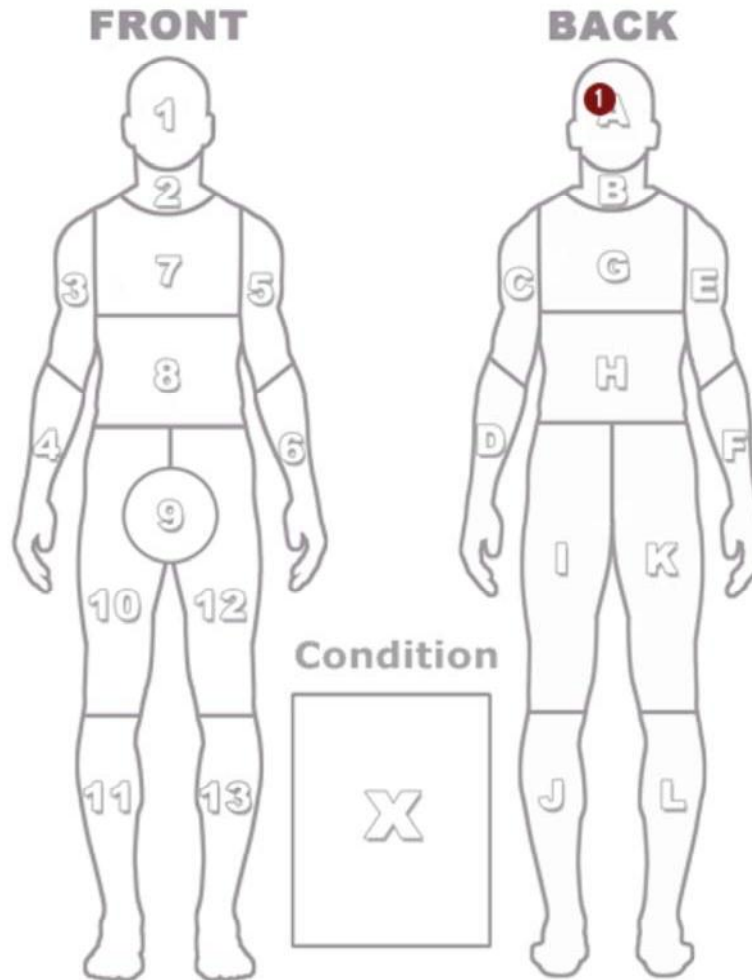

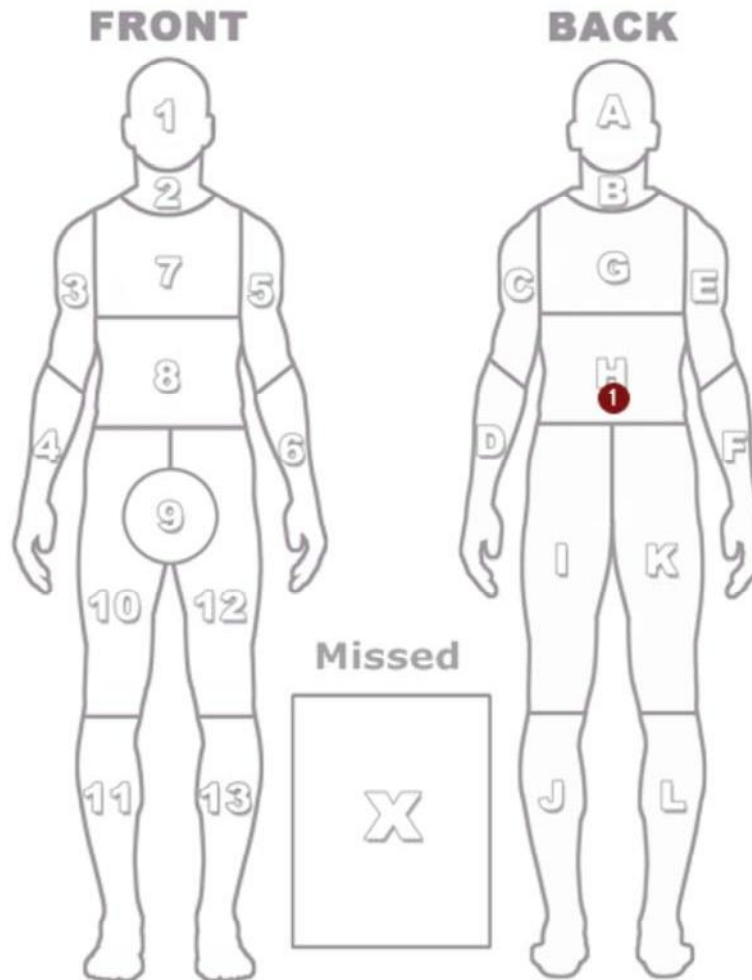

Susan Obrien of Municipal Court saw Paul J Reinhardt climb above the front doors of the Public Safety Building and break a glass out to gain entry. She was terrified. Reinhardt then broke out a window of a door by SCSO Civil Division. He was then in the secured area of the PSB and was a danger to officers, deputies, and all the Records personnel. Reinhardt went to the SCSO Detectives area and climbed into the ceiling. He fell through the ceiling and hit a desk before falling to the floor.

When officers went hands-on to arrest Reinhardt he violently resisted. He refused to show his hands. Officers did not know if he had the bar he used to break the windows out or another weapon. His left hand was under him by his waistline. Reinhardt tried kicking Officer Lyons and officers were struggling to control his arms. He was also showing possible signs of excited delirium

Officer Lyons deployed his taser and applied a drive stun to Reinhardt's lower back. When he did officers were able to get control of Reinhardt's arms and handcuff him. Officer Lyons was justified using a drive stun to help get control of Reinhardt.



On 08/22/2015 at approximately 1324 hours, I was contacted by James Triplet in front of the jail at 1100 W. Mallon in Spokane, WA. Triplet advised he was a Judge for the County of Spokane and was confronted by a male subject, later identified as Paul J. Reinhardt, in the secured area of the parking lot. Triplet stated the Reinhardt left his truck blocking the road on Mallon near the gate and was running east bound. I observed a male with a red shirt run east bound towards the Public Safety Building (PSB).

Triplet informed me Reinhardt had driven up to the barriers on Jefferson Street and asked him, "Am I in trouble?" Not knowing who Reinhardt was, Triplet ignored him. Reinhardt then drove his truck around the cement barriers, onto the grass and over the sidewalk, entering the secured area of the PSB parking lot. Reinhardt pulled his truck alongside Triplet's vehicle and asked, "Why am I in trouble?" Triplet told Reinhardt to "Get out of here." Triplet observed Reinhardt turn westbound onto Mallon and park his truck in the middle of the road, blocking any vehicles from entering or exiting the secured parking lot. Triplet observed Reinhardt exit the truck and run east bound between the PSB and the Jail Annex.

Deputy Audie, who also heard Triplet's information, advised communications of the situation. Along with Deputy Audie and other responding Spokane Police units, I assisted in searching the area for Reinhardt. Communications advised a complainant, Susan Obrien, who works in the Municipal Court building, was reporting a male with a red shirt and blue jeans was on top of the main entrance to the PSB and had what appeared to be some type of crowbar in his hands. Obrien advised the male subject had broken the glass door and gained entry into the PSB, walking past the metal detectors. Obrien was hiding under a desk at this point.

Upon walking to the main entrance of the PSB south doors, I observed shattered glass on the ground. I entered the PSB with other responding officers and unholstered my firearm for safety purposes. The glass door leading into the Sheriff's Office wing was also shattered. I advanced down the hallway towards the east side of the building. I observed the ceiling of the Detective Division had collapsed. I could hear movement in the ceiling. Following the sounds, I observed the ceiling tiles flex as the subject was moving above. Suspecting the male subject was Paul Reinhardt, I, along with other officers, began giving orders for "Paul" to come out from the ceiling. The male subject fell through the ceiling, hitting a desk before landing on the ground.

I immediately gave commands for the male, who was Reinhardt, to show me his hands. Reinhardt was yelling, "Please don't kill me," as I began to move closer to place him into handcuffs. I assisted other officers in an attempt to control Reinhardt's hands. As I grabbed Reinhardt's left arm, he violently pulled his arm back, tucking it under his chest. Not knowing if Reinhardt was possibly reaching for a weapon or the said crowbar, I gave verbal commands for him to remove his arm. Reinhardt did not comply, so I began giving him knee strikes to his ribs and arm until I was able to free his left arm.

After Reinhardt was placed into handcuffs and frisked for weapons, he was moved to an open area so responding paramedics could evaluate him for injuries. I observed blood on the ground where Reinhardt had fallen through the ceiling and also blood on the ground where he laid waiting for medical attention. Paramedics treated any cuts Reinhardt sustained and cleared him of any injuries, giving the "ok" for him to be booked into jail.

Reinhardt did not speak nor did he make any comments. I escorted Reinhardt to the jail where he was booked for burglary 2nd degree.

I returned to the PSB and took photographs of the scene. Deputy Audie recovered a torque wrench, which was the tool used to gain access into the building. I completed a probable cause affidavit and also placed the tool into property as evidence.

Based upon the information I received, I believe probable cause exists to charge Paul J. Reinhardt with:

On 08/22/15 at about 1330 hours, Myself and Deputy Nguyen were completing a booking and sitting in my patrol car outside on the west side of the jail. A vehicle quickly pulled up to the front of the patrol car and Judge James Triplet exited the drivers side. Judge triplet explained a truck had driven around the barriers and was blocking his exit from the courthouse grounds. Judge Triplett explained the male said something about not being in trouble and ran towards the court house holding a long steel rod. Triplett described the male as white with a red T-shirt and jeans. (See Deputy Nguyen's arrest report for more details)

We located the truck which was registered to Paul J. Reinhardt DOB 08/10/68. It was blocking the exit. We walked to the E. side of the Court House looking for the male. While we were looking for the male the city was receiving multiple break alarms to the Court House itself. We did not know about this due to we were on the wrong channel.

I observed two City Officers running toward the S. entrance of the building. As I arrived there I could see Glass on the ground inside the foyer area. On closer examination it appeared the male had climbed on top on the glass entry way and broke the glass ceiling making entry into the Court House itself.

We also were receiving information from Mardee K. Ellis (records division) that she was inside the building and saw the male break in. She described the male as White, red T-shirt and holding a long silver rod. Ellis advised she and two other County Employees were hiding under their desks in records.

Myself, Deputy Nguyen and several City Police Officers made entry into the building and started searching for the male. We could hear noises coming from the S/W corner of the building in the Sex Crimes offices. Once in the area I could see that the ceiling had been torn down and ceiling tile was over desks and on the floor. It was obvious the male had attempted to hide himself in the ceiling. I could hear him moving around up there and followed the noises into the Detectives area.

At one point I could actually see the ceiling moving down where he was stepping. We started giving the male verbal commands to come down from the ceiling. Eventually he walked to the S. side of the room where he fell through the ceiling on to the floor. I did have my service weapon out

at this time pointing it at the male as he fell.

A city officer utilized his tazer causing the male to fall to a prone position on the floor where myself, Deputy Nguyen and another City officer took him into custody.

On 082215, I responded to 1100 W. Mallon (Municipal Court Building), reference a suspicious person. Dispatch advised that 911 received a call that a male was outside climbing on top of the door. The suspect has an object in his hand that was possibly a crowbar. They described the suspect as a white male, 5-10 to 6-00, thin, wearing an orange shirt and blue jeans. They also advised that it is the main doors into the public safety building.

Enroute to the call, they advised that there was a Toyota truck parked in front of the courthouse that belonged to Paul Reinhardt. I immediately recognized the name Paul Reinhardt as a ROP in our computer system and as a violent offender. We had contact with him about two weeks ago where he was involved in a hit and run DUI collision, ran from the collision with channel locks and broke out a window at Global Credit Union. He was contacted by Officers in the area of 3rd and Adams, and refused to drop the channel locks and had to be tased to control him from assaulting Officer's. He was intoxicated on a narcotic at that time and was uncooperative.

I contacted other Officer's at the south side of the public safety building, near the glass doors. I observed fresh damage to top of the glass window that leads into the atrium. There was broken glass inside the atrium and one of the inside door windows leading into the public safety building was freshly shattered. A glass trail was throughout the building and I observed a broken window into the Sheriff's side of the public safety building, that leads towards records. It should be noted that several female civilian employees were working in the building at the time and I was concerned for their safety. They then advised that records employees heard yelling in the hallway. I made my way through the hallways past the Chief's conference room and down towards volunteer services. I heard several Officer's advise that the suspect was on the County's side of the public safety building.

When I got to Spokane County Sheriff's Department side of the building, I immediately recognized fresh damage to the tile ceiling. There was a square tile removed from the detectives area and the tile was sitting on top of a secretary's desk. The metal frame that holds the tile in place was bent and appeared that someone had climbed up into the rafters of the ceiling. There was also fresh damage to other tiles in the ceiling that appeared to be from someone stepping through the tiles.

At this time, the suspect had committed 2nd degree burglary and felony malicious mischief and possibly theft from several offices in the public safety building. He posed an immediate threat to Officer's, Deputy's and civilian staff in the public safety building based on not knowing if the suspect

was armed and where he was in the ceiling of the building. He was also actively resisting arrest and was attempting to evade arrest by getting into the rafters of the ceiling.

We started to clear the Detectives area on the southwest of the building. As I was clearing the cubicles I heard a noise up in the ceiling. The noise was consistent with someone walking across the metal of the tiles over a Detectives desk. I advised Paul to "get out from the roof." I advised other Officer's of his location. He immediately fell through the ceiling tile directly in front of a Detectives desk. He appeared to be trying to hold onto the rafters as he fell through. Several Officer's were giving commands to get on the ground. He fell to a fetal position onto his left side with his hands balled up towards his chest and his knees were up towards his chest. I observed nothing in his hands and took right arm control. His arm was tense and he refused to pull it away from his body. I told him to roll over and to remove his left hand from under his body. As I rolled Paul over onto his stomach he refused to remove his left hand that was now down by his waistband, where it is a common place for suspects to carry weapons. His shirt was covering his waistband and I was unable to see his left hand. I placed my shin across the upper part of his shoulders to control his upper body and placed his right hand behind his back, maintaining control to allow other Officer's to handcuff him. His body was tense the entire time and was yelling "Don't kill me." I advised him that he was under arrest and he continued to yell for us not to kill him. Once he had handcuffs on, he started to calm down and was breathing very heavy. I asked for someone to start medical attention. We attempted to walk Paul out to the west doors for medics to evaluate him, but he refused to cooperate and would not stand up. We then placed him back down onto the floor and put him on his side and waited for Spokane Fire Department to arrive on scene.

I assisted in checking around the public safety building, to see if anything else was damage or for any victims that were not contacted.

On 082215 at approximately 1330 hours, I responded to the Public Safety Building, 1100 W. Mallon regarding a male climbing on top of the front door with a crow bar.

As I responded, Officer's located the suspects vehicle west of the Public Safety Building and Radio advised it was registered to Paul Reinhardt.

It should be noted that approximately 2 weeks earlier I arrested Paul after he ran from a head on collision on the Maple street bridge, broke a window, and then confronted officers with a pair of large metal channel lock's. In that incident Paul had to be tasered to get him to drop the weapon. Paul was extremely high in that incident.

Upon arrival we were advised that Paul had gained entry to the building and was near the municipal court. I approached the front doors (south side) of the Public Safety Building and could see that the inner door of the public entrance was shattered, but the outer door was still intact. I could also see that the glass above the area between the inner and outer entrance doors was broken. I entered the Public Safety Building and began to move towards the Municipal Court, which is on the east side of the building. At that point Radio advised that a Records Clerk had called and that Paul had gained entry to the secure law enforcement portion of the building. We moved to the door that led to the secure law enforcement portion of the building and could see that the glass had been broken out. We began to clear the building and were advised that Paul could be heard in the Spokane County Sheriffs Detectives office's.

We moved to the Sheriff's office's, which is the south west corner of the building. We began to clear the office's and Ofc. Heuett advised that he could hear movement in the ceiling above a desk. We set up, Ofc. Heuett with lethal cover, and me with less lethal, my issued Taser X26P and gave Paul orders to come down from the ceiling. I could see movement and then Paul fell through the ceiling landing on a desk and then falling to the ground. Paul appeared to have fallen through the ceiling tiles, not come down to give up. It should be noted that I was wearing my duty uniform. When Paul fell, I recognized him from my prior contact. We ordered Paul to stay on the floor and moved in on him. I continued to cover Paul with my Taser until Ofc. Heuett took control of one of Paul's arms. Paul ignored commands to roll onto his stomach and was screaming. I took a hold of Paul's right leg and tried to pull him into the prone handcuffing position. Paul attempted to kick my hand with his left leg. I re-acquired my grip on Paul's leg and then trapped his legs under my knees. Officer's struggled

to control Paul's arms, I could see Paul's fists clenching and could see that his arms were tensed. Due to how close I was to Paul, and the proximity of other Officer's I chose not to deploy my Taser in probe mode.

At this point we had probable cause to arrest Paul for 2nd degree burglary (breaking into the Police station), the initial complainant advised that Paul was armed with a crow bar and had not yet been searched, in a prior contact Paul was armed with a large metal tool and fought with Police, and Paul was un-cooperative and struggled with Police. Paul was also exhibiting the signs of excited delirium and we needed to control Paul as soon as possible for his safety.

I removed my Taser cartridge, and applied a 5 second drive stun application to Paul's lower back. The drive stun application was successful and Officer's were able to control Paul's arms. I placed Paul into handcuffs and told him that he was under arrest. I searched Paul incident to arrest. I could see that Paul was bleeding from the head and covered in dirt.

We decided to put one leg restraint on Paul so that we could control his legs if he started to fight again. I placed my leg restraint on one of Paul's legs.

Officer's stood Paul up and started to walk him out. Paul was still screaming not to kill him. Paul began to struggle and Officer's advised that we needed to place Paul into leg restraints. Officer's placed Paul back onto the ground and I placed Paul into leg restraints.

We decided to leave Paul in place until medics arrived.

I checked Paul's lower back and could see red marks in the approximate area I deployed the drive stun. Cpl. Dahle took photographs of Paul's lower back and the red mark.

Sgt. Huddle and I downloaded my X26P Taser, serial # X12000N85. The Taser report showed that on 082215 at 1340:29 there was 1, 5 second trigger event.

I arrived and approached from the south, where the doors to the Public Safety building are located for the public. I observed shattered glass in the entry of the first set of doors. The glass had been broken from the top glass pane and entry gained.

Officers went inside and started a search of the building. I noticed the broken SCSO glass door which again would have allowed entry.

Officers continued with the search and I held a perimeter spot on the hallway.

The suspect was located in the back offices of the PSB in the SCSO area. See officers reports.
