### Incident Summary

2nd Response into two days of unusual behavior by suspect. (1st Response 15-198812). The call today was roommate came into complainant's room and yelled at complainant. Comp believed that roommate was going to rape her. He was playing with himself and 911 could here screaming from comp and suspect in background. Roommate slamming door and threatening to kill comp. Roommate laying naked on her. Roommate identified as Christopher Bertsch. Comp advised Bertsch had kicked in her door. 911 could hear comp yelling at Bertsch to get away from her. Bertsch is supposed to have 2 guns at the house.

Officer Matt and Johnson arrive onscene. Officer Johnson sees some bullets on porch as comp comes out to contact him. Officer Johnson advised Officer Matt that he was going to use Taser if Bertsch gave him the opportunity. Officer Johnson viewed video on Comp's phone that should Bertsch forcing his way into her room while naked. Bertsch then opened the door again and began yelling at officers.

Officer Johnson believe based on all of the facts and the suspects behavior that he posed a threat to officers and others. He was standing in the threshold of the door and the guns could have been in easy reach just out of sight. Bertsch was still acting very agitated as though he was having either a mental and/or drug induced problem. Officer Johnson tased him. The result was that Bertsch was immediately incapacitated and went to the floor. Officers were able to get him handcuffed and detained without any further injuries. They immediately requested medics to come in and treat Bertsch due to the Taser and possible Excited Delirium.

Officers developed probable cause for 1st Burglary, Unlawful Imprisonment, Harassment Threats to Kill, and Indecent Liberties.

For more exact details see Officer Johnson and Officer Matt's Reports. They were also both wearing body cameras and filmed the incident. The videos from them starting at 1911 hrs shows the use of force.

Medics did arrive and transported Bertsch to the hospital. After he was treated, he was booked into jail.

No photos were taken of the suspects injuries.

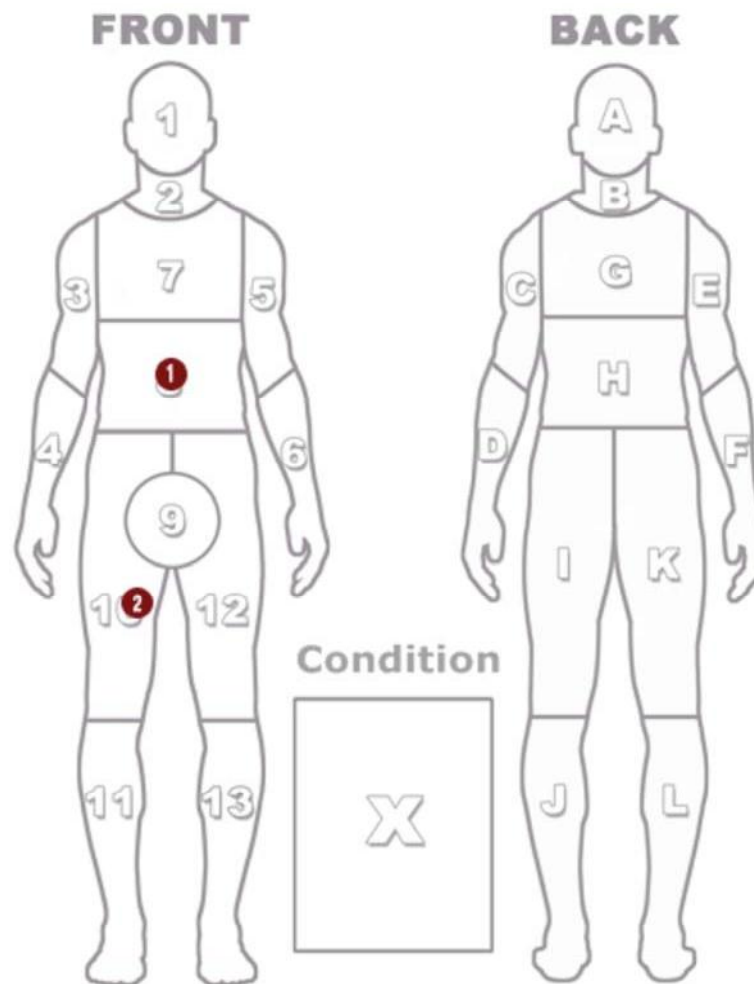

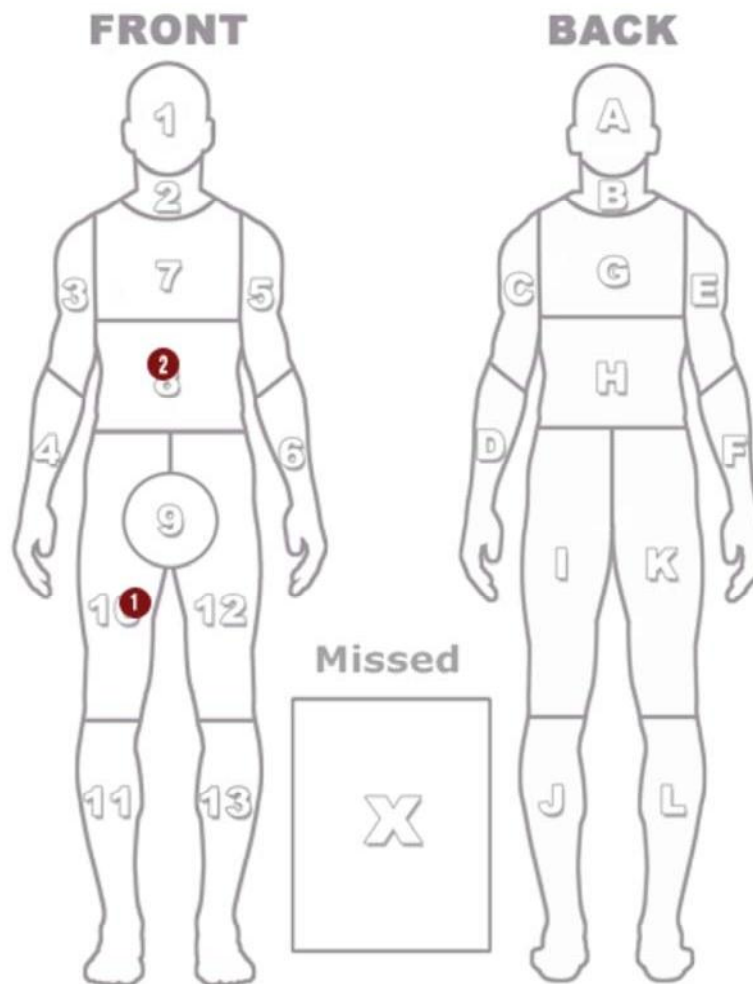

On Sunday June 14th, 2015 at approximately 1910 hours, I responded to 206 W Buckeye Avenue, within the City of Spokane, reference a sexual assault report.

Upon arrival I witnessed A1 Christopher being strapped to a medical gurney for transport to a local hospital. Christopher at the time was yelling incoherent statements and acting irrationally and aggressive. Christopher was trying to break free from the restraints by pulling forcefully against them.

When Christopher was being wheeled away from the residence, he sighted the Victim **#1a** standing nearby. He sat up on the gurney and began to pant and make grunting noises towards her. His behavior obviously scared **#1a** further and she began to cry and attempt to hide to the side of the house out of view of Christopher.

I then interviewed the Victim **#1a** who told me that she had rented a room to Christopher in December of 2014 after meeting him in law school. She told me that Christopher has exclusive

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use of his bedroom as well as the common areas of the house. Each of the bedrooms are separate dwellings in the home and each is equipped with a padlock affixed to the outside, to prevent entry from anyone other than the occupant.

**#1a** said that she was in her exclusive bedroom studying for an upcoming exam, with the door closed, however it was not locked.

**#1a** said she could hear Christopher ranting in the hallway, yelling something about, "Faggots". There had been a prior incident of Christopher acting irrational the night before and he had been taken by Police to Sacred Heart Hospital for mental evaluation. Incident # 15-198812. Christopher had been released only hours after being committed for observation and evaluation and had immediately returned home.

**#1a** became frightened and grabbed her phone dialing 911. She began to take video while pointing her cell phone towards the door. Suddenly Christopher opened **#1a** bedroom door and she saw he was completely nude. Christopher uttered something to the effect of, "Faggot" and then quickly closed the door slamming it shut. He repeated this several more times before yelling a statement that sounded like, "I should kill you".

Christopher then slammed the door with such force that it broke the door jamb. He suddenly opened the door and quickly entered the room. He stood in front of **#1a** and began to masturbate by stroking his penis, directing it towards **#1a** face.

Christopher then lunged forward grabbing **#1a** from behind, wrapping his arms around her as his weight pushed her forward down onto her bed. Christopher began to kiss **#1a** neck and shoulder while yelling, "Touch Me, Touch Me, Touch Me" and "Dry humping" her. **#1a** said she could feel Christopher rubbing his genitals up and down her back.

**#1a** said she struggled to free herself but Christopher forcibly tried to prevent her from breaking free by grasping her harder. **#1a** said she did manage to free herself from Christopher's grasp, however he was actively blocking her exit from the room by positioning himself between her and the door.

**#1a** managed to slip by Christopher and run downstairs and out onto the front porch, with Christopher in pursuit. Once outside she was trapped on the east side of her porch, while Christopher suddenly sat down on the steps, still acting irrational and completely nude. **#1a** said Officers were arriving so she stayed where she was.

Officers Johnson and Matt were the first to arrive and were forced to subdue Christopher by deploying a Taser in order to affect his arrest.

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**#1a** had been on the telephone during much of the incident with 911. Dispatch was relaying information to responding Officers such as, the Victim was screaming and crying and Christopher could be heard threatening to kill **#1a**. Those recordings were requested as evidence from Police Radio and will be available as evidence.

During the incident the night prior, Christopher had also made threats to "kill", resulting in one firearm being taken by Police for safekeeping. Christopher had made statements earlier to **#1a** that not all his guns had been found and she believed he may still have guns hidden somewhere on the premises. There were three .22 calibre live bullets found lying on the front steps of the residence, which she said she believed Christopher had placed there.

While I was inside the residence and in the proximity of Christopher's open bedroom door, I could smell the strong distinctive odor of marijuana coming from his room. I could see that Christopher had several glass Water Bongs and Pipes for smoking Marijuana on his night stand. I believed that Christopher had recently smoked Marijuana and it may be very likely that another substance such as the synthetic drug "Flaca" may have been used. Christopher's behavior was consistent with the use of a hallucinogenic drug.

Christopher was taken to Sacred Heart Hospital for a medical evaluation and when cleared, was taken to Spokane County Jail and booked.

Christopher was charged with Burglary in the First Degree 9A.52.020 a Class A Felony, for entering the exclusive usage bedroom of **#1a** with the intent of committing the crime of Indecent Liberties.

A charge of Indecent Liberties 9A.44.100 a Class B Felony for while nude, masturbating in front of **#1a**, then forcibly kissing and rubbing his genitals against her.

A charge of Unlawful Imprisonment 9A.40.040 a Class C Felony by forcibly preventing the escape and exit of **#1a** from the room during and after the assault.

A charge of Harassment 9A.46.020 a Class C Felony for repeated threats to "Kill" Ashley prior to and during the commission of the other crimes.

**#1a** stated she believes Christopher's intent was to sexually assault her and she was in fear for her life during the assault. She stated that she fears for her personal safety, should Christopher be released and return to the residence. She added that she believes Christopher is capable of following through on his threats to kill her.

**#1a** had issued Christopher an eviction notice prior to this incident occurring. She expressed a strong desire for a No Contact Order to be issued if possible, preventing Christopher from returning to her residence

On the 14 Jun.2015 at 1908hrs. I was dispatched to 206 W. Buckeye Ave. with several officers reference a rape. #1a called 911 saying her roommate, Christopher Bertsch, came into her room and yelled at her. She believed he was going to rape her. She said he was naked and was playing with himself. She was screaming and then began crying while talking to 911. She then stated he was laying naked on her. She then said he was standing in her doorway. 911 could hear #1a yelling at Bertsch to get away from her. She then told 911 he had broke her door and would not let her leave. She stated he possibly had two guns inside the home.

Dispatch advised LE had been at this location at 0330hrs. on todays date. I read the call where it showed Bertsch had been screaming and running through the house. Units at that call advised he was possibly having an Excited Delirium with Bertsch. They were able to take him into custody and transport him to Deaconess Hospital to be treated by Mental Health Professionals. It should be noted MHP released Bertsch less than three hours after being taken from his home.

Ofc. Matt and I arrived and observed Bertsch in the front yard of his home and was naked. Sgt. Tiegen advised there were multiple guns in the home as they had only found one the night before.

Bertsch was yelling hysterically and making statements about rape. He immediately ran into the home and locked the door as I walked onto the front lawn. He continued yelling at LE and banging on the front door as I talked to #1a. I began talking to #1a who was shaking and was hysterical. She appeared to be scared for her life. She stated Bertsch still had a rifle and a handgun in the home that LE had not found the night before. I then saw two .22 bullets sitting on the steps of the porch leading to the front door.

Based on Bertsch's behavior over the last 16 hours and having guns in the home I advised Ofc. Matt that we would not allow Bertsch back in the home if he exited it.

#1a began showing me video from her cell phone of Bertsch. I observed Bertsch continually walking into her bedroom and yelling about raping her while being naked.

Bertsch then opened the front door and began yelling at us. I was standing to the west of the front door behind a post.

At this point Bertsch was naked and was suspected in committing burglary by forcing his way into the victims bedroom. He also had assaulted the victim by laying naked on her in her own bedroom. He was playing with his genitals in front of the victim. Bertsch was also suspect in unlawfully imprisoning the victim in her bedroom.

Bertsch had acted irrational at 0300hrs on todays date and been taken to the hospital for a

Bertsch was naked in the front yard of his home screaming about raping people and killing. Bertsch appeared to be high on unknown drugs based on his being naked and his irrational statements. Based on several experiences I have recently dealt with I believed Bertsch might be under the influence of Bath Salts or Flakka. These drugs cause people to have "super human strength and to become naked. Getting naked is possibly caused by the fact the body core temperature heats up. Symptoms also include bizarre behavior, agitation, paranoia and delusions. Bertsch had threatened to kill the victim and had at least two guns still in the home. Based on his bizarre behavior he had committed numerous violent crimes while being naked.

Bertsch refused to come out of his home that had numerous weapons. As he stepped out of the home I decided to deploy my X26 Taser. I needed to take Bertsch into custody as quickly as possible to avoid injury to him and other officers. Extended fighting is a contributing factor to Excited Delirium. I decided deploying the Taser would be the safest choice to detain Bertsch to take him into custody and provide him Medical help for his drug symptom's.

As Bertsch stepped out of the front door I waited till he stepped slightly out of the front door. He then began walking back into the home as I walked up to him. I feared that there were other possible victims in the home and he could harm them or LE outside with the weapons he had in the home. He was a danger to himself and others if he was allowed to reenter the home.

I deployed my Taser knocking him to the ground on his side. He immediately rolled to his stomach after the five seconds from the Taser. I placed him into handcuffs (DL) and kept him on his stomach until Medics arrived. He did not sustain any injuries.

He was transported by AMR to SHMC. I sat with Bertsch at the hospital.

I then booked him into the SCJ for 1st Burglary, Unlawful Imprisonment and Indecent Liberties. He attempted to get out of his handcuffs at jail and was placed in a back cell.

On 6/14/2015 at approximately 1908 hours, I was dispatched to a reported sexual assault at 206 W. Buckeye Ave. The complainant advised her roommate was naked and was trying to rape her. She advised he was playing with himself and wouldn't let her out of the bedroom.

I arrived on scene and as I was walking up to the house, I could see a male run out into the front yard. I could see he was fully naked. As I walked closer, I saw the male run towards the house and inside. The male was later identified as Christopher Bertsch

The male came back outside and Officer C. Johnson and I walked towards the front of the house. The male saw both of us and ran back inside. The complainant was standing in fear on the front porch.

She had advised there was possibly guns inside the house. Officer C. Johnson made contact with the complainant **#1a**. While Officer C. Johnson was speaking with **#1a**, I could hear Christopher banging on the front door from inside. I was trying to peak through a front window to see what Christopher was doing inside but couldn't see him.

Christopher opened the door momentarily and yelled, "I need help." Both Officer C. Johnson and I advised Christopher we were there to help him. He told Christopher to come outside and speak to us. Christopher kept opening the door slightly and saying stuff. He was hard to understand and wasn't making much sense.

I was standing on the East side of the porch. Officer C. Johnson advised there was 22 bullets on the porch by the steps. Due to Christoph's erratic behavior, Officer C. Johnson and I decided for the safety of others and ourselves we weren't going to let Christopher close the door on us. It was unknown if Christopher had any weapons inside or if there were other people inside the house.

Christopher opened the door again and I drew my taser and held it by my leg. Christopher kept his eyes on me as he opened the door further. I kept telling Christopher to come outside and speak with us. As soon as Christopher opened the door all the way, Officer C. Johnson deployed his taser and struck Christopher in the lower abdomen with a probe.

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The undersigned, a law enforcement officer, competent to testify, states as follows: That he believes a crime was committed by the above named defendant in the City and County of Spokane, State of Washington, because:

**#1a** may testify to the following:

1. On June 14th, 2015 at approximately 1905 hours, she telephoned 911 emergency and reported that she was being assaulted by her roommate/tenant, Christopher Bertsch.
2. Christopher, who at the time was totally nude, had made entry into her bedroom, which is her exclusive domain within the house, uninvited, with the intent to commit the crime of indecent liberties.
3. The defendant Christopher held her against her will, physically preventing her from escaping, while he kissed her neck, rubbed his genitals on her back and told her, "Touch Me, Touch Me, Touch Me".
4. She had videotaped Christopher's actions prior to him entering the room and assaulting her, while she was on the telephone line with 911, which was also audio recorded by the 911 system.
5. Christopher threatened to Kill her during the incident and she believed he would make good on those threats had Police not intervened in time.
6. She relayed the details of the incident to Officer Scott at the time of his investigation and expressed a desire for prosecution.

Ofc. J. Scott will testify to the following:

1. On June 14, 2015 at approximately 1910 hours, he responded to 206 W. Buckeye Avenue, within the City of Spokane, reference a Domestic Violence Assault.
2. Upon arrival he interviewed the victim [REDACTED] #1a who relayed that she had been assaulted by her roommate/tenant, whom she had a room in her home for the past 7-months.
3. He established that the Victim [REDACTED] #1a account of what had occurred was consistent with the information relayed by 911 operators, Video taken by [REDACTED] #1a, and physical evidence of the broken door jamb.
4. He personally witnessed the behavior of the defendant Christopher after being taken into custody, which was consistent with [REDACTED] #1a accounts of his irrational and aggressive behavior prior to Police arrival.

Ofc Johnson will testify to the following:

1. He responded to 206 W Buckeye Avenue and contacted the defendant Christopher Bertsch, who was at the time completely nude, acting irrational and aggressive. He was forced to deploy a Taser against in order to effect an arrest upon him.

1. He responded to 206 W Buckeye Avenue, and took photographs of the scene.



On 6/16/2015, I met with and interviewed #1a at the YWCA. She stated that she had used her phone to video some of the incident. She showed me the videos and she gave me permission to take her phone and have the video copied by TARU.

One video (1:27), showed Christopher Bertsch entering her room completely naked. He was ranting and yelling. He yelled, "You should kill yourself!" He also said, "Do you want to fuck me? In another video (:23) you could hear Bertsch yelling about "faggots".

I later placed the video into Property as evidence.

#1a said that she had met Christopher at Gonzaga University. He did not have a place to stay so she allowed him to rent a room from her on a monthly basis at 206 W. Buckeye. He started living there in December 2014.

#1a said that she started noticing Christopher exhibiting strange behavior this past week. On June 13, Christopher had been taken to Sacred Heart hospital to be evaluated but was released only a few hours later.

#1a said that on June 14 at approximately 7 PM, she was in her bedroom studying when she heard Christopher yelling and ranting in the hallway. She said that she grabbed her cell phone and began to video the incident. #1a said that Christopher opened her bedroom door and she observed that he was completely nude. Christopher was yelling something about faggots. He quickly shut the door and then opened it again he repeated this several more times before he yelled, "You need to kill yourself." He then said, "Do you want to fuck me?"

#1a said that Christopher then slammed the door with such force that it broke the door jam. He then opened the door again and entered the room. #1a said that she then dialed 911. #1a said that as he entered the room for the final time he said, "I am going to kill you!" #1a said that Christopher then began to masturbate in front of her. #1a said that Christopher then lunged forward and grabbed her from behind and pushed her down onto the bed. He began to kiss her neck, face, and shoulder while yelling, "Touch me, touch me, touch me!" #1a said that Christopher was, "Dry humping" her and she could feel his genitals rubbing on her leg and back. #1a said that she was screaming on the phone to 911 as Christopher was touching her.

#1a said that she struggled to get away but Christopher would not let go of her. #1a said that he held her down for about 30 seconds. #1a said that Christopher finally let her go but then blocked her exit by positioning himself in front of the door. #1a said that Christopher held her in her room for about 1 to 2 minutes before she was able to get away. She then managed to slip by him and run downstairs onto the front porch. #1a said that Christopher chased her down the stairs out onto the porch. #1a said the police then arrived and Christopher ran back inside the house. He was then arrested.

#1a said that she was extremely frightened during the incident. She knew that Christopher had firearms and she feared for her life. #1a stated that one of Christopher's firearms had been removed on the 13th but the other two had not been found. #1a said that she went to Christopher's first appearance and gave a statement to the judge because she was afraid for her safety.

I had TARU download the officer's video from this incident and I placed that into property as well.

Prior to arriving at the scene, officers were investigating what they believed to be a possible sexual assault in progress. Information was relayed to responding officers that the victim could be heard screaming and crying due to the actions of the suspect. Other information, included in the officers' reports, included that the suspect was laying naked on top of the victim, at one point masturbating in front of her, and the victim was yelling at the suspect to "get away from her". In addition, the officers were told the suspect had broken a bedroom door and was not allowing the victim to leave her room. Several firearms were reportedly in the residence that belonged to the suspect.

Ofc Johnson's report indicates that he read information regarding a prior call from the previous evening involving the suspect under similar circumstance regarding his erratic behavior. In that incident, the suspect had been transported to Deaconess for a mental health evaluation and concerns had existed about possible excited delirium. Several firearms were known to be in the residence during the first incident involving the suspect.

Upon arriving on scene, officers noted the suspect sitting on the front steps completely naked. As officers approached, he stood up and ignored commands to not go in the house. He walked inside and shut the front door, leaving the victim crying on the front porch and officers repeatedly attempting to talk him out of the house and explaining they were there to help him.

Officers noted several rounds of ammunition laying on the front porch next to the front door. Sgt Teigen advised officers that they had been unable to recover all the firearms inside the house from the previous nights' incident. The victim told officers that the suspect still had a rifle and handgun inside the residence.

Ofc Johnson reported that the suspect could be heard yelling from inside the residence that he was going to rape the victim. A plan was formed to prevent the suspect from re-entering the house if he exited.

Ofc Johnson indicated that he had probable cause for the attempted sexual assault, burglary (unauthorized entry into victim's bedroom, which he did not have authority to enter), and unlawful imprisonment.

The body camera footage shows the suspect opened the front door of the residence (common entry) and stood just inside the doorway. He appeared to still ignore officers' directions to exit the residence. Ofc Johnson deployed his Taser, which immobilized the suspect and caused him to drop the floor. The suspect was taken into custody without further incident (transported and treated at a local hospital).

Based on the details outlined in officers' reports, the nature of the crimes being investigated, the mental and emotional condition of the suspect, the body camera footage, and the potential threat to officers, the victim, and the suspect (concerns were expressed about the suspect suffering from excited delirium if a prolonged struggle ensued to take him into custody), I believe this use of force was within policy and the safest manner for officers to take the suspect into custody.
