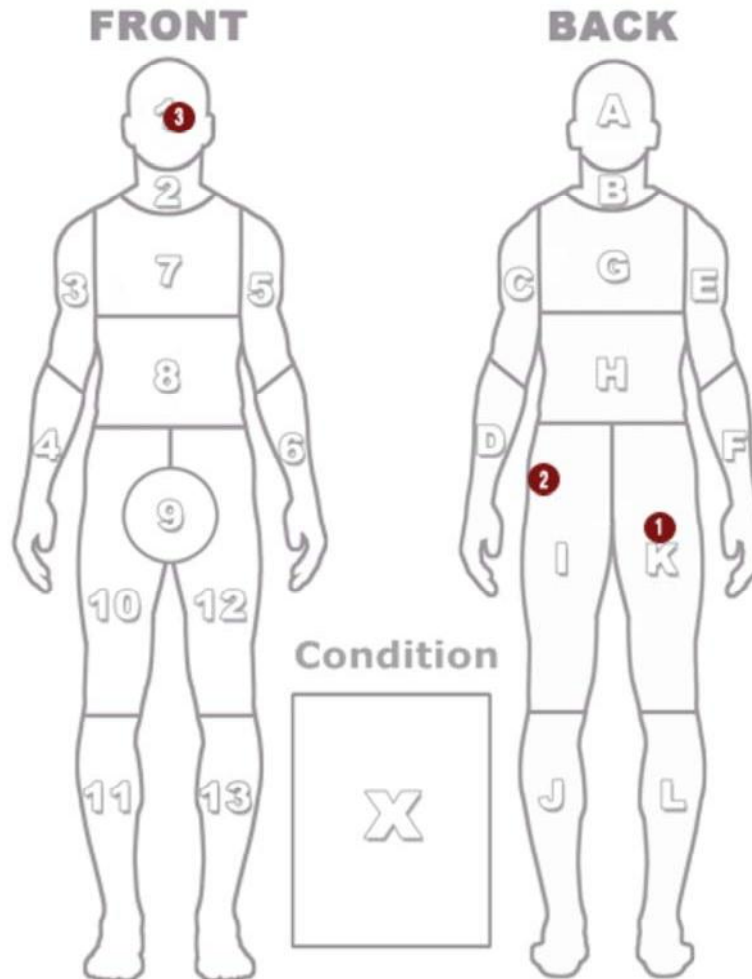

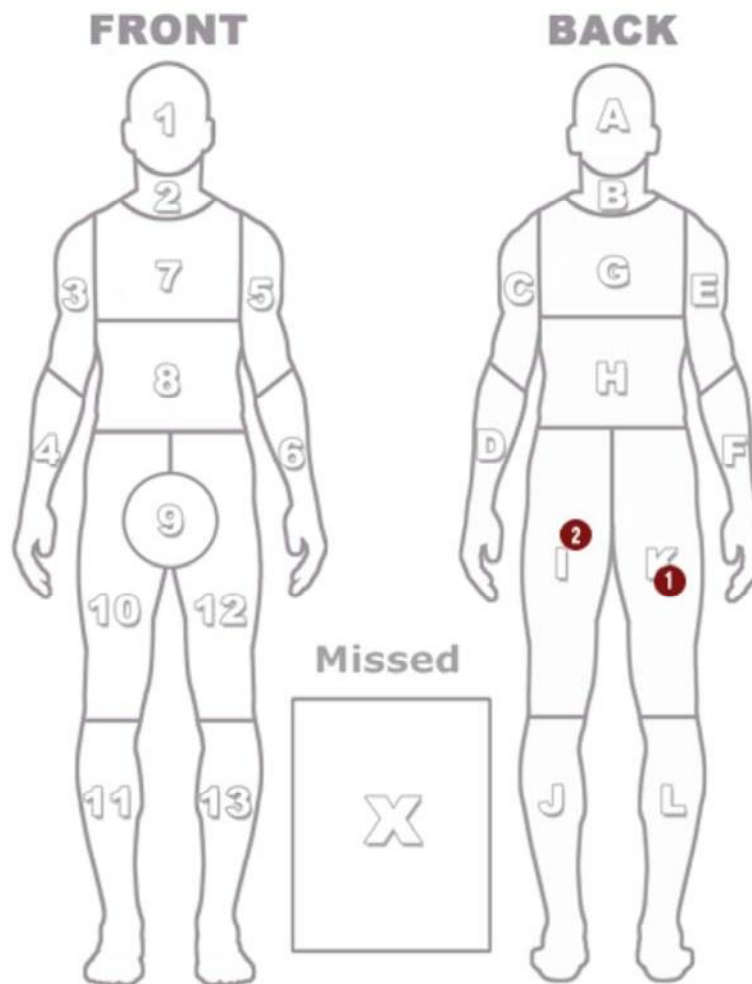

<b>Sender's Instructions:</b> Policy 309.5.1 authorizes officers to deploy the CED (Taser) when they encounter a violent or physically resisting subject, or the subject demonstrates an intention to be violent or to physically resist and reasonably appears to present the potential to harm officers, himself/herself, or others. Sgt Hartman's body camera footage did not appear to catch the initial efforts by the subject to place his hand/arm underneath him (Sgt Hartman appeared to be focusing on the subject's vehicle, which had two passengers inside of it). Sgt Hartman and Cpl McCollough both indicated in their reports that the subject appeared to attempt to reach towards his waistband area. Cpl McCollough and information that the subject was wanted for a violent felony and was concerned the subject may still be armed with a weapon. In addition, the subject was of a very large stature. The use of force in this incident was within policy and likely presented injury to the officers or subject as they struggled to get him handcuffed.				
<b>Recipient's Comments/Response:</b> The use of force was reasonable and within policy.

Incident #15-185705; use of force review.

I responded to the area of 1800 E. South Riverton and made contact with officers on scene. They were detaining a very large male. The Spokane Fire Department medics were just leaving the scene. I made contact with Sgt Hartman. He advised me he had responded to this area to assist officers attempting to stop a vehicle and detain a suspect (Piggot also last name of Brown) Airway Heights PD had been looking for. He stated he deployed his taser during the arrest process because the suspect was resistive and the crime he was wanted for was a felony assault.

I reviewed all reports and downloaded Sgt Hartman's taser data as well as his body camera footage. The link to this video footage is attached below. This incident involved a suspect who was wanted for a felony assault and had been armed with a machete and possibly a gun based on information from Airway Heights PD. The suspect was extremely large and during the arrest process he pulled his arm away from officers and reached underneath his body. This behavior and the facts and circumstances known to the officers at the time created great concern that he may be attempting to access a weapon. Sgt Hartman deployed his taser and fired causing the darts to strike the suspect in the buttocks area. This was for the 5 second cycle. It was effective and the officers were able to finish the handcuffing process. Medics responded and checked on the suspect's condition. Injuries to suspect's forehead were consistent with prone handcuffing. Medics also removed the taser probes, which left minor injury to suspect's buttocks.

I find that the taser deployment and use was within SPD policy and training. All reports are attached. Video link below.



I spoke with Detective Justice from Airway Heights and he advised that he had p.c. to arrest Matthias Piggot for Assault 2nd. Piggot was reportedly in a white 2013 Chevy Impala, Idaho #K541632. The victim reported that Piggot was armed with a machete style

knife and had told his girlfriend to give him a pistol. After the victim ran away Piggot left in the white Impala with two females. See Detective Justice's report under cross reference number for more information.

Myself and other P.A.C.T. team members checked several areas of town for the vehicle.

At about 1200 hours Ofc. Howe advised that he had located the vehicle near 1800 E. SouthRiverton. He maintained surveillance of the vehicle as it drove w/b and pulled up in front of 1800 E. Marshall.

I was at Mission/Napa and came around the corner, e/b, and saw Piggot walking away from the Impala. He was walking towards the front door of 1839 E. Marshall. Ofc. Cole and I gave Piggot verbal commands to get down on the ground and I told him he was under arrest for his warrant. He complied and went to his knees. Ofc. Cole and I then began to handcuff Piggot in the prone cuffing position. Piggot is a large male, approximately 5'11" and over 350 lbs. I took control of Piggots left arm and Ofc. Cole took control of his right arm. Ofc. Cole was able to get a handcuff on his right wrist. Due to Piggot's size we realized we were going to have to use at least two pairs of cuffs, maybe three. I was able to get a handcuff on his left wrist and we realized we would need a third pair. I had a hold of the cuff on his left hand as Ofc. Cole was trying to get the third pair on.

Before we could get the thrid pair on Piggot quickly pulled his left arm away from me and I lost control of the handcuff. He tucked his left arm under his body and appeared to be trying to access something under his body. Due to the nature of the Airway Heights call I believed he may be trying to access a firearm or other weapon. I was pulling on his arm, but was unable to get it out from underneath his body. Ofc. Cole and I were giving him verbal commands to get his hand out from underneath his body.

Piggot refused to comply and Sgt. Hartman deployed a taser. See Sgt. Hartman's report for more information.

After taser deployment Piggot removed his arm from underneath his body and we were able to complete handcuffing, using three pairs of handcuffs.

Medics were called to the scene for probe removal and a medical evaluation of Piggot. Piggot was not complaining of any medical issues. He had some slight abrasions on his forehead and are consistent with prone handcuffing.

I photographed Piggot and his injuries.

I also photographed the suspect vehicle and females Sarah Serrano and Dorei Reynolds.

I found that there is p.c. to arrest Piggot for Resisting arrest.

Ofc. Vantassel transported Piggot to jail where he was booked for the D.O.C. warrant and cited for Resisting.

On June 4, 2015 at about 1202 hours I responded to the area of 1800 E. South Riverton to assist PACT (Patrol Anti Crime Team) units. They advised they were following a suspect vehicle in a felony 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Assault incident. It was unclear to me at the time what, if any weapon was used during the incident as this a rapidly evolving situations. There was probable cause to arrest a named subject (Piggot) for this charge. Officers did follow the suspect vehicle around the area and the vehicle eventually stopped in front of an address in the 1800 block of E. Marshall St. I heard over the radio that PACT officers were contacting the suspect (Matthias Piggot) in front of a residence. I was a few blocks away and drove directly to their location.

As I drove up to the scene I activated my department issued body camera (this written report is a summary of many of my observations some of which were captured on the video). I parked my car about 50-75 feet to the south of the officers contacting the suspect. I got out and moved to their location. Corporal McCollough and Officer Cole had the suspect on the ground in a prone position. They were working on handcuffing him. The suspect is an extremely large man. He is about 5'10 and 330-350 lbs. His girth and strength appeared to slow the handcuffing process as his arms/shoulders weren't very flexible and officers were attempting to use multiple sets of handcuffs. As I walked up I could see that the suspect was using muscular tension to resist officers' attempts to control his arms. I warned the suspect that if he persisted I would TASER him. I moved around the suspect to the area of his feet and covered the suspect and kept my TASER at the ready.

A number of additional unknown threats concerned me at this point. The vehicle the suspect had just exited was parked on the street about 25 feet behind officers. It was occupied by at least two associates of the suspect. They were not under control at this point and it was unclear if they'd intervene on the suspect's behalf. To the west of officers and a few feet away was a fourplex style apartment building. It was likely that the suspect was going to one of these units and that subjects friendly to the suspect might be inside.

Officers continued their efforts to get the suspect controlled with multiple sets of cuffs. The suspect suddenly pulled his

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left arm away from Cpl. McCollough and thrust his hand under him to the area of his waistband. I recognized this as an immediate threat and that the suspect was possibly trying to access a weapon. This is very atypical behavior for a suspect who is cooperating with handcuffing.

This situation was tense, uncertain, and rapidly evolving.

**Crime:** 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Assault, Resisting Arrest

**Threat:** The suspect was a younger and much larger adult male. He was significantly larger (about 330-350 lbs) than the officers attempting to control him. No pat down for weapons and search incident to arrest was possible up to this point. Officers were in close proximity to a vehicle and residence that held associates of the suspect, who could potentially interfere with his arrest. Our attention was divided between the suspect and these unknown threats.

**Resistance/Flight:** The suspect was using muscular tension to overcome the body weight of officers and the control techniques officers were using on his hands and arms. The suspect was warned that if he persisted with his resistance officers would use force on him, specifically a TASER. This warning went ignored, when a few seconds later the suspect was able to pull his left arm away from officers and thrust it under his body into the area of his waistband. The waistband is an area that people typically secrete weapons. This caused me to fear an immediate assault was forthcoming from the suspect.

Based on the above factors I chose to use my TASER. I alerted officers two times with an "Index" warning to prevent sympathetic fire. Officers were covering much of the suspect's back area, so I fired my TASER darts into the area of the suspect's buttocks and upper legs. The dart application appeared to have an immediate effect. Officers were able to regain control of the suspect's arms and finish handcuffing. During the 5 second application I knelt on the back of the suspect's legs and did get shocked myself. I believe only one (1) five second application was used. The approximate distance away from the suspect when the TASER was fired was 3-5 feet.

One dart stuck into the suspect's buttocks. The second dart was loose. It was unclear if it had ever hooked into the suspect's pants and we saw no indication that it had penetrated his flesh.

Note: the body camera footage that captures the TASER applications starts at about 1:45 into the first video.

Officers offered to turn the suspect on to his side and put him into a more comfortable position. He chose to remain prone. SFD medics responded to our location at our request. They removed the one dart that had penetrated the suspect's buttocks, checked his vitals, and gave him an overall examination. They had no medical concerns and cleared the scene. The suspect claimed no other injury, other than the dart penetration.

Cpl McCollough took photos of the suspect's injuries and the scene. The spent TASER cartridge was collected. I turned this over to Officer Van Tassel and asked him to put it on property as evidence.

I discovered significant information about the suspect after he was taken into custody. This included: he had an active DOC warrant for a past felony conviction ( Robbery). He was listed as a DOC Violent Offender. He has past gang contacts/affiliations. He has past arrests for armed burglary, assault, Forgery, and Attempt to Elude along with many other criminal charges.

I notified Lt. Walker of the TASER application.

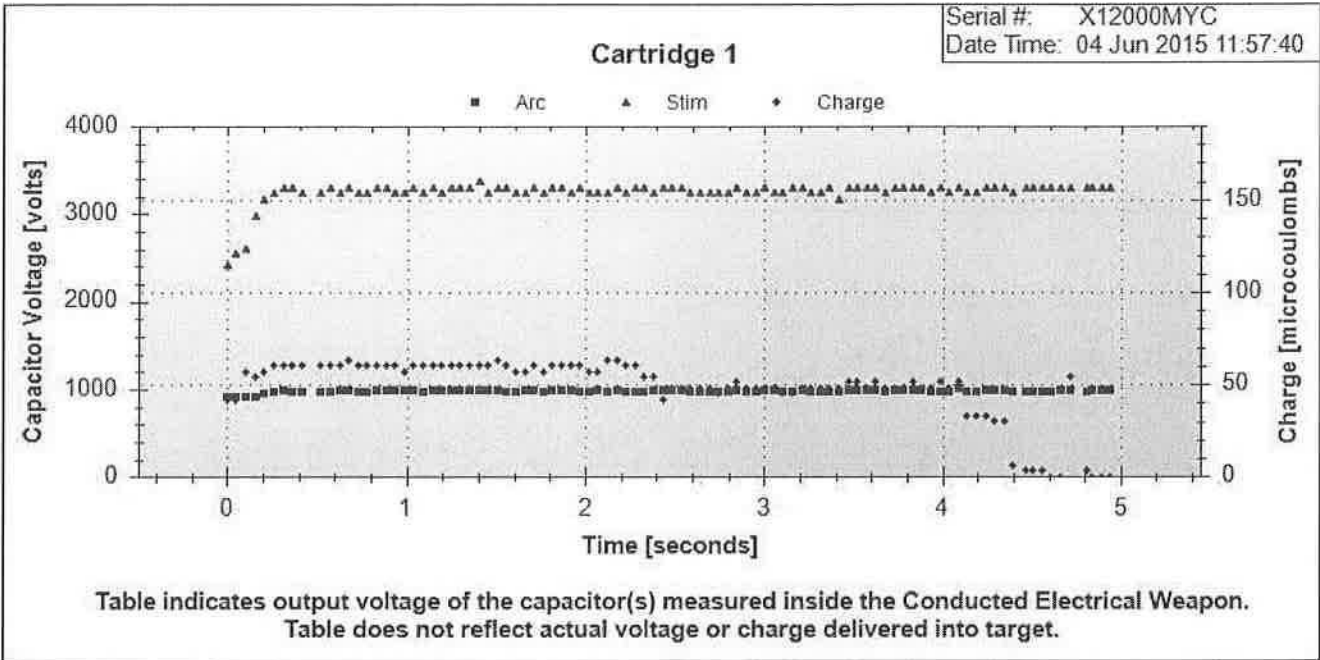
