet and got Lora's handgun to protect himself.

said he retreated to the area of his bedroom, said one of the males was in the kitchen. It should be noted the kitchen is very small and Jeremys bedroom is off the kitchen. There is a small alcove type area going from the kitchen to the bedroom, there is an ironing board cupboard on the west wall of this alcove said he checked this and it was empty. The bathroom is also off the alcove said the bathroom was also empty.

#14 said the guy on the left is 4" from me so I knew e couldn't shoot from that angle, he then disappeared.

#14 said the male that had been in Lora's bedroom shot at him. #14 said he did shoot back at the suspect, but has no idea where the suspect ended up or if he left the house.

said he fired three shots at suspect in 903 E Bridgeport, he also said suspect shot at him 3 or 4 times.

We only located five shots in this residence all except the bathroom one appeared to be fired from where was in the alcove.

said he made his way to the neighbors 907 E Bridgeport to ask for help. #14 v said the female that lives there let him in the house.

#14 said he thinks part of the other guys "crew" was no in the neighbors house, #14 said he was afraid he was being shot.

The female pointed him to the back room where her gun was, said it was a long rifle he thought it was a 30-06 bluish gray gun metal.

said he does not know where the female went from here.

said he could see a gun pointed at him from two different places in the sheet rock fragment said he pulled trigger three times on the rifle but it didn't fire until the third pull.

#14 said there were at least two other males in the house 907 E Bridgeport and one outside.

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I asked that how the refrigerator got tipped over and the food all over the floor, #14 said when there was an extra guy in the house his partner may have hit him.

I asked #14 why he decided to come out of the house when he did he said he heard the police calling to him and knew it was safe.

I had asked #14 earlier if he heard us yelling to him he said he had not. It should be noted no one had been yelling for him to come out when he did.

While waiting with the state of the hospital he continued to say he was seeing people in the over head metal light fixture. He kept asking me if "these people would not stop at anything", I asked him what people and he pointed to the light fixture again, I asked who he saw there he said "no one" then covered his head with the pillow.

Per Sgt Reynolds will also be booked for 1st Burglary for 907 E Bridgeport.

An affidavit was completed.

Cpl Dahle did repond and take photos the damage.

Also a mental hold/evaluation should be placed on #14 once he arrives at jail.

On 07/27/14 at 0712, Sharon Krahn reported a burglary at 907 E Bridgeport. Sharon advised someone was trying to get in her front door. Sharon was armed with a shotgun and heard glass breaking. Her male neighbor was in her living room and had come over to warn her that somebody was at her door trying to get in. Sharon was concerned about her neighbor **114** and thought he was crazy. Sharon advised **114** was cornering her and then became locked in her bedroom with her shotgun. Sharon gave **114** the shotgun because he had told her somebody was breaking into the house. Sharon fled the home with her baby.

I responded to the incident to assist Ofc Malinak and other officers on scene. Malinak had made contact with Sharon outside the house and advised was also armed with a handgun. There was another tenant (Natalie) in the house in an upstairs apartment.

I arrived onscene at 0729 and deployed my Colt M4 rifle. I contacted officers on scene to obtain further information for the incident and where **114** was last seen in the house. I then directed other officers into positions around the house for containment. I went with Malinak to the NW corner of the house. Within minutes of setting up on the NW corner of the house from the backyard of 903 E Bridgeport, I heard one round discharged from a firearm inside the home at 0737 where **114** was located inside of 907 E Bridgeport. The round clearly sounded like a handgun round. The sound came from the area of the bedroom where **114** had last been seen by Sharon on the NE corner of the house. I was approximately 50 ft away from where it sounded like the round was discharged.

Officers were able to establish contact with Natalie and get her out of the house. Officers were unsuccessful through phone or verbals to make any type of contact/communication with fragmeter Radio advised fragmeter had a felony warrant for PCS and 2 misdemeanor driving warrants. A majority of the officers on scene including my self were using fragmeter house/yard at 903 E Bridgeport for cover/concealment. I heard objects in the rear of the house being moved around. Other officers from around the house also advised they heard fragmeter moving things around. It sounded like fragmeter was trying to barricade himself in the house. To this point fragmeter had multiple confirmed warrants, was armed with two firearms, displayed a firearm while entering Sharon's home, had discharged a firearm in the house while officers were on scene outside the house, appeared to be having some sort of mental health episode, and he was barricading the house while he remained unlawfully in Sharon's home. He had refused to communicate with officer's attempts to contact him.

At 0815, <u>#14</u> came out of the house onto the front porch. I heard officers in front of the house communicating with <u>#14</u>. I opened a man gate in the fence at 903 E Bridgeport to go towards the front of 907 E Bridgeport where officers were attempting to contact <u>#14</u>. As I came through the gate I could see <u>#14</u> complying with commands to lie on his stomach on the front porch. Officers were also directing him to display his hands. I could only see <u>#14</u> head/neck and right arm/hand. I couldn't completely see his left arm/hand and this was the hand officers were now directing him to display. He was slow to follow commands to display his left hand.

had previously discharged a handgun in the house and I began given him commands to extend and display his left arm. I feared he still had the handgun on his person and feared for the safety of officers at the front of the house and the citizens in the neighborhood. If the had already demonstrated is willingness to discharge the firearm. If the complied and extended his left arm and I could see it was empty. During the contact with I to this point I do not believe I pointed/aimed my rifle at I and on target. It is a possibility but I do not recall doing this during the tense situation to gain compliance from I and I. I had my rifle directed at a low ready position at the ground below where I and I was on the porch.

After tild complied and showed both hands, I closed in with other officers to take tild y into custody. I slung my rifle and drew my handgun at a low ready position against my chest as Malinak closed in to take tild into custody. My handgun was never aimed/targeted at tild Unce the was taken into custody I secured my handgun. Tild told officers he had multiple guns on his person. No guns were found on him.

I then assisted officers in clearing the house. I observed a handgun with the slide locked back on the living room floor from the front porch. We cleared the home and there was nobody else inside. The Taurus 9mm handgun had an empty magazine with the slide locked to the rear. In the kitchen, the refrigerator and water cooler had been tipped over against the cabinets. The contents of the refrigerator had fallen onto the ground. In the back bedroom in the NE corner of the house where had last been seen I observed a shotgun leaning against the wall at the base of the window on the east side of the house. It was a single shot Taurus .20 gauge shotgun with a spent bird shot casing inside. The shotgun round had been discharged directly into the east wall of the bedroom just south of the bedroom window. Part of the round/wadding struck a flat screen Phillips TV that was next to where the impact in the wall was. The round penetrated the TV and destroyed the screen.

I collected the shotgun, handgun, and spent .20 gauge casing after photos were taken of the incident. Officers learned that fired the shotgun round into the wall when he believed he saw the imaginary burglary suspect on the other side of the wall. Officers also learned fired had emptied the Taurus 9mm into the walls of his house at 903 E Bridgeport prior to bringing the 9mm handgun over to Sharon's house and coming inside. I assisted Malinak in collecting five 9mm Luger

On 7/27/14 at approximately 0715 hrs, I responded to a possible burglary call at 907 E Bridgeport. The caller indicated that her neighbor had come to her house and told her someone was breaking into her house. The caller believed her neighbor at first and gave him her shotgun. After noticing some strange behavior by her neighbor, she took her child and went out of her house. Officer Malinak arrived on scene first and was speaking to the female caller one house away. I joined them and listened to the caller describe her neighbors behavior. From her description, it sounded as if he (identified as #14 was on drugs or had some kind of mental breakdown. With the caller's information that ______was still armed inside her home, more units were dispatched to our location.

Several other units arrived and I was asked to watch the back door to the home, facing north. I went with Cpl. Dahle to the back yard of the neighboring house to the East, and found cover behind a vehicle. While watching the back of the house, I could hear loud banging inside as if #14 were barricading himself. Also while watching the back, Officer D. Bishop was making loud announcements at the back for #14 to come outside with nothing in his hands.

After some time watching the back, I heard a noise at the front of the house and heard other Officers yelling at someone to show them their hands. I held the back of the house until units in front advised they had #14 detained.

I went to the front of the house where I was asked to follow the ambulance to the hospital with #14 . I followed AMR to Deaconess E.R. where he was later treated. While there with #14 he was saying that he was trying to run from people chasing him and he hurt his leg. He said that seven or eight men came thru holes in the walls that they had made, to get him. He said he fired several shots at the intruders, but he wasn't sure if he hit any of them. Shortly afterward, Officer Malinak arrived to relieve me.

Officers requested a supervisor at 907 E. Bridgeport so I responded. A neighbor, later identified as **a supervisor** had forced his way into 907 E. Bridgeport with a handgun in his hand. The complainant said there was a loaded shotgun in the residence. She was able to get out the the building.

When I arrived Bridgeport was blocked off and the residence was secure. Officer D. Bishop controlled the tactical deployment of officers around the residence. Officers were able to contact the upstairs resident and got her out of her apartment safely. Residents to the East of 907 E. Bridgeport were advised of what was happening. Officer Aitken responded with the SWAT Bearcat and parked it in front of the residence on Bridgeport. Officer K. Gately found out who lived at 903 E. Bridgeport with and contacted her. Officers on scene advised they heard a shot from inside the apartment. I set up the command post in my vehicle at Bridgeport and Cincinnati.

I advised DSO Captain Arleth of the situation and called Lt. Meidl about the possibility of having SWAT respond. I had dispatch send out a command page. I advised Brian Schaffer,Spokane Fire Department of what was happening. Medics staged to the East of the residence.

#14 suddenly walked out the front door of the residence and was detained in handcuffs. Officers cleared the residence and found a wall inside was shot with the shotgun. The shot did not penetrate the outside wall of the house. There was a handgun inside. Medics treated #14 and he was transported to Deaconess Hospital to be treated.

The resident of 903 E. Bridgeport gave us permission to clear the residence. Officers found 5 spent casings and bullet holes in several walls. Surrounding cars and houses were checked for any bullet holes.

#14 was booked for First Burglary.

On 07-27-14 at approx 0715 hrs I responded to 907 E. Bridgeport reference an occupied 1st burglary. When I arrived onscene I assisted with the inner perimeter. The SWAT team was also activated and arrived with the Bearcat to give Officers additional cover due to the lethally dangerous situation. I was posted at the SW corner of 903 E. Bridgeport with a patrol rifle.

Initial information was that the suspect had come from 903 E. Bridgeport and was currently barricaded in 907 E. Bridgeport. He arrived at 907 with an empty (at that time) handgun and had got a loaded shotgun from the occupant before she escaped. While officers were setting up the perimeter (and before I arrived) they advised radio that they heard a gun shot from inside the residence.

I was posted with Ofc. Palmer. We discussed our firing angles if the suspect was to exit through the front door which was the side we were covering. We also said that we could not let him fight his way back into 903 because we assumed he could have more weapons stashed in his own house.

After about 1/2 hour I heard the front door of 907 and saw free emerge. Ofc. Palmer and I were the closest Officers to him and in his direct line of sight with only the corner of the house as cover. He was profusely sweating and looked confused and paranoid. His head was swiveling quickly and it appeared he was looking for escape routes. His shirt was baggy and I could not tell if he had secreted weapons on his person. I could see that his hands were empty. I considered Dreher to be a definite threat and pointed my patrol rifle at the center of his chest.

I then assisted Officers with clearing 907. I saw a black Taurus handgun laying on the floor in the living room. I could see the slide was locked to the rear. In the NE bedroom I saw a silver/black shotgun. After the house was clear I exited and asked #14 for fired the gun in the house. He said that he did and that he had found a "double barrel, single action, 30-06. He said he heard a suspect on the other side of the wall so he shot through the wall because he knew he could hit the suspect through the wall.

I went back into the house and saw what appeared to be a shotgun blast to the TV in the NE

I then assisted clearing 903. I saw at least 4 or 5 handgun shell casings on the floor in the house. There were also multiple holes in the walls. I assigned Cpl. Dahle and other Officers to track the holes and compare it to the number of casings that were found. They also checked neighboring houses and vehicles to make sure stray bullets had not hit anyone.

I did not interview anyone or collect any evidence.

I discussed the elements of 1st Burglary with the officers conducting the interviews and gathered information from Spokane Police Dispatch Supervisor Marvin Tucker. Although the victim initially allowed into her house under the guise that he was looking for a prowler, he remained unlawfully and committed the crimes of malicious mischief and discharging a firearm. After he was in the house she became very concerned about his behavior and then he barricaded himself into her bedroom. She was so scared of him that she grabbed her baby and abandoned the house to go down the block. He was also in possession of a firearm when he initially entered the house and then shot a round off from the 2nd gun that he obtained in the house. I determined that this fit the elements of unlawfully remaining inside and being armed with a deadly weapon.
