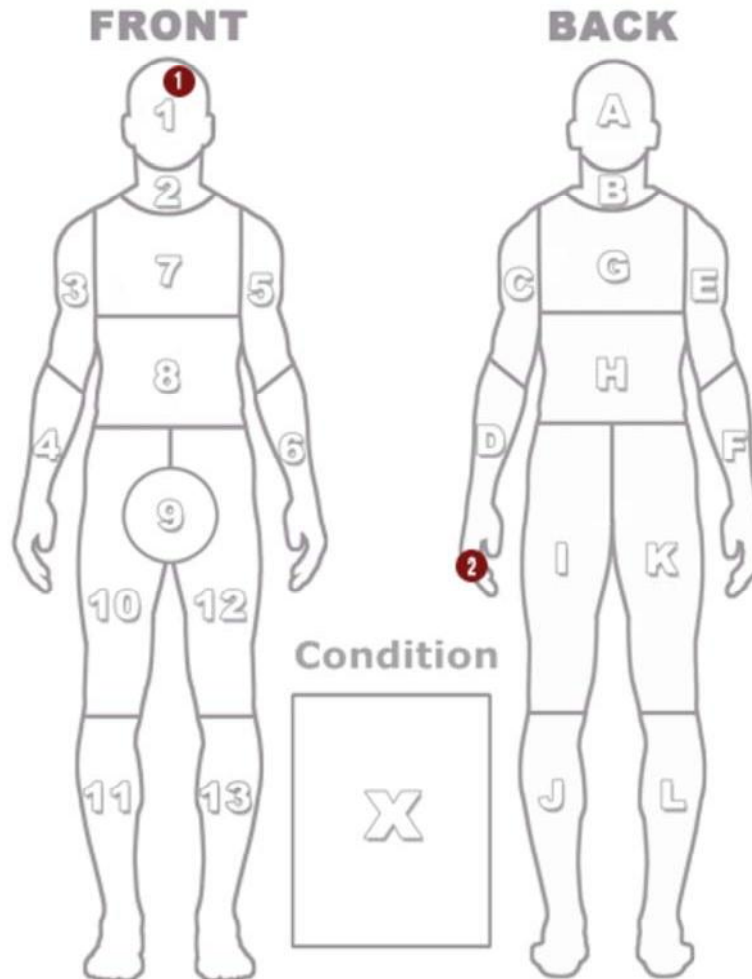

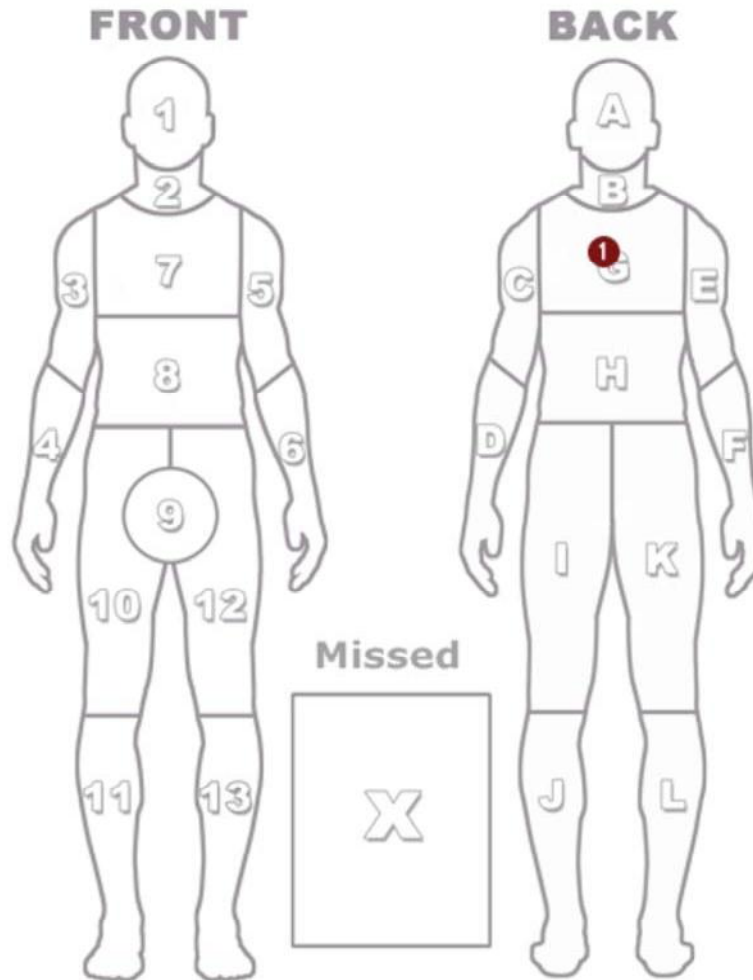

Recipient's Comments/Response: I agree with Sgt. Crane's assessment. Sgt. Vigesaa was attempting to apprehend a suspect fleeing on foot. Sgt. Crane noted the potential threats to the officer and others during the foot pursuit as well as Sgt. Vigesaa's attempt to de-escalate the incident prior to using force. Ultimately, the suspect continued to attempt to evade arrest and the use of the "push" of the running suspect and prone handcuffing was reasonable and within department policy as the suspect was actively resisting and attempting to evade arrest. In Sgt. Vigesaa's report he noted that the vehicle sped off from the initial stop, traveled a short distance, and then the suspect fled on foot. Sgt. Vigesaa did follow the suspect around the corner, but based on what he noted in his report he did not describe having probable cause for eluding and as described, did not appear to be in actual pursuit of the suspect. Attempting to follow the suspect a short distance in his vehicle to determine the intent of the suspect appeared reasonable and not a violation of policy. Lt. Hendren #482

Incident Being Investigated

This is a review of a Use of Bodily Force resulting in injuries to the arrested suspect, hereafter referred to as Witness or Pedersen.

Incident Summary

Sgt. Vigesaa initiated a traffic stop on the driver of a vehicle for having mismatched license plates and an obstructed field of view because of a damaged front windshield. Sgt. Vigesaa was in his SPD Patrol Vehicle with emergency lights and siren. Pedersen refused to stop and tried at least once to get back to the car he dumped to continue his attempt to evade capture and flee. Pedersen yelled for his passenger, Baxter, to get into the car and flee, which she did not do. Sgt. Vigesaa identified himself as "Police" and issued the command to "Stop".

At one point, Pedersen ran up onto the front porch of 3318 E. Fairview and stopped. Sgt. Vigesaa, instead of forcing a physical confrontation, stopped in the front yard and ordered Pedersen and Baxter to sit down. This was an attempt by Sgt. Vigesaa to de-escalate the incident and afford them both the opportunity to surrender. Instead, Pedersen again took off running.

Sgt. Vigesaa took the opportunity, once he caught up to the fleeing Pedersen, to shove him in an effort to make him stop running. Pedersen then flung himself onto the hood of a car. When Sgt. Vigesaa attempted to handcuff Pedersen there was again physical resistance. Pedersen "flailed his arms" and did not cooperate with Sgt. Vigesaa's commands to put to his hands behind his back. Sgt. Vigesaa pulled Pedersen off the hood of the car and placed him onto the sidewalk in a prone handcuffing position, and Pedersen was taken into custody.

Pedersen was wearing a large pair of female style sunglasses when he was taken to the sidewalk, which resulted in a cut across his forehead. He received stitches for the cut at Holy Family Hospital.

Officer Interview Summary

My interview with Sgt. Vigesaa is consistent with his Police Report (see attached).

Witness Interview Summary

When I spoke with Pedersen after he was treated, he informed me sometime during the incident, he had dislocated the pinky finger of his right hand. He said he was able to pop it back into place and it was not broken. Pedersen said he was "pooped out", which is why he laid across the hood of the car. He said Sgt. Vigesaa "handled me" and he wasn't sure how the cut happened to his forehead. He said he received 7 stitches at the hospital. Pedersen said the reason why he ran was because the female with him had warrants, and he was trying to let her get away. He was upset the plan didn't work as "they got the girl too". Pedersen's only complaint was that he didn't think the cop had a reason to stop him.

Investigative Summary

Pedersen, was wanted on a local Robbery Warrant, as well as Misdemeanor Warrants out of Wenatchee. He ran from Sgt. Vigesaa on foot in the area of 3300 E. Fairview. The passenger, Jessica Baxter, also had a Felony Warrant for her arrest, as well as a local Misdemeanor Theft warrant, but offered minimal resistance.

Sgt. Vigesaa's professional response and application of verbal tactics in association with his bodily force and weight, resulted in the physical arrest of the Dangerous and Potentially Violent fleeing suspect Pedersen. Although the force resulted in an injury to Pedersen's forehead, it was not acquired by intentional means, but instead as an unintended result of prone handcuffing, in association with the sunglasses being worn by Pedersen. Sgt. Vigesaa's application of minimal force and the reporting of it, was objectively reasonable and within department training and guidelines.



On 03-31-15 at about 1103hrs I was on Patrol in the northeast area of Spokane. I observed the listed vehicle traveling EB on Euclid from Market. I noticed that the vehicle's front license plate differed from the rear plate.

The front license plate was 246YFJ which returned showing to be for a 1998 Plymouth Neon and the rear plate ABG6570 came back on a 1997 Buick Riviera. I also noticed the front windshield had several cracks that interfered with the drivers view.

I activated my Police Impala's emergency lights to stop the vehicle for the listed violations. I was wearing the uniform of the day with an SPD badge on the left chest and SPD shoulder patch. The driver later identified as Jeremey Pedersen turned SB on Thor from Euclid and pulled over just south of the intersection. I exited my vehicle and was near my drivers door when Pedersen was looking in his drivers side mirror back at me.

When I took a few steps towards his vehicle he sped off SB on Thor. I jumped back in my vehicle and activated my siren with the emergency lights and followed Pedersen who turned WB on Fairview. Pedersen drove about 200 ft west of the intersection of Thor and was exiting his vehicle

running when I came around the corner.

I followed behind Pedersen briefly in my car with lights and siren while he was running, then I exited my vehicle and chased him on foot. Pedersen ran through a few yards and over fences NB then back SB towards his vehicle. When we ran back by his vehicle the female passenger-Baxter was standing outside the vehicle looking as though she was going to run. Pedersen was trying to lose me and was hoping he could've gotten back into his vehicle but I was too close to him so he kept running SB past his vehicle.

Pedersen ran SB across Fairview and through more residential yards and over fences. He fell at least twice going over fences. He then doubled back again and ran up onto the front porch of 3318 E Fairview. This entire time I was ordering him to "Stop" and "Police" and to get on the ground. Pedersen had been reaching into his pants pockets the entire time and was wearing large sunglasses that appeared to be females. It was apparent while I was chasing him that he was wearing the sunglasses to disguise his face. Pedersen was also reaching into his pockets for potential weapons and at one point something black had fallen out of his waist area (later determined to be his wallet) while he was reaching in his heavy sweatshirt mid section area.

Pedersen ran onto the porch of 3318 E Fairview and began yelling at Baxter who was still by the car. He was telling her to get in the car and take off. I stayed in the yard of 3318 and yelled to the female-Baxter to sit down and not to try and drive away. Pedersen then took off running again SB through the yards and over to Thor then back NB towards the car. Pedersen was running to the car when I closed distance and pushed him from behind. There was a small sedan parked on the south curb of Fairview in front of 3318. I pushed Pedersen towards the hood as he was running by it.

Pedersen sprawled out on the hood and I came up and tried to control him on the hood to handcuff him. Pedersen was still flailing his arms and not cooperating to my commands to stop resisting, so I pulled him off the vehicle's hood and onto the sidewalk where I could try and better control him with prone handcuffing.

I held him on the ground and Ofc Shrier came running up and assisted with handcuffing DL.

Pedersen recieved a cut to the left side of his forehead. I believe his sunglasses cut his head during the prone cuffing. His glasses were next to his head and broken. They were photographed in place.

Pedersen dislocated his right pinky finger sometime during the incident. Medics were dispatched and arrived to check on him.

I read Pedersen his CR's and he stated he understood and waived his rights. I began by asking him his name and he told me "Don" but wouldn't tell me his last name. Pedersen was obviously lying to me so I let Ofc S Kennedy confirm his name and interview him.

I then went and backtracked his route and found his wallet next to a fence. Pedersen was wanted for Robbery locally. He had several misd warrants out of Wenatchee and his driving status was suspended 1st.

Baxter was wanted on a Felony DOC warrant and misd theft warrant.

Ofc Killian transported Pedersen to HFER where he was treated. He relieved 6 stitches on his forehead and his finger was sprained.

He was then transported to the Det's office reference the Robbery then taken to jail and
