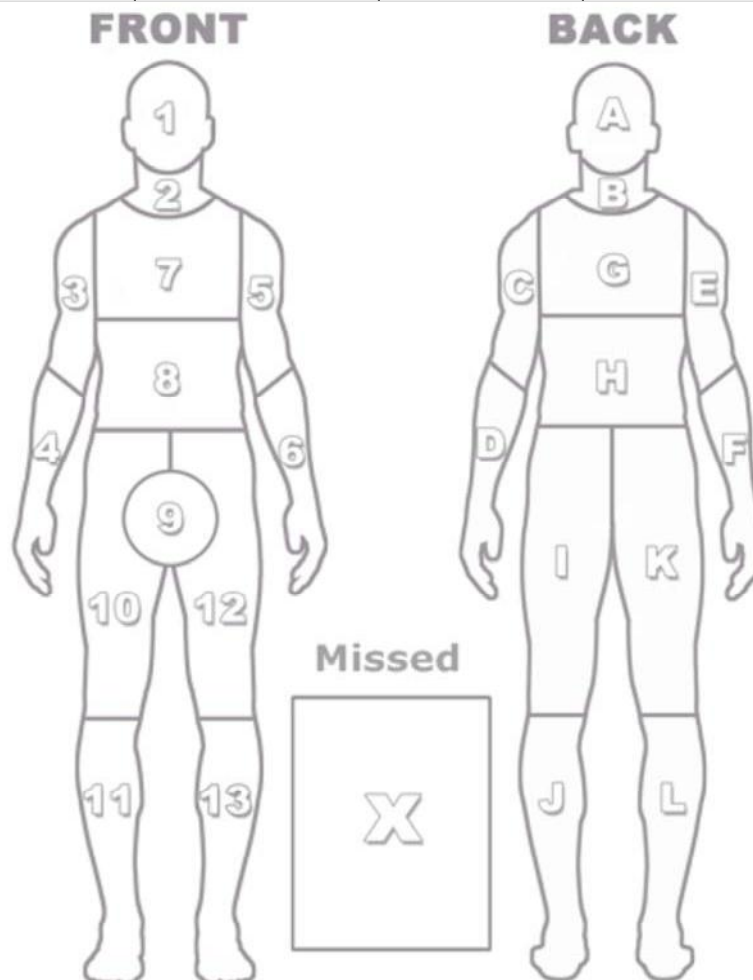

Use of force was justified and within department policy, case law and use of force guidelines.

Incident Being Investigated

This is a review of Ofc McMurtrey pointing his rifle at a kidnapping suspect who was said to be armed with a firearm.

Incident Summary

Ofc McMurtrey along with Ofc's Brannon and Wheeler were on surveillance of a Kidnapping suspect out of Nespelem, Wa. Colville Tribal Police sent out a BOLO for Jack, Andrew J 06-29-79 regarding him Kidnapping [REDACTED] #1a at gun point. Colville Tribal had PC for this as well as UPF on Jack who is a convicted felon.

Ofc McMurtrey located the vehicle at the Boulevard Motel and set up surveillance. I arrived on scene a few hrs later and planned a ruse to separate Jack from [REDACTED] #1a who were both inside Motel Room #9. The plan was to stage a collision with Jack's vehicle and one of our UC vehicles and have him meet the manager in the office. The arrest team (including McMurtrey) were staged in room #10. Jack came out as planned and began looking at his vehicle. McMurtrey and Wheeler and Brannon came out and confronted Jack in the parking lot. McMurtrey pointed his rifle at Jack while announcing SPD and ordering him to get on the ground. The attached body cam footage of McMurtrey shows this as well as his rifle being on safety the entire time.

Investigative Summary

The investigation put Jack in a Motel room at the Boulevard Motel. We knew he was inside with the victim and there was PC for Kidnapping and UPF. There was PC that he was armed with a firearm during the crime and it was highly likely he was still armed with a firearm. The high severity of the crimes along with the threat to the victim and Police who were going to arrest him, presented a very dangerous situation. The goal was to detain Jack before he had a chance to access a vehicle and/or flee. There were two other family members in the Motel who were in room #4. We didn't know if the family members were Police friendly but did know they were relatives of Jack. We wanted to prevent a possible escalating scene with multiple family members if we were to wait until they all came out of the Motel on their own and congregated together. The plan was well orchestrated and Jack was placed in custody without incident. There

were no injuries to Jack or Officers. Ofc McMurtrey's pointing of the firearm I feel was reasonable and justified as well as within SPD Policy.

On the night of 5-13, I read a broadcast of a possible kidnapping from Stevens County.

On the morning of 5-14, I was made aware that officers had located the vehicle listed in the call at the Boulevard motel. They were losing cover of darkness and needed assistance with watching the vehicle. They had established with tribal officers that there was probable cause to arrest Jack.

I arrived and notified the motel owners of the situation. They provided me with access to the adjacent motel room. I was in room number 10 and the target room was #9. I learned from the motel clerk that they had arrived at about 2300, and that the young couple was in #9 and there were two older women in room #4, and that one of the ladies had paid for both rooms.

I could hear that the male and female occupants in the room conversing. They were speaking in normal voices, but I could not make out the words. There was a brief moment of arguing. The tone of the female's voice did not leave me to believe she was in immediate jeopardy.

At about 0600, we staged a vehicle collision in the parking lot and had the motel owner call Jack. He came outside and was taken into custody without resistance. #1a came out at the same time.

I had opportunity to speak with #1a. She confirmed with me that Jack had a very small handgun, most likely a revolver, and that it was probably still on the dresser. She stated that he had taken the gun apart the night before. She is not sure the gun functions, but saw that there was a gold colored bullet. She believes he uses the gun for intimidation, and that it may not fire.

She stated that she lives down the road from Jack, and that they had lived together for about one month at his residence, which he shares with his aunt, Holliday. That was in December and she began staying at her home more often, but they still have a dating relationship.

She stated that she has broken up with him in the past, but he comes back more forcefully when she does. She mentioned that he is very intimidating to her, and she thought her life would be worse if she did separate from him.

She gave me a statement about the incident that had occurred on 5-12. She had been fishing at Owlhi lake with her uncle, Harvey George, a male named Michael who she only knows as "MJ", a male named Matthew Turner and a relative of Jack, Lyle Jack. She said she had let it slip to during a phone conversation where they were. When they were returning from the lake on a secondary road, Jack and Holliday caught up to them in a vehicle and honked their horn and both vehicles pulled over.

She stated that she remained in the back seat, but there was confrontation with all the others. She stated that Jack had the pistol and was demanding #1a go with him, and was accusing #1a of infidelity. To quell the situation, George told her to go with him, which she did. She said they drove to Grand Coulee where a female was meeting with them to give them a gas card. After an extended wait for the card, they learned that the card had not credit and they drove to Jack's residence.

She stated that they returned to his home. She remained in a back room of the home overnight and most of the next day. She said Jack made several comments about her being his, and that she was not leaving. She felt that if she were to attempt to get away, he would be able to find her, and that there was no other persons who could protect her. She said he remained aware of where she was in the home, and that he became increasingly insistent that she was his, and was very intimidating with his physical presence and his verbiage.

During that day, tribal police came to the home looking for her. Holliday met them at the door, and told them that she and Jack were not there.

On the afternoon of 5-13, they drove to Spokane for a financial reason for Holliday, needing to go to a bank in person. They checked into the motel. She said she slept during the night for a brief time, and at one point had put on her shoes, telling Jack she was going to leave. She stated he sat on the floor in front of the door at one point, remained vigilantly aware of where she was while in the room, and told her several times that she was not leaving. She felt that she could not leave or would risk being assaulted.

I remained with **#1a** until the arrival of Tribal officers and an FBI agent, clearing the scene at about 1000.

On 051415 at approximately 0122 hours, I was in a marked police vehicle (362) searching the hotels on Sunset Hwy in Spokane, WA. I had received information via police radio CAD messages to be on the lookout for a blue 2011 Chevrolet Equinox, WA lic# ANY4298.

Colville Tribal police reported that the vehicle was being driven by Andrew J. Jack (6-29-1979). He was reported to have taken his girlfriend, **#1a** **#1a** against her will by means of a semiautomatic handgun.

It was reported that he may be staying in a Spokane or Airway Heights hotel.

I located the listed vehicle parked in the parking lot of the boulevard Motel (2905 W Sunset Ave). The vehicle was parked in front of Room #4.

At that time I had limited information regarding the details of the case as well as probable cause for arrest. I determined it was necessary to form a perimeter to contain the suspect inside the hotel, prevent him from leaving and also to respond to any emergency therein.

I allocated units to certain locations both to observe the hotel from all directions and to be able to block the vehicle's exit.

Upon the arrival of SWAT Officer Brannon, I allocated tactical planning to he and Lt. Sprague.

SWAT Officer Wheeler and I took up an observation post on the railroad tracks to the West and above the hotel. I could see both the vehicle and all door to the hotel.

Based on the available information, we had reason to believe that **#1a** was being held against her will inside an unknown hotel room by Jack. He was reported to be armed with a handgun.

We made several contingency plans and briefed SWAT team leader Preuninger of the situation.

It was determined that we would observe the hotel room and delay initiating contact until sufficient SWAT assets were available.

At sunrise, PACT Sgt. Vigessa and Officer D. Cole arrived to assist with the operation.

Officer Cole obtained information from hotel management that Jack and the female (believed to be #1a) were inside room #9. Officer Cole entered Room #10 to observe and listen. He advised he could hear a male and female voice, that she did not sound to be in distress.

Sgt. Vigessa determined they would use a rouse to get the suspect out. He planned on faking a vehicle collision with the listed vehicle. Officers Brannon, Wheeler and myself snuck in to room #10, which was the door next to #9, to the West.

The suspect exited the hotel room when called and walked towards the vehicles. The female, #1a, exited the room with him.

Officers Brannon, Wheeler and myself then exited the hotel room behind them.

I used my department issued M4 rifle as my primary defense weapon. I am a SWAT officer (since 5-2011). I have been a police officer in Washington State since 1-2006. I directed my weapon at the suspect based on the fact that he was suspected of being armed with a handgun and that he was committing a felony crime of Kidnapping 1st degree as well as being a felon in possession of a firearm. We verified earlier that Jack was a convicted felon.

Jack was compliant and surrendered as directed. Officer Wheeler detained him in handcuffs.

Once he and the female were secured, we conducted a safety frisk of the hotel room. We believed the room contained a firearm, as the female reported he had one inside and it was not located on his person when he was frisked. For officer safety and to prevent evidence destruction, it was imperative that we clear the hotel room of additional persons to preserve the crime scene and to provide safety for the investigators.

We used a key to enter the hotel room (#9) and located no persons inside.

We then exited the room and shut the door pending a search warrant.

At that time, I spoke briefly with #1a. She thanked us officers. She was crying and was visibly shaking when I talked to her. She stated something to the effect of, "You guys are amazing". She stated in summary that she was scared of Jack and that he would not allow her to leave the hotel room. She tried to leave prior to his detention and he placed a chair in front of the hotel room door and sat in it. He had the handgun on a table in the room within his reach. This incident was recorded via my body camera, see video for her exact quotes.

We then turned the investigation over to Sgt. Vigessa and cleared the scene.
