

Use of Force Incident # 16-18864 Date - 01/16/2016

On 01/16/16 officers responded to a suspicious person call. Officer Bode and Officer Yrigollen made contact with the suspect (Dustin Kerr) behind 1114 E Walton. It was clear that Kerr was on some type of drug and exhibiting strange behavior. They were investigating a possible crime (trespassing) and Kerr was not cooperating with their investigation (obstructing). Kerr was also holding a cup of what he described as urine and officers did not want this thrown on them. They determined they needed to control Kerr and place him in handcuffs to control his movement and confirm he did not have any weapons. Officer Yrigollen placed hands on Kerr to control him and Kerr immediately became combative and Officer Bode also felt a hard object in Kerr's sleeve, which he believed to be a weapon. Officer Bode and Officer Yrigollen advised Kerr he was under arrest and continually told him to stop resisting. A witness also overheard officers advising Kerr to stop resisting.

They advised dispatch that they were fighting with the suspect and other officers responded. Kerr grabbed Officer Yrigollen's testicles during this struggle and also bit Officer Yrigollen's hand. Officer Bode and Officer Yrigollen both removed their tasers during this struggle, but did not utilize them. Officer Bode's taser cartridge was broken during the struggle though. Lt Cowles arrived to assist and determined the best method to control Kerr was to move behind him and place him in a level 1 LNR. Kerr was not rendered unconscious and officers were able to control Kerr eventually. Medics responded to check on Kerr's welfare because of his behavior and potential of a drug overdose. Kerr was transported to the hospital for further evaluation.

I responded to the scene and could see that the area where officers made contact with Kerr was very icy and slick, which was unsafe for them as they struggled to maintain footing. Kerr was making strange statements and overly focused on lights and I could see his pupils were very large. He appeared to be on some type of drug and it was clear he was not going to be able to give me any type of coherent statement. Medics were also on scene and checked him while I was there. They determined he did not have any injury from his struggle with officers.

Officer Bode's body camera was knocked off during the struggle and landed face down in the snow, but you can hear muffled statements from the officers and the struggle. It was clear from audio statements that Kerr had grabbed Officer Yrigollen and also bit him. The video is marked where Lt Cowles arrived on scene. I observed Officer Bode's taser cartridge and the damage to it. The blast doors were broken. Sgt Eckersley downloaded Officer Bode's taser data to confirm that it had not been fired. On page 11 (taser download report) it is confirmed that the taser was

not fired during this incident. Cpl Busch responded and took photos. Other officers also responded, but did not get directly involved. Their body camera links are attached.

Officer Yrigollen was assaulted by Kerr and the bite did not break the skin on his hand. He did admit that he was in extreme pain when Kerr grabbed his testicles. Kerr was charged with 3<sup>rd</sup> assault and obstructing. I find that Lt Cowles use of the level 1 LNR followed SPD training and was within SPD policy # 300.8.2. This was a minimal use of force to control Kerr given his assault on a law enforcement officer.

On 01/16/2016, at 2310 hours, I was dispatched to 1114 E Walton on a Suspicious Person call. The call stated a subject appears high on heroine or Meth in the backyard going through items, subject trying to steal items, neighbor said she does not know who is in her yard. The description of the subject was a W/M, 30's, 5-10, Med, White sweater, blue jeans.

I observed two individuals who appeared to live at the location gesturing next to them where a male that matched the suspect description was grabbing items from near a trash can directly behind the residence. The male appeared to be under the influence of a controlled substance by his motions being slow and erratic and his eyes being very wide open and having a blank stare. In my training and experience this is all indicative of an individual under the influence of a controlled substance.

I kept quite a bit of distance of approximately 7 feet between myself and the subject and started talking with the male. The male was later identified as Dustin Kerr. I asked Dustin what he was doing and he said he is working and then made other statements which did not make much sense. Ofc. Bode was standing off to the East of the subject and was equipped with a body camera which recorded video and audio, for further info see Ofc. Bode's report. Dustin then kept holding up in his hands, in his left hand was a large cup with a yellow substance in it and in his right hand was another drink which was a can. I asked Dustin several times to please sit down and he kept not complying. I then told Dustin several times he needed to take a seat and he still continued not to comply. I asked Dustin his name and he seemed confused as to my question. I asked Dustin for his ID and he still looked at me confused. While asking Dustin for his name and ID he refused to

comply. Dustin was looking up and leaning backwards making me think he may fall back into the metal BBQ that was behind him. Dustin stated the cup in his left hand was full of urine. At this point Dustin was on someone else's property, possibly prowling and attempting to steal items. My experience is that when someone will not provide their name they are possibly going to try and flee from the scene. Dustin appears to be under the influence of a controlled substance and with the signs he is giving it appears we are at the low point of his behavior where having him put the items in his hands down and detaining him in cuffs while we continue our investigation will be the safest approach. Due to him failing to cooperate at this point he is obstructing my investigation.

As I approached Dustin to gain arm control he tensed up and I immediately spoke to him trying to calm him and have him comply with our directions of not tensing up and putting the items down in his hands and then putting his hands behind his back. Ofc. Bode had the left arm and the drink with the possible urine was in that hand and I had the right arm and the other canned drink was in that hand. Dustin would not put either drink down, would not let go of either drink and would not comply with several commands. Dustin was also resisting us placing his hands behind his back and resisting arrest at this point.

Dustin continued to resist arrest and then started to pull away and move away from us, I was unable to overcome his resistance at this point and as Dustin was attempting to pull away and stand up I faced towards Dustin used my right arm as a neck restraint and held Dustin in that position while continuing to try and get his hands behind his back. I was giving several verbal commands to stop resisting. Dustin grabbed ahold of my testicles and squeezed causing me pain at which point I was able to maneuver away from him give him verbal commands not to assault me and continued telling him to stop resisting. At this point Dustin has committed an Assault 3rd by assaulting myself a law enforcement officer.

Dustin continued to pull away and resist and when I moved to gain more control of his right arm and got it behind his back, I used my right hand to hold down Dustin's head so he would not attempt to get back up. Dustin maneuvered his head placing his mouth on the right side of my right hand and started to bite down, I was able to move my hand out of his mouth as he was biting down causing some pain but minimal marks due to me having winter gloves on as well. This was another Assault 3rd on a law enforcement officer

After a while we were able to get Dustin into custody. We had medics respond and check him out due to his very erratic behavior. Dustin was transported to Sacred Heart Medical Center for treatment. Once we arrived and the medical staff treated Dustin we were advised by the physician that Dustin was under the influence and needed to stay at the hospital for several hours prior to being booked into jail.

I completed the affidavit for the officers at the hospital to book him in on once he is released.

On 011616, I was on-duty as a Spokane Police officer. I was wearing the duty uniform of the day which consisted of a utility style jumpsuit with police badge on right chest and color Spokane patches on each shoulder. I was also wearing a black police duty belt.

I was dispatched to 1114 E Walton to assist Officer Yrigollen with the report of an unknown suspicious male in the complainant's backyard.

The complainant, Brandon, called 911 and said there was a W/M in his 30's, 510, medium build wearing a white sweater and blue jeans. The male was seen in his backyard and Brandon thought he was trying to steal items.

I arrived and parked to the west of Morton and Walton and approached on foot. Officer Yrigollen arrived about the same time and advised over the radio that he located the male in the alley behind the house. Officer Yrigollen made contact with the male who was later identified as Dustin while I made my way around the east side of the house and entered the backyard through the unlocked short chain link gate.

As I came around the corner of the house, I activated my department issued body camera.

I held a position as a cover officer while Officer Yrigollen talked to Dustin. I observed Dustin's physical size and clothing was consistent with what the caller had reported.

I could see Dustin was standing at the back of the house under a car port near a barbecue grill. There was a hard tine garden rake propped against the grill directly behind Dustin within arms reach.

Dustin was not answering simple questions such as what was his name and where was his ID card. Dustin had a plastic soda cup in his hand that he said was filled with urine. Due to Dustin's lack of cooperation with the on-going investigation, I was concerned he could throw or splash the urine on us. I told him I thought the liquid looked like Mt Dew (because he also was also holding a Mt Dew bottle) he again stated it was urine.

Dustin was asked and told several times to put his items down and refused. He was asked for his name and ID several times but again refused to cooperate with the lawful investigation.

Dustin began leaning backwards and staggering. He said he had been drinking and it also appeared he was under the influence of a drug because his pupils were large and he stared at things with wide eyes. Officer Yrigollen started moving in to contact Dustin.

Officer Yrigollen tried to control the cup of urine in Dustin's hand. I grabbed arm control on Dustin's left arm. He had a sock over his hands that he was wearing as gloves. I grabbed a hold of his wrist with my left hand while I held near the back of his bicep with my right hand. I felt an unknown hard object approximately 1 inch wide and at least 4 inches long under the sock that Dustin was secreting on the inside of his arm. As soon as I touched the item, Dustin tensed his muscles and tried to pull his arm away from me. I told Officer Yrigollen that I was not sure what he was hiding in the sock and based on the hardness of the object and the way he was acting, I believed it could be a weapon. Dustin said it was a music player but I could not verify that. I told Dustin to put his hands behind his back. He refused to comply and again tried to pull his arms away.

#### FACTS:

We were responding to a citizen complaint of an unknown male in their yard whom they thought was possibly stealing items. We located a male matching the description provided by the citizen in the backyard of the address provided by the citizen. At that time we had reasonable suspicion to believe Dustin was the male involved in a possible theft or trespassing. We were attempting to conduct an investigation to confirm or dispell the suspicion as provided in Terry v Ohio. As part of that lawful investigation, Dustin was required to identify himself which he refused. He refusal was willfully delaying our investigation. When I felt the hard object hidden in Dustin's hand, I believed it to be a weapon. The safest course of action for us and Dustin was to detain him in handcuffs and remove the item from his jacket. The detention and weapon frisk is also allowed in Terry v Ohio.

Dustin pulled his arms away and was using body force to actively resist detention. We had moved laterally to the snow and ice covered concrete back steps of the house. I was afraid we could slip and fall on the concrete steps during the struggle causing injury to any of us. I reached over Dustin's right shoulder with my right arm and using body weight pulled him to the ground.

At this point, my body camera fell off my uniform and landed face down in the snow in the backyard. It continues to record but you can only hear the audio. It appears at several times through the struggle the body camera gets kicked while on the ground.

Several times both myself and Officer Yrigollen tell Dustin to stop resisting and to put his hands behind his back. We also told him he was under arrest.

At one point in the struggle, Dustin was trying to get his hand into his left jacket pocket, which had not been searched or frisked. I advised radio that we were fighting with the male which got more units enroute to our location.

Over the next few minutes, both Officer Yrigollen and I struggled to maintain control of Dustin's arms. He had extreme strength and was able to resist our efforts to handcuff him. At one point, Officer Yrigollen yelled out something to the effect of "Don't grab my balls", or "Let go of my balls." I recognized this to be assaultive behavior to Officer Yrigollen and accessed my Taser. I told Dustin to put his hands behind his back or he was going to be tased. Officer Yrigollen also accessed his Taser so I re holstered mine thinking he was going to deploy his. There was a lull in the struggle and I was able to get one handcuff on Dustin's left wrist.

I knew I was not going to be able to get his hands secured with one set of cuffs so I placed two sets on for a longer reach. With Officer Yrigollen's help, I was able to get the other cuff secured on Dustin's right wrist.

Lt Cowles arrived as the next officer on-scene. Reference his report for more information.

Spokane Fire Department personnel were summoned to the scene to check Dustin's vital signs due to his possible drug use and the extended struggle. They stated he was under some drug and was not answering their questions so they recommended he be taken to the hospital.

I rode in the ambulance with Dustin to Sacred Heart Medical Center.

During the struggle, I was not able to get my Taser properly snapped into its holster and it fell out of its holster while we were wrestling on the ground. The blast doors broke off of cartridge C4102RN6R, rendering it inoperable.

I advised Sat Eckersley that I did not deploy my Taser but due to the damage he wanted to download the firing log anyways. The firing log showed my Taser had not been fired.

On 01/16/16 I was on routine patrol driving a marked police vehicle wearing the uniform of the day when I heard a brief and garbled radio transmission from Officers at 1114 E. Walton. The transmission was an officer with stress in their voice stating that they were involved in a fight with a subject. I was close to the location and responded to the call for help.

I was the first assisting officer to respond to the scene. As I exitted my patrol car i transmitted that I was onscene and attempted to find the officers involved.

I heard the officers call for me and i went to their location. They were standing in a dimly lit car port behind the house in the alley behind the house. As i approached I was careful because the ground was covered with ice and snow causing an innate hazard. The officers were standing over a male who was laying partially on his side, and partially on his stomach. Ofc. Yrigollen and Bode were both holding onto the subject's arms. Because of the lighting i could not see if they had any injuries from their altercation. The subject was handcuffed, but they were both exerting control over the male trying to hold him still, each with both hands.

I asked the officers how I could help. They told me that they couldn't search the subject to check him for weapons. I could still hear tension in their voices. They explained that the male wouldn't let them search him and that even while cuffed he continued to resist them.

#### Crime-

I was unsure at this time the precise nature of the crime involved however I was aware that the officers on scene had just been in a physical confrontation with the suspect and were particularly concerned that the subject was possibly armed. The male had recently been in a physical fight with uniformed officers and while handcuffed, if armed could still pose a significant risk to myself and persons in the vicinity.

Suspect Resistance and Additional concerns-

I was particularly aware of the amount of effort that the officers were using to contain the movements of the subject. Both officers had both of their hands on the arms of the suspect. I could see the male attempting to writhe out of their grip. Particularly I could see him trying to push with his legs to free himself from their grasp.

In addition to the icy conditions a concrete staircase, metal pole, and a vehicle were in close proximity to the suspect and the officers. Should any of the officers be knocked off balance on the slick, snowy, and wet footing they could easily be significantly injured by the fall.

I am aware that an intense physical confrontation can cause rapid fatigue not only with officers but also with the detained suspect. Additional physical effort not only puts officers at risk, but the additional physical strain of the suspect would increase the risk of injury to himself.

Force Used-

I determined that it was best to immediately contain the subjects movements.

I moved onto the ground beside the male. I told him who I was and placed him in a level 1 neck restraint. I explained to him that if he fought with officers while they searched him he would be rendered unconscious.

Having the male in upper body control with the neck restraint I was able to feel the tension in his body and the force he was exhibiting with his legs. I applied pressure to the technique to maintain control and overcome his resistance. My vision of his lower body was limited because of my position, but I could feel him thrash his feet and push against myself and the other officers. I was able to maintain control of the male. I could hear officers yelling for him to stop grabbing at them.

He was not rendered unconscious:

Speaking calmly and clearly to the male I made an effort to reassure him and calm him down. During the application of the technique the male made the statement that he had a bomb in his hand and that if he released pressure on it the bomb would detonate.

My use of the technique was successful in providing a level of control that officers were able to properly check him for weapons and remove the items he was clenching in his fists.

The technique allowed me to control the head of the male protecting him from injuring himself on the concrete, the metal pole, or the vehicle.

Monitoring of subject and after care:

As the male calmed down I released the technique and he was rolled into the 'rescue position' on his side to ensure he had a clear airway and could breath properly. Until I found a knit cap, I protected his head from the concrete with my leg, kneeling next to his head.

Medics were directed into the scene:

Officers advised me that he had tried to bite them, and had grabbed one of the officers testicles while they tried to control him.

I noticed that the male's eyes were extremely dilated. He would become intently focused on unrelated details like an officers set of keys or the red light blinking on another officer's camera.

His muscle movements were very 'gross' in function and he was not able to maintain steady control of his head. I noted that even though his clothing on his torso was wet and he was laying in slush, snow, and ice he did not shiver. He was provided a blanket to keep his body temperature stable until medics arrived.

Eventually, the male was identified as Dustin Kerr. He became cooperative enough to allow him to sit up.

Medics arrived and checked on his vitals. He did not cooperate with their interviews

Because of his condition and our concern for his health he was transported by ambulance to Sacred Heard Medical Center where he was medically cleared before being booked into jail for the assault.

Reference additional officer's reports. I advised Lt. Walker of the restraint technique I employed to control Kerr.

The suspect was still resisting when I arrived so I secured his legs by holding them to the ground. After the suspect was under control, I went and contacted the original complainant, Brandon Ward who lives next door.

I asked Brandon what he observed and he told me the following:

He saw the suspect rummaging through items in the back of his neighbors house so he asked him what he was doing. The suspect stated that he was taking out the trash for the lady that lives there. Brandon knew that this wasn't true and with the fact that he has had items disappear from his residence, he called 911.

Brandon saw officers arrived and contact the suspect behind the neighbors house. He went inside to make sure that he wasn't in the way of the officers doing their job so he did not see what happened but could still hear their conversation.

He heard an officer ask the suspect several times to have a seat and make himself comfortable. He also heard the officer tell the suspect several times to drop whatever was in his hands. The suspect refused to obey any of the requests that the officer gave him.
