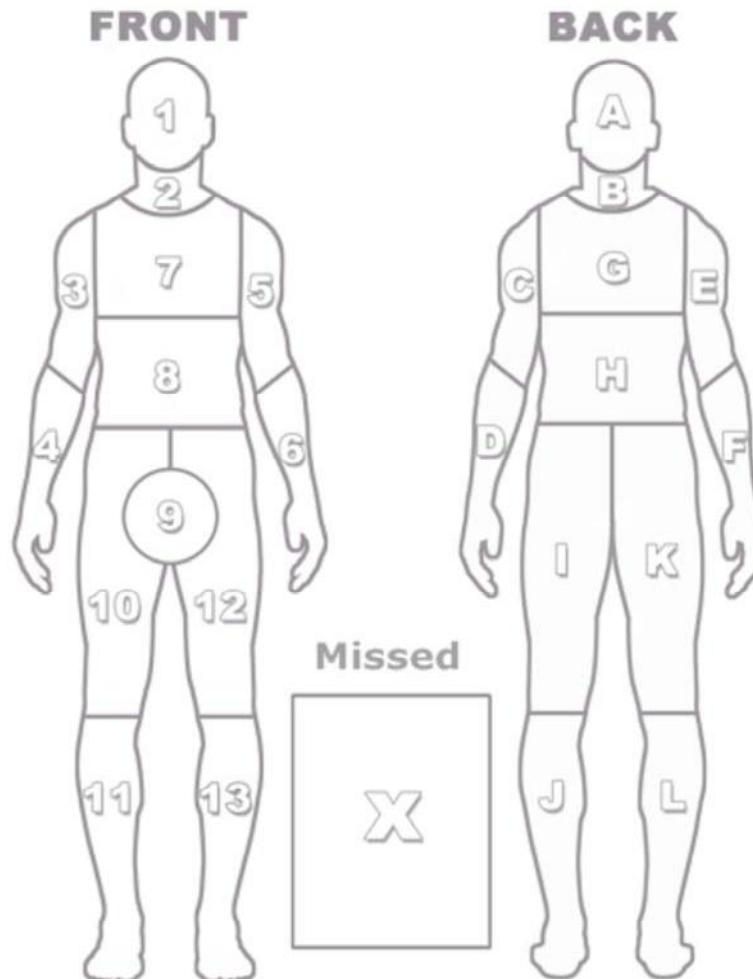

A citizen advised Officer Quarles of a burglary in progress at 215 W. Main. He called for help and approached the business. A suspect on the S/W corner of the business fence saw Officer Quarles and became confrontational. Officer Quarles drew his handgun and held it at the low-ready position to try and control the male. He then saw a second male inside the fenced area of the business. That male, Zaak Holder, would not show his hands and refused to obey commands given by Officer Quarles. Holder would show his hands, then pull them back down and put his right hand into his jacket pocket. Officer Quarles did not know if Holder was armed, and his refusal to obey commands put Officer Quarles in a dangerous situation. He pointed his handgun at Holder. He was able to get Holder into a prone position and handcuffed.

The business involved was downtown. There were many people walking in the area. Holder was inside a fenced area of the business that was closed. He refused to obey commands. That put Officer Quarles at risk. Pointing his handgun was a correct use of force to control a potentially dangerous situation. He was alone and trying to control two burglary suspects, not knowing if either was armed.

NARRATIVE

On 08/21/2015 at approx. 1212 hours I was on hot spot patrol in the area of Main and Wall, 200 W. Riverside. I pulled over to look at my computer and was contacted by a female who walked up to my patrol vehicle. She was identified as Krista N. Yep. She advised me she just witnessed two males breaking into the Riff bar, located at 215 W. Main.

I advised her to wait in the area and advised dispatch of my location and what I had. I also requested more officers to my location. I then approached the area and observed a white male wearing a bandana and no shirt. As I turned the corner, the male saw me. He immediately began yelling at me. He was talking very loud and stated something to the effect of "I'm not doing anything wrong Officer". At this time I had not seen the male on the other side of the fence. The male not wearing a shirt continued to yell at me. I believe he was doing this in an attempt to warn the other male.

I had my gun drawn at the low ready. I advised the male who was not wearing a shirt to keep his hands where could see them and to stay where he was.

I was looking at the fenced area when I observed another male heads just below the top of the fence. I stated "Police, show me your hands" He did not respond to my commands. I again advised him to show me his hands. He briefly placed his hands in the air and then put them back down. I

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then observed him place his right hand in his jacket pocket.

The fence was a 5 ft. wooden fence. The area also had a roof on it and there were valuables and other locked containers within the area. It was clear to me this area was not open to the public and part of the business. Only to be accessed by entering the business, during business hours, from the front door of the business. There was a gate to this area, however, the gate had a padlock on it and it was closed. This area was an extension of the business and clearly not open to the public. It was closed off outdoor patio area for patrons of the business.

At this point I was investigating a burglary in progress. I knew the male was inside a closed business and he was not following commands. Burglary is a Class A felony. It has been my experience that people who are willing to commit burglaries are usually also committing other crimes.

He was also in the process of committing a burglary in middle of the day in downtown Spokane where it is busy. This type of behavior leads me to believe he did not have respect for authority and could be dangerous. He was also not following my verbal commands to show me his hands. He reached also reached for a pocket where weapons are often concealed. Due to the male not following my verbal commands and reaching to his pockets, I pointed my side arm at the male through the fence.

He continued to move his hands up and down. I was concerned for my safety due to the possibility of the male having a weapon. I backed up to the northwest corner of the building to take a position of cover in the event the male had a gun. I kept him at gun point and advised dispatch I had 2 males at gun point. At one point the male climbed over the fence. I advised him to lay down on the ground and placed him in the prone cuffing position. I held my position until Officer R. VanTassel arrived. Officer R. VanTassel and his reserve placed him in handcuffs. He was later identified as Zakk M. Holder.

I then walked up to the other male and placed him in handcuffs (DL). He was later identified as Kailer J. Carver.

Officer R. VanTassel interviewed both suspects. See his additional for further.

I re contacted the initial witness/complainant, Krista N. Yep. She stated the following about the incident. She was standing on the northside of Main in the W. 200 block. She normally parks her vehicle in parking lot just to the west of the Riff. She had her vehicle broken into recently, so she tries to be aware of what is going on in the parking lot. While she was standing across the street, she observed one male jump the back fence of the location and the other male was looking around. She then walked over to me and told me about the incident.

I was able to contact the owner of the business, Nicholas D. Squires. He stated he has never given

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anyone permission to be at or in his business when it is not open. He allowed me to look at the surveillance footage inside. While watching the video, I observed Zakk jump over the fence and begin looking around the area inside the fence. It appeared as though he was looking down. He then went out of view of the camera. When he came back into view, I was on-scene giving him verbal commands.

Both males were booked for 2nd Burglary. Officer R. VanTassel located stolen credit card on Zakk. He was also booked for PSP 2nd. See his addition and Officer J. Cedeno's report for further.

On 8/21/15 at 1214 hours, I assisted other officers at a burglary call at 215 W Main Ave.

Upon arrival, I contacted Marcus Brown who witnessed the incident happen and was across the street. Marcus said that he saw one male suspect hanging outside the fenced area holding a skateboard before the police arrived. Marcus said that this male was looking around to see if anyone was coming and was a "lookout". When the police arrived on scene, he saw another male with red hair inside the fenced area near the first male. He heard the officers giving both suspects verbal commands of "Show me your hands". Marcus said the officers used these commands "More times than I can count". Marcus said the suspects became argumentative when the officers were giving them verbal commands. Marcus said the officers had their firearms out but they were not raised. One of the suspects kept refusing to show the officers his hands and the officer raised his gun only once until the suspect complied. The officers finally got the suspects to comply and put them in handcuffs. Marcus said that the suspects were not compliant and that "there would not have been a need for as many officers if the suspects just listened to the officers commands". Marcus believes that the officers were justified in everything they did because "I couldn't see his hands and I am sure the officer could not either".

On 082115 at approx. 1212 hrs. I responded to 215 W main (Riff Bar), City of Spokane, Spokane WA, to assist Ofc. Quarles with suspects burglarizing the bar.

When I arrived I located a witness to the incident, **#1a**. **#1a** said he and a friend were walking to lunch in the area of the bar and saw a two white males who appeared to be casing the bar. **#1a** said the male in a red bandana appeared to be the lookout for the other male he was with in a brown sweatshirt. Both males were looking into the covered and fenced patio area of the bar on the west side of the building. **#1a** said the male in the sweatshirt climbed over the cement blocks and fence and into the patio area. The red bandana suspect stayed outside and was looking around frantically.

#14 friend contacted Quarels and told him about the suspects. When Quarels contacted the bandana suspect, the suspect became loud and belligerent. **#14** said the suspect started cussing, "...Fuck you..." repeatedly at Quarels then at his friend.

#14 told me Quarles ordered the sweatshirt male numerous times to show him his hands but the suspect refused to comply. The bandana male tried to distract Quarles while Quarles was engaging the male inside the fenced area. **#14** said the sweatshirt male (in the fenced area) would not take his hands out of his pockets as far as he could tell.

At this point a male and female approached me with a medical emergency so I was unable to continue my contact with Sean.
