Incident Summary

Officers responded to assist Fire who was out on a medics call treating dog bit victims. There were 3 pitbulls running around and they had bit several pit. The dogs were also being aggressive towards Fire personnel. Officers arrived and were in the street in front of the home where the dogs lived at 2924 W. Beacon. While in the street the male pitbull charged out of the yard into the street towards the officers in an aggressive attack mode. Officer Bode fired 2 rounds from his .223 at the dog killing it in the street.

I responded to the scene. Asst. Fire Chief Brian Schaeffer told me the officers acted appropriately. He said the dogs were attacking them and the dog then charged at officers.

Officer Bode told me he waited for the dog to get into the street before firing downward as to avoiding shooting towards houses.

Officer Bode's shots were on target and the dog was killed.

The other 2 dogs were a female and a pup. The dogs had broken through the fence at their house to get out. The owner arrived and was contacted by SCRAPS as they took over the investigation of the dog bites. The shooting of the dog was justified.

On 100815, I was riding in a two officer training car with Officer Valencia.

We heard on the radio that Fire-1 (SFD Chief) was on-scene at the report of a dog bite. He requested PD assistance because the three pitbulls had returned to the scene and were trying to bite firemen.

I observed a large group of people outside at a school 2 blocks to the east of the location. I was concerned the dogs could get over to the large group and injure more people.

When I arrived on-scene, I met up with Officer C. Lesser who had already arrived. Fire advised the dogs had ran off to the north prior to our arrival. Fire-1 said one victim had already been transported to the hospital and they were on-scene across the street with a second bite victim.

I deployed my SWAT rifle because it has superior accuracy to my handgun and it has an EoTech aiming sight making shots on moving targets easier.

Two of the dogs returned to the location and ran into the landscaping at 2924 W Beacon. Officer C. Lesser, Officer Valencia and I took up a position in the street between the dogs and fire personnel. We were waiting for SCRAPS to arrive to contain the dogs when the large grey colored pitbull charged unprovoked from the bushes directly at me and Officer Lesser.

The dog had barked and growled, it was charging with its teeth barred and back hair raised. It had already bit several people in the neighborhood. The dog got to approximately 5 feet (I had to wait before firing to get a downward trajectory). I fired one round from my rifle into the dogs upper chest

cavity on the left side at a downward angle. The dog fell immediately and was loosing a large amount of blood from the wound. I waited a few moments to assess the effectiveness of the round. The dog tried to get to its feet and I fired another into its body cavity. It ceased moving.

The second tan pitbull ran and tried to get back into the fenced area of its yard. It did not act aggressively during this incident. While we were guarding the firemen, a pitbull puppy ran from the backyard. I caught the puppy and secured it in the back of a police car.

The owner, Freddie, returned home and I gave the puppy back to him.

Lt Arnzen was briefed on incident.

Corporal Dahle took photos of the scene.

SCRAPS responded and took over the investigation. Reference their case number 2015-15210.

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On 10/8/2015 at approximately 1722 hours, I was in the area of W Francis/N Alberta St when I heard FD1 (SFD Chief) get on city radio channel 1 and ask for assistance. FD1 stated they were out with a dog bite victim, and that there was several pit bulls running around the area uncontrolled. FD1 stated they were being attacked by the dogs, and that they could not fend them off.

I arrived on scene and grabbed my patrol rifle. I spoke with several of the fireman outside who told me that there was at least 2 victims enroute to the hospital with serious dog bite injuries. I updated dispatch with injuries and confirmed that SCRAPS was enroute. Several residents stated the dogs belonged to 2924 W Beacon Ave.

Ofc Bode and Ofc Valencia arrived on scene. Ofc Bode and myself began to check the area to the north for the loose pit bulls. As we were walking north, the dogs returned and began circling around the firemen who were outside. Myself and Ofc Bode stood in the middle of the street and put ourselves between the pit bulls and firemen/citizens.

Two large adult pit bulls began circling the front yard area of 2924 W Beacon Ave. Myself and Ofc Bode attempted to contain both dogs in the yard until SCRAPS arrived and took control.

Without warning, the large dark colored pit bull began to charge in a very aggressive manner toward myself and Ofc Bode. By the time myself and Ofc Bode were able to react, the pit bulls was approximately 5ft from our location. The hair on the dogs back was sticking straight up, he was snarling, and showing his teeth. The dog was clearly focused on myself and Ofc Bode. I was in fear that the large pit bulls was going to bite innocent citizens, Ofc Bode, or myself. There was also a school in close proximity which had several hundred kids outside.

With the serious injuries the aggressive pit bulls had caused today, and the way he was charging at us, it was clear he was going to continue to be aggressive and attack innocent people until he was stopped. At this point, Ofc Bode decided to use force and fired two rounds from his department issued rifle. See Ofc Bode's report for additional details.

When both rounds were fired, I did not observe any rounds exit the aggressive pit bulls. It appeared as if both rounds stayed inside the dog. Ofc Valencia immediately began checking nearby houses/residents to insure nobody was harmed.

On 10/08/15 at approx. 1728 hours, I was dispatched to 2921 W Beacon Av on a animal problem call. The call involved 3 pitbull dogs attacking multiple people. I was advised that fire were on scene and were being attacked by the dogs.

Upon arriving on scene, fire advised us that the dogs left the area north bound after they attacked two males. Officer Bode, Officer Lesser, and I went north looking for the dogs. As we were about 100 meters from where fire personnel were, I heard them yelling "the dogs are back." We immediately went back and saw two pitbull dogs running around the street and then going to the west side of 2924 W Beacon Ave. Officer Bode, Officer Lesser and I positioned ourselves between fire personnel and the dogs. We were standing on the middle of the street when one of the dogs (dark in color) charged at us. I observed the dog's ears pointing forward, the neck hairs were raised,

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the dog was showing the teeth, had the tail raised and was growling at us. As the dog charged at us and was approx. 5 feet away from us, Officer Bode used deadly force to prevent the dog from attacking us. See Officer Bode and Officer Lesser reports for more details.

A second dog approached us but did not show any signs of aggression towards us. After a couple of seconds around us, the second dog went to the back of 2924 W Beacon and did not came back.

Fire Chief Brian P. Schaeffer and fireman Nathan C. Powell told me that they observed the dog charging at us. The also informed me that it was the same dog that attacked them before.

Ann M. Pullaim came to the location with two of her kids, James R. Pullaim (12) and Kallen L. Pullaim (5), who were attacked by the same dog couple of minutes prior. Kallen had a small bruise behind his right ear and James had bite marks on his lower and upper right leg.

James L. Randal informed me that he, as well as his neighbor Ron Thaxton, were also attacked by the same dog. Ron was already at the hospital with bites on his right or left arm and James had bite marks on his left forearm and middle left lower back.

I went to 2930, 3006, and 3010 W Beacon to make sure no one was injured. All residents were safe and there were no damages to the houses.

A supervisor and a Cpl. were requested to the location as well as SCRAPS personnel.
