

Incident Summary

Officers responding to an escalating physical fight call at 202 E. Wedgewood were advised that 2 black males were beating up a female and had just left on foot with one white male. Officers arriving in the area detained arrestee Higgins along with another black male and a white male coming out of the parking lot as suspects. Higgins did not comply immediately with commands to stop and tried to walk briskly away with the white male (who had a felony warrant). Higgins was confrontational and extremely intoxicated, cussing at officers with his hands in his pockets. He ignored officer requests to provide truthful information, and finally tried to run away. Ofc. J. Howe grabbed Higgins by the sweatshirt as he tried to flee and spun him around, taking him to the ground face down. Higgins did not completely catch himself before his face struck the asphalt, and he sustained a bloody lower left lip.

I interviewed Higgins as he sat in the back of a patrol car while the assault/fight investigation continued. Higgins admitted that he heard the officer's commands and refused to obey them and tried to run, he declined medical attention for his lip, and when specifically asked if the officer was unprofessional said that the officer (Howe) was professional and did what he needed to do.

Use of force was appropriate and reasonable given the circumstances, and was within department policy, case law and use of force guidelines.





Use of Force

Complainant Interview Summary

Complainant was contacted while handcuffed in the back of a patrol car with the door open. He was under arrest for Obstructing. He had not requested a supervisor, but officers on scene had done so. He stated that he knew he was being detained for an incident which had just occurred nearby of which he had been a part, and had tried to run away after being uncooperative. He stated that the officer acted professionally, and he shouldn't have tried to run. He declined medical attention. He was obviously intoxicated.

Officer Interview Summary

Ofc. Howe responded to a fight/assault call at 202 E. Wedgewood where updates described a physical assault on a female by 2 BMs, who were walking away with a WM. Officers arrived as the three were coming out of the parking lot onto Lidgerwood. Higgins and the WM refused commands to stop and tried to quickly walk away. Higgins was verbally abusive, uncooperative and untruthful, initially refusing to sit down or remove his hands from his pockets. Once he did sit, he continued to evade questions, then abruptly tried to rise up and run. Ofc. Howe grabbed Higgins by the back of his sweatshirt and pulled him to the ground. Higgins sustained a bloody lower lip from impacting the ground.

Witness Interview Summary

Ofc. Caleb Howard was on scene dealing with the other 2 males when Higgins tried to run. He observed Ofc. Howe grab Higgins by the back of his sweatshirt and pull him to the ground to be handcuffed.

Ofc. Beau Brannon was in the area at a distance, and saw the incident the same way.

Investigative Summary

Ofcs. Responding to an escalating physical fight call at 202 E. Wedgewood were advised en route that 2 black males were beating up a female and had just left on foot with one white male. Officers arriving in the area detained arrestee Higgins as part of the trio coming out of the apartment parking lot. Higgins did not comply immediately with commands to stop and tried to walk briskly away with the white male (who had a felony warrant). Higgins was confrontational and extremely intoxicated, cussing at officers with his hands in his pockets. He ignored officer requests to provide truthful information, and finally tried to run away. Ofc. J. Howe grabbed Higgins by the sweatshirt as he tried to flee and took him to the ground face down. Higgins did not completely catch himself before his face struck the asphalt, and he sustained a bloody lower lip. Officers then requested a supervisor at the scene.

I talked with Ofc. Howe witness Officer Howard at the scene, and they provided consistent accounts of the incident.

I interviewed Higgins as he sat in the back of a patrol car while the assault/fight investigation continued. I observed a bloody lower left lip, and noted a strong odor of intoxicants in addition to his glassy, unfocused stare, slow head

nodding and slurred speech. Higgins admitted that he heard the officer's commands and refused to obey them initially, knowing he was being detained. He also admitted he tried to run and was caught by Ofc. Howe, he declined medical attention for his lip, and when specifically asked if the officer was unprofessional said that the officer (Howe) was professional and did what he needed to do.

Use of force was appropriate and reasonable given the circumstances, and was within department policy, case law and use of force guidelines.

The originating incident was a legitimate assault, however the injured female was equally hostile and uncooperative, and refused to press charges. Higgins was booked for Obstructing. Cpl. Kakuda responded and took photos of Higgins' injuries, and Ofc. Howe advised that the incident was filmed by his body camera.

progress. Five different residents from that apartment complex called in saying there was a large group of about 10-30 people physically fighting.

Officer Howard and I arrived in the area and saw three males walking away from the parking lot of 202 E Wedgewood. When figured they were involved and contacted them.

As I exited my vehicle one of the males stopped immediately and sat down. Two of the other males continued to briskly walk away and pretended to not hear me telling them to stop. I yelled at them at least twice to stop. They both finally and reluctantly stopped. Howard contacted one of the males and I contacted the other.

The male I contacted was immediately confrontational and extremely intoxicated. He began walking towards me cussing at me and had his hands in his pockets. I ordered him to take his hands out of his pockets and sit on the ground. The male ignored me and continued walking at me with his hands in his pockets.

I ordered him again to take his hands out of his pockets, which he finally did, but would not sit down. He continued to walk at me and asking if he was being detained. I told him he was being detained and he was not free to leave. He asked why he was being detained and I told him I was investigating a crime. He told me I wasn't and began to argue with me and refused to follow my repeated commands to sit down.

The male continued to ask if he was being detained and told him he was. He then told me that I was lying and still refused to sit on the ground.

At that point it was apparent that he was not going to comply with me and was going to continue to obstruct my investigation so I determined I was going to physically detain him in handcuffs and get him under control before he either decided to fight (which is what I thought he was going to do) or take off running.

As I approached him to grab a hold of him he turned away from me and then quickly sat down so I let him sit there. Once he was sitting he continued to argue with me and ask if he was being detained. I again told him he was detained and not free to leave and also told him I was investigating a fight/assault.

The continued to argue with me then started demanding my badge number, which I gave to him. I started trying to ask him where he was coming from and question him about the fight. When I asked where he was

coming from he said he was coming from Francis and Wellesley (which didn't make any since. Those two roads run the same direction and do no intersect).

I asked him what his name was and he said he was Darren Higgins. I asked how old he was since I could tell he had been drinking. He said it didn't matter and refused to tell me. He then went on to say that he didn't need to tell me anything and refused to answer me and again asked if he was being detained.

I asked him again how old he was and he said it didn't matter and he was 23 years old. Then he turned to his friend that Officer Howard was talking to and asked him if he was being detained. I told him again that he was being detained and not free to leave.

About that time Darren tried to get up and run away. He stood up and before he could get far I grabbed him by the sweatshirt and spun him around and took him to the ground face down. Once on the ground I told him he was now under arrest for obstructing.

I searched Darren incident to arrest and found his WA State ID card in his wallet.

I could see that Darren was bleeding slightly from his mouth. It appeared the when I took him to the ground he hit his lip on the pavement and caused a minor scratch. I asked him if he need medical attention and he said no.

At that point I picked him up and walked him over to my patrol vehicle. Once there I sat him inside.

Lt Sprague arrived on scene and spoke to Darren. Sprague asked him if he followed the officers' commands and he said no. Darren said that he didn't blame the officer for doing what he did. Sprague asked him if he felt the officer treated him appropriately and he said yes.

Officer Bishop was at the apartment complex where the fight call originated from and contacted a female named Treann Andrew. According to Bishop Treann had been assaulted by a black male named "Pistol". Bishop said there was evidence on Treann consistent with City Assault.

The male Officer Howard had contacted was identified as Steven Lewis. I asked Steven if he had a moniker
