Incident Summary

Officers were dispatched to 141 S Sheridan on a subject squatting in an abandoned van on the property. Officers saw a male subject in the van who Ofc Brownell recognized the male as Jeremy Warfield from an earlier call in the same area. Ofc Brownell and Prim were on scene and advised Warfield was talking incoherent and holding a knife to his own throat. I responded along with Ofc K Gately, D Bishop, Watson and Quarles. Ofc D Bishop had a bean bag shot gun loaded with sock rounds. Ofc Quarles had a shield, Ofc Watson had a taser. Ofc Prim and Brownell were Lethal coverage while Ofc K Gately handled the negotiations.

Ofc K Gately successfully got Warfield to exit the van. He stood next to the passenger double doors facing to the north. He had the small knife in his left hand. He stood there saying how paranoid he was. While standing there he put his left hand then his right hand in his outer coat pockets.

He then turned to the west and started to walk away. Ofc Quarles, Watson and Brownell followed Warfield to the west. Warfield went to the front of the van the officers could not see where Warfield had put the knife. Based on Warfield potentially having a knife and walking away Ofc Brownell attempted to taze him. One of the probes stuck in the coat sleeve and the second went past Warfield not making contact. Warfield was stopped walking and was taken into custody without incident.

Ofc Brownell's actions were with policy based on Warfield actions, verbal statements and non verbal behaviors.



Officers took critical steps to have a coordinated response team in place with multiple force options available, including hands, Taser, Kinetic Energy Devices, and a Hostage Negotiator. The male, who had been advised was under arrest, left the vehicle and walked away from officers. Officers believed he was still armed with the knife and posed a danger to themselves and others. The Taser was deployed before the male surrendered for arrest. The Probes, while one hit clothing, did not make contact with the subject. It 'appears' as though the deployment was the catalyst for the surrender. This Use of Force is in accordance with Policy. Policy 309.5.1 (b) The subject has demonstrated, by words or action, an intention to be violent or to physically resist, and reasonably appears to present the potential to harm officers, him/herself or others. **Of Note, Policy 309.4 requires~ "The fact that a verbal or other warning was given or the reasons it was not given shall be documented by the officer deploying the TASER device in the related report." This information was not included in the report, nor an indication that a warning was given. While exigency may have precluded the warning a quick notation in the report would have been sufficient. I believe a quick verbal reminder to the officer would suffice to remedy the oversight for future reporting.</p>



On 12-22-14, at approx. 1238 hrs, I responded to 141 S Sheridan (Casey Motors) reference a trespassing male.

It should be known that on 12-22-14, at approx. 0914 hrs, I responded to this location earlier after a passerby called to report a male wearing a thick flannel hooded coat that was on the SE corner of the intersection of Pacific and Sheridan was yelling at passing vehicle's.

I had contacted male Jeremy Warfield. Jeremy matched the physical description of this male yelling at passerby's. Jeremy was yelling and talking to himself.

As soon as I contacted Jeremy, he started to yell at me that he wanted me to get the chief of police and mayor of Spokane to him right now. I tried talking to him to figure out what was going on with him. He refused to have a conversation with me and was yelling.

I had offered Jeremy services (ride to the mission, MHP) and he refused. I told him he should leave and he did.

The second time we were called back, I contacted the complainant Rex Paulus. Rex said he is the owner of Casey Motors. He said he was notified of a belligerent male sitting in WA Reg 792NLL which is his vehicle on his property. He asked that LE remove the individual. I asked him if he wanted to press charges if the male refused to leave and we were forced to arrest him for trespassing. Rex said he would press charges.

I had Ofc's Prim and Watson with me. Ofc Prim advised me that he saw Jeremy in the vehicle holding a knife.

We attempted to establish verbals with Jeremy. He had all the windows covered and he was mumbling but I wasn't sure what he was mumbling. I asked Jeremy several times to drop his knife and he said, "Fuck NO!" He said this several times. I tried several times to ask Jeremy to step out of the vehicle so we could talk without results. I tried to de-escalate this situation by telling Jeremy that we wanted to talk and that if he would leave, he would be free to go. Jeremy repeated over and over that he wasn't going to leave. After about 5 minutes of trying to negotiate with Jeremy and him refusing to communicate back, I advised him he was under arrest for trespassing.

I asked for a negotiator. Ofc Gately arrived. After minutes of talking to Jeremy, Ofc Gately was able to talk Jeremy into getting out of the vehicle.

While Ofc Gately was talking to Jeremy, I formulated a plan with other Ofc's to help ensure Jeremy's safety. I gave other Ofc's assignments and I advised them I would deploy the taser if needed. I advised them I and Ofc Watson would be the hands team as well.

As soon as Jeremy got out of his vehicle, he kept putting his hands in his pockets. We weren't able to account for the knife. Jeremy's sweatshirt sleeves were long and partially covered his hands. I wasn't sure if he still had the knife. Jeremy started to walk away from LE. As I approached him I heard another Ofc say something about Jeremy possibly still having the knife. I deployed my taser to ensure LE's safety. The first probe struck Jeremy in the left sweatshirt forearm (didn't penetrate or touch his skin). The second probe went past Jeremy on his left side (unable to find). As soon as the taser started it's cycling sound (due to not completing the circuit), Jeremy stopped walking and immediately put his hands in the air. Ofc Watson and I were able to handcuff him without further incident.

Once I had Jeremy handcuffed, he kept repeating, "Why didn't you guys just kill me. I wanted you to kill me." I checked Jeremy's thick sweatshirt for the taser probe that stuck. I removed one probe that was freely hanging. The taser probe didn't touch Jeremy's skin.

I had Ofc Watson transport Jeremy to jail where he was booked for 2nd degree trespassing. Ofc Watson confirmed that the taser probes didn't touch Jeremy. Ofc Watson also completed a SCJ Mental Health Evaluation Form.

I put the taser cartridge (S/N C41012WKN) and probe onto property as evidence. Sgt Giannetto downloaded my taser.

On 12/22/14 at 1240, I was dispatched to assist Officer Brownell on a trespass call at 141 S. Sheridan. The notes in the call said that a male was "squatting" inside an abandoned van on the property. Officer Brownell advised me that the male suspect, Jeremy Warfield, was most likely high on a narcotic and was unstable. Upon arrival, I observed that the van was clearly on the property of the business (Casey Motors). I briefly communicated with Warfield, who was inside the van. I identified myself as a police officer and could partially see Warfield sitting in the passenger area of the van. The van had some of the windows broken out. I offered to give him a ride to a local shelter, but he instantly declined, saying that he is not welcome at any of the shelters due to his past behavior. I then saw that he was holding a small knife with the blade exposed (outwards), in an aggressive posture. His eyes were widened and he had a blank stare, as if he was very agitated. I asked him to put the knife down and exit the van with his hands visible, again offering to take him to a different location. I told him that he wasn't in trouble and that I did not want to use force. Warfield mumbled and didn't make sense. It was apparent that he was high or intoxicated, due to his inability to speak coherently. Warfield could barely piece together a full sentence.

I moved my patrol vehicle in a position to block the rear van doors. I assisted Officer Gately, during verbal communications. Officer Gately was successful in talking Warfield out of the van. Warfield then decided to walk away from Officers, while still having the knife in his possession. Warfield continued to walk in the direction of the business entrance. The business manager and employees were still inside the building. I could not see if he had put the knife away. Through his actions and incoherent speech, he posed a threat to Officers and the employees of the business.
