



Use of Force - Taser application

Officer Interview Summary

Officers were interviewed at the scene and their reports are consistent with the statements given. All details are within their individual reports. The only additional comment made was that a body camera in this particular incident would have given great evidence of the suspect's aggressive actions and behavior.

Anest talked briefly with me but would only say he "didn't do anything" and "I didn't fight with the officers." He did inadvertently admit that he had sprayed some lady with "mace" because she "was coming at me." He would not let me look at the Taser contact points on his body. He was obviously intoxicated and/or on unknown drugs. Anest is very large and muscular. He had a small abrasion on the right side of his forehead. He did not complain of pain or injury.

Witness Interview Summary

Witness Angela Archuletta refused to talk to me probably because she was under arrest for assaulting one of the officers when Anest was being taken into custody. There were no other witnesses.

Physical Evidence

Justin Anest refused to allow pictures to be taken. He also refused to let me look at the Taser contact points. His booking photo does show the small abrasion on his forehead from when he fell to the ground. The Taser cartridge was placed onto Property.

Investigative Summary


The conclusion of the investigation indicates that the two probe and one contact Taser applications were appropriate and within policy given the circumstances. Officer Belitz articulated well the reason for each of the individual applications which were a response of the active and assaultive behavior exhibited and exercised by Anest. During the struggle to get Anest into custody the danger and significance of Anest's resistance was amplified when his wife, Archuletta, jumped into the fray and ultimately assaulted one of the officers.

Policy 309 states, "The TASER device is intended to control a violent or potentially violent individual, while minimizing the risk of serious injury." In this case, the Taser device application accomplished that intention.



On 10/01/2014 I (Officer Groom) was dispatched to Snoops Tavern located at 805 E. Rosewood in Spokane WA, reference an assault call. It was reported that a male maced a female and a male in the parking lot outside Snoops Tavern. The suspect was described as a WM, in his 40's, about 5'05", heavy, bald head wearing a tank top and had tattoos. It was mentioned that the male was the husband of a bartender that worked at Snoops.

I arrived on scene and contacted John T. Mahoney. John explained that the following happened:

He over heard an argument that happened while he was in the bar. He went outside to the parking lot and was just hanging out. He saw a male later identified as, Justin Anest, exit the bar and get into an argument with a female, Debra Arguellez.

John saw Justin go to his truck a Gray full size truck with WA license plate #B37548U and grab a can of OC. John saw Justin spray Debra and another male, David Arguellez, in the face. John saw the male go back into the bar after spraying them.

I contacted Debra Arguellez, she was very distraut and was complaining of her eyes and face hurting. She explained that the following happened:

She got into an argument with Justin inside the bar around the pool table. The bar staff was able to break up the argument and nothing else happened inside the bar.

She exited the bar and was in the parking lot talking to bar staff when Justin exited the bar and continued arguing with her. Justin went to his truck and grabbed a can of OC Spray.

At first Debra thought it was a gun and she could not see what he had. Justin walked up to her and sprayed her in the face. She was able to turn away and her son, David jumped in front of her and got

sprayed as well. Justin continued to spray her and David.

Justin then returned to the bar and only left when he got word that the police were coming. He got into the truck and drove towards the crowd in the parking lot, but turned off missing them.

Through a license plate check it showed that the vehicle was registered to an Angela Archuleta that lived at 13204 E. 9th in Spokane Valley WA.

Myself, Ofc. Mohondro, Ofc. C. Lesser, Ofc. Belitz, and Ofc. Gorman responded to Justin's residence at 13204 E. 9th Ave in Spokane Valley to contact Justin.

I knocked on the door several times and announced that I was a police officer. We received no answer at the door. Justin's vehicle was not parked at the house. As we were walking back to our patrol vehicles, Justin's vehicle drove by the location going EB on 9th Ave.

Justin's vehicle continued past his house and turned SB on S. Clinton Rd. I went back to my patrol vehicle and went EB on E. 11th Ave to attempt to stop Justin.

I turned NB on Clinton and saw Ofc. Mohondro and Ofc. Lesser had Justin stopped on S. Clinton between E. 9th Ave and E. 10th Ave. I pulled to the right of Ofc. Mohondro's patrol vehicle and activated my emergency lights.

Ofc. Lesser and Ofc. Mohondro conducted a felony stop on the vehicle. See there reports for further.

Justin had assaulted two individuals using pepper spray. He flipped us off when we arrived which already showed that he was uncooperative. I drew my gun to the low ready position and took a position of cover near the back of Ofc. Lesser's patrol vehicle.

I ordered Justin to step away from the vehicle and show his hands which he refused to do. He was yelling "I didn't do anything".

After several commands to do so Justin finally stepped away from the vehicle. He was yelling "I didn't fucking do anything" over and over and saying "fuck you leave me alone." We continued to order Justin to show his hands and stay away from the vehicle. Justin yelled "for what" and I advised him that he was under arrest for third degree assault.

Justin started saying, "shoot me!" and putt his hands into his pockets. He would pull them out and continued to yell "shoot me" or "leave me the fuck alone." Justin was willfully disobeying all lawful orders given by officers on scene.

I could see from where I was standing that the muscles in Justin's shoulders and arms were flexed.

Justin was clearly very physically fit, weighing about 250 pounds and standing about 5'09", much larger than myself and the other officers on scene. It was clear that Justin was not going to comply with any lawful orders.

I continued to order Justin to show his hands and his wife Angela D. Archuletta began yelling at us. She yelled, "shut the fuck up" and "well fucking shoot him then!" several times and refused orders to step away from Justin.

Angela kept walking in front of Justin and pulling his hands down. Angela turned back toward us several times and yelled "fuck you!" while flipping us off.

Justin walked back to the vehicle and leaned into the driver side. I was unable to determine what if anything was retrieved from the vehicle. Justin was ordered to take his hands out of his pockets, and he quickly removed both of his hands and yelled "shoot me" as he stretched his arms out. He continued to yell at us before leaning back into the driver side of the vehicle.

Around that time I observed Ofc. Belitz behind Justin's vehicle. Justin stepped away from the vehicle again, and Ofc. Belitz deployed his Taser. See Ofc. Belitz's report for further.

Justin fell to the ground and Angela moved toward him and grabbed him. Ofc. Mohondro and I attempted to gain arm control on Justin. He continued to yell that he didn't do anything. I had Justin by the right wrist and elbow. I advised him several times that he was under arrest for assault and ordered him to stop resisting.

I was able to get his right arm behind his back, but he was fighting us from getting his left arm behind his back. I felt Justin flex his right arm and try to pull it under his body. Eventually Ofc. Mohondro and I were able to detain Justin in handcuffs.

Fire was requested to remove the taser cartridges. A supervisor was requested to the scene. I assisted Justin to Ofc. Mohondro's patrol vehicle. Justin was searched and transported to the Spokane County Jail and booked for Assault 3rd 9A.36.031.

Justin was also cited #4Z0932006, for Resisting Arrest 10.07.034 and Obstructing 10.07.032 due to him not obeying commands and resisting.

Justin refused to have photos taken of his injuries.

I conducted no further investigation.

On 10/01/2014 at approximately 2340 hours, I was dispatched to 805 E Rosewood Ave to assist Ofc Groom on a possible assault call.

I arrived on scene and contacted Ofc Groom and Ofc Mohondro. Ofc Groom and Mohondro had already interviewed several people, and established probable cause to arrest Justin Anest for 3rd degree assault.

Justin had since fled the scene but due to witnesses on scene we were able to trace the license plate of Justins vehicle back to his address in the Spokane valley.

Myself, Ofc. Groom, Ofc. C. Mohondro, Ofc. Belitz, and Ofc. Gorman responded to Anest's residence at 13204 E. 9th Ave in Spokane Valley to attempt to make contact with him.

Upon arriving on scene, we received no answer at the door. As myself and the other officers were walking back to our vehicle, Anest drove by the location going EB on 9th Ave. As Anest's truck drove by I observed Anest in the driver seat mean mugging us. Anest continued past his house and turned onto Clifton Rd. I ran back to my patrol vehicle and went EB on E. 10th Ave to attempt to intercept Anest and conduct a traffic stop.

As I came around the corner of S. Clifton street, I observed Ofc Mohondro's patrol vehicle stopped in front of Anest's truck. Ofc Mohondro had all of his emergency lights on and was identifying himself as the Spokane Police Department. I pulled up in front of the vehicle and

activated my emergency lights. Ofc. Mohondro and I conducted a felony stop on the vehicle.

Anest had assaulted two individuals earlier in the night using pepper spray and it was unknown if he still had the pepper spray on him. As I Gave Anest verbal commands to remove his hands from his pockets, he flipped me off and returned both hands into his pockets. Local records showed Anest had a history of violent behavior, and Ofc Belitz advised me that Anest had been violent in his past run run-ins with him.

I drew my gun to the low ready position and took a position of cover near the back door of my patrol vehicle. I gave Anest verbal commands to step away from the vehicle. Anest told me that he was not going to step away, and that he was not going to listen.

After several commands to do so Anest stepped away from the vehicle. He was yelling "I didn't fucking do anything" over and over and saying "fuck you leave me alone." I continued to order Anest to show his hands and stay away from the vehicle. Anest yelled "for what" and Ofc. Groom advised him that he was under arrest for third degree assault. Anest started saying, "shoot me!" and putting his hands into his pockets. He would then quickly pull them out and continue to yell "shoot me" or "leave me the fuck alone." Anest was willfully disobeying all of myself and Ofc Mohondro's verbal commands. I could see from where I was standing that Anest was wearing a tank top which exposed the majority of his arms and neck. Anest was flexing his muscles and balling his fists. As Anest continued with these motions he was continually challenging us verbal to fight him. The vein in the side of Anests neck was flexed and I could see it from several feet away. Anest was clearly physically fit, weighed approximately 250 pounds. Anest was estimated to be 5' 9". Anest was clearly more muscular and physically fit then myself and other officers on scene.

Myself and other officers continued to order Anest to show his hands. Anest's wife, Angela D. Archuletta began yelling at officers. Angela continually yelled, "well fucking shoot him then!" and "shut the fuck up". I told Angela several times to back away from Anest and to sit on the curb. Angela continued to disobey commands by responding with profane language. Angela kept walking in front of Anest several times and bear hugging him. Angela would also pull down his hands down and tell officers to shoot them. Angel flipped us off several times throughout the felony stop

Anest walked back to the vehicle and leaned into the driver side door. I ordered Anest to exit the vehicle immediately and to show me his hands. He stepped back away from the vehicle with his hands in his pockets. I was unable to determine if Anest had retrieved a weapon or anything from the vehicle. Anest was ordered to take his hands out of his pockets. Anest quickly removed both of his hands from his pockets and yelled "shoot me". Anest reached back into the vehicle several more times as I continued to yell at him to exit the vehicle. I observed Ofc. Belitz and Ofc. Gorman behind Anest's vehicle taking a tactical position. Anest stepped away from the vehicle again. Ofc. Belitz deployed his Taser. See Ofc. Belitz's report for further details.

As Anest was effected by the Taser and fell to the ground, Angela moved toward Anest and latched onto his chest. I stepped away from the cover of my patrol vehicle and took arm control of

Angela. Anest was not detained yet and I was afraid that Angela would continue to start problems amongst officers and Anest. As I escorted Angela to the side of the road and out of the way, she screamed profanities at me and clinched her fists. I could feel Angela tensing up her arms and shoulders. As I was holding Angela in arm control, I could feel Angela attempting to pull her arm away. I had to physically restrain her from her pulling out of arm control. I told Angela several times to stop resisting and to calm down. Angela continued to scream at me and she refused to unbal her fists. Angela was escorted to the ground in attempt to detain her.

As I attempted to detain Angela in handcuffs, she was able to roll over and use her fingernails to scratch my right arm. Due to our hands being sweaty, Angela was able to slip her small hand out of my grip. Angela balled her fist, cocked her hand back, and struck me in the face. I was able to gain control of Angelas hands and detain her in handcuffs (d.I)

I established probable cause to arrest Angela for obstructing and 3rd degree assault on a police officer. I searched Angela incident to a lawful arrest and placed her in the back of my patrol car.

Angela stated that she wanted her purse out of the truck along with the keys. The truck is registered in Angelas name. Angela gave consents to go in and search the truck for her "keys", "purse" and "whatever the fuck else we needed". I filled out a search and consent card. Angels purse and keys were removed from the vehicle. The vehicle was locked up and secured to the best of our ability. The can of OC spray used in the earlier assault was not located.

Ofc Belitz transported Angela to the Spokane County Jail where she was booked for 3rd degree assault on a police officer and obstructing.

Cpl Kakuda met me at the public safety building and documented via photographs scratch marks on my right hand.

On 10/01/2014 at about 2344 hrs I responded to Snoop's Tavern at 805 E. Rosewood Ave to assist Ofc. Groom on a report of an assault. The complainant advised that a male had maced a male and female in the parking lot of the bar.

Upon arrival, I contacted David R. Arguellez. Arguellez is deaf and was unable to speak to me. I communicated with him in written form. I asked Arguellez what happened and he wrote, "long story." He started pointing at his eyes and then rubbing them. He was shirtless and his eyes were red, watery and appeared to be irritated. Arguellez made a back and forth motion in front of his face with his index finger held up as if he were holding a canister of some sort. I asked Arguellez if he wanted to press assault charges and he shook his head side to side and made a pushing motion away from him with both hands. I wrote "yes or no" and he circled "no".

Ofc. Groom interviewed another victim and a witness, who provided him the suspect's license plate and their statements. He was able to determine probable cause to arrest the suspect Justin M. Anest for third degree assault.

13204 E. 9th Ave in Spokane Valley to contact him. While enroute I checked Anest's history through local records and discovered that he had been arrested several times for assault, harassment, and had been arrested for Assault in the second degree with a deadly weapon in October 2013.

Upon arrival we received no answer at the door. As we were walking back to our patrol vehicles, Anest drove by the location going EB on 9th Ave. I saw him look at us as he slowed down and continued EB. Anest continued past his house and turned SB on S. Clinton Rd. I went back to my patrol vehicle and went EB on E. 10th Ave to attempt to stop Anest.

I observed Anest's vehicle stopped on S. Clinton between E. 9th Ave and E. 10th Ave. I pulled up in front of the vehicle and activated my emergency lights. Ofc. Lesser and I conducted a felony stop on the vehicle. Anest was standing between the driver side and open driver door of the vehicle urinating in the street. When he observed my emergency lights, he raised his left hand and flipped me off. Anest had assaulted two individuals using pepper spray. He flipped me off when I arrived which already showed that he was uncooperative. Local records showed Anest had a history of violent behavior. I drew my gun to the low ready position and took a position of cover near the back door of my patrol vehicle. I ordered Anest to step away from the vehicle and show his hands which he refused to do. He was yelling "I didn't do anything" among other things.

After several commands to do so Anest stepped away from the vehicle. He was yelling "I didn't fucking do anything" over and over and saying "fuck you leave me alone." I continued to order Anest to show his hands and stay away from the vehicle. Anest yelled "for what" and Ofc. Groom advised him that he was under arrest for third degree assault. Anest started saying, "shoot me!" and putting his hands into his pockets. He would then quickly pull them out and continue to yell "shoot me" or "leave me the fuck alone." Anest was willfully disobeying all of myself and Ofc. Lesser's lawful orders. I could see from where I was standing that the muscles in his shoulder's were flexed. The vein in the side of his neck was also prominently showing through his skin. Anest was clearly very physically fit, weighing about 250 pounds and standing about 5'9" tall, much larger than myself and the other officers on scene. It was clear that Anest was not going to comply with any lawful orders.

I continued to order Anest to show his hands and his wife Angela D. Archuletta began yelling at us. She yelled, "shut the fuck up" and "well fucking shoot him then!" several times and refused orders to step away from Anest. Angela kept walking in front of Anest and pulling his hands down. Angela turned back toward us several times and yelled "fuck you!" while flipping us off.

Anest walked back to the vehicle and leaned into the driver side. I ordered him to step away from the vehicle again and he continued to yell from inside the vehicle. He stepped back away from the vehicle with his hands in his pockets. I was unable to determine what Anest had retrieved from the vehicle. Anest was ordered to take his hands out of his pockets, and he quickly removed both of his hands and yelled "shoot me" as he stretched his arms out. He continued to yell at us before leaning back into the driver side of the vehicle. At that time I observed Ofc. Belitz behind Anest's vehicle.

Anest stepped away from the vehicle again, and Ofc. Belitz deployed his Taser.

Anest fell to the ground and Angela moved toward him and grabbed him. Ofc. Lesser and I moved up and placed Angela into arm control and pulled her away from Anest. Ofc. Lesser escorted Angela away from Anest and Ofc. Groom and I attempted to gain arm control on Anest. He continued to yell that he didn't do anything. I had Anest by the left wrist and elbow. I advised him several times that he was under arrest for assault and ordered him to stop resisting. I ordered him several times to put his hands behind his back and he refused to do so, saying "no fuck you." I felt Anest flex his right arm and try to pull it under his body. My left hand slipped from Anest's wrist and I felt his hand wrap around the fingers of my left hand. I believed Anest was attempting to gain control of me to pull me onto the ground so that he could assault me. Eventually Ofc. Groom and I were able to detain Anest in handcuffs.

Spokane Valley Fire responded and evaluated Anest. They removed the Taser probes and Anest began to yell at them. He refused to allow them to take his blood pressure or evaluate him any further. Ofc. Groom and I escorted Anest to my patrol vehicle and placed him in the back seat. Anest complained that the handcuffs were too tight and hurting his wrists. We removed Anest from the vehicle and checked the handcuffs. Ofc. Groom adjusted them to finger spacing and double locked the handcuffs per department policy. Anest was placed back inside the vehicle.

Sgt. Tiegen responded to the scene and spoke with Anest.

I transported Anest to the Spokane County Jail. The entire way to jail, Anest continued to yell at me. He yelled various things, calling me a "little bitch" and a "douche bag", saying I am "a little punk" and that he didn't do anything. Anest did not stop yelling the entire way to jail. Upon arrival at the west gate to the public safety building, Anest started screaming that his handcuffs were too tight. I told him that we had already adjusted them for him and that they would take them off at jail, where we had arrived. Anest velled "fuck you" several times again and began kicking the rear passenger door of my patrol vehicle.

I booked Anest into the Spokane County Jail for Assault 3, Obstructing, and Resisting arrest on citation #4Z0932006.

Cpl. kakuda responded to jail to photograph Anest's injuries and he declined to have photos taken.

On 100214 at approximately 0042 hours, I responded to assist other officers in arresting a felony assault suspect. The suspect was identified as Justin M. Anest. Officer Groom had PC to arrest Justin for 3rd Degree Assault. It was discovered that Justin was living at 13204 E. 9th Ave in the Spokane Valley.

We arrived at the location in an effort to contact Justin. When we knocked at the house, we received no answer. After we decided to clear the location, we were walking back to our patrol vehicles when I observed Justin's Nissan truck turn east on 9th from McDonald.

As the truck passed us, I observed Justin driving the vehicle. He continued east on 9th Ave, past his house and then turned south on Clinton St. Officers Lesser, Mohondro and Groom ran to their vehicles and attempted to get Justin stopped. Officer Gorman, his K9 partner AxI, and I ran back to the house in case Justin returned.

As I was at the house, I heard officers giving Justin orders to "get his hands out of his pockets" and to "get on the ground." These orders seemed to be coming from the area of Clinton and 9th Ave. I then heard Officer Lesser say over the radio that they had the vehicle stopped and it was occupied by 2 people.

Officer Gorman and I ran east on 9th to Clinton and then headed south. We located Justin and the other officers about mid block on Clinton between 9th and 10th. Officers Lesser, Mohondro and Groom were attempting to conduct a felony stop on Justin but he was very aggitated and non-compliant.

As I approached, the first thing I heard was Justin yell loudly "fucking shoot me!" Justin was shoving his hands into his pockets and rapidly removing them. He appeared to be attempting to provoke a lethal encounter by getting officers to think he had a deadly weapon. Officer Gorman and I were able to sneak up behind Justins vehicle while the other officers continued verbal commands with Justin. I could hear the officers loudly and clearly tell Justin several times that he was under arrest.

Meanwhile, his wife Angela, was also very aggitated and screaming profanities at the officers. I could hear her screaming "fuck you, you shut the fuck up" as the officers were attempting to give

Justin orders. Angela would step in front of Justin and yell at officers and then step away telling Justin that he did not need to follow orders because he did nothing wrong.

Neither Justin or Angela were compliant with anything the officers asked or ordered. At one point, Justin yelled "fuck this shit, I'm done" and headed back to the truck and started to get into the drivers seat. Justin was reaching all over the drivers area and it was unknown what he was reaching for. He refused all orders from officers to show his hands and to stop reaching in the vehicle.

Justin emerged from the vehicle in a violent manner throwing his hands out in front of him again yelling "come on, fucking shoot me." Justin stopped just in front of the front bumper of his vehicle and flexed his muscles and yelled to the officers in front of him "come one, bring it on" and took a fighting stance.

*****At this point, Justin was under arrest for 3rd Degree Assault, a felony. This crime of assault is a crime of violence.

*****As Justin was being contacted, he was clearly very aggitated and cussing at officers. Justin had not been frisked or searched and therefore I was uncertain if he was in possession of or concealing any weapons on his person. Furthermore, Justin appeared to be attempting to provoke a lethal encounter with his behavior. He was continually reaching into his unsearched pockets and even dove back into his vehicle at one point and appeared to be searching for something. I was very familiar with Justin and his criminal history throughout my 10 years in law enforcement between SPD and the Spokane County Sheriffs Office. Justin has a long history of violent felony crime ranging from DV assault to 2nd Degree Assault with a deadly weapon. If Justin was able to escape, he had the potential of creating a danger to the community. Justin was wearing a tank top shirt and I could clearly see that he was a very large individual. He was fit and muscular and the muscles in his arms were large and he appeared to be a weight lifter or someone who routinely works out. We needed to control the situation as quickly as possible as Justin seemed to be escalating.

***** Justin refused all orders to get on the ground and to stop reaching into the vehicle or into his pockets. It was very clear that Justin completely disregarded the fact that we were police officers and showed no signs of following orders or directions. Justin continually looked around as if to be looking for an escape route to avoid going to jail. Justin had placed himself in a situation where he knew he was under arrest and seemed to be willing to whatever it took to avoid going to jail. Justin was very aware that we were the police as all officers on scene were in full uniform with badges and department patches and the vehicles that were in front of him were fully marked police cars with their overhead emergency lights activated. Justin then looked directly at the officers in front of him and yelled "fuck you, bring it on" and took a fighting stance. Justin clearly had some fighting experience based on his stance and the fact that he had rolled his shoulders forward. Justins hands were

clenched into fists and I could see the muscles in his back and shoulders start to bulge as he did this. His behavior was assaultive and there was no telling what Justin would do to get awav.

For the above mentioned reasons, when Justin rolled his shoulders forward, I stepped out from the rear of his truck and yelled "index" and applied the probes (Cartridge #H09-1343667) from my TASER (Serial #X12000MMH) to Justin's back. The probes contacted Justin in the top middle of his back and the other was just below the belt line.

Justin stiffened up and fell backwards to the ground. Officers Mohondro and Groom moved in to take Justin into custody during the 5 second application. Angela was interfering so Officer Lesser took control of her (see Ofc, Lessers report for details). I told Justin to roll over to his stomach while the TASER was still in cycle. Once Justin was on the ground. Officers Mohondro and Groom attempted to get Justin into handcuffs. See their reports for details.

After the 5 second cycle from my TASER was over, Justin again started to become assaultive. He now appeared to be more angry. As Officer Mohondro was attempting to gain control of Justins left arm, it appeared that he was attempting to strike Officer Mohondro with a clenched fist.

*****Justin had already had the TASER applied to him and knew that he was still connected to it. He seemed to not care that he was still connected. I told him to stop resisting and to give up his left arm. Justin seemed to be completely ignoring all of my commands. Justin outweighs both Officer Mohondro and Officer Groom by over 100 pounds each and was clearly taking advantage of this significant size mismatch. Justin appeared to be focused on assaulting Officer Mohondro. I gave Justin one last warning to stop resisting or I would again apply the TASER to him. Justin again refused my commands and continued to swing his left arm at Officer Mohondro.

For the above mentioned reasons, I again pressed the trigger of my TASER (Serial #X12000MMH) and delivered another 5 second cycle to Justin with the already connected probes. During the 5 second cycle, Officer Mohondro attempted to gain control of Justins left arm. He was finally able to maintain control of Justins arm and wrist.

I continued to give Justin commands to stop resisting and to calm down. At first, Justin. appeared to be complying. Approximately 20-25 seconds later, Justin again began yelling at us and was able to pull his left arm away from Officer Mohondro. He then grabbed onto Officer Mohondros wrist and appeared to be pulling him down towards him.

When Justin did this, I could see the veins in his arm bulge and his knuckles turned white. The size of Justins hand compared to Officer Mohondros wrist was significant. His hand appeared to completely engulf Officer Mohondros wrist.

*****At this point, Justin had already had the TASER applied two times. He clearly did not care that he was still connected and completely disobeyed every order we gave him. Justin appeared very focused and committed to get away and not go to jail. Justin was very strong and was winning the battle with Officer Mohondro. Justin did not appear to be tiring. In fact, he appeared to be gaining strength and stamina. Justin appeared to be set on continuing this fight at any cost. Justin had already attempted to provoke a lethal encounter several times and it was clear to me that he was not ready to stop his resistance and assaultive behavior. I had to stop the fight before an injury to officers or Justin occurred.

For the above mentioned reasons, I knelt on Justins shoulder area to the left of his neck and told him that he better stop resisting or he would get another TASER application. He did not stop his resistance so I applied a third application from my TASER to Justin. This time, I applied a drive stun to the upper right shoulder area on Justins back. I maintained contact with Justins shoulder for the 5 seconds while Officer Mohondro was able to gain control of Justins left wrist and arm.

It was at this time that Officer Mohondro and Officer Groom were able to place handcuffs on Justin (D/L). Justin ceased all resistance at this time and said "alright, I'm done." We rolled Justin onto his right side and into the recovery position. After Justin began to calm down, we sat him up to the seated position.

I called for medics and a supervisor to respond to the scene. Medics arrived and removed the probes from Justins back, and cleaned the probe marks. When Justin fell, he received a small abrasion to his forehead and it appeared that he had a small amount of blood coming from his mouth. Medics also cleaned these injuries.

Sergeant Teigen arrived on scene and I briefed him of the incident. After the incident was complete, Justin was booked into jail for 3rd Degree Assault, Obstructing and Resisting Arrest. Also, during the incident, Angela assaulted Officer Lesser (see his report for details) and therefore was arrested and booked for 3rd Degree Assault L/E along with Obstructing.
