





Vigesaa was looking for a possible armed subject, who had been involved in a shooting and was possibly at the address he was at, when Luu-Karber walked up wearing a hoodie that concealed his face. Luu-Karber was met at the door by Sgt. Vigesaa in uniform, Luu-Karber did not comply with Sgt. Vigesaa's orders to sit on the steps, and he fled. Sgt. Vigesaa ran the suspect down believing he could be one of the subjects he was looking for. He used several knee strikes to the suspect's ribs to gain control of the suspect as he kept telling him to stop resisting. During his resisting arrest, the suspect kept reaching to the area of his front waistband, causing great concern for Sgt. Vigesaa's and Officer S. Kennedy's safety because they did not know if this suspect was armed. Based on the information Sgt. Vigesaa had at the time of this incident and the actions of the arrestee, Luu-Karber, the use of force was within SPD Policy and was proper. If Luu-Karber had complied with Sgt. Vigesaa's instructions at the door, no use of force would have been necessary.

I arrived on scene after Luu-Karber was in custody and in the back of the patrol car. The area he was arrested at was wet and muddy. Luu-Karber had mud all over him including his face. I noticed that he had a red mark on the right side of his face that would be consistent with being face down struggling. There was mud on his face consistent with same.

Luu-Karber was complaining that his right arm may be broken. He told me that it had actually been broken 11 months ago by the Spokane Valley Police. He said a pin was put in his arm at that time. He then told me that the officer hit him in his ribs 5 to 6 times using his knee. He complained that his left rib cage hurt. Luu-Karber said that he has PTSD from getting his arm broke by the Spokane Valley Police. He said that whenever he sees the police he runs.

Medics arrived and looked at Luu-Karber. They advised they did not see anything consistent with a broken are, however they thought he should be seen at the hospital. He was later transported. While Luu-Karber was being looked at he told medics that he was kneed in the ribs 4-5 times.

In reviewing the reports and the circumstances at the scene I believe that Sgt. Vigesaa was justified in chasing after Luu-Karber. At the time Sgt. Vigesaa was looking for a subject involved in an assault at a residence, Luu-Karber showed up at that address with a hoodie covering his face. He saw the officers and took off running. While running he had his hands in his sweatshirt pocket. Sgt. Vigesaa was concerned that he was reaching for a weapon. Luu-Karber was taken to the ground. He continued to actively resist being arrested and kept trying to reach into his front sweatshirt pocket. Sgt. Vigesaa and later Officer Kennedy both were concerned that he was reaching for a weapon. Sgt. Vigesaa used knee strikes to help gain control. Eventually after a long struggle with Luu-Karber the officers were able to get him handcuffed.

In my opinion I believe the use of force in this case was clearly justified and follows policy.

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

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



I arrived to find the victim on the front porch of 2912 N. Smith. He was conscious and talking. He was identified as Nathan D. Shields 11-04-81. Nathan told me that he was visiting at the house and having a smoke in the front yard. He said he left the others that he was with and went inside the house to urinate. Nathan said he came back outside to see his three female friends arguing with two Hispanic males dressed in dark clothes. Nathan told me that as he walked out into the street to see what was going on, one of the males shot him in the chest.

Nathan could not give me a description of the gun, or of the suspects other then two Hispanic males in dark cloths.

I could see a small hole that was bleeding a little bit in the left side of the middle of his chest. Nathan was breathing fine and able to talk to me as we waited for medics to arrive. I checked and could find no exit wound. I checked the black Carhart coat that he was wearing and it did not have a hole in it. It was unzipped and open when I got to him on the porch, so the bullet is believed to have missed the coat, went through the shirt and into his chest.

Medics evaluated Nathan and transported him to Sacred Heart Hospital for treatment.

The black Carhart coat was collected as evidence and given to Officer Specht, see his additional.

I attempted to find any evidence in the street where the shooting was supposed to have taken place. I could not find any blood, or shell casing. The black coat appeared to have a small blood spot on the inside left pocket. No other evidence could be located.

A K-9 track was attempted to the south and east, the direction the witnesses said the suspects ran, but nothing was found.

I did transport Misty Coleman-Woods and Sandra Meshell in two different trips to the north and to the east, to view two possible suspects that had been detained. All of those show-ups performed were negative.

I briefed Officer Valdez and Det. Gallion as they arrived on scene to continue the investigation.

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On 11-09-2014 at approx. 1110 hrs, Sgt. Vigesaa, Cpl. McCollough, Ofc. Howe and I responded to 4715 E. 3rd, to contact wanted subject(s) Erica Ellis, and Trevor Frantz. We knew Trevor was a possible suspect in a shooting which occurred the previous evening at 2912 N. Smith.

Upon arrival, I was on a perimeter position on the Northeast side of the residence. While other officers were attempting to make contact at the front door I remained on the east side. During this time, I saw a black Chevy 4 door bearing Idaho plate K543037, pull up to the house. I notified other officers of the vehicle that just arrived. Sgt. Vigesaa told me to stay were I was to watch. I saw a

male, who matched the physicals of Trevor exit the front passenger side of the car. I saw the male walk towards the house where the front door was, but could not see beyond that.

Within just moments I heard Sgt. Vigesaa in foot pursuit. At the time I thought it was in fact Trevor. The male running had baggy clothing and a baseball cap. I could not see his face.

Sgt. Vigesaa caught the fleeing male within just seconds. I ran to Custer on 3rd, and saw Sgt. Vigesaa struggling with the male on the ground. I ran to assist at which time I saw the male, later identified as Matthew Luu-Karber, reaching for the front of his waistband. I told the male numerous times to stop resisting. Matthew refused.

It was raining, and we were all on the ground in a mud puddle struggling. Matthew was slippery and strong. I was focused on getting his right arm controlled as Sgt. Vigesaa attempted left arm control. During the entire struggle, Matthew was adamant and determined to get something from his waistband. At this time, I thought for sure it was a gun, and during this time both Sgt. Vigesaa and I were communicating with one another that Matthew was reaching for the front waistband with both arms.

I repeatedly told Matthew to stop resisting, when he refused, Sgt. Vigesaa told Matthew to stop resisting, then offered a knee strike to Matthew's left side. This did not stop Matthew from reaching to his waist however. Sgt. Vigesaa told Matthew again to stop resisting, and offered another knee strike. Still Matthew continued to ignore verbal commands to place his hands behind his back. This was said several time during the struggle, and Matthew blatantly ignored commands. Matthew continued to either reach in his waistband, or place his hands under his body in an attempt to get up and regain balance.

Matthew was complaining about a broken arm during the struggle however this did not stop him from resisting. I didn't understand the broken arm complaint until later.

At this time, the black Chevy 4 door rounded the corner. I knew this car was with Matthew, but didn't know how it was involved. Within moments the female driver identified herself as Matthew's girlfriend. This female, later identified as Desirae Scott, was yelling at us to stop hurting Matthew, however I explained to her we were not hurting him. I explained the resisting was all him, and he could stop at any time he chose. Desirae heard both Sgt. Vigesaa and I telling Matthew to stop resisting, and she began yelling at Matthew to stop resisting with us.

The struggle still went on, until Sgt. Vigesaa and I were able to handcuff Matthew. I had to handcuff Matthew's right wrist with my handcuffs, while Sgt. Vigesaa was doing the same with Matthew's left wrist and his handcuffs. This was an unusual way to handcuff, but due to Matthew's strength, I felt this was the only way as it gave a bit more leverage in terms of spacing. Sgt. Vigesaa and I attached the open ended side of the handcuffs to each other, leaving Matthew double handcuffed.

Even after being handcuffed, Matthew was still reaching for his waistband. Sgt. Vigesaa was able to determine Matthew did not have a weapon in his waistband by rolling Matthew to his side and patting him down.

Once Matthew was controlled, Medics were called to check him out. Matthew was now complaining of his ribs and "broken arm".

I spoke to Desirae and her mother Juanita. They were both crying hysterically. I explained, Matthew was just fine, and his biggest compliant was being caught. Desirae told me she drove Matthew to his cousin's, (Dawn Dowd) to pick up the \$20 she owed him. Desirae told me she knew nothing about why he ran and was angry at Matthew for leaving her like that.

Desirae told me she wanted Matthew to stop resisting to prevent getting hurt.

When I spoke to Juanita, she told me she suffers from memory loss. Desirae's told me she has a medical condition to where Desirae must be her power of attorney. Desirae has no criminal history and was cooperative.

Next I spoke to Matthew. I read Matthew his Constitutional Rights at 1214 hrs. Matthew verbally acknowledged he understood his rights and agreed to answer questions. Cpl. Ferguson was witness to the reading and waiving of rights.

Matthew told me he ran because of two reasons, one of which he had a warrant, and the other because last time he dealt with police he got beat up. He told me his arm was broken during the last altercation, and now has a pin in his right arm. This made sense to me know, how he was complaining about a broken arm, the pain he was complaining of, was from a previous injury.

Matthew told me he was at his cousin's to smoke Meth. He told me he uses both Heroin and Methamphetamine. Matthew bragged about how he has run from the police the last 7 times and never was caught. He also bragged about being a wrestler, which explains the strength, and determination during the struggle, which he vocalized.

Matthew told me Desirae just found out they were pregnant. He said, "I'm glad this happened, so I can get things taken care of". He also made the comments of "I got my ass whipped", during this struggle. He admitted to resisting by saying, "I was resisting a little bit, but he didn't need to over amp it". Matthew complained mostly about being tackled.

I explained to him we thought he was Trevor Frantz, and the fact he kept reaching for the front of his pants we thought he was reaching for a gun. Matthew told me it all made sense to him now. He was seeing what occurred from police perspective and confirmed he knows "Native" has guns and believes Native is crazy. Matthew said the rumor on the street was Native is "Trigger Happy".

Matthew continued saying when he first met Native, which was about 1 week ago, Native threatened him. Native confronted Matthew and Desirae by asking if their intent was to steal from the house. Matthew told him no, and that Dawn was his cousin. Native threatened him by saying he was going to tie Matthew up, force him to watch, while shooting off Desirae's arms. Matthew told me he hates Native.

I rode in the ambulance with Matthew. We went to Deaconess so he could be medically cleared for jail. He was telling medics his right arm was twisted during the time he was resisting. I told Matthew I was sorry, and that I was the one who twisted his arm. Matthews reply was, "that's ok, I'm sorry for resisting". It was later determined by Deaconess Doctors, Matthew had no injuries sustained from our altercation.

Matthew told me he was trying to get rid of the stuff in his pockets, and the Meth because he "Panicked".

Sgt. Vigesaa gave me the property found on Matthew to place on property,

During this time, other members of our team were back at the house. I was advised they found Trevor hiding and that there were guns in the house. I was advised Detective Presta was applying for a search warrant.

I assisted in the search of the search warrant and found a single shotgun shell in Erica's bedroom in a grey zip up cosmetic style bag. I advised Detective Mia, who was documenting items found in the house.

While placing Matthew's items on property, we quickly discovered this would not keep the items Detective Mia was placing on property, in order. To keep proper order, I gave Matthew's items to Detective Mia. Detective Mia had to place Matthew's items on property when finished with the items recovered from the residence.

As I came into the area I turned SB onto Smith from Euclid. I observed two Hispanic males walking NB on Smith towards me wearing dark clothes and both had their hoods of their sweat shirts up on their heads.

Because these two males matched the physical and clothing description of the possible suspects and were only a block north of the incident, I illuminated my spot lamp onto the two males and ordered them to the ground. Both males complied and went down to their stomachs. I had them remain there until Officer Potter responded to the location. Myself and Officer Potter contacted the males and placed them into handcuffs (dl).

The male I contacted identified himself as, Fransico Rogel-Ramirez and I later confirmed that with a Washington State Driver's License.

Because we were responding to a shooting call I conducted a quick pat frisk of Rogel-Ramirez but did not locate any weapons on his person.

I advised Rogel-Ramirez that at this time he was being detained as we investigated a possible shooting call. Rogel-Ramirez immediately stated that he was just walking to the store.

I advised Rogel-Ramirez of his Constitutional Rights (CR) from a pre printed car. Rogel-Ramirez advised he understood his rights and voluntarily waived them to answer my questions about the incident:

Rogel-Ramirez stated the following:

Him and his brother (Juan Rogel-Ramirez) had just left his friend, Angie Russel's, residence and were walking to the gas station on the corner to get some cigarettes when he was stopped by me. I asked him where Russel's residence was at and he stated it was just a couple blocks down on Smith street but he did not know the exact address. I asked him if anyone other than him and his brother were at the location and he advised Russel's boyfriend (unknown name) and about three to four other people were at the location.

Rogel-Ramirez advised that at Russel's location there was no fighting and to his knowledge just him and his brother left the location to go to the store.

I advised him that within a block of where I contacted him at there was a shooting and asked him if he knew anything about that and he stated he did not, and he did not hear anything.

I asked him if he heard any yelling or screaming while he was outside and he stated he did not. He stated that while walking he observed a group of people standing outside of their residence a few houses behind him, but he did not hear anyone yelling, arguing, or any loud noises that may have been gunfire.

Three show ups were performed on Rogel-Ramirez and all three of them were negative for a match with the suspects.

I removed the handcuffs from his person and released him at the location without further incident.

I responded to 2912 N. Smith where I remained until detectives at the location finished with their interviews.

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On 11-09-14 at approximately 0254 hours, I was dispatched to 2912 N Smith for a shooting call. Dispatch advised that Lisa called 911 and stated that two to three Hispanic males walked past the neighbors house and shot at a male. Missy also called 911 and stated that her friend was shot.

Upon arrival, I observed a male sitting on the front porch of 2912 N Smith. This was the male who had been shot. He was identified as Nathan Shields. He was being assisted by other officers.

I then contacted Jamie McMahan who was standing outside of the house. Jamie told me the following:

He currently lived at 2912 N Smith. They were in the front yard smoking when they saw a male and a female arguing in the street near Cleveland and Smith. They all went back inside the house and then heard people outside whistling.

He and his girlfriend, Sandra Meshell, went outside to see what was going on. The people who were outside started yelling at Sandra and he stepped in to help her. He said that there was a male who was wearing a ski mask. He said that this male came toward Sandra and he told him to back off. He said that Nate came outside and stepped into the middle of them. The male that was not wearing the ski mask then pulled out a gun and told them all to "get back." He told the male that they did not want any problems with them.

The male without the ski mask then shot the gun and Nate was hit by the bullet. The male

was approx. 10 yards away from Nate when this happened. All three of the suspects ran away after the gunshot. They ran south on Smith to Cleveland and then ran eastbound.

Jamie thought the gun sounded like a CO2 gun. He described it as looking like "an old school paintball gun." (End of Jamie's statement.)

Sgt. Teigen advised that he needed me to ride in the ambulance with Nathan. I stopped my interview with Jamie and got into the ambulance and rode up to Sacred Heart with Nathan. He was conscious and breathing on his own in the ambulance.

Once at Sacred Heart he was brought into the trauma unit where medical staff worked on him. I followed him to get a CT scan and then back to the trauma room.

Nathan was conscious the entire time I was with him. The bullet entrance wound was in his left abdomen area and there did not appear to be an exit wound. There was a bruise on the right side of his abdomen. Hospital staff advised that there was a bullet still inside him where the bruising was. At that time hospital staff advised that he was in stable condition and that they would continue to monitor Nathan.

Detective Presta arrived on scene. I advised him of the situation and he took over the investigation. He did not need me for anything further and I cleared the hospital.

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On 11-9-14 at 0255 hours, I responded to 2912 N. Smith St. for a call where a person was shot. I arrived on scene at 0258 hours. Once on scene I contacted witness Emily Moyer. She told me she is very close friends with the victim, Nate, who was shot. Moyer told me she was out front of the house at 2912 N. Smith. She saw two males walking north on Smith. The two suspect males were in the street and some words were exchanged between Nate, Jamie and the two suspects. She was not sure what the words were exactly. Moyer was standing directly behind a gray Dodge Durango (WA license ALT 0372) Jamie was towards the front and Nate was in the street somewhere in the middle of the Durango. The two males were standing to the north of Nate and directly west of her in the middle of the street.

Suspect #1 was the person who pulled a gun from the waistband of his pants near his lower back. The suspect used his left hand to reach behind him and pull out the gun. The gun was a dark colored "six shooter" style gun. The shooter fired one shot after pointing the gun at Nate. After hearing and seeing the shot, Moyer said she froze with panic. Before she could move, both suspects ran south on Smith St. to Cleveland and then ran east on Cleveland.

They all went to the porch and Moyer did not realize that Nate had been hit by the bullet. Nate laid down on the porch and grabbed his chest and stated he had been shot.

Moyer described suspect #1 as: Hispanic or Indian male, 5'7" tall, medium build, mid 20's to early 30's for age. He was wearing a black hoodie with the hood pulled up over his head. He had thick eye brows.

Suspect #2 was wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt with the hood pulled up over his head. He was a dark skinned white

person or a Hispanic male. He had a black bandana pulled up covering part of his face. He was wearing dark jeans.

Moyer said she could identify the shooter if she saw him again, but could only identify the clothing of the other suspect.

I was advised that three people had been detained as possible suspects. I transported Moyer to Ofc. Potter and Specht for the first two show-ups. Moyer immediately stated both suspects were not involved. I then transported her to where Ofc. Donaldson had another suspect. She immediately said that person was not involved.

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On 110914 I went to 2912 N Smith reference a possible shooting. Radio advised that one person had been hit and the suspects were two h/m's wearing all black.

Upon arrival the victim, who was alert and talking, was on the front porch. We had medics come in to treat him. I contacted Sandra Meshell. She lives there and was outside when the shooting happened.

Just before the shooting she was outside with her boyfriend, Jamie, and some other friends. They were talking and laughing about a game they were playing inside. Just to the south of them in the intersection a man and woman were arguing. The male started yelling up to them asking who had a beef. She yelled down that there was no beef and they went inside to avoid a problem.

Just a few minutes later they heard whistling from outside. There were two males standing in front of the house dressed in black. She ended up being very close to the males and described them as suspect 1(s1) as younger h/m 502 thin wearing all black the top being a hoodie. He also had a black hockey or ski mask piece of clothing covering the lower part of his face. Suspect 2(s2) was a younger h/m 502-503 athletic build, wearing all black but he did not have anything on his head or face. He had short thick black hair a small mustache and quarter size gauges in his ears.

She went out and tried to have everybody else stay in to avoid a confrontation. She figured they

would not be threatened by a female coming out. When she went out they were asking where her "homeboy" was that had the beef. She was telling them there was no beef and that they were just having a good time and that they should go back and leave them alone. S2 started yelling at her that she needed to bring out her homeboy and that they know where they live and have their house marked. She tried to ask him what for, because they had not done anything.

This made both of them yell even more and S2 started throwing up his arms and took a step towards her. At this point they were near the sidewalk and the suspects were just in the street, not 8 feet away from her as she described it. Jamie had come out and started toward them asking if they were threatening his girlfriend, Sandra. The suspects again started asking who had the beef and that the house was marked. Around this point is when she heard a pop and said that it was s1 had shot a gun, but could not describe it at the time.

After the shot they both took off running s/b then turned e/b onto Cleveland. She ran after them to see where they went but when they continued running she went back to the house and discovered that Nate had been hit.

The victims coat was collected it at the house and I took it up to Sacred Heart and gave it to ofc Potter to put on property. I also took pictures of the Nathaniels injuries.

On 11-08-14 at about 0800hrs I was notified by Sgt Keller about a shooting with a victim that occurred about 0300hrs this morning. The person of interest was a subject who's moniker was "Native". My team (PACT) is familiar with Trevor Frantz and know his moniker is Native as well as having info that Frantz was carrying a firearm last week. After talking with Sgt Keller, Frantz was now the person of interest with this shooting.

At about 1130hrs myself and my team went to 4715 E 3rd to look for Frantz. Cpl McCollough knew that Frantz was living here. We also knew that a Repeat Offender by the name of Erica Ellis lives here. We knew that Frantz had a current Felony warrant for UPF 1st and Ellis had a felony warrant for PSP2nd.

Myself and Cpl McCollough knocked and announced at the front door for a few minutes. During this time, we knew there were people inside. I could see movement from the shades and people looking out as well as Ofc Howe saw a male come out the rear slider and go back inside.

After a few minutes, the front door was answered by Dawn Dowd. Dowd said she lived there. We informed Dowd we were looking for Ellis and Native-Frantz. Dowd's father-Bill was present for our conversation as well as Dowd's boyfriend-Matthew Lang who was in and out of the front room. Dowd said that she hasn't seen Native-Frantz for 2 days and that she hasn't seen Ellis today. Dowd confirmed that both live here. I asked Dowd if we could come inside and look for them. Dowd wavered on what she should say and I already could tell she wasn't being truthful about their whereabouts. I advised Dowd that both have Felony warrants for their arrests and that I believed one or both were inside. I knew there were more people inside then the three we were with. I explained to Dowd that based on my PC believing one or both were inside and their Felony warrants, we had a right to come inside and look for them. Dowd understood and invited us inside as well. At no time,

did Bill or Lang refuse us entry or search.

I stood by inside the front room with Dowd, Bill and Matthew while Cpl McCollough and Ofc Howe began looking for Frantz and Ellis.

The listed Chevy Metro pulled up in front of the house, while I was in the front room. Ofc S Kennedy was on the east side of the house for containment and saw the vehicle pull up as well. At this point, McCollough and Howe had just started their search and nobody was located. I could see through the front window that a male subject with a black hoodie got out of the vehicle and began walking up to the front door. It should be noted our vehicles were parked away from this house and out of sight. There was nothing visible from the outside showing we were inside the house. I knew that Frantz was still outstanding as well as another subject who was with the shooter this morning. I believed that this subject walking up could be Frantz or a subject involved with the shooting. I also knew that the firearm was still outstanding.

As the subject walked up the porch to the door, I opened it and announced Spokane Police Dept grab a seat on the step there while pointing at the porch step. I was in uniform with a SPD Badge on my left chest and SPD patch on shoulder. The subject looked up at me and immediately turned and began running. I began chasing after the subject for the reasons mentioned and now the subject was Obstructing a Police Officer as well. I chased the subject down the porch and out to 3rd then WB on 3rd. I identified myself as Police again and ordered the subject that he was under arrest and to Stop!. The subject was running WB on 3rd in front of me and reaching towards his waist in front of him while running. I was believing he was reaching for a weapon and possibly the firearm. I continued to give the subject directives to get his hands up and stop running as he turned NB on Custer. A cell phone fell out of his hands or clothing just north of 3rd and I began closing distance. About 200 ft north of 3rd I tackled him.

The suspect later identified as Luu-Karber fell to his stomach and violently began trying to access his waist area. Still on the belief he was trying to access a weapon, I held him on the ground with upper body control and began trying to pull his right arm away from his waist as he was forcefully trying to reach his waist area. While holding onto his resisting right arm, he began forcefully pushing his left arm to his waist while trying to roll over on his side. At this time, Ofc Kennedy began running up, I passed Luu-Karber's right arm over to her and began trying to pull out his left hand which was now in his waist area. All this time, I was giving him commands of "stop resisting" but Luu-Karber continued violently resist. I have been in numerous foot pursuits, fights, resistings etc and Luu-Karber was unusually highly motivated and strong. I was tiring and knew I had to get his left hand out and get him in handcuffs. Meanwhile, Ofc Kennedy was struggling with Luu-Karbers right arm/hand which was continuing to try and access his waist area.

At this time I decided to give Luu-Karber a knee strike to his left side which was the side I was on. He was still face down and trying to get up as well as trying to access his waist area. The situation was tense and uncertain and due to the violent resisting to get up and access his waist area (which is the most common area to access a weapon), I gave him two knee strikes to his left rib cage area. My intentions with the knee strikes were for Luu-Karber to stop resisting and stop trying to access his waist area which hadn't been searched yet. I was kneeling next to him and holding onto his left arm and trying to hold his upper body on the ground with my left knee. The knee strikes were

effective in allowing me to get his left hand out. At this time, the Chevy metro which dropped him off came pulling up.

Sometime during this, Ofc Kennedy was able to get a handcuff on his right hand. Luu-Karber was still violently resisting and trying to shove both hands to his waist area while ignoring our commands to stop resisting. Even though, Ofc Kennedy had a handcuff on his right hand he was still resisting our attempts to get his hands cuffed. I was able to get a handcuff on his left hand as well. With two handcuffs, we would be able to get his hands cuffed easier without having to get them close which he was resisting our efforts. A female in the car that pulled up who I believe was his girlfriend began velling at Luu-Karber to "Stop Resisting" along with us.

Without being able to get both of his hands together even with two handcuffs, I gave Luu-Karber 2 or 3 more knee strikes to his left rib cage area. This loosened him up enough temporarily to get the two handcuffs connected. Even with two handcuffs connected, Luu-Karber was flexible enough to continue to reach into his waist area. Det Willard arrived and assisted with putting him in one handcuff. At this time, we were able to control his body with more officers. I was able to search him incident to arrest for Obstructing and resisting arrest.

Luu-Karber was wearing sweat pants on top of another set of sweat pants or shorts. In his right front inner liner pocket of his shorts, I removed a baggie of white crystal substance that later field-tested positive for Meth and several credit cards, cash and a drug snorting straw with aluminum foil with burn marks. The straw and foil are used for smoking pills such as hydrocodone. One STCU credit card taken out of his pocket, was later found to be stolen from a mailbox from Danny Green incident # 14-368209. In his left front inner short pocket I removed a pocket knife and several cell phones.

I placed all the items in a plastic bag and let Det Willard and other arriving officers take custody of Luu-Karber. I then asked for another supervisor due to the knee strikes I used. Sat Ervin responded.

Luu-Karber advised his right arm was broken (from an altercation with Police a few months ago) and his side hurt (from my knee strikes potentially). Medics were called and arrived to examine Luu-Karber.

Ofc Kennedy later interviewed Luu-Karber and the girl in the vehicle that dropped him off, as well as riding with him to Deaconess in an ambulance to be further examined.

As reported to me by Ofc Watson who stayed with Luu-Karber at Deaconess, there were no injuries found on him.

Karber was later transported to jail and booked for a DOC warrant he's had since 05-14 as well as new charges of PCS-Meth and PSP 2nd. There is PC for Obstructing and resisting arrest.

I then went back to 4715 E 3rd and assisted with the investigation that yielded the arrest of Frantz, as well as recovering firearms and Meth.

The undersigned, a law enforcement officer, competent to testify, states as follows: That he/she believes a crime was committed by the above named defendant/defendants in the City and County of Spokane, State of Washington, because:

This Ofc can testify that:

I was working patrol on 11-09-14 at about 1145hrs.

My team (PACT) was actively searching for a shooting suspect and his accomplice from earlier in the day.

A victim was shot and the person of interest in shooting was "Native".

We knew a "Native" who matched the suspect description as well.

We went to 4715 E 3rd on this date and time looking for Native and his accomplice.

While we were at the residence which was native's residence a car pulled up in front.

All of us officers were inside or out of sight.

A subject later identified as Def Luu-Karber got out of the vehicle that pulled up and walked to the front door.

Luu-Karber was wearing dark hooded sweatshirt and I couldn't see if it was Native or not.

At this particular time, neither Native nor his accomplice were in custody and there were known handguns outstanding.

Luu-Karber came to the front door and I opened it for him.

I was wearing the uniform of the day which had a badge on the left chest and SPD patch on the shoulder.

I answered the door "Spokane Police" and told him to sit down on the porch step.

The subject looked at me and immediately turned around and ran down the porch.

At this point, I believed this subject could be our shooter or accomplice and ordered him to "Stop Police".

I then chased after him on foot.

After a foot chase and lengthy struggle to get the suspect in custody I advised him he was under arrest for Obstructing and Resisting.

The suspect-Luu-Karber was also wanted for a DOC warrant.

I searched him incident to arrest in front of Det Willard and removed a baggy of white crystal substance from his right front inner garment pocket as well as several credit cards that weren't all in his name.

A STCU Visa card was one of the cards removed from his pocket.

This card showed to be stolen from Danny Green on 10-31-14 in Spokane Wa.

The substance field-tested positive for Meth.

Luu-Karber was now under arrest for PCS-Meth and PSP2nd as well his warrant and PC for Obstructing and Resisting.

Ofc S Kennedy can testify that:

She was working on this date and time as part of the PACT and was onscene at 4715 E 3rd in ref to the above mentioned incident.

She observed Luu-Karber walk up to the residence while we were inside.
