After reading the attached documentation and debriefing Ofcs. Kester and K. Scott I find that the use of a takedown technique was reasonable and within Department Policy and met Department expectations.

Officers had developed PC for the suspect, Dobler, for DVOPV. When they attempted to arrest her she pulled away from them and attempted to avoid being arrested. In order to control her movements they used a takedown technique. Dobler received minor injuries when she landed on the rough and uneven surface.

It should be noted that there was no body camera footage of the incident.

I collected the photographs that were attached to this report number from the forensics department.

On 8/6/15 at 1620 hours, I was dispatched to serve an exclusionary DV protection order at 1002 N South Riverton on Lisa Dobler (12/8/77).

Officer K Scott assisted me, and upon arrival, a male answered the door that identified himself as the respondent of the order, [REDACTED] #1a [REDACTED] #1b).

I asked if Lisa was home and he said "yes" and invited us in the house. We entered and contacted Lisa in the living room, who was holding her youngest son, [REDACTED] #2d (9/18/14). I advised her she was being served with a protection order and gave her a copy.

The order is a temporary order for protection and notice of hearing. The order was filed July 29, 2015, #152030-7. It lists the petitioner as [REDACTED] #1a ([REDACTED] #1b) and the respondent as Lisa M Dobler (12/8/77). The order also protects the minors, [REDACTED] #2d (1 year) and [REDACTED] #2d [REDACTED] #2d (10 months). The order stated Dobler is to have no contact whatsoever with [REDACTED] #1a and restrains her from entering [REDACTED] #1a residence ([REDACTED] #1d) and must not come within two city blocks of the residence. The order states Dobler was only to take her personal clothing items. The order is valid once served until the court appearance on August 10, 2015. The order was served at 1708 hours today.

I advised Dobler she is to grab her personal clothing items then must vacate the residence immediately. She was extremely argumentative from the beginning, and stated she hasn't done anything wrong and that [REDACTED] #1a is the dangerous one. I explained that she would be able to state her case in front of the judge at their appearance date. She stated she would not go and that she cannot tell the judge everything because her kids would be taken away from both of them. She was very emotional and loud as she spoke and was yelling at me at times. Several times she stopped packing to yell at me and I had to remind her to grab her belongings so she could leave. While standing in her bedroom I advised her she needed to give us her son to give to [REDACTED] #1a since he was a protected party as well. She kept saying she didn't have to and I kindly reminded her it was in the order that was signed by a judge, and at this time if she did not comply, she would be violating the order. She finally handed Officer Scott the child. As she was grabbing clothes, she said she hates "pigs" and we all abuse her and that the police raped her when she was a little girl.

Once Dobler was done gathering her items, she walked out the back door to leave in her vehicle. She kept saying that we were harassing her and she stated, "You're going to get it," as she was getting into her vehicle, WA #AGM9950.

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I advised dispatch that the order had been served as we were standing out back, waiting for her to get in her car and leave, which was at 1708 hours. She drove away out of sight eastbound on Cataldo. We briefly spoke to #1a and told him we were leaving, but to call if she violates the order. We walked to our vehicle's which were parked east of the residence on Cataldo. I was in my car about to drive off when I saw Dobler drive past me in her vehicle, going westbound on Cataldo towards the residence. I drove behind her and activated my lights. She stopped her vehicle at the corner of South Riverton and Cataldo in front of the residence. I approached her and told her she needed to get out of the car. Both her driver's window and passenger window were rolled down. Officer K Scott also told her she needed to get out of the car and that she was under arrest. She then exited on the driver's side and I told her she was under arrest for violation of the order. I went to gain left arm control to place her in handcuffs and she pulled away from me stating she hadn't done anything wrong and she was coming to get her driver's license.

At that point, Officer K. Scott had come around to the driver's side where I was standing and attempted to gain control of Dobler's right arm. Dobler then pulled away from both of us.

At this time, we had already developed probable cause for a violation of the order we had just served, as well as resisting arrest. Dobler was adamant she had done nothing wrong and wanted her license from inside the house. It was unknown if she was trying to go back into the house and attempt to contact the children or #1a and due to her being so agitated and upset, I did not want her to have the opportunity to assault #1a or to assault Officer K. Scott and myself. There were many unknowns, and the car she was in had not been cleared for weapons and the windows were down which left an opportunity for her to access items inside the vehicle. She had also not been searched yet and it was unknown if she had concealed weapons on her. She had already made it clear that she did not believe she did anything wrong and had already pulled away from me and started flailing her arms, resisting arrest.

I attempted a hair take down, while Officer K. Scott was trying to bring Dobler to the ground from the left side. We were able to place her in the prone position on the ground. She had her right hand tucked under her body. We told her numerous times to bring her hands to her back. We were able to pull both arms out from under her and placed her in handcuffs (DL) and searched her incident to arrest.

Dobler kept stating she came back for her license and saw us there so she

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honked. She said she wasn't violating the order because we were still there and the incident was still going on.

Corporal Bartlett was advised and responded for photos as well as the Fire Department to check on Dobler's injuries. She had blood running down her forehead that appeared to have been caused from the gravel during the arrest. The road we were on was a rocky gravel road. Once the blood was cleaned off her forehead she showed a scratch above her left eyebrow as well as road rash on her left elbow that was consistent with prone handcuffing on the gravel terrain we were standing on.

I transported Dobler to the Spokane County Jail for DVOPV and Resisting Arrest on citation #N054657. Sgt. Reynolds was advised of the incident and responded to the jail. See Officer K. Scott's additional for more information.

I later spoke to a witness of the phone, James 'Mike' Reno, and asked if he had witnessed the arrest that occurred across the street from him. He stated the following:

He saw two police cars parked down the street and saw two female officers (myself and Officer K. Scott) contacting a women he knows as "Lisa" in the backyard. He saw Lisa drive off and heard her screaming out the window. He said she sounded all emotional. He later saw Lisa come back in her car and saw my patrol SUV pull behind her and stop her by the fire hydrant at the corner. He could tell Lisa was upset and saw her get out of the car and start flailing her arms. He saw me grab Lisa's hair and saw us "wrestle" her to the ground because she did not want to get arrested. He could still hear Lisa yelling. He said again it sounded very emotional. He was not able to hear exactly what was being said and was standing in the front yard of 928 N Perry, which was directly across the street to the south from 1002 N South Riverton.

On 8/6/15 at approximately 1620 hours, I responded to assist Ofc. Kester with a DVOPV- Exclusion call at 1002 N. South Riverton Ave. Police records was asking that police go serve Lisa M. Dobler with an order. The risk factors were that Lisa would be angry.

The order is a temporary order for protection and notice of hearing. The order was filed July 29, 2015 (#152030-7). It lists the petitioner as #1a #1d, and the responded as Lisa M. Dobler (12/8/77). The order also protects the minors, #2d (1 year) and #2d #2d (10 months). The order stated Lisa is to have no contact whatsoever with #1a and restrains her from entering #1a residence #1d and must not come within 2 city blocks of the residence. The order states Lisa was only to take her personal clothing items. The order is valid once served until the court appearance on August 10, 2015.

I pulled up Lisa's SPRS photograph via my MDC prior to contact.

Upon arriving on scene, Ofc. Kester and I contacted the protected party of the order, #1a #1a at the front door. #1a allowed us inside to contact Lisa. As Lisa saw us come inside, she was immediately agitated by our presence. Ofc. Kester served her with the order at that time. See her report for additional information.

I briefly spoke with #1a who informed that she would be very "volatile" and mean.

Lisa was informed to gather a few belongings while we stood by, to include some clothing and her vehicle. During the several minutes inside, allowing Lisa to gather belongings, she was extremely verbally aggressive and abusive.

Lisa was yelling at us that we "are pigs!.. I fucking hate you guys!.. I'm gonna get you..." throughout the duration of the contact. She continually argued with us that we could not "harass" her, we can't take her children from her, etcetera.

Finally, Lisa got into her vehicle (AGM9950 WA), getting ready to leave. We advised her again that she was not allowed back at the property, or to come within 2 blocks of the address. As she was leaving she continued yelling at us, including "You're gonna get it!"

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Ofc. Kester and I stood by with #1a for a couple more minutes, and reiterated with him that Lisa was not allowed back within 2 blocks of the location, or to have any contact with him whatsoever, and he understood. The order was served at 1708 hours today.

Ofc. Kester and I got back into our vehicles, which were parked on the side of the street, on Cataldo, next to the neighboring house of 1002 N. South Riverton Ave. Within a couple minutes, Lisa drove past us in our patrol cars, looked over at me, and pulled up in front of the house. Ofc. Kester pulled up behind her, and activated her emergency lights to detain her.

Ofc. Kester and I approached the vehicle which Lisa was driving. She was refusing Ofc. Kester's commands to get out of the vehicle. I informed Lisa that she was under arrest at that time, and she got out of the vehicle. Ofc. Kester and I went to handcuff Lisa and we each took an arm of Lisa:

- At this point, Lisa had committed a misdemeanor crime of Domestic Violence Order of Protection Violation, a mandatory arrest in the state of Washington. She was also showing the pre-cursing actions/behaviors of resisting arrest, a potentially violent misdemeanor crime.

- Lisa has continued to yell at us, not complying with our commands. Once Ofc. Kester and I placed hands on each of her arms to place her into handcuffs, she immediately balled up her fists, tensed her arms and body, dropped her center of gravity into an athletic position, pushed her bodyweight against us when we attempted to move her up against the car. At this point, Lisa had not been searched for weapons.

- Lisa was attempting to get her arms away from us during this encounter, so that she would not be placed into handcuffs for her arrest.

Ofc. Kester and I attempted to use pain compliance on Lisa's wrists initially, but she continued to resist us, and attempt to pull away from us. Ofc. Kester used a modified hair take-down to get Lisa on the ground, while I used a modified arm bar take down, grabbing onto her left arm, and onto the back of her neck. Ofc. Kester and I were able to get Lisa onto the ground, onto her stomach. Lisa continued to attempt to pull her hands away from us and kept her fists balled up. I placed all of my body weight on top of Lisa, and was able to control her. At that point, Ofc. Kester and I placed Lisa into handcuffs (DL). I searched Lisa incident to arrest.

Lisa had a cut on her forehead from the gravel that was on the ground when she went down. Fire was called to check on her. They provided Lisa with medical attention, and they cleared her to go to jail.

Cpl. Bartlett arrived on scene and took photographs of Lisa, her cuts/scrapes to her forehead, and elbows. He also took photographs of me and my right knee, which was injured during the
