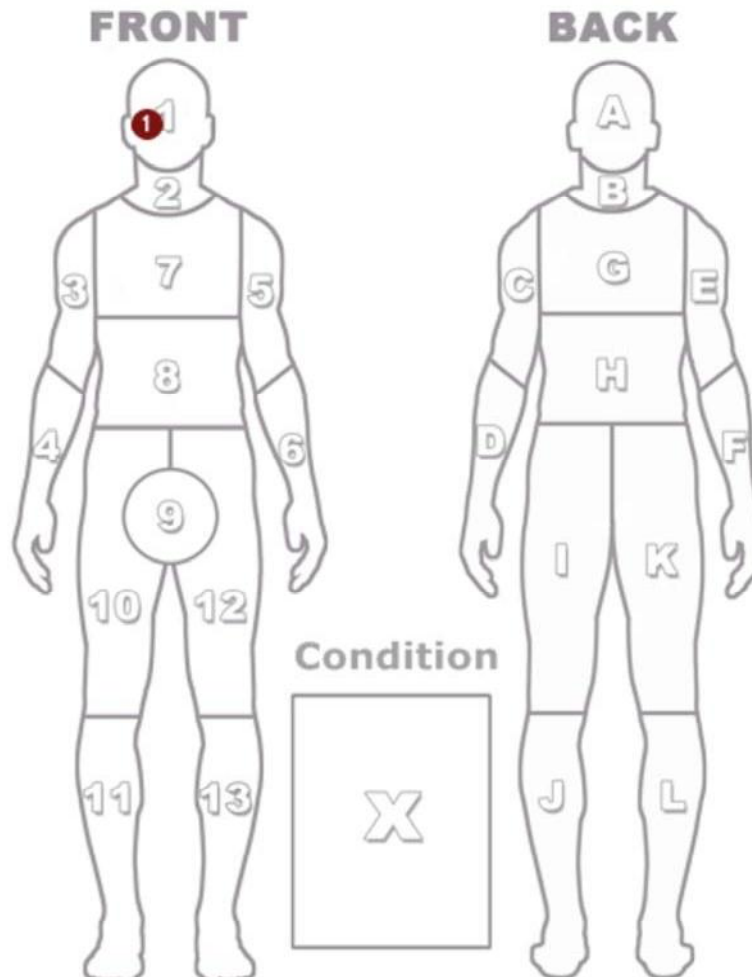

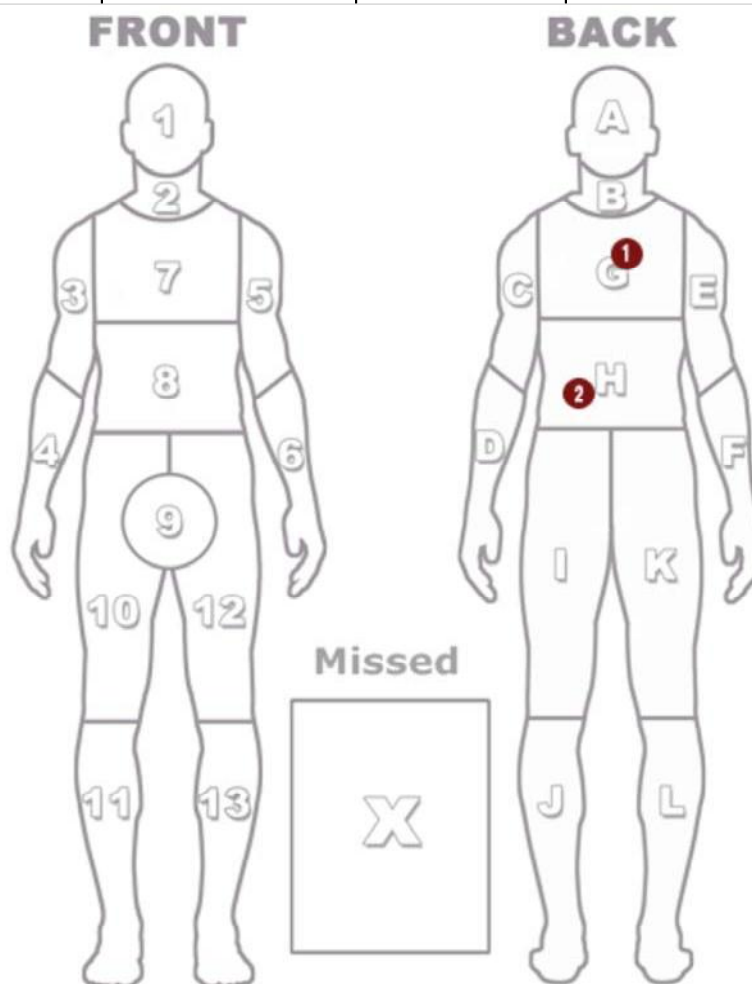

<b>Recipient's Comments/Response:</b> The video shows Ofc. O'Brien controlling the torso of the subject once he is on the ground handcuffed. The subject continues to flail his legs, though he is not able to see behind				

him due to his positioning on the ground and Ofc. O'Brien's positioning over him. There is no concern of the subject being able to rise with Ofc. O'Brien using his body weight to keep him immobilized on the ground. The use of force policy indicates that officers "should not" use the TASER against a handcuffed person. This qualification refers to those who are actively resisting or assaultive, else there would be no need to include this qualification in the use of force policy. Compelling reason must be given to utilize the TASER against an individual that is handcuffed. Under the circumstances in this specific use of force, with the subject immobilized on the ground while already handcuffed, unable to see behind him, upper body controlled by Ofc. O'Brien, and two officers present, I do not find the use of the TASER outside this restriction compelling. Under the use of force policy with a stipulation against TASER deployment on handcuffed subjects, a "control technique" (as opposed to "pain compliance") would have been the appropriate response. Control techniques under these very same circumstances have been taught by DT instructors. Training unit to coordinate use of force training for Ofc. O'Brien, including proper "control techniques" (vs pain compliance techniques) under similar circumstances.

**Suspect Interview Summary**

I was not able to interview Dale Tindal at the scene, since he was leg restrained and was continuing to fight officers. I did not see any visible injuries at this point. I went to jail and contacted Dale in a holding cell. After medical talked to him, I introduced myself and asked if I could speak to him. I could see that Dale had red marks on his wrists from the handcuffs and a red mark on his right cheek area. Dale told me that he was tired of people messing with him. Dale said that officers contacted him and he was angry. I asked Dale if he was aware of the sit and lie ordinance. He said that he was aware of it, and that he usually tries to get up and walk away before being contacted by the police. He said that today, he was just sitting down reading the paper. I explained to him that he was violating sit and lie and that is why he was contacted. I asked Dale if he heard the officers say that he was under arrest. Dale looked at me and said he didn't want to talk to me anymore. He turned and sat on the bench in the cell. This concluded my interview.

**Officer Interview Summary**

Officer Christensen was on patrol and saw Dale Tindal sitting on the corner of Riverside and Post. Officer Christensen attempted to warn Dale for violating the sit and lie ordinance. Dale became disorderly and was repeatedly warned that he would be arrested if he did not calm down. Dale continued with this behavior and was arrested for Disorderly Conduct. Officer Christensen and Officer Obrien took control of Dale and eventually took him to the ground to do prone handcuffing. While on the ground, Dale kicked Officer Christensen repeatedly. Officer Obrien did a closed fist strike to Dale's shoulder to get him to stop kicking. Dale continued kicking, so Officer Obrien took out his taser and removed the cartridge. Officer Obrien tased Dale in drive stun mode to get him to stop kicking Officer Christensen. After Dale was put in leg restraints, he bit Officer Heuett on the leg. On the way to jail, Dale spit on Officer Obrien's face.

### **Investigative Summary**

Officer Christensen contacted Dale Tindal to address a sit and lie violation. Officer Christensen then arrested Dale for disorderly conduct. Officer Christensen repeatedly told Dale that he was under arrest and to turn around and put his hands behind his back. Dale refused to comply with verbal commands, so Officer Christensen and Officer Obrien took control of Dale using two officer cuffing. While they were trying to get Dale into custody, Dale began trying to bite Officer Obrien. Officer Christensen and Officer Obrien did a soft take down of Dale and made sure he was not injured while being taken to the ground. They showed great restraint and care in trying to take Dale into custody without injuring him.

Once on the ground, Officer Christensen and Officer Obrien were able to get Dale into handcuffs despite him trying to grab their fingers and twist them. Officer Christensen began to search Dale incident to arrest. Dale began to kick Officer Christensen. Officer Obrien gave Dale verbal commands and delivered one closed fist strike to Dale's shoulder area. Dale continued to try and kick Officer Christensen, so Officer Obrien took out his taser and removed the cartridge. Officer Obrien placed the taser on Dale's back and warned him that he would be tased. Dale continued to kick at Officer Christensen, so Officer Obrien applied one 5 second cycle. Officer Obrien then observed that Dale was still squirming and kicking. He placed the taser on Dale's buttock and told him that he would tase him if he did not stop kicking. This was effective and leg restraints were put on Dale. Despite Dale being in handcuffs, he was still being assaultive and actively trying to kick another officer. Dale had to be searched and transported to jail. At this point, Dale was under arrest for disorderly conduct and assault 3<sup>rd</sup> against a law enforcement officer.

While Dale was being placed in the back of a patrol car, he bit Officer Heuett on the leg. Once in the car, he was transported to jail. Officer Obrien was driving. Dale was continuing to make threats and he spit on the side of Officer Obrien's face. Dale was uncooperative at jail and had to be carried to a holding cell. He was booked for three counts of Assault 3<sup>rd</sup> degree. There is also probable cause for disorderly conduct and resisting arrest.

Officer Obrien was justified and within policy when he applied the close fist strike to the shoulder area of Dale. Dale was being assaultive even though he was in handcuffs. When this did not work, Officer Obrien continued to give Dale verbal commands and warnings. Officer Obrien then applied one taser application in drive stun mode. This was also justified and within policy given that Dale was still being assaultive and committing a felony assault. Dale was not injured from the force and he did not complain about injury from Officer Obrien. We were unable to get pictures of Dale's injuries because of how uncooperative he was during the arrest process and at jail.

I asked the citizens standing around the area if they had witnessed the incident. I found no one that witnessed the use of force.

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sitting on the N/E corner on the sidewalk reading some paperwork. The male had both of his legs extended out onto the side walk with his back up against the building. He had some papers and a brown paper bag with some other items to the one side of him. I rolled my car window down and tried to get the male attention to let him know that he was not allowed to sit and lie on the downtown sidewalk. The male who was later identified as Dale Tindal stated, I couldn't do anything about it and that if I get out of the car he will take care of me.

I advised radio I would be out with one at this location. As I got out of my car and walked to Tindal's location, I could see that he was now standing up with his coat in his hand. I asked him what the problem was. He said, "You started the problem bitch!" He said, "I was only reading some fucking papers you ass hole!" He continued to yell and cuss at me at the top of his lungs. He continued to yell, "You fucking ass hole" and that he did not care. I advised him that he was being disorderly with his behavior of yelling and cussing. We were in the downtown core next to open businesses and people and children were walking past us.

Tindal continued to yell and scream. He was clenching his teeth together and hitting his hands together as if he was getting ready to fight. He then took off his shirts, pants and shoes. He said he was agitated because of us. He continued on with his verbal cussing callings me a, "dumb bitch." He was advised to stop swearing or he would be arrested for disorderly conduct. He said, "I don't give a shit! He then looks over at Officer O'Brien and says, "You want to do something?" He then grabs his hands and starts stretching like he is going to fight. He continues to tell Officer O'Brien that he would knock the smile off of his face. Officer O'Brien told him that he was not smiling.

Tindal then makes a statement about, "I hoping that he has aids from all the shit he has done." He goes onto swear and call us more bad names. He starts putting his clothes back on and says, "I can even take care of you with these clothes on." At this point he is holding his cloth belt in his left hand and he raise it up and says something like "I will whip your ass with this belt."

At this time I ask him three different times to turn around and place his hands behind his back. I told him that he was under arrest for Disorderly Conduct. The defendant refused to comply to my orders. At this time Officer O'Brien and I close in and take arm control of him. I took a hold of his left arm. As we were trying to control his arms, I saw him open his mouth really wide and lean forward and try and bite Officer O'Brien on the arm. I then told Officer O'Brien to take him to the ground. We placed Tindal on the ground on his stomach. I was then able to handcuff [d/I] his hands. He continued to thrash and kick his legs. While handcuffing him he grabbed my hands several times squeeze my fingers. He also did this to Officer O'Brien.

While I was getting ready to search Tindal he lifted up his left leg and kicked me three times in my left calf. At this time I pinned his legs to the ground with my body weight. At some point I heard Officer O'Brien say he was going to Drive Stun Tindal with the Taser. See his report for more detail.

Tindal continued to try and kick along with grabbing fingers and wheat ever else he could with his hands. I asked for another unit to assist in leg restraining Tindal. Sgt Reese arrived on-scene and I was able to leg restrain him. As we were carrying Tindal to the patrol car I heard Officer Heuett say stop biting me and I saw Officer jump his lower body away from Tindal's face.

Officer O'Brien and Officer Fiskvik transported Tindal to jail. On the way to jail Officer O'Brien advised over the radio that Tindal had spit in his face. See Officer O'Brien, Officer Fiskvik and Officer Heuett's reports for more detail. I booked Tindal for three counts of Third Degree Assault. PC also exists for Disorderly Conduct. An affidavit was completed.

On 123015, I responded to the area of Post and Riverside, to assist other Officers. Other Officers were out with a disorderly male, who they had in custody. They were asking for additional units and leg restraints to control the suspect for his safety and other Officers safety.

Upon arrival, I observed the suspect, later identified as Dale Tindal on the ground. He was attempting to roll around on the ground and was yelling and cursing at the other Officers. There were several people in the area, taking photographs and video taping the incident. It should be noted that this incident occurred in the downtown core area with several people shopping during the holiday season. The male was within a block from a crowded Mall and I observed several individuals walking by scared by the males actions.

I assisted in carrying Dale to the patrol vehicle. I lifted his legs and began carrying him towards the car. He tried to squirm his way out of us carrying him and was flailing his head from side to side. I started to put his legs in the back of the patrol vehicle and had to slide down towards Dales head. I continued to place him in the back seat and felt a pinch on my upper left thigh. I quickly pulled away when I realized that Dale was biting my left thigh.

I had a bite mark with fresh saliva on my left thigh pocket of my jumpsuit. I had Officer Bulkley take a photograph. I followed Officer Obrien to Spokane County Jail and had Corporal Dahle took another photograph of my jumpsuit.

Sgt. Reese was advised of the incident and was on scene.

On 12-30-15 at about 1136 hrs I assisted Officer Christensen with a subject who was in violation of the sit/lie ordinance at Riverside Ave. and Post. St. I activated my body camera.

As I was getting out of my car, I heard the subject screaming at Officer Christensen. The subject's language was full of profanity.

The subject, eventually identified as Dale Tindal, screamed and cursed the entire time during our contact. Tindal began to remove two layers of shirts along with his shoes.

Tindal began to challenge us and make threats that he could kick both of our asses.

## CRIME:

Tindal was being disorderly and obstructing Officer Christensen's investigation. Tindal challenged and dared officers to contact him while holding a belt in his hand. I feared Tindal was going to swing the belt at me with the intent to cause bodily harm.

## THREATS:

Tindal took his clothes off and said, "I could take you with these clothes off. You guys want to do something? Do it." Tindal was holding a cloth belt with a metal clasp on the end in one hand. Tindal said he could use the belt to whoop both our asses. Tindal looked at the cloth badge on my uniform and said the badge wasn't real and "I'll fucking rip it off you." Tindal shook his arms out acting like he was preparing to fist fight while making comments that he could, "Take both of us." Tindal said, "I hope I got AIDS."

## RESISTANCE:

Tindal tensed up and resisted when Officer Christensen and I grabbed his arms. We took Tindal to the ground without causing him any injury. While trying to cuff Tindal, he repeatedly tried to grab both my and Officer Christensen's fingers. Tindal began to kick his legs at Officer Christensen. Tindal resisted while being put into leg restraints and while trying to put him in the

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patrol car, he bit Officer Huette's leg. While transporting Tindal to jail he spit through my open shield. Tindal spat a large quantity of mucus on the right side of my head.

After quite a bit of time, Officer Christensen told Tindal he was under arrest. He told Tindal several times to turn around and put his hands behind his back. Tindal refused every request.

Officer Christensen and I grabbed Tindal and overcame his resistance to place him face down on the sidewalk. I made certain to keep his head from hitting the sidewalk. I used my left shin to keep Tindal's upper body in a prone cuffing technique.

While Officer Christensen and I were trying to put Tindal into cuffs, I had to repeatedly pry his fingers away from us. I gave Tindal one strike to the shoulder blade area while he was trying to grab fingers. I kept telling him to stop grabbing our fingers. I held onto two of Tindal's fingers on one hand to try and prevent his behavior.

I heard Officer Christensen tell Tindal to quit kicking him and I saw Tindal kicking his legs against Officer Christensen.

I warned Tindal not to kick Officer Christensen anymore but he didn't comply.

Tindal began to kick Officer Christensen again so I removed the cartridge from my Taser and applied one drive stun to his back.

Tindal continued to squirm and kick so I placed my Taser against his buttock and told him I would use the Taser again if he failed to quit kicking us.

I held Tindal in the prone position until he was placed in leg restraints then I helped keep him from spitting on us while he was searched.

While carrying Tindal to the back seat of my patrol car, I heard Officer Huette say Tindal just bit him on the leg.

It appeared to me Tindal was trying to prevent us from placing him in the car by using his legs against the car. He was eventually put into the car without any injury.

Officer Fishvik got into my car so we had a two officer transport to jail.

While transporting Tindal to jail he said something similar to, "I'm going to grab that shotgun and blow you up." As we were driving in front of the Community Health building, Tindal spat through

I removed my body camera from the holder on my uniform and used it to capture an image of the spit on the side of my face. I took a picture of the spit with my department cell phone and had Corporal Dahle photograph that image on my phone.

I notified Sergeant Reese of the biohazard exposure and told him about the use of force.



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The undersigned, a law enforcement officer, competent to testify, states as follows: That he/she believes a crime was committed by the above named defendant/defendants in the City and County of Spokane, State of Washington, because:

Officer Christensen can testify to the following:

1. Seeing the defendant sitting on the sidewalk on the N/E corner of Riverside and Post on 12/30/15, at about 1136 hours.
2. The defendant was sitting with his back against the building and both of his legs extended out fully onto the sidewalk. He had a brown paper bag with some miscellaneous items beside him.
3. I advised the male he was not allowed to sit on the sidewalk.
4. He immediately became confrontational and started yelling at me telling me that I couldn't do anything about it and that if I got out of car he would take care of me.
5. I advised radio that I would be out at this location with a person.
6. As I got out of my car and walked towards the male he was now standing on his feet and holding his coat.
7. I asked him what the problem was. He said, "You started the problem bitch."
8. He stated, "I was only reading some fucking papers you asshole."

9. The defendant started to scream and swear at me at the top of his lungs
10. He continued to scream, "You fucking asshole" and went on about how he didn't care.
11. I advised him that his behavior was now being disorderly. We were in the downtown core next to business where people and children were walking by us.
12. The defendant was clinching his fists and banging his hands together, along with clinching his teeth.
13. The defendant was highly agitated.
14. He then started to take his shirts and pants off.
15. The defendant continued to call me a dumb bitch.
16. I told him to stop yelling and swearing or he would be arrested for disorderly conduct.
17. The defendant told me, "I don't give a shit!"
18. He looks at Officer O'Brien and says, "You want to do something?" At the same time he grabs his hands together and stretches his arms, like he is getting ready to fight.
19. He told Officer O'Brien that he would knock the smile off his face. Officer O'Brien advised him he wasn't smiling.
20. The defendant stated, "I hope I have AID's for all this shit I did."
21. He also stated that, "I can even take you with these clothes on."
22. The defendant then puts on his shirts and coat. He picks up his belt and raises it with his left hand and said something like, I will whip your ass with this belt.
23. I asked the defendant three times to turn around and put his hands behind his back and that he was under arrest for Disorderly Conduct.
24. The defendant refused to comply.
25. Officer O'Brien and I went into handcuff the defendant.
26. The defendant immediately opened his mouth and tried to bite Officer O'Brien on the hand or arm.
27. The defendant pulled away and continued to yell and swear.
28. We took the male to the ground and handcuffed him.
29. While handcuffing the defendant he grabbed both Officer O'Brien and my hands and was squeezing them with his hand.
30. The defendant kicking me in left calf three times with his left leg when he was lying on his stomach on the ground.
31. Placing the defendant under arrest for three counts of Third Degree Assault.

Officer O'Brien can testify to the following:

1. I assisted Officer Christensen on a disorderly call at Riverside and Post.
2. The defendant constantly screamed and cursed at us.
3. The defendant was told he was under arrest and he took arm control of the defendant.
4. While holding the defendant in a prone cuffing position, the defendant repeatedly kept grabbing Officer Christensen's and my fingers.
5. The defendant kicked Officer Christensen several times and I used a drive stun technique with my Taser to stop his assaultive behavior.

6. While carrying the defendant to my patrol car, I heard Officer Heuett say the defendant had bit his leg.

7. I saw a wet mark on Officer Heuett's upper thigh.

8. While transporting the defendant to jail, the defendant spat through my open patrol car shield hitting him on the side of the face.

Officer Heuett can testify to the following:

1. Responding to Post and Riverside on 12/30/15 at about 1148 hours.
2. To assisting Officer's in carrying the defendant who was leg restrained.
3. While placing the defendant into the rear of the patrol car he felt a pinching on his upper left thigh as if something was piercing his skin.
4. Looking down and saw the defendant biting his upper left thigh.
5. Having the defendant's teeth marks on his jumpsuit.

Officer Fiskvik can testify to the following:

1. Riding in Officer O'Brien's patrol car and watching the defendant as he was leg restrained.
2. Seeing the defendant spit on Officer' O'Brien through the open shield in his patrol car.
3. The spit hitting Officer O'Brien on the right side of his face.

1. Taking photos of Officer O'Brien.
2. Taking photos of Officer Heuett.
3. Taking photos of the defendant.

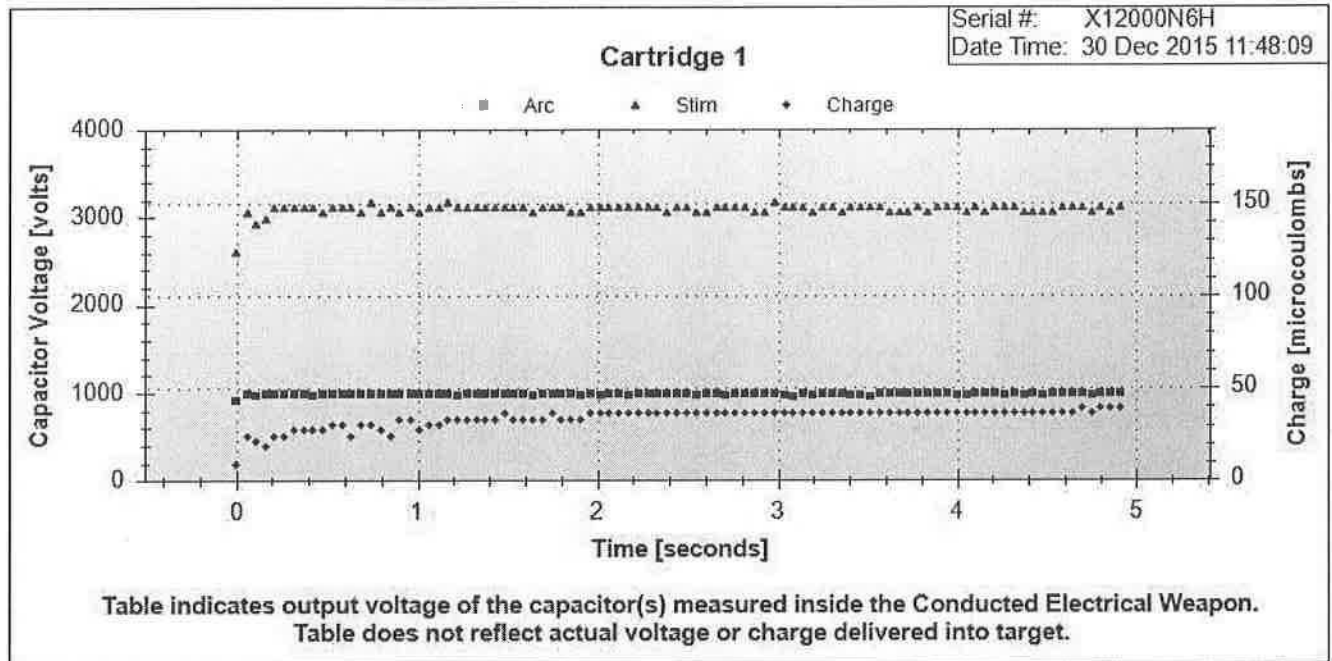
