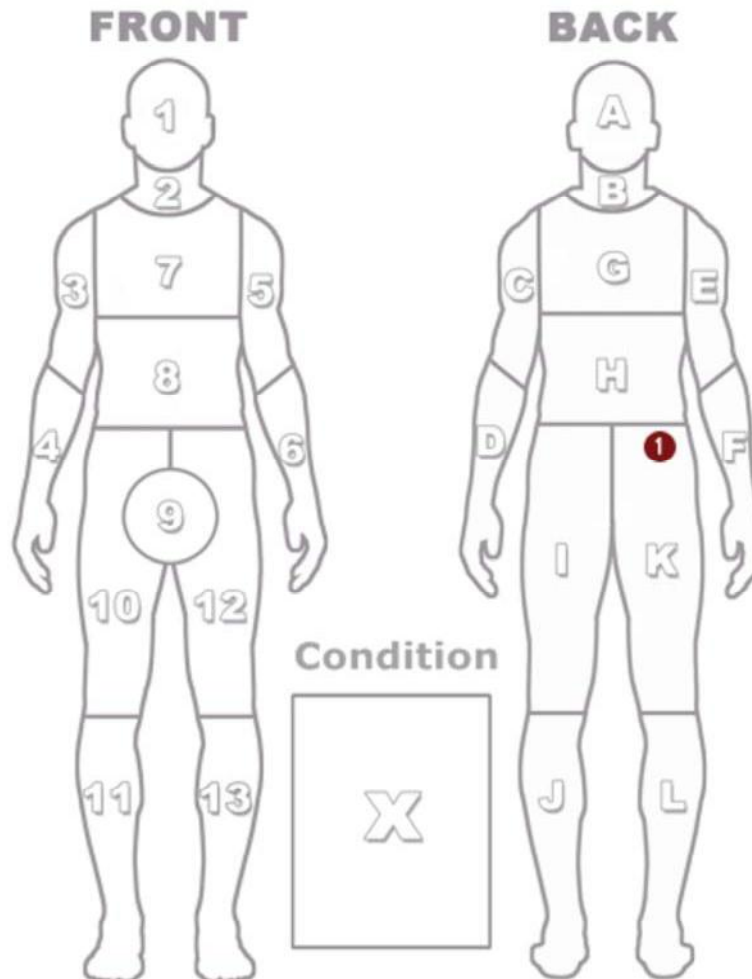

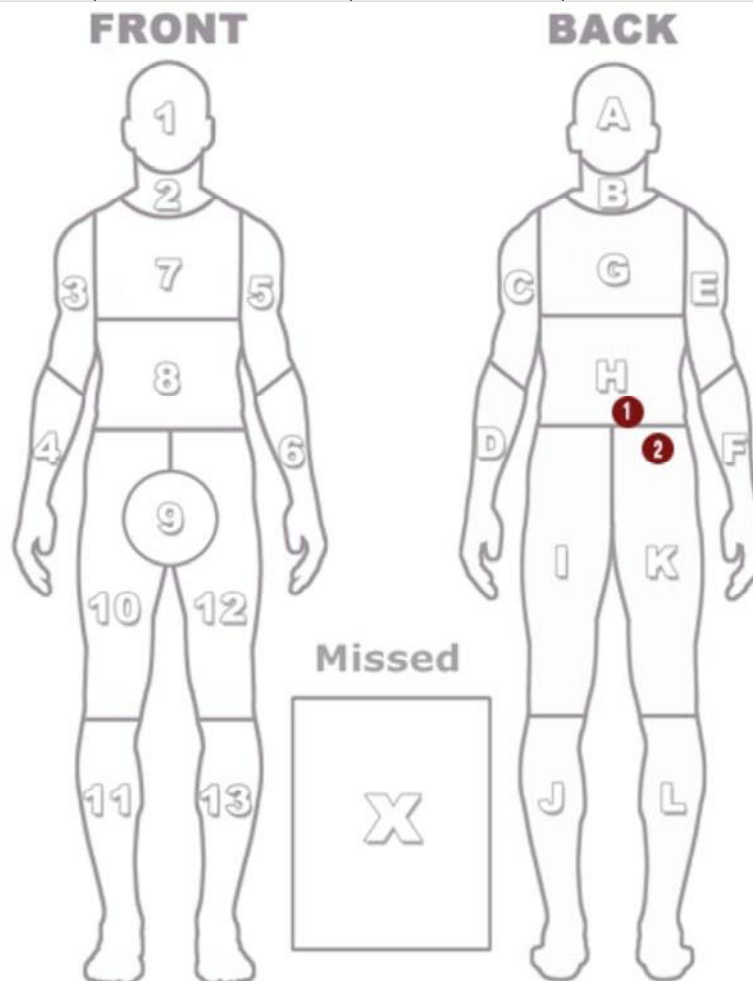

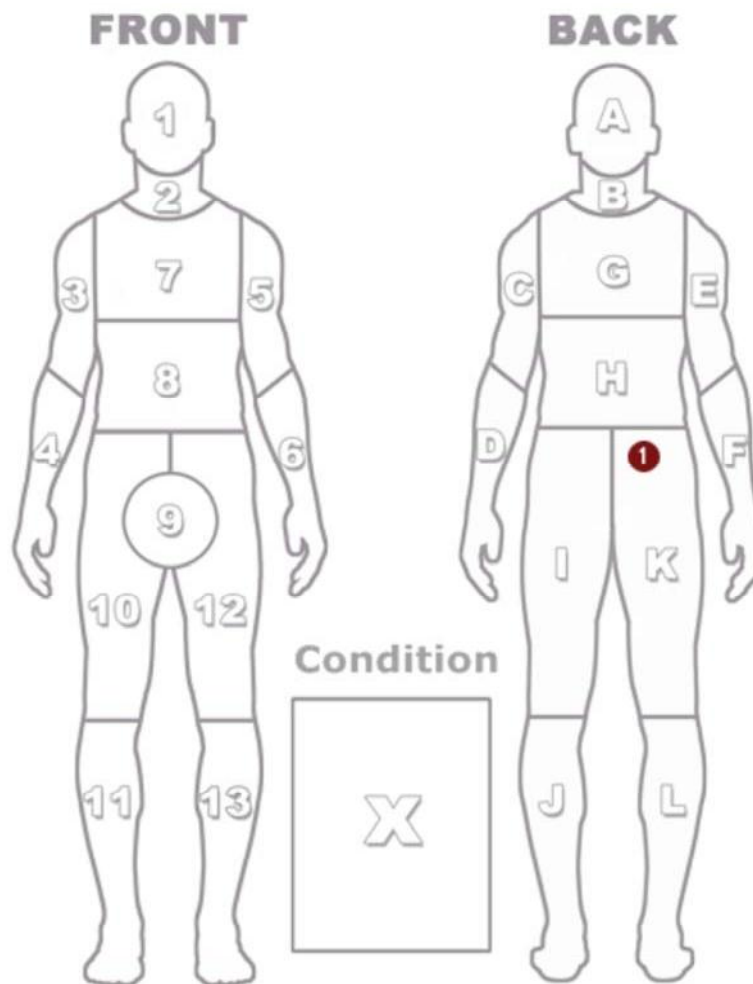

Investigative Summary

The CAD report indicates no supervisor responded to the scene. Lt Sprague was enroute at one point but was pre-empted. No supervisors were available so therefore no on-scene investigation was conducted.

The conclusion of my portion of the investigation indicates that the Taser usage was appropriate in defense of the apparent assaultive behavior displayed by the suspect.





N A R R A T I V E	<p>On 07-18-15, at approx. 0157 hours, I was working as a downtown bar patrol unit in the area of Main/Division, Spokane with Sgt. Hartman. The general duties are to patrol the downtown bar district during our shift from 2100-0330 hours.</p> <p>We were in the area of the Globe tavern (200 block of N. Division) when I observed a physical altercation on the S/W corner of Main/Division. I could numerous male subjects involved in a physiscal fight. I saw one male (Govan) being punched by another male (later identified as Steyart). There were numerous subjects and it appeared they were trying to separate Govan and Steyart. I saw numeorus punches being thrown, but could not identify the subjects at that time due to the large group of people (and another fight to the south). I observed Govan and Steyart fall to the concrete sidewalk and Govan was on his back. Steyart swung 3-4 "haymakers" at Govan as they were on the ground (that I observed). Officer Wells and I approached them and Officer Wells was telling them to stop and identifying us as the police. Steyart continued to punch at Govan while he was on the ground. Steyart was the agressor based upon my observations. Officer Wells grabbed Steyart by his shirt and pulled him away. Govan started to stand up and I told him to sit back down on the sidewalk. There was also another physical altercation occuring to the south of us, but I was not able to leave Govan and that situation at that time. I was telling the subjects to the south of me to stop fighting (and shining a flashlight at them) when I heard a taser deployment and observed Steyart lying on the side walk (on Main) next to the light pole at the S/W corner of the above location. I could see the taser probes in his back. Other officers were with him taking him into custody. The fight to the south of me had stopped and I spoke with Govan.</p> <p>I spoke with Govan and he advised me that he had been with some friends in the area of the intersection "joking around". He said the male that was in custody (Steyart) came up to one of his friends and "smacked" him. They started arguing about why Steyart hit his ffriend and Steyart started becoming more agitated. Govan said they ended up on the ground and Steyart was striking him. Govan said he hit Steyart, but he was only defending himself. Govan was not able to tell me how many times he had been struck or how many times he struck Steyart. Govan continued to say he was only defending himself from Steyart. Govan had some blood around the edges of his mouth when I contacted him, but he did not want medics or to press charges at that time.</p> <p>I spoke with Brayden Boswell. She is the girlfriend of one of Govan's friends (Heath). Brayden said they were at the Taco truck (S/W corner of Main/Division) when Steyart came up to her. She said was on the phone with Heath (he was across the street). Steyart was saying "hey baby what are you doing". She said he was trying to "touch" her. Brayden said another friend (Aronson) got between them (in an attempt to make him leave) and Steyart struck Aronson across the face. Brayden said people in the area were asking what was going on and a fight started. Brayden did not see the actual fight that occurred between Govan and Steyart.</p> <p>I spoke with Anders Aronson. He said they were standing in the above area when Steyart approached them and he was being "overwhelming" towards Brayden. Anronson said he started to interject when Steyart struck him with an open right palm across the left side of his face. Aronson was telling him he was in the military and asking him why he would be disrespectful when someone came over his right shoulder and the fight started. Aronson said he was trying to pull Govan away from Steyart. On 7/18/15 at about 0157 hours I was working downtown bar patrols with Detective Curtis, Officer Wells, and Officer Workman. Officers were working this bar district due to the commonplace violent activity. Fights and Disorderly Conduct are common. The crowd dynamics include predominantly younger adult males and females who are drinking. Many of them are intoxicated. Fights often take place due to ejections from a bar, perceived disrespect between subjects, men fighting over women, etc. The crowds are large and sometimes interfere with police efforts to control violent subjects. Other Patrol Officers told me they had responded to several fights in this area on different days over the past 3-4 days.

We were dealing with a disorderly subject in front of the Globe Bar at the northeast corner of Main and Division. While dealing with this issue, officers heard then saw a fight break out between multiple male subjects at the southwest corner of the intersection. Officers began to cross the street to deal with this problem.

As I moved across the street I could see this was more than a pushing match or bumping of chests. Subjects were rolling around on the pavement and into the street. One subject (Steyart) was throwing haymaker type punches with an obvious intent to injure. He was a younger male with a very muscular build. I saw Officers Curtis and Wells try to break up the fight. Steyard was briefly separated from the male he was trying to punch by officers, but then started to move back towards the subject and officers. It was clear to me he planned continue his violent actions and possibly direct his actions towards officers trying to intervene.

Crime: Assault and Disorderly Conduct

Threat: The suspect was attempting a serious assault on another male. His forceful punches could easily cause a facial fracture, knock someone unconscious, and/or cause other serious injury. The fight was close to spilling out on to Division, a state highway, during bar closing time/drunken hour. The location of the fight subjected the involved parties and officers to the dangers of nearby traffic. I was also aware of the earlier mentioned crowd dynamics and the hundreds of people leaving the bars at closing time.

Resistance: The suspect ignored verbal commands from officers to stop fighting. When he was moved away from the subject he was striking, the suspect attempted to reengage.

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Note: I was wearing and using my department issued body camera as I approached this altercation.

I did draw my department issued TASER. I fired the cartridge at Steyart's back as he tried to reengage in the altercation. The TASER application eventually had the intended effect, neuromuscular incapacitation. I was approximately 3-5 feet away when firing. Along with the TASER use I gave Steyart a light push from behind to guide him to the ground. He fell forward into a prone position on the sidewalk.

When Steyart was on the sidewalk I identified myself as the police and told him he was under arrest. I explained that I had TASERed him and that he need to comply with my directions or he might receive another application. Steyart had blood on his hands, which got on my own hands when I handcuffed him. I later found his blood on the pant leg of my patrol uniform.

I did read Steyart his CRs off a department issued card. He said he understood his rights and agreed to speak with me. Steyart appeared intoxicated. His speech was somewhat slurred and his demeanor was sluggish. He admitted to consuming 5 beers. He was sketchy on the details about the fight. He was bleeding from the mouth and told me this was from being punched. When I asked Steyart how he ended up in a fight he said, "I don't know". He estimated he was punched four times by a subject(s) he couldn't identify.

I spoke with other officers who interviewed witnesses and other involved parties. The information they received indicated that Steyart was the primary aggressor in this altercation. The subject he assaulted didn't want to pursue criminal charges.

Fire department medics responded to our location to check on Steyart and to remove the TASER probes. The TASER wires were caught up in the handcuff and they had to cut them to facilitate the probe removal. I collected the TASER cartridge, wires, and probes. Cpl. Kakuda took these items from me to place on property.

An exception form was completed by the transporting officers. I completed a first appearance "window affidavit" and turned this into corrections staff before clearing jail. Steyart was booked for Disorderly Conduct.

Cpl Kakuda took photos of Steyart's injuries at jail. It appears many of his injuries most likely took place during his fight and prior to police contact. Cpl Kakuda believed he located the probe strikes on Steyart's right hip/buttocks area and on his lower right back.

On 7-18-15 at 0157 hours, I was working bar patrol in the area of Division and Main. I was altered to a fight which was occurring on the southwest corner. As I approached I could see a black male who was on the ground. A large white male named Robert Steyart was on top of him and throwing "haymaker" punches. Robert had his knees on the concrete and his upper body pinning the other male on the ground. I identified myself and ordered everyone to stop fighting. There was one male behind Robert who was trying to stop Robert from throwing punches. I pulled that male off and he stopped and backed away. Robert continued to throw punches toward the head of the male on the ground and I grabbed him by the collar of his shirt and pulled him back and away. Robert was able to get his balance again after running around a pole and started back towards the other male to continue the assault. Sgt. Hartman came in from the north and made one Taser application to Robert. The Taser was effective and Robert fell to the ground where he was placed in handcuffs and advised he was under arrest by Sgt. Hartman. Medics came and evaluated Robert who was highly intoxicated. Robert's knees were scraped, but I believe that occurred from the concrete during the fight and not from that Taser application.

I was wearing my body camera when I approached Robert, but it fell off during the initial scuffle. The video shows the Taser application, then gets knocked off. I picked it up off the ground and started recording after Robert was handcuffed and receiving medical attention.

On 07/18/2015 at approx, 0157 hrs, I was standing on the NE corner of Main and Division ref a disorderly subject that was outside the Globe, when a fight broke out on the SW corner of Division and Main. There were several males fighting in the NB lanes of Division. I was with Sgt Hartman, Ofc Wells, and Detective Curtis. Those officers ran across the street while I was still with the disorderly subject who was in handcuffs. The disorderly subject was released and I went across the street to assist the officers.

When I got to the SE corner, I heard Sgt Hartman advise that there was a taser application. I then saw a subject later identified as Robert Steyart on the ground. Steyart was on his stomach on the south sidewalk of Main. I did not see the taser application.

I contacted Jeff Hainsworth who had injuries to his face. Hainsworth told me that he was with Steyart. Hainsworth said that he did not see what started the fight, but that he tried to stop Steyart from fighting by pulling on him. Hainsworth's right eye was swollen and he had a mark under his left eye. Hainsworth said that he did not see who had punched him in the face and did not want to press any charges. Hainsworth said several times that he did not know why or how the fight started. Hainsworth said he and Steyart had been at several bars after attending the Shock Football Game.

I did briefly talk with Heath Jolley and Andrew Govan. Govan's shirt was torn in the fight. Jolley said Steyart for unknown reasons struck him in the chest area. Jolley said that he questioned Steyart why he struck him at which point a fight started. Govan said he started fighting with Steyart after Jolley was struck. Jolley and Govan said Steyart was "drunk".

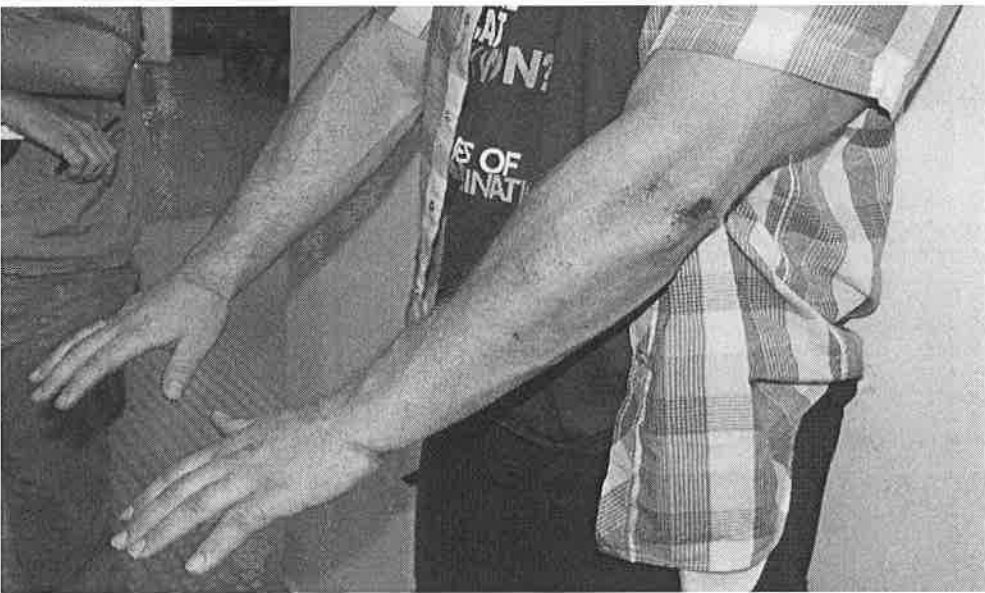
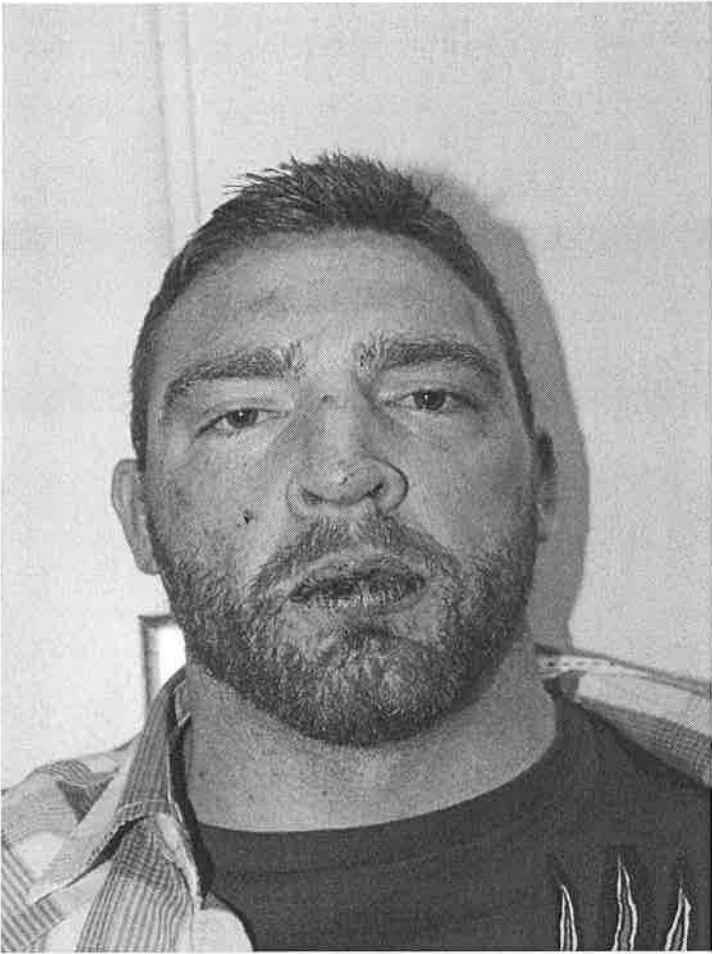

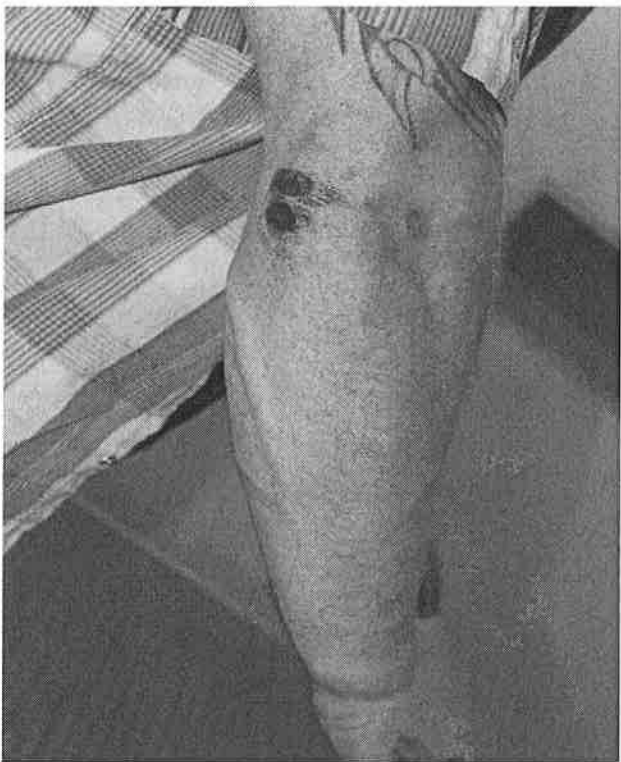
