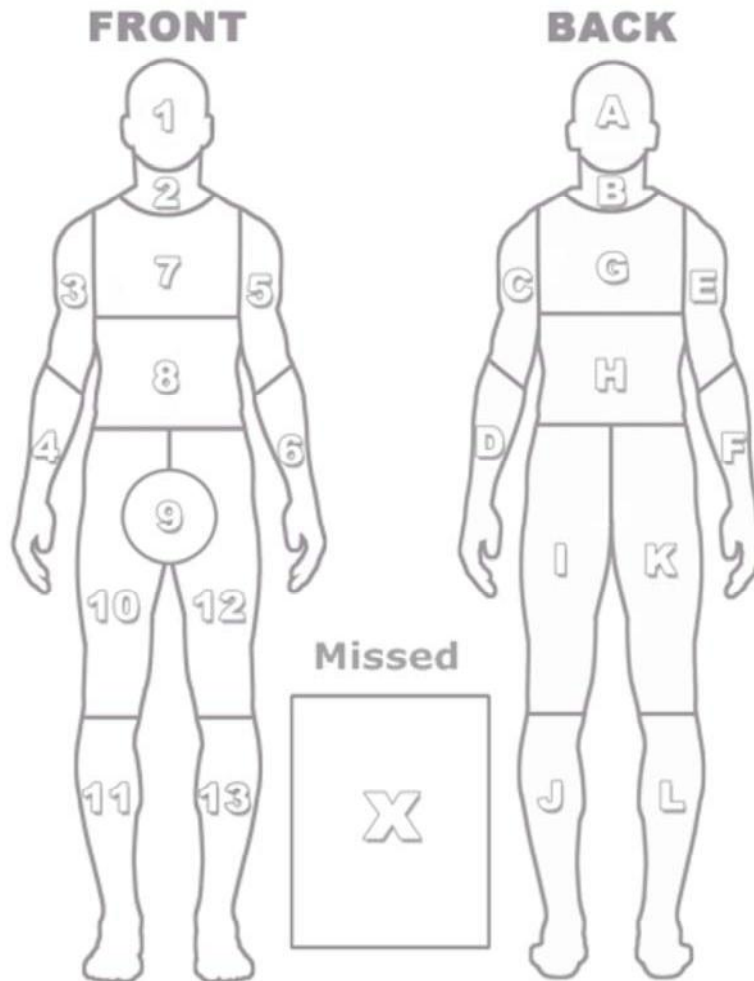

Officer Interview Summary

Ofc. J Kernkamp was responding to 29 S Thor on the report of a DV. The caller made comments about people in the apartment building having "guns". While approaching from the rear parking area of the building Ofc. J Kernkamp observed a male run inside the building. The door the male ran through leads to a dimly lit hallway.

Officer Kernkamp looked through a small window in the door and observed a female, later identified as Adiamond Harrelson, pointing what appeared to be a handgun at the door. Ofc. Kernkamp drew his duty pistol and pointed it at Harrelson while identifying himself. He ordered the Harrelson to drop the gun and she complied.

Other officers detained the female.

Suspect Interview Summary

Harrelson explained she lives in the building. She saw the male run in the back door and go into his apartment #3. She had been in the hallway with a BB gun shooting at a bottle on the ground.

After she heard Ofc. Kernkamp identify himself as a police officer she dropped the BB gun, realizing it looked like a real gun.

Investigative Summary

Ofc. Kernkamp responded with other officers to 29 S Thor on the report of a DV. The complainant was not cooperative and advised she was not at the location. She called a few minutes later advising that people at the location were armed with guns.

The location has a front door on the west side with the rear door on the east side. There is a hallway that runs between the front door and rear door with apartment doors on both sides. The hallway does have lighting, but is very dimly lit.

Harrelson was standing near the center of the hallway with the bottle on the floor between her and the rear door. The BB gun did have BB's in it and it did appear that Harrelson had been shooting at the bottle. It was also apparent that she was pointing the BB gun in the direction Ofc. Kernkamp

Conclusion

Ofc. Kernkamp was responding to a DV. The complainant made comments about people in the building having guns, which heightened responding officers' awareness. Officer Kernkamp's observation of the male running into the building through the rear door further raised concern for their safety.

Ofc. Kernkamp clearly identifying himself as a police officer and ordering Harrelson to drop what he believed was a real gun prevented the situation from escalating.

Ofc. Kernkamp immediately notified me that he had pointed his firearm at the female when he first observed her pointing what he believed was a real gun in his direction (SPD Policy 300.5.1).

I believe Ofc. Kernkamp's actions were reasonable and within policy.

300.5.1 NOTIFICATION TO SUPERVISORS

Supervisory notification shall be made as soon as practicable following the application of force in any of the following circumstances:

- (a) The application caused a visible injury (with the exception of minor marks on the wrist consistent with being handcuffed and minor marks to the face as a result of prone cuffing).
- (b) The application would lead a reasonable officer to conclude that the individual may have experienced more than momentary discomfort.
- (c) The individual subjected to the force complained of injury or continuing pain.
- (d) The individual indicates intent to pursue litigation.
- (e) Any application of the TASER® device or control device.
- (f) Any application of a restraint device other than handcuffs, shackles or belly chains.
- (g) The individual subjected to the force was rendered unconscious.
- (h) An individual was struck or kicked.
- (i) An individual alleges any of the above has occurred.

NARRATIVE		

On 012016 at 2156 hours I responded to 29 S. Thor reference an anonymous female calling in stating her daughter had hit her over the head, and that if she goes back she will be hurt. There was no other details given other than radio hearing people argue in the background. The caller also stated it was apartments 1 through 5, not specifying exactly which one.

This location is very well known to law enforcement. I had already checked out with a suspicious person behind the residence a few hours prior. Recently it has been very active with criminal activity, drugs, stolen property, and wanted persons.

Tonight while en route, Officer who were familiar with the complex identified the caller as possibly #4c who is a person who is frequently contacted by the police and currently has a misdemeanor warrant. Her mother was identified as Cindy Hill.

Ofc.Kaurin and I were responding to the residence with Ofc. Gobble. Ofc. Gobble and Ofc.Kaurin went to the front of the residence. I went to the back, where there is a man door under the carport.

As I was walking up, Phillip Heckathorn saw me in the breeze way, slammed the hall door shut and ran back towards the west. There was an unknown female at the location who was right next to him in the doorway. I later identified her as Adiamond Harrelson.

I walked up to the hallway and looked in the door through peg board holes over the window cutout. Through the holes in the board, I saw a female, Harrelson, standing in the isosceles position with a dark colored semi-auto handgun pointed directly at the door, approximately chest high.

At that point I thought she had seen me when Heckathorn ran back into the apartment. I felt that she was waiting for Officers to walk through the doorway and shoot them. Knowing that she is already prepared, an unwitting Officer would be taken off guard walking through the door and fall victim to a vicious attack.

I immediately moved to the side of the door, behind a car as point of cover. I called out to the female and started giving her verbal commands to drop the gun, and exit out the back door with her hands in the air. At this time I had lost site of her, however was much safer and was able to have a wider view of the complex.

I drew my department issued Glock, pointing in, and ordered Harrelson out of the complex were she was detained.

1) CRIME BEING INVESTIGATED

- Officers were responding to a DV between mother and daughter.
- Officers were not given a specific apartment and upon arrival saw a female pointing a metal colored dark semi automatic handgun towards the backdoor.
- DV crimes are often very dangerous for Officers to respond to because of the passion and well being that is shared between the victim and the suspect.
- This complex is notorious to Police and frequently has other crimes such as drugs, theft, wanted persons that are subsequently involved.

2) THREATS TO OFFICERS

- Unknown exact apartment of where the assault was occurring.
- Fearing that a gun pointed at me would cause great harm to my body and cause me to perish if inflicted by a gunshot.
- An Anonymous caller, not giving good detailed descriptions, indicating a possible ambush.
- A residence where the Police frequently respond for stolen property, fights, thefts, stolen cars, and drugs.
- Already contacting wanted subjects/convicted felons at the location a few hours earlier.
- Other officers advising that the location is a hotbed of criminal activity.
- Seeing a female in the common hallway pointing gun at chest level towards the back door.
- Not knowing who exactly is in the apartments that are not related to the crime being investigated.

3) BEHAVIOR OF SUSPECT

- Female in the hallway immediately responded to verbal commands of dropping the gun, and walking out to the sound of Officers voices.
- Backing up to the sound of Officers voices
- Harrelson cooperating with Officers as she was handcuffed (DL) and patted down for further weapons.
- Harrelson voluntarily telling Officers she had put the gun down in the hallway and that it was a BB gun.
- Advising Harrelson of her Constitutional Rights. She agreed to answer my questions with no confusion.
- Harrelson telling me that she was shooting at a target on the back side of the door, and a pop bottle, not knowing the police were coming to the location or even at the complex.

Harrelson stated she was target shooting with her bb gun, a black colored semi auto style bb gun. She would never harm a police officer. Harrelson has little to no criminal history and was extremely cooperative.

Through the course of the investigation I determined it to be a coincidence of Harrelson
