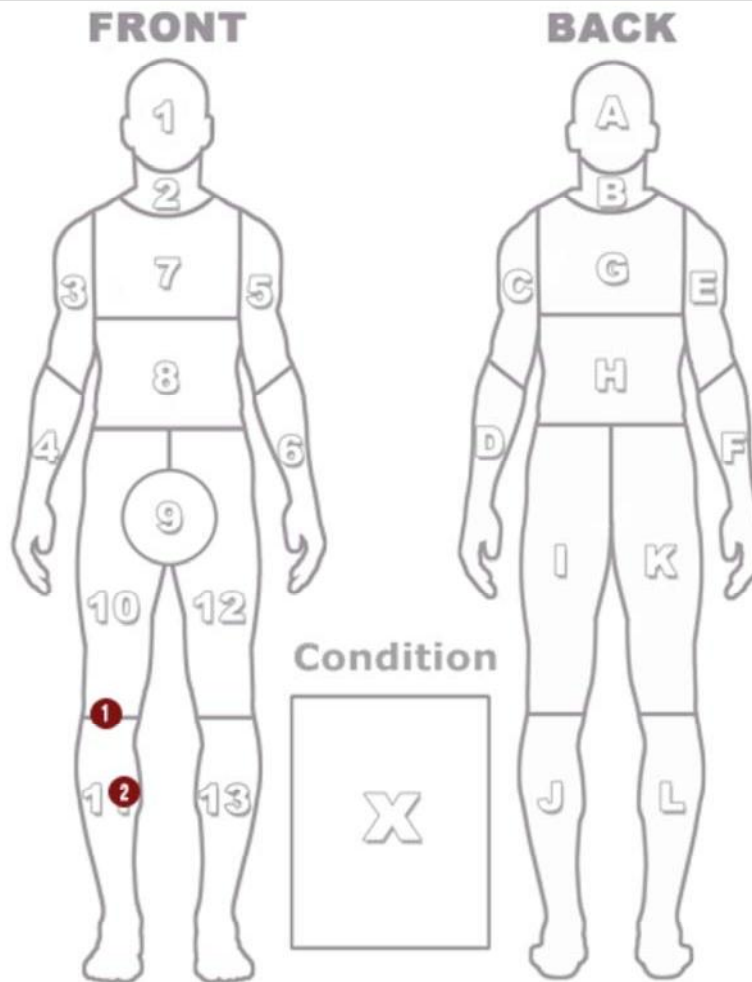

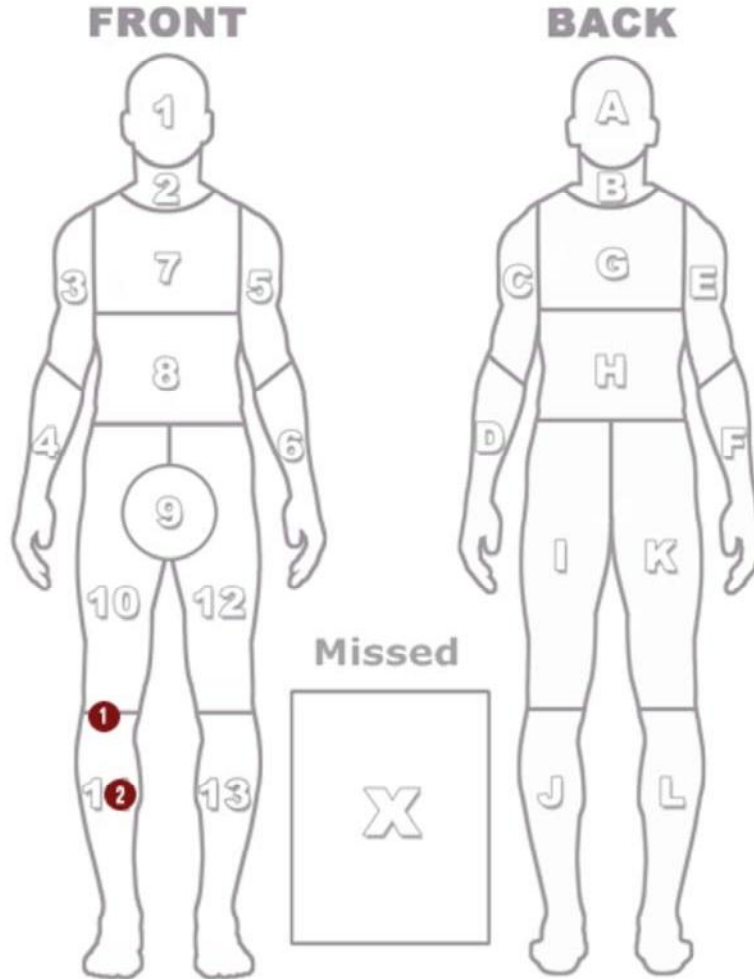

Report Narrative

On 02-25-15 at about 0106 hours, I was asked to assist the Spokane Police Patrol Anti-Crime Team (PACT) with contacting the residents at 4917 N. Martin reference a stolen go-cart.

SPD radio had checked the history of the house and found there was a male with a felony warrant that had history at this place. His name was Chad W. Cochell and had a confirmed felony warrant for 3rd degree assault.

I was able to look at a recent booking photo prior to arriving on scene.

I responded with K9 Leonidas (Leo). We are a WAC certified police patrol dog team and have been for over 6 years. We are also accredited with the Washington State Police Canine Association (WSPCA). I am accredited as a Master Handler with the WSPCA, as well as, being a Master Trainer with the WSPCA. Leo is my second working dog in nearly 11 years as a K9 handler.

I responded in a fully marked "Spokane Police K9" car and was wearing the uniform of the day. Leo was wearing a harness with "POLICE" marked on both shoulders along with a Spokane Police patch affixed to his left side. We were clearly identifiable as police.

Leo and I took a position on the south side of the house, which gave us a view of the backyard and the back door. We were about 30' away from the house. It was dark and I wasn't able to use my flashlight due to it giving away my location. I was also able to see through a large picture window that was on the south side of the house. Cochell was transported to Holy Family ER where his minor injuries were checked out and treated. His injuries consisted of some minor raking. He was wearing some thick insulated coveralls and Leo only got him on the right leg.

His injuries consisted of some scrapes on his right calf and some scrapes/compression marks on his right knee.

Cpl. Busch took some photos of the injuries.

I spoke with Cochell a little at the hospital. He told me he knew the police were at the house but he claimed he didn't know who I was when he slipped out the back door. He said all he saw was my flashlight and his "blood pressure shot up." He said he never heard a thing and just ran. He said he didn't hear my K9 announcement but that he would have run anyway.

After Cochell was released, he was booked into the SCSO jail for the 3rd degree Assault warrant.

Sgt. Eckersley was aware of the K9 contact.
