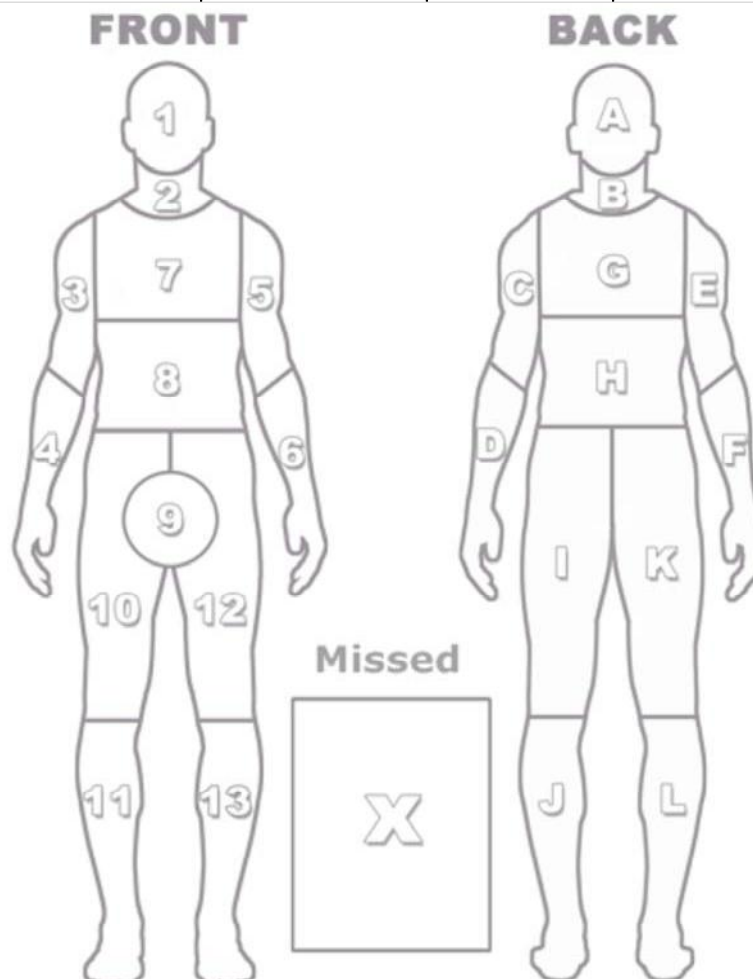

Incident Being Investigated

This is a review of a vehicle pursuit where officer Atkins was the lead car and officer Snider was second. Officer Atkins was in a fully marked police car and officer Snider was driving a black Tahoe that had emergency lights and siren. Also a use of force by officer Snider where he used a draw and direct on Lund.

Incident Summary

Officer Atkins and officer Snider were looking for a vehicle prowling suspect that was driving a stolen Geo Tracker, WA AJR5554. They were both in the parking lot of the Shadle Shopping Center when officer Snider saw the vehicle driving through the parking lot going towards an exit. Officer Snider confirmed the vehicle plate and that it was stolen. They followed the vehicle onto Wellesley going E/B. At this point officer Snider was first and officer Atkins was behind him. Officer could see that there was only one occupant in the car, Ashton Lund.

Lund turned N/B onto Belt. Officer Snider activated his emergency lights and used the air horn several times to get Lunds' attention and have him pull over. Lund continued to drive at 15 mph or less. Lund turned W/B onto Broad, still

going 15 mph or less. Officer Atkins drove in front of officer Snider so he was now behind Lund in his fully marked police car. Officer Atkins had his emergency lights on when he pulled behind Lund. Lund then turned N/B onto Nettleton still going 15 mph. Officer Atkins activated his emergency siren in addition to the lights. Lund continued to drive at 15mph until he got to Olympic. He then accelerated to an estimated 50 mph still going N/B. Officers Atkins and Snider did not speed up but did continue to follow going 20-25 mph. Officers shut off their emergency equipment after he was several blocks ahead of them.

Lund tried to turn E/B onto Rowan but was not able to make the turn. He lost control of the vehicle and went over the north curb and ended up with the front part of the car on top of a fire hydrant. Lund got out of the vehicle and ran around some houses and was contacted by officer Snider in the back of 2310 W Rowan. Lund was not obeying commands to stop. Officer Snider had his gun at the low ready while giving him orders.

Even though Lund was being told to stop he continued to walk toward the house. When officer Snider started to approach Lund, who was approximately 15 yards away, Lund quickly put his left hand into his left side area. Lund was watching officer Snider when he did that. Officer Snider pointed in on Lund fearing he was reaching for a weapon and wanted to be able to defend both officers and citizens. Lund still did not comply immediately. Officer Atkins was able to get into the backyard and make contact. Once Lund was contacted officer Snider holstered and went to assist officer Atkins in handcuffing.

Officer Interview Summary

My interviews with the officers who were either involved or witnesses were consistent with their reports (see attached).

Witness Interview Summary

Investigative Summary

Based on the facts of the case;

Officers were investigating a vehicle prowler driving a stolen car. When they saw Lund in the stolen car officer Atkins was in a fully marked police car, wearing a jumpsuit. Officer Snider was driving a black Tahoe with emergency equipment; he was wearing a police polo with his badge clearly visible.

Officer Snider was behind Lund first and attempted to stop him using emergency lights and air horn blasts. Lund continued driving at low speeds and not stopping. Officer Atkins got behind Lund and also used his emergency lights,

Lund still did not pull over but continued driving slower. When officer Atkins activated his siren Lund accelerated to an estimated 50 mph in a 25 mph zone. Officers Atkins and Snider continued their speed of 20-25 mph, not speeding up to go after Lund. Emergency equipment was turned off after he was several blocks ahead of them.

Lund now approx four blocks ahead of the officers was not able to negotiate a turn and ended up going across the street over a curb and landing with the front part of the car on top of a fire hydrant. He was able to get out of the car and start running around some houses and was contacted by officer Snider when he was in the back of 2310 W Rowan.

Officer Snider with his gun in the low ready position was ordering Lund, who is going to be arrested for two felonies, to the ground while approximately 15 yards away. Lund refused to obey simple commands and was walking toward the back of the house. When officer Snider approached him Lund shoved his left arm down to his side, giving officer Snider the impression he was reaching for a weapon. Officer Snider had no choice but point in on Lund to defend himself officer and citizens in the area from a possible lethal force encounter. Lund, with a gun being pointed in on him, continued to defy orders being given to him and was looking at officer Snider. Lund still had his hand down where it could not be seen. Lund finally complied as officer Atkins got close to him. As soon as the immediate threat was gone officer Snider lowered his gun.

Based on the letter of the policy officer Atkins and Snider did violate the pursuit policy. Neither of them believed at the time they were since they did not accelerate or engage in any emergency driving to chase Lund. I counseled both of them on policy, instructing them that they should have pulled over, stopped and turned off all their emergency equipment.

Officer Snider's use of force was within policy and training to address a possible lethal force threat by using the draw and direct on Lund.

the suspect left in a Chevy Tracker with Washington license AJR5554. That vehicle showed as a reported stolen and was last seen west on Rockwell from Monroe.

I drove west on Rockwell from Monroe and worked my way over to the Shadle Center where I met up with Snider. We were not there five minutes when Snider saw the vehicle pull out of the parking lot and proceed east on Wellesley.

We fell in behind the suspect with our emergency lights on. The suspect drove north on Belt then turned west on Broad. On Broad, Snider let me take the lead as he was in an unmarked Chevy Tahoe and I was in a marked patrol car.

The suspect turned north on Nettleton from Broad and I turned on my siren in addition to my lights. The suspect accelerated from about 15-20 mph to a high rate of speed. I maintained a speed of about 20 to 25 mph and was about to stop following when I saw the suspect crash at Rowan and Nettleton several blocks north of me.

The suspect, later identified as Lund, got out of the car and ran east between some houses. Residents in the neighborhood came out and started pointing where they last saw the suspect. Snider and I had Lund in custody a short time later. He was in the yard behind 2310 W. Rowan.

I DL handcuffed Lund with SFS and put him in my car. I told Lund he was under arrest for possessing a stolen motor vehicle and I read Lund his Constitutional rights and completed a CR card. Lund said he understood his rights and was willing to answer questions. I did not question Lund.

Sergeant Cordis responded to the scene. I screened the arrest with him.

I transported and booked Lund into jail without incident then completed the required PC Affidavit.

On 110315 at 0913 I responded to the area of Garland and Monroe on a report of a suspicious male checking the door handles on cars. Officer Snider responded as well. While enroute Radio broadcast the suspect left in a Chevy Tracker with Washington license AJR5554. That vehicle showed as a reported stolen and was last seen west on Rockwell from Monroe.

I drove west on Rockwell from Monroe and worked my way over to the Shadle Center where I met up with Snider. We were not there five minutes when Snider saw the vehicle pull out of the parking lot and proceed east on Wellesley.

We fell in behind the suspect with our emergency lights on. The suspect drove north on Belt then turned west on Broad. On Broad, Snider let me take the lead as he was in an unmarked Chevy Tahoe and I was in a marked patrol car.

The suspect turned north on Nettleton from Broad and I turned on my siren in addition to my lights. The suspect accelerated from about 15-20 mph to a high rate of speed. I maintained a speed of about 20 to 25 mph and was about to stop following when I saw the suspect crash at Rowan and Nettleton several blocks north of me.

The suspect, later identified as Lund, got out of the car and ran east between some houses. Residents in the neighborhood came out and started pointing where they last saw the suspect. Snider and I had Lund in custody a short time later. He was in the yard behind 2310 W. Rowan.

I DL handcuffed Lund with SFS and put him in my car. I told Lund he was under arrest for possessing a stolen motor vehicle and I read Lund his Constitutional rights and completed a CR card. Lund said he understood his rights and was willing to answer questions. I did not question Lund.

Sergeant Cordis responded to the scene. I screened the arrest with him.

I transported and booked Lund into jail without incident then completed the required PC Affidavit.

tt On 11/03/2015 at about 0915 hours, I responded to the area of Monroe and Garland for a suspicious person/stolen vehicle report. The initial report was that a W/M was in the US Bank parking lot trying door handles to vehicles in the lot. He had driven a vehicle there, a gold GEO Tracker. The witness to the incident had given the plate of WA#AJR5554. Radio advised that vehicle was stolen. As I neared the area, radio advised that the witness was no longer watching the vehicle or the suspect as the suspect drove away W/B on Rockwell from Monroe.

I went W/B on Rockwell with the intent to locate the Tracker. I searched the area of Shadle Park High School and then went to Shadle Shopping Center. I parked in the lot closest to Wellesley and the main entrance and exit area. Ofc. Rick Atkins arrived and we met in the parking lot. As we were talking about the incident, I saw the vehicle drive behind me and start towards the parking lot exit. I read the license plate clearly to radio, WA#AJR5554. Radio confirmed the plate as stolen. I followed the vehicle E/B on Wellesley towards Belt. I could see that there was a single occupant in the vehicle.

I saw that the vehicle activated the left turn signal to turn northbound on Belt. I was driving an unmarked Chevrolet Tahoe, equipped with emergency lights and siren. I activated my lights and applied the air horn to get the drivers attention. The light turned green and the vehicle turned N/B onto Belt. The vehicle was going about 15 mph or less. I saw that the suspect driver, later identified as Ashton Lund, activated his left turn signal again and went W/B on Broad. Again, his speeds were about 15 miles or less. I saw Officer Atkins behind me, I moved over so that he could get his fully marked patrol car behind the vehicle in an attempt to get the driver to stop. Officer Atkins had already activated his lights and was now directly behind the vehicle. Lund turned N/B on Nettleton, at some point Officer Atkins activated his siren as well. Lund continued to drive at about 15 miles per hour until he got to Olympic, where he accelerated to about 50 mph (estimated.) Officer Atkins and I did not follow Lund, we continued at about 25 mph. I saw that he continued at a high rate of speed N/B on Nettleton, he was now about 4 blocks ahead of us. As Lund neared

Rowan, he attempted to make a right turn and failed to negotiate it. The vehicle crashed on the N/E corner of Rowan and Nettleton. As I neared the intersection, I saw Lund fall out of the driver's side door and onto the ground. He turned and looked towards Officer Atkins and I and ran to the North and East through yards and homes. I clearly saw that he was wearing dark jeans and a grey hoodie type jacket, he was a W/M in his 20's.

I continued N/B on Nettleton and came back S/B on Hemlock. As I neared Rowan, Ofc. Atkins advised he saw the suspect at Rowan. I parked my car at Rowan and Hemlock and instantly saw Lund in the backyard of 2310 W Rowan. Lund was wearing the exact same clothing as when I saw him moments before when he ran from the vehicle. Lund continued to look at me as he walked towards the back door of the home. I had my gun in the low ready position and yelled at him to stop. He said, as he pointed towards the home, "I live here." He was walking with his right side exposed to me as he walked East in the yard. I saw Lund, very quickly jam his left hand into his left side area as he watched me walk up to him. Due to the fact that I did not know if he was armed or reaching for a weapon as his clothing was baggy, I did point into Lund for fear that he would produce a weapon and try to harm myself and Officer Atkins. I told him to get on the ground, numerous times. He did eventually go to the ground, but with numerous commands to get his arms out. I was on the outside of the fenced yard at the gate and approximately 15 yards from Lund. Officer Atkins gained access to the yard and made contact with Lund. Officer Atkins and I handcuffed Lund (DL) without incident. Lund immediately began asking for us to let him go if he gave us information on other stolen vehicles. I told him he was under arrest for taking a motor vehicle without permission. We escorted him to Ofc. Atkins vehicle and completed a search of Lund incident to arrest. While walking to the car, Lund said he had bought the car from a friend. Then he said he had the key to the car.

I contacted witness Randall and Lori Sullivan at 5528 N Nettleton. Lori stated that she was in their home and heard the crash. She came out the front door and saw the vehicle on the corner and a W/M, "hopped out, dazed" and then run through the houses.

Randall said he was alerted to the noise as well and came out front and saw the suspect run between his neighbors homes. He said he followed the suspect into the back yards and tried to stop him. Randall said, "Don't run, you're going to get into more trouble." He said the suspect said, "Just let me go, just let me go." He saw the suspect go into another yard and then out of sight.

Kimberly Smith lives at 5522 N Nettleton. She said she heard the crash and came outside as well. She saw the drivers door open on the crashed vehicle and then saw the suspect run between the houses.

The stolen report stated that a search of the vehicle was permitted. Inside the car I saw there was a key in the ignition. There was a backpack on the back seat, numerous cell phones laying about, some CD's and two computer tablets.

Steven Repp, the owner/victim of the stolen vehicle arrived. He went through his car and said the items were not his. I collected the tablets, backpack and cell phones as found property.
