Incident Summary

This occurred in a large apartment complex while Ofc. Kirby was present for an unrelated call. A family fight broke out in an adjacent building. Kirby simultaneously heard sounds of an argument and units being dispatched to it.

Kirby excused himself from the original call and went outside to investigate. He saw the door to apt. 42 open, several people inside and heard continued yelling in a foreign language. While waiting for backup, a male, #1a, ran outside and yelled that someone armed with a knife was threatening to stab someone. Seconds later another male, Omar Ado, exited the apartment and began chasing #1a while yelling that he was going to kill #1a. Kirby grabbed Omar and held Omar's hands behind his back. Just as quickly, a third male, Mahdi Ado, ran up and tried pulling Omar away from Ofc. Kirby.

Mahdi ignored several commands to let go and step back. Ofc. Kirby then attempted to handcuff Omar in order to focus his attention on Mahdi. Mahdi reached around and slapped Ofc. Kirby's hand and the handcuffs away.

Simultaneously, two more males exited the apartment and began yelling in a foreign language that was unfamiliar to Ofc. Kirby. Kirby was unsure if these men were telling the combatants to calm down or urging them on.

Kirby then administered a one-second burst of pepper spray in Mahdi's face to stop the aggression and take control of the situation. Mahdi quickly stopped his actions and removed himself from the situation.

Additional officers arrived and controlled the overall situation which resulted in multiple arrests for DV assault. Mahdi refused all offers of medical aid. He was arrested for Obstructing.

I was present shortly after the pepper spray was administered. There was a large number of people inside the apartment and numerous neighbors had come outside. Many were yelling; only a few using English. Mahdi and two other males were sitting on the ground as directed by other officers. In broken English, Mahdi said he face burned but he did not want medical help.

Other than handcuffing, no other force was used by officers.

Ofc. Kirby does not have a body camera.

This use of force with pepper spray was justified and within our policy.

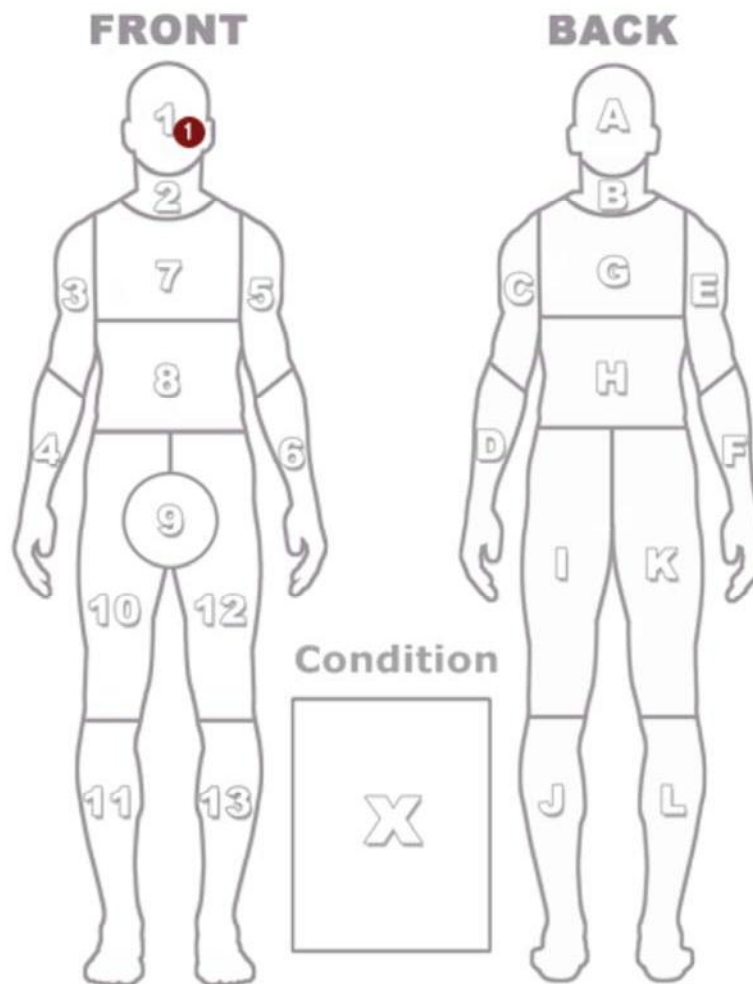

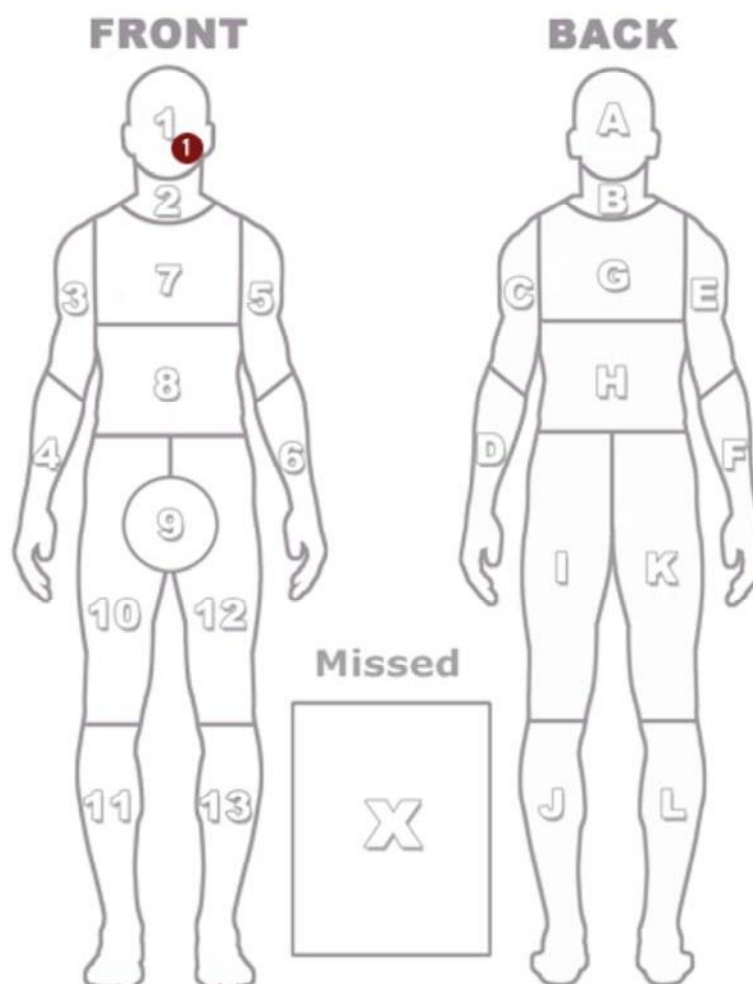

It was clear from the call and Officer Kirby's request for more officers that it was a chaotic and dangerous situation. Officers were also advised somebody was armed with a knife. I find that Officer Kirby followed proper training and SPD policy with his use of pepper spray to control the suspect and eventually detain him while he was clearly outnumbered. The photos taken at the scene were related to the DV incident.

On 11-11-15 at about 2250 hours, I was at 4102 N Regal for a child sexual assault investigation. While at the location, I could hear a lot of yelling outside of the apartment building that I was in. It was not related to the investigation I was working on. After a few minutes, dispatch sent 2 officers to the location #47 for a possible fight between brothers. As I was at the location, I went outside to see what was going on.

I knew that the target apartment was in the building to my east. When I went outside, I could see that the door was open and could hear yelling. The yelling was not in English. I also determined that there were several people inside the apartment. I estimated there was over 6 people inside so I waited outside about 30 yards away in the parking lot for the other officers.

While I waited, a male ran outside and saw me. He ran over to me in the parking lot yelling something about a knife. He told me that someone was going to get stabbed. I told him to wait with me, there was more help on the way. That male was later identified as **#1a**. He was with me for a few seconds before another male ran out to us. **#1a** was afraid of this male who was later

identified as Omar Ado. Omar began chasing after #1a and they were running circles around me. Omar was yelling at #1a that he was going to kill him.

I grabbed Omar and placed his hands behind his back. He was somewhat compliant. He was pulling away but not hard enough that I believed he was trying to get away. He did let me put his hands together and I was able to hold onto the fingers of both hands with my left hand. He continued to try and turn but just to yell at #1a.

At about that time, a 3rd male ran up to us. He was later identified as Mahdi Ado. Mahdi grabbed Omar by the head and began pulling him away from me. Mahdi was yelling you are not going to take my brother. Mahdi was pulling on Omar harder than Omar himself was trying to pull away. We had a brief tug-of-war with Omar. I had his hands and Mahdi had his head. I told Mahdi several times to let go and step back. He continued to pull on Omar. I attempted to put handcuffs on Omar to control him so I could then work to control Mahdi. When I put the handcuffs to Omar's wrist, Mahdi reached over the top of Omar as he had been pulling his head forward and slapped my hand with the handcuffs away.

At least 2 more males had come out of the apartment at that time. They were watching but not getting involved other than yelling. I had no idea what they were yelling as it was not in English. They could have been telling everyone to calm down or enticing them to continue.

At that point I determined the best way to control Mahdi was with pepper spray. I sprayed him in the face with a short 1 second burst. He let go of Omar's head and ran off. The pepper spray was a reasonable and necessary use of force to stop Mahdi's actions and control the situation.

I was then able to place Omar in handcuffs. Omar calmed down and I was able to get him to sit on the curb outside. A short time later, several officers arrived and we were able to take control of the situation as there were still more people yelling inside the apartment.

Officer Yinger was able to locate Mahdi inside the apartment. I advised that there was PC to arrest Mahdi for obstructing an officer. Mahdi was arrested and secured in a patrol car.

I then spoke with Omar about what had occurred. Omar told me that he lives in #47 with several family members. He stated several times that they are all Muslim. Omar told me that he was very upset with how his sister, #1a, had dressed today. Omar explained that he had been yelling at his sister and that his brother was also upset with her. Omar denied that there was any physical fighting with anyone.

Officer Bode spoke with #1a who stated that Omar had hit her in the face during the argument. Officer Bode observed injury to #1a face consistent with her statements. She denied that anyone had threatened her with a knife.

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Officer Ames spoke with a witness, Emir Ado who told him that Omar had a knife during the argument. He reported that Omar had threatened to kill #1a if she continued to dress like she did today. He chased after her with the knife and stabbed the wall a few times.

Inside the apartment, Officers located a large kitchen knife. The knife was collected as evidence and placed on SPD property. Photographs were taken of the knife impacts to the wall.

Officer Brown-Bieber developed PC to arrest Ayad Ado for assaulting his brother #1a. See Officer Brown-Bieber's additional report.

#1a had told me when he first ran out to me that someone had a knife inside the apartment and was going to stab someone. He later recanted that statement when talking to Officer Brown-Bieber.

I determined there was PC to arrest Omar for assault 2nd DV. He was arrested and booked into the Spokane County Jail.

On 111115, I responded to Officer Kirby's request to step it up (officer needs assistance) for a fight at 4102 N Regal #47.

When I arrived on-scene, several officers were in the courtyard with several involved people. I entered the house because it had not been cleared for potential victims. I assisted Officer Ames and Sgt Meyer with clearing the apartment.

I made contact with a B/F in her late 50's but she did not speak English. I contacted **#1a** who told me she had been fighting with her brothers.

I observed redness to **#1a** eyes and a red mark on her right cheek. She said her eyes were red because she had been crying. She told me that earlier today around 4:30pm, she was at her families apartment at 4102 N Regal #47. Her brother Omar was yelling at her in the living room about how she was dressed. He thought she should have more clothes on. When she refused to put more clothes on, Omar hit her on the right side of her face. **#1a** was unable to tell me if it was a slap or a closed fist punch that Omar hit her with. I asked her if the mark on her cheek was caused by Omar and she said she didn't know. She said her family tried to de-escalate the situation and

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took #1a to her aunts house. Later at an unknown time, they returned to the house and Omar was gone. On 11-11-15 at 2258 hrs, Ofc Ames and I (two officer unit) responded with other officers to 4102 N Regal #47 to assist Ofc Kirby on a DV call. A male caller said brothers were fighting. There was lots of yelling and screaming in the background and people were saying "help me". There were other people from the apartment complex reporting people fighting and a male armed with a knife. Ofc Kirby was taking a report at another apartment nearby and responded. He requested immediate assistance. Ofc Kirby advised he was out with subjects fighting and one subject ran away after being pepper sprayed.

Upon arrival, Ofc Kirby had one male detained in handcuffs. He advised us and Sgt Wuthrich that the fighting had been in #47 and more subjects were inside the apartment. We needed to check the welfare of anyone inside.

More officers arrived and we went to #47. The front door was closed but we could hear subjects yelling inside. We knocked and the door was opened by a male. I heard him say everything was fine inside and it was just a family fight. There were at least 6-8 people inside. We called them out and three males came out and we had them sit down. Ofc Ames and other officers went inside and contacted the other subjects.

One of the males that came outside and sat down was very agitated and shouting. He said he had been fighting with his brother but it was okay and just a family matter. He said he had been pepper sprayed by the officer. He repeated that he just wanted his brother to come back inside the house. He said his brother Omar Ado was the person Ofc Kirby had in handcuffs. The male verbally identified himself as Mahdi S. Ado (041096). I saw his face was wet. He had tears coming out of his eyes and snot coming out of his nose. I asked him if he wanted medics and he said no. I told him the effects of the pepper spray would wear off in 20 minutes or so and the best thing for him was exposure to the fresh cold air outside.

Mahdi said some family members were fighting tonight. He then denied he had been fighting with his brother. He repeatedly said he needed his brother to be released by the police and to come back home. Mahdi would not tell me anything else about what had happened.

Ofc Kirby advised me there was PC to arrest Mahdi for at least Obstructing. Ofc Kirby advised that he had been trying to detain Omar in handcuffs and Mahdi physically interfered with him. Ofc Kirby pepper sprayed Mahdi to get him away. Officers Stone and Specht arrested Mahdi and placed him in handcuffs. After further investigation, Ofc Kirby also arrested Mahdi for City Assault DV.

Officers also arrested Omar for 2nd Assault DV and another brother for City Assault DV.

On 11/11/15 around 2258 hours Ofc. B. Yinger and I were working as a two-officer patrol unit, and dispatched to 4102 N. Regal #47 reference the report of a large fight occurring at the location. Ofc. A. Kirby had been the first officer to arrive on scene, and almost immediately he requested several more units for assistance.

Dispatch received numerous calls on the altercation, and it was reported that there was a subject involved who was armed with a large kitchen knife. Ofc. Kirby stated he had one subject detained on scene, and he pepper sprayed another subject who subsequently ran off.

Ofc. Yinger and I arrived on scene, and were tasked with making contact at the apartment. Ofc. Yinger and I knocked on the front door of the residence, and eventually had several male subjects exit the apartment and take a seat on the ground just outside the front door.

It appeared that there was a large family all living together at the residence, and almost all of them were involved in a large fight. It should be noted that very few of these subjects spoke much / any English, and were discovered to be originally from Libya.

I could see several females still inside the residence after these males were removed, and the females were all crying and looked very upset. I eventually entered the apartment with a few other officers to clear the apartment, and found three females and one other male inside.

I contacted the male, who spoke fairly decent English and was identified as Amir S. Ado (102597). Amir confirmed that he lives at the location with his entire family, which consists of his two parents, his four brothers, and his two sisters. Amir told me that the family is "Muslim," and the fight involved some family issues regarding their culture.

Amir said that earlier in the day around 1600 hours his brother Omer Ado, got extremely upset with his sister **#1a**. Amir explained that Omer was mad because **#1a** was wearing some

clothing, which was in-appropriate relating to their Muslim culture and offensive for the family.

Amir told me that Omer confronted #1a about her choice of clothing, and she basically advised him to mind his own business. Amir informed me that this caused Omer to become very angry, and Omer attempted to fight several people at the residence during the earlier confrontation.

Amir verified that nothing physical occurred during the first altercation, however Omer never calmed down and was still angry. Amir advised me that he sleeps upstairs at the residence, and in the same room with two of his other brothers who he identified as Ayad Ado and Mahdi Ado.

Amir stated that his sister #1a also sleeps upstairs, along with his parents. Amir claimed that almost all of his family was in bed upstairs inside the residence, and attempting to go to sleep. Amir confirmed that Omer was awake, and he was downstairs in the living room and still very angry about what #1a had been wearing.

Amir said that he was not sure if Omer was drinking alcohol, but he continued to be upset and out of control. Amir explained that around 2100 hours his brother Atif Ado arrived home from work, and Omer began telling #1a what #1a had been wearing and what occurred.

Amir advised me that Omer was able to convince #1a to also be angry with #1a, and then the two started screaming at #1a as they were downstairs. Amir told me that everyone in the family was just trying to ignore Omer and #1a but at some point they started walking up the stairs while threatening to kill #1a if she dressed that way again.

Amir informed me that as soon as Omer and #1a began walking up the stairs, he and his brothers Ayad and Mahdi got out of bed and stopped them from coming up any further. Amir said the brothers were all yelling for Omer and #1a to be quiet, and just go back downstairs.

Amir explained that Omer and #1a refused to calm down and go back downstairs, and began trying to fight with all of the brothers. Amir stated his mother eventually came out of her bedroom and told Omer and Atif to stop, however they were disrespectful to their mother as well.

Amir told me #1a also came out into the hallway, and the altercation escalated to a large altercation. Amir was telling me that all of the brothers were fighting, but he was having a hard time verifying all of the specifics of the fight where all the brothers were involved.

Amir vaguely described a large argument, which lead into some pushing and some punching occurring between the brothers. Amir said #1a was also briefly involved, until #1a started throwing items from the living room towards all of them on the stairwell.

Amir then advised me that at some point during the altercation Omer went downstairs, and apparently secured a large butcher knife from the kitchen. Amir stated everyone quickly retreated upstairs when Omer approached with the large knife, and as he was walking up the stairs he began repeating his threats towards #1a.

Amir confirmed Omer was threatening to kill #1a as he was walking up the stairs holding the knife, and saying if she wore the in-appropriate clothing once again he would kill her. Amir verified Omer was also stabbing the knife into the dry wall on the stairwell while threatening #1a and telling all of the brothers he was not scared of them.

Amir explained that this is when he became concerned, and called 911 on his cell phone. Amir said #1a also got on her phone, and called an uncle identified as "Sheikh-Den" who lives in a different apartment in the complex for help. Amir told me this uncle immediately rushed over to their

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apartment, and removed Omer and #1a

Amir claimed that the uncle then locked Omer and #1a out of the apartment, and this was about the same time Police arrived on scene. I then observed fresh knife marks in the dry wall on the walls of the stairwell, and other officers on scene advised me they found the knife somewhere downstairs with dry wall residue on it.

Ofc. Kirby had detained Omer when he arrived on scene, and I went outside to contact all of the other officers who interviewed people regarding the incident. It was then determined there was probable cause to arrest / charge Omer for Assault 2nd Degree DV, and Sgt. E. Wuthrich was advised of the situation / incident.

Ofc. Kirby transported / booked Omer into jail, and Cpl. N. Spiering took photographs. See all other officers reports for further on this incident.

On 11/11/15 at 2257 hours I was dispatched to 4102 N. Regal St. #47 for a report of a 911 hangup call. Dispatch advised they had received a call from that address and could hear people yelling and screaming for help in the background. Prior to my arrival Ofc. Kirby arrived on-scene and requested that other units expedite their response. Other callers said one of the parties involved in the incident was armed with a knife.

When I arrived Ofc. Kirby directed me to interview a male standing in the parking lot of the apartment complex. I asked that male, later identified as #1a, to step to my car and he agreed to do so. Since #1a was apparently involved in an altercation involving a knife, I patted him down to check him for weapons. Finding no weapons on his person, I had him sit on the front of my car while I interviewed him.

#1a provided the following information: He and his family had moved to Spokane from Egypt about 3 months ago. They were originally from Libya and had been brought here by World Relief. #1a had gotten a job working as a cook at Gonzaga University. On 11/11/15 at 1600 hours #1a left for work. He finished work at 2130 hours and got a ride home with a friend. When he arrived home and entered his residence at 4102 N. Regal St. #47, he saw his brothers Omar Ado and Ayad Ado fighting inside.

#1a intervened and asked them why they were fighting. Ayad then hit #1a on the head with a flowerpot and also hit #1a on #1a left arm with the flowerpot. #1a got Omar to go outside to get away from the argument. #1a then went outside and Ayad followed. The argument continued outside until police arrived. #1a showed me a swollen area on his left arm, which he said was caused when Ayad hit him with the flowerpot. Cpl. Spiering responded and photographed #1a injuries. Cpl. Spiering also photographed the inside of 4102 N. Regal St. #47 and observed a flowerpot lying on the floor on the landing. He photographed that flowerpot as well.

Later that night I returned to 4102 N. Regal St. and found Ayad standing in the parking lot. He approached me and asked what was going on. I asked him what had happened that night and he said #1a and Omar had gotten in a fight. Ayad said he had split up the fight but denied ever hitting #1a.

Based on #1a statement that Ayad had hit him with a flowerpot, the flowerpot lying on the floor in

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the apartment, and the marks on **#1a** arm, I determined there was probable cause to arrest Ayad for city assault DV. I placed Ayad under arrest for that charge, transported him to booking, and issued him a citation for that charge.
