

Officer Interview Summary

Ofc. Geren responded to 1429 W. Grace on a report of an order violation. On his arrival, he observed Anthony Hall in front of the house. He recognized Hall from his most recent booking photo. When Hall saw Ofc. Geren, who was in a full police uniform with badge and shoulder patches and exiting a fully marked patrol vehicle, he fled on foot. Officer Geren gave chase and briefly lost sight of Hall as he ran through the alley and into a yard. He located Hall hiding beneath a bush. He could only see Halls left side, and it appeared that he was trying to reach under the Bush with his right hand. Ofc, Geren drew his weapon and gave Hall several commands to show his hands; Hall did not comply. Officer Geren was concerned because Hall had just committed a violation of a no contact order which was related to a recent domestic violence charge, he immediately fled and attempted to hide when officers arrived, he was wearing bulky clothing and had not been searched, and was intentionally refusing to follow commands to show his right hand. After numerous commands with his pistol at low ready and the Hall continuing to refuse to show his right hand, Ofc. Geren pointed his firearm at Hall and again ordered him to show his right hand. Hall reluctantly did so; however he was continually scanning the area and what appeared to Ofc. Geren as an attempt to assess if there were other officers nearby or to identify possible escape routes. Once he saw both of Hall's hands, he depressed his muzzle to low ready. Officer Schneider arrived shortly after and assisted in taking Hall into custody.

Witness Interview Summary

Officer Schneider was with Ofc. Geren when they arrived on scene and Hall fled on foot. When officer Geren gave chase, he got back into the patrol car and drove around the block in an attempt to cut him off. He arrived at the location where officer Geren was contacting Hall. Hall was underneath the bush and had his hands out in front of him; but as he approached, he reached toward his waist with his right hand. Officer Snider began to draw his weapon as he was concerned Hall was attempting to access a weapon. Hall then brought his hands back out and showed they were empty. He was taken into custody.

Physical Evidence

Investigative Summary

I, Sgt. Hallock, reviewed the CAD log and officer reports associated with this case. Based on the totality of the circumstances I believe officer Geren's use of force was justified and was effective in gaining partial compliance of the suspect. His pointing in at the suspect with his firearm was for a brief time frame, and only for so long as it took him to confirm that Hall had not accessed any weapon.

Anthony and Krista had both arrived late for a hearing regarding the protection order. Court Officers were concerned that Anthony and Krista may have left together. Krista's last known address is 1429 W Grace, the address specifically listed on the no contact order. I reviewed the No Contact

I attempted to contact Anthony and/or Krista at Krista's home at 1429 W Grace. There was no answer. There was a Gold Cadillac registered to Anthony parked on the West side of the home.

I talked to neighbor, David Jones (DOB 6/1/71). Jones told me the following: He came home around noon today. He observed Tony (Anthony Hall) and Krista in the front yard arguing. Jones was accusing Krista of stealing thousands of dollars from him. Jones went inside his home. According to Jones Anthony and Krista argue frequently. Jones also said that all of the Hall's cars were parked in front of the house on the street, so he believed that they would be there.

Jones also mentioned that Krista had once told him that Anthony had two hand guns because he believed that there were people out to kill him.

I also talked to Walter Myers (DOB 3/1/78), who lives with Jones. He had heard Anthony and Krista arguing outside when Jones came home today. Myers did not look out to confirm that it was Anthony and Krista, but they argue frequently so he was positive that it was Anthony and Krista arguing.

Officer Geren and I knocked multiple times on the door to 1429 W Grace. There was no answer. I parked to the North of address and we waited for a couple of minutes.

We then observed Krista and Anthony ride up to the front of the residence on bicycles. Anthony walked up onto the front porch. I drove up and it was clear that it Anthony on the front porch of 1429 W Grace. At this time there was PC to arrest Anthony for violation of a DV No contact order.

Anthony began to run West and then South of the residence. Officer Geren pursued on foot, and I did in my car. I followed Officer Geren and Anthony into the Alley just south of 1429 W Grace. I observed Anthony run South and then Westernly. I drove to the West end of the alley, and then south to Buckeye where I turned West.

As I drove West on Buckeye there was a small blue car, which I now suspect was Krista, in her car, possibly attempting to block Buckeye or just pick up Anthony. I drove around the car to where Officer Geren had detained Anthony, see his report.

At the time I thought the blue car may have been a confused motorist, since there were Officers chasing people on foot, and a patrol car with its overhead lights on. However upon attempting to contact Krista, I found that both she and her car were no longer at the Grace Address.

As I got out of the car. I could see Anthony lying on his stomach. His arms in were in front of him. He appeared to be arguing with Officer Geren. He pushed up with one hand, and his other hand dove into his waist area. I began to draw my pistol as I recognize that the waist is a common place to

conceal weapons, and Anthony was clearly not following commands.

Anthony then produced an empty hand and he was handcuffed in prone position. I holstered my pistol at no time did I point my pistol at Anthony.

Anthony was sweaty and he smelled of Marijuana.

Anthony had small scratches on his head, in the area of front scalp line. Anthony was asked at jail what had caused the scratches. Anthony responded that he had put his head into a bush.

Anthony admitted that he had been with Krista. He said that he was late to court. He just was at the house to see his son. Anthony said that he had arrived in an RV which was now parked in the alley behind the home

I explained to Anthony that he was under arrest for a violation of a no contact order. He was searched and placed into the back of my car. Anthony's wallet was removed from his person and placed into a property bag. Officer Geren

At jail, Corrections Officer Rogers, found a small approximately 1"x1" zip top baggie with a white crystalline substance inside of Anthony's wallet.

I tested the substance. It field tested presumptive positive for methamphetamine.

Anthony was also booked for Possession of a Controlled Substance to wit Methamphetamine.

The baggie and its contents were placed onto property.

A triple I was performed looking for DV Order Violation convictions. Anthony showed one previous conviction.

Anthony was booked on a citation for the Order Violation.

A charging document was written for the PCS charge.

On 10/06/2014 at about 1444 hours Officer Schneider and I responded to 1429 W. Grace reference a possible no-contact order violation. Officer Schneider had information that Anthony Hall 04/14/1977 had previously been in contact with victim Krista Hall. I observed a copy of the order and saw that the address listed was 1429 W. Grace.

We attempted contact at the residence but received no answer. Officer Schneider contacted several neighbors, one of which advised him that Hall had been carrying a gun. (See Officer Schneider's report.) Officer Schneider also advised me that Hall had been contacted numerous times during domestic violence incidents.

We conducted surveillance from north of the residence. At about 1438 hours we observed a female and male pull up to the front of the residence on bicycles. We pulled up to the home and I observed the male was Anthony Hall based on a SPRS photograph.

As our fully marked patrol vehicle pulled up to the home and came to a stop, Anthony began running south on Walnut. I started pursuing Anthony on foot. I was dressed in a fully marked patrol jumpsuit with Spokane Police patches on both sleeves and a badge on my chest.

I followed Anthony east through the alley and into a yard on the north side of Buckeye, two homes east of Walnut. I lost sight of him temporarily as he rounded the corner of the home.

I re-located Anthony crouched down in a bush in the front yard. I was only able to see the left half of his body and he appeared to be reaching under the bush with his right hand. I drew my weapon and gave him several commands to show me his hands. Anthony did not comply.

- Anthony had just committed a no-contact order violation, which I had observed. No-contact orders are issued after an initial domestic violence arrest as part of the release from jail. These are crimes of violence.
- Anthony had fled upon observing a fully marked patrol vehicle and police officer in full uniform. Based on my experience, foot pursuits are extremely dangerous to the officer. I was not aware of his intentions and I had temporarily lost sight of him as he turned the corner of the home. He was wearing clothing that was bulky and he had not yet been searched. I had information that Anthony had a gun. Despite my commands, Anthony refused to show me his right hand. Based on my experience, furtive movements such as Anthony's were consistent with trying to access or conceal weapons. I also was concerned that Anthony could return to the home he had been attempting to access, which was the residence of the victim the order was issued to protect.
 - Anthony had fled on foot and tried to secrete himself in a bush. I gave him several commands to

show me both hands and he refused to show me his right hand.

Based on Anthony's actions and his refusal to comply, I drew my pistol and pointed to the low ready. He still refused to comply and I pointed my pistol at him and again asked him to show me his hands. Anthony withdrew his right hand, which contained his hat. I lowered my pistol to the low ready but Anthony still was slow to comply with commands. Anthony looked in each direction as I told him to lay down and put his hands behind his back. It was apparent that Anthony had not made the decision to comply and was looking for other officers response or a possible escape route.

Officer Schneider arrived on scene and Anthony finally put his hands out in front of him, but still did not bring them behind his back. I holstered my pistol as Officer Schneider took right arm control of Anthony and I secured his left arm. We placed him into custody without further incident.

Officer Schneider and I searched Anthony incident to arrest and removed a black wallet from his person. I opened the wallet long enough to see Anthony's identification in the center.

We assisted Anthony to his feet and transported him to jail. Upon arrival at jail I observed some scratches on his face. He told jail staff that they had been caused when he had tried to hide in the bush.

I notified Sgt. Hallock of the incident.

I did not conduct any further investigation.
