Incident Summary

On 12-12-2015/ 1352 hours, at 2528 E. 1st, a male was seen chasing a female who was yelling for help. The male was reportedly hitting, slapping, and shoving the female. Police radio provided a description of the suspect.

Officers responded to the area. The first officer on scene observed a male that "somewhat" matched the description. The officer attempted to contact and detain the male pursuant to investigating the assault. After a brief verbal exchange, the male suspect ran into the residence.

The officer was advised by a bystander that the male had fled out the rear door of the house. The officer observed the same male jogging away from the location. The suspect was ordered to stop. The suspect continued to flee.

The officer pursued the suspect on foot. The suspect ran for approximately a block and a half. The officer lost sight of the suspect after he ran around a house near Pacific and Cook. Officer Yen arrived to assist searching the area for the suspect near 2504 E. Pacific.

Officer Yen was in the backyard of 2504 E. Pacific. He checked a green garbage next to the rear of the house. When he opened the bin, the suspect was found hiding inside. He drew his gun and pointed it at the suspect and ordered the suspect to show his hands and to put his hands up. The suspect was not complying.

Officer Hice noticed that Officer Yen had located someone hiding in the bin. Officer Hice tipped the bin over (Exceptional Technique noted). The suspect fell out of the bin and was taken into custody. The suspect was found to have been armed with a fixed blade knife approximately 12 inches in length.

The suspect appeared to be under the influence of drugs. He was also possibly experiencing what appeared to be a panic attack. He was checked out by medics. Medics were concerned with what he may be under influence of. He was transported by ambulance to the hospital for further evaluation. After being medically cleared, the suspect was booked into jail for 3 Arrest Warrants, Obstructing, and possession of a Legend Drug.

The suspect after being mirandized, admitted he ran was for being a wanted fugitive. It was determined that he most likely did not have anything to do with initial DV Assault incident.

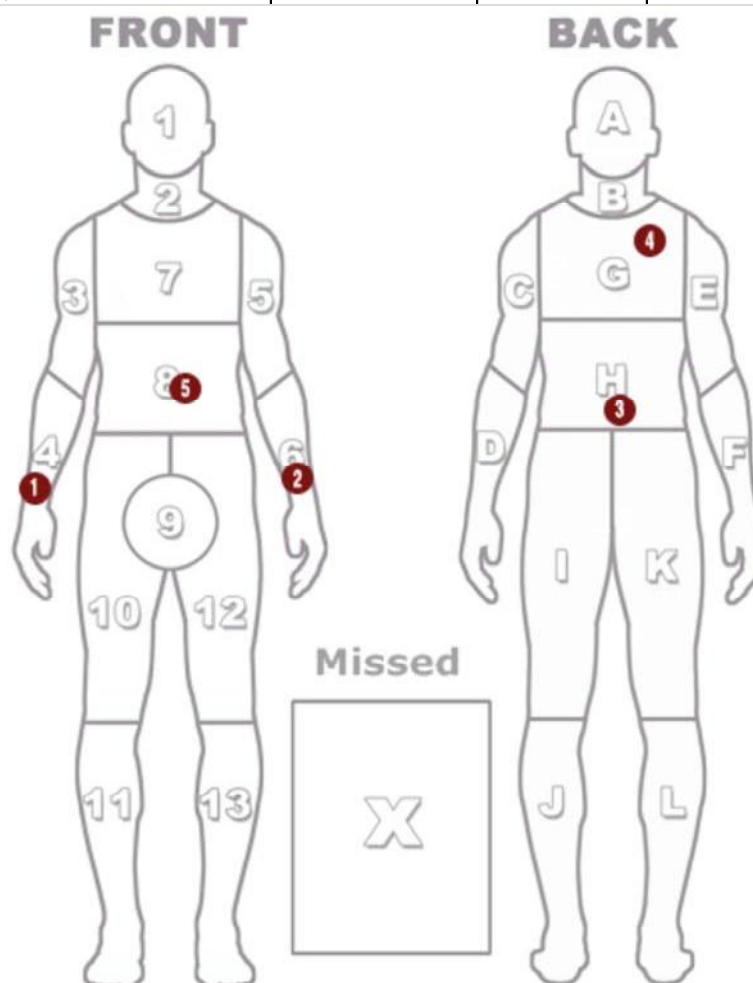

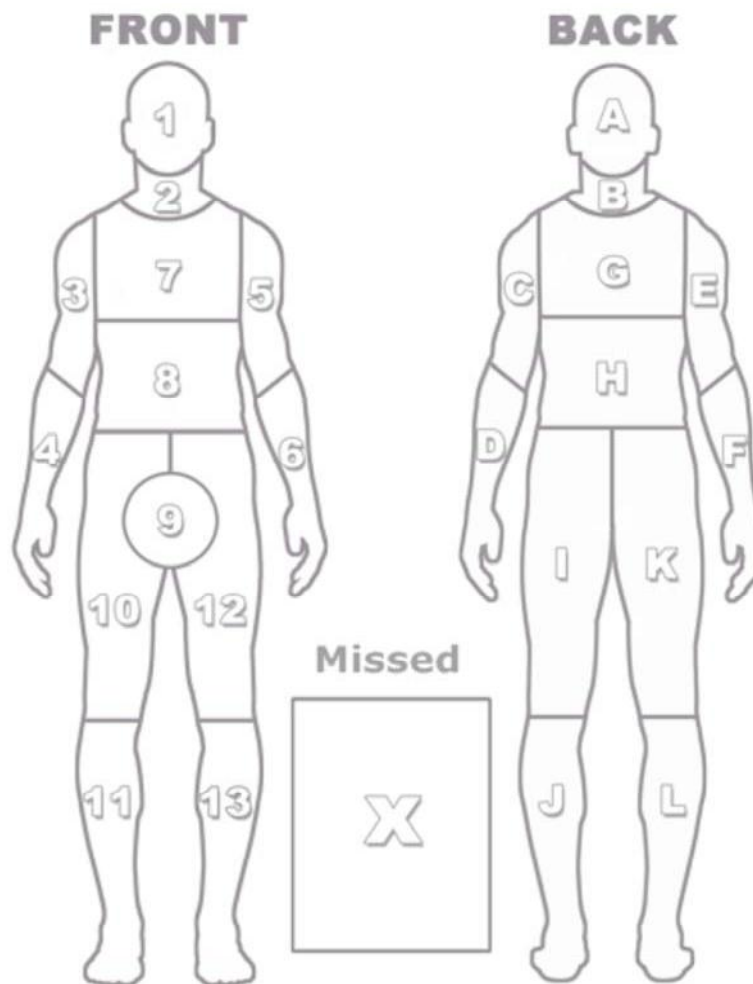

Recipient's Comments/Response: Officer Yen's decision to point his firearm at the suspect was reasonable and within policy. Officer Yen believed that the suspect had been involved in a DV assault and ran from officers when contacted. Prior to running it was not known if the suspect had any weapons on his person or if he was running in an attempt to gain access to a weapon or in an attempt to ambush the officers. Officer Hice's decision to puch the garbage can over was also reasonable based upon the rapidly evolving situation. The fact that the suspect was wanted and was in possession of a deadly weapon (a fixed blade knife with an approximate 12" blade) validates the officers tactical decisions.

On 12/12/15 at approximately 1352 hours, I Officer S. Hice arrived on scene of a dispatched call at 2528 E. 1st Ave. (The call described a Hispanic looking male who was seen beating up a female who was calling out for help.) On scene, I observed a Male (later identified as James A Begley) who somewhat matched the description given by dispatch, of the male who had been assaulting the female.

As I exited my Police Vehicle (My emergency lights were on) I immediately told the male to "Stop" and to "show me his hands". The male began looking around and I advised him that he was not free to leave, that I needed to speak with him. The male threw up his arms and began walking backwards from the yard towards the house saying, "I haven't done anything wrong". I again ordered the male to "STOP" and to "Walk towards me." Suddenly, Begley turned and ran into the front door of the house.

I notified dispatch, that Begley had fled into the house. Moments later, a male who was sitting in a nearby vehicle waved to me that Begley had just ran out of the back door of the house. I observed the back door was open and then spotted Begley jogging away. I yelled for him to "stop" and gave chase. (When I yelled for Begley to stop, he increased his pace to a sprint.)

I notified Dispatch that I was in a foot pursuit with Begley, and put out his description. Begley continued to run approximately a block and a half with me closing ground.

I chased Begley around the corner of a house and lost sight of him near the corner of Pacific and Cook. Several other officers were arriving on scene and I advised them to search the area. Officer Yen was on scene and I pointed out the area where I thought Begley must be hiding. (The back yard of 2504 E. Pacific) Officer Yen and I began to search the area again, when suddenly I heard Officer Yen giving commands loudly to Begley. (See Officer Yen's report for further.)

I could see that Officer Yen was yelling commands and was fixated on a large green trash can. I immediately ran up and grabbed the can, tipping it over. As I did, Begley fell out of the trash can. Officer Yen, Officer Grant, and I took Begley into custody without further incident. (It should be noted that Begley had an extremely large knife, Approximately 12 inches in length ripping through the cargo pocket of his pants.)

While searching Begley's backpack, we found a Prescription Medication which did not belong to him, a credit card which belonged to a female, as well as a large amount of Marijuana and several

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small baggies that I suspected had held Meth. (Begley appeared to be under the influence of some sort of drug). The items were later booked into property.

Dispatch notified us that Begley was wanted for 3 different Warrants. Begley later admitted (after being Mirandized) that the reason he had run, was because he knew he was wanted on warrants. (Begley was not the male we were attempting to locate regarding the Assault against the female.)

Before transporting Begley, he appeared to have some sort of panic attack. We notified Dispatch and had them send AMR to the scene for an evaluation. AMR transported Begley to Sacred Heart and he was later discharged.

Begley was booked into Jail on the 3 warrants, Obstructing, and Possession of Legend Drug.

(It should be noted that I attempted to turn on my body cam, however, due to the rapidly evolving situation I somehow did not capture any footage and must have hit the record button only once.)

On 12/12/15 at 1352 hours, I was dispatched to 2528 E 1st Ave for an assault call.

Prior to my arrival, I heard over police radio that a suspect later identified as James Begley ran into the house at 2528 E 1st Ave. I arrived at the house and was told by other unidentified people that he ran out of the back of the house and was wearing a brown coat. I heard over police radio that another Officer was in foot pursuit with the suspect WB on Pacific Ave. I ran to Pacific Ave and ran to the intersection of Cook and Pacific. I did not see James or anyone run past that point. As a perimeter was set up I went back to the 2528 E 1st Address to try and contact the victim to see if we had PC for an assault.

I arrived at the house and no one answered the door. All of the people who were in the yard were now gone. I contacted **#2d** who was standing on the corner across from the house. **#2d** said that after the officers left to chase the suspect a female and 3-4 males got into a burgundy minivan and went NB on Smith and didn't know where they went after that. **#2d** does not know any of the people who got into the van.

I contacted Officer Hice who had James in custody in the area of Cook St and Pacific Ave. See his report for more information. I saw James was wearing a brown coat. I read James his Miranda rights who understood them and waived them. I assisted Officer Hice by transporting James to Spokane County Jail and reading him his warrants. I took a bank card that had **#1a** name on it and a bottle of prescription pills that other officers found on his person search incident to arrest to property as evidence.

I went to the last known address for **#1a** and was unable to contact her. **#1a** has an order against James. I tried to call the last known number for **#1a** and it was not a working number. I could not make contact with **#1a** or any other victims at this time.

On 12-12-2015 at 1347 hours I assigned myself to assist on an assault-in-progress call at 1st and Smith. Dispatch was advising that a male was chasing a female and physically assaulting her by hitting, slapping, and shoving her. At 1352 hours I arrived on scene as Officer Hice stated a male that had run into a house at 2528 E. 1st had thereafter run out the back door southbound.

Officer Hice began going southbound towards the 2500 block of east Pacific. I also went that way in a more southwesterly direction. Soon thereafter we both saw a male running westbound in the alley of 2500 east Pacific. Officer Hice began a foot pursuit in the alley, and I paralleled the foot pursuit on the south side of Pacific. I could see the male was about 30-40 yards ahead of Officer Hice and caught glimpses of him between the houses as I paralleled him. My intent was to intersect and corral the male as he came out onto Cook, but as I reached the west end of the block I no longer saw the male.

Officer Hice was certain the male must have secreted himself somewhere in a backyard between mid-block and the end of the block. He advised me that he had PC for Obstructing at that point. Officer Feero was sent back to the house to attempt to locate the assault victim for further possible PC and to assist her.

We set a perimeter and began a yard-to-yard search. Officer Yen eventually located the suspect hiding in a "Clean Green" can in the backyard of the house on the SE corner of Pacific and Cook. He was taken into custody without incident. I retrieved a black backpack from the can. There was nothing else inside it besides a few dozen wet leaves. The black backpack matched the appearance of the one I saw the defendant wearing during the foot pursuit. I assisted officers in searching the defendant and his property incident to arrest.

This incident was recorded on my police body camera.

On 12/12/15 at approximately 1352 hours, I Officer S. Hice arrived on scene of a dispatched call at 2528 E. 1st Ave. On scene, I Observed a Male (later identified as James A Begley) who somewhat matched the description given by dispatch, of a male who had been assaulting a female. I immediately told the male to "Stop and to show me his hands". The male began looking around and I advised him that he was not free to leave, that I needed to speak with him. The male threw up his arms and began walking backwards towards the house saying, "I haven't done anything wrong". I again ordered the male to "STOP" and to "Walk towards me." Suddenly, Begley turned and ran into the front door of the house. I notified dispatch, just as Begley then ran out of the back door of the house.


I notified Dispatch that I was in a foot pursuit with Begley, and put out his description. As I chased Begley I was yelling for him to "STOP". Begley continued to run approximately a block and a half with me closing ground.

I chased Begley around the corner of a house and lost sight of him. Several other officers were arriving on scene and I advised them to search the area. We found Begley hiding close by in a trashcan. While searching Begley's backpack, we found a Prescription Medication which did not belong to him as well as a large amount of Marijuana and several small baggies that I suspected had held Meth. (Begley appeared to be under the influence of some sort of drug).

Dispatch notified us that Begley was wanted for 3 different Warrants. Begley later admitted (after being Mirandized) that the reason he had run, was because he knew he was wanted on warrants.

Begley was later booked into Jail on the 3 warrants, Obstructing, and Possession of Legend Drug.
