

<u>Incident Summary:</u> Officer Wells was working in the area of Northtown Mall due to recent gang activity. He attempted to contact a subject in the area, who was possibly a wanted subject the department was looking for. The subject was uncooperative upon contact and tried to flee. The suspect sustained minor facial injuries while struggling with the arresting officer on hard terrain.

Officer Wells' body camera shows his multiple attempts to gain verbal compliance and employ VDI (Verbal Defense and Influence) tactics. The camera footage shows the suspect flee from the officer and a struggle ensue when the officer catches him. The most pertinent portion of the video is the first three minutes of Officer Wells' longer video.

<u>Officer Interview Summary:</u> See Officer Wells' police report detailing his contact and arrest of the suspect

causing havoc at Northtown Mall. Officer Wells was using this information along with information provided by NCO Ponto that resulted in him contacting the suspect on a Terry Stop.

I am familiar with the suspect Daniel Burland due to my participation as a Gang Liaison Officer (GLO) for the department. He is a documented member/affiliate of a local criminal street gang with violent tendencies. A local criminal history check shows past charges for Burland including: Riot with a Deadly Weapon, 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Armed Robbery, Felony drug charges, and Burglary.

### **Sergeant Findings:**

It is my judgment the officer acted within the scope of his training and department policy. I believe his actions were reasonable and necessary given the totality of the circumstances.

On 3-17-16 at the morning roll call, Neighborhood Conditions Officer (NCO) Traci Ponto attended and we spoke about the Young Killa Squad (YKS). I was aware of information that had been put out regarding the group, but was only familiar with Austin Ides. Ponto advised us she has over 30 pending cases which she has investigated in recent week regarding "The Squad". Several of its members had been arrested and she had pending charges against 5 others. The charges included, assault, vehicle prowling and felony malicious mischief. She further advised that the members of this group are all in their mid teens, but are not attending school and are busy during the day committing crimes. Their main area of operation is in the Northtown Mall area. I have contacted Northtown Mall security prior to today and they are aware of the trouble they have caused. Ponto also advised that the members of the group like to wear red Chicago Bulls baseball hats as part of their identifying clothing. Two of the still wanted members are Lakota and Cedar Knowhisguns. I had never contacted either person before and had only a small picture from a flyer to identify them.

At 1216 hours, I was driving south on Mayfair St. from Sanson Ave. There was a young man walking north on the east side of the street. I noticed he was wearing a white shirt, red and white shoes and a red Chicago Bulls baseball hat. The male briefly looked at me, but upon seeing me quickly looked away from me which I believed was suspicious. Mayfair and Sanson is only a few blocks north of Northtown. The male was small in stature and appeared to be a teen based upon the short glance I had before he turned his face away from me.

I turned my car around and called out with a suspicious person. I believed the male who was later identified as Daniel Burland was one of the group Ofc. Ponto was looking for, but in the moment could not recall a name. I parked my car behind him, but did not turn on any overhead emergency lights. I got out of my car and called to him, but he ignored me. Burland continued to walk north on Mayfair and I again called to him asking if he would speak with me. Burland looked at me, but then kept walking. I called again for him to talk to me as he passed Sanson St. He told me he had not done anything wrong. I agreed that I was not stopping him for an infraction. I was executing a Terry stop believing he was one of the Knowshisguns brothers or other members of the squad. I told him I was looking for members of the Young Killa Squad and advised I wanted to ID him so I could verify if he was one of the suspects Ponto was looking for. He told me he didn't know Ofc. Ponto. Burland continued to quickly walk north and I continued to follow, walking about 20 feet behind him while advising dispatch of the situation and asking for more officers. Burland would take about 10 steps between glances over his shoulder to see where I was at. I could also see him scanning the area ahead of him as he walked. Based upon my experience, he was looking for a place and time to run from me.

I politely called for him to talk to me and he refused, still claiming he had not done anything wrong. As we crossed

Rowan St. I told him to come talk to me. He still refused and continued north. I looked at where he was headed. The area Burland was walking towards was the service area behind Ross Dress for Less. This is an area where few people go and I believed Burland was going to run. If I had to fight Burland in this area, it would be more dangerous for me, because no one would see me to help if I was hurt or injured and responding officers would not know where to find me. I waited for Burland to make a glance over his shoulder and as soon as he did and then looked forward again I started to run towards him across Rowan Ave. While still several feet away, Burland heard my steps and started to run. I was able to grab his shirt which stretched as he continued to pull away from me. I ordered him several times to get on the ground, Burland continued to try to escape by pulling away, then turning to face me and moving around.

At the time, I suspected Burland was a suspect associated with the YKS gang. I know that people who run in gangs are often armed. Ofc. Ponto had probable cause to arrest several of its members for assault, vehicle prowling and felony malicious mischief. Burland was wearing red and white clothes which I know are worn by members of the Norteno Red Boys. He was wearing a Bulls hat which are signature clothing often worn by members of the YKS.

Burland was refusing to comply with my requests and commands to stop and talk with me. He continued to walk north for 1½ blocks when we reached Rowan Ave. He was looking around and it appeared he was looking for a place to run. He was quickly walking towards the back service area of a department store were very few people would go. Should I need assistance or become injured, responding officers would have a hard time finding me there. I suspect that once in the low traffic area, Burland was going to either run to turn to fight me.

Burland started running from me and I grabbed him by his shirt as pulled away from me. I told him to get on the ground several times and he refused to comply. He had turned into me and was now facing me. He was pushing away from me in an eggressive manner. I tried to do a leg sweep while holding his left shoulder, but it did not work. We wrestled in a standing position with his arms keeping me back. Finally, able disrupt his balance to toss him to the ground.

Before I was able to toss Burland to the ground, we had traveled about 15-20 feet across the asphalt driveway to the parking lot. We wrestled while standing, I told Burland to, "get on the ground." He refused to comply and yelled, "For what." I again told him to get on the ground and Burland continued to try and get away while yelling, "Why." I again told him to get on the ground and he stated, "I didn't do nothing." When Burland landed, his face and head contacted either the asphalt or a raised cement curb. When his momentum stopped, he was now in some bushes and dirt. He was still trying to get away from me by tucking his feet under him and trying to roll onto his back. I used my open hand to hold his head down and then was able to place my knee across his upper back and neck to hold him down. His arms were also tucked in tight to him and I commanded him to bring his arms out. He complied and gave me his left arm while his right arm was pinned under him. At this point I was able to access my radio and advised dispatch that I was fighting with Burland. An older man (about 70 years old) was driving by and walked up to help. He walked up and helped hold Burland's left arm while Burland moved his right arm behind his back. I placed him in handcuffs. Burland asked why I punched him, I replied to him, "I did not punch you, but did take you down."

l asked Burland what his name was and he refused to say anything. During the struggle, he lost one of his shoes which was now lying on the pavement. I assisted him up and then started walking to the car. He accused me of "drop kicking him" which I did not. I placed him in the back of the car and shut the door.

I noticed that Burland had a minor amount of blood inside of his mouth. He also had two abrasions on the right side of his face. Each was slightly larger than a quarter. One was high on the scalp and in the hairline. The second was near his chin. I placed him in the back of Ofc. Uberuaga' car. I collected his items and then placed them in a bag. I requested Ofc. Ponto and a supervisor come. I re-contacted Burland and again asked who he was. We had observed he had a tattoo about his right eye which read, "red boyz." Which I know to be a north side gang. Burland refused to answer any basic identification information would not even look at me. I advised him he was under arrest and closed the door. Based upon the tattoo, Sgt. Hartman suggested the person I detained might be Daniel Burland. After checking a booking photo, I confirmed it was Burland. Dispatch ran Burland and confirmed he had a felony DOC warrant. After confirming Burland was not one of the YKS, and had Ofc. Ponto clear the call. I advised Burland he was also under arrest for his DOC warrant and his right to remain silent and to have an attorney.

I then contacted Brandon Lyngstad who had been working with a crew running chain saws and cleaning yard debris. When I was quickly walking after Burland, they had stopped to look. When I started chasing Burland, they shut the chainsaws off. They were standing about 50 feet away from us. Lyngstad told me he saw me chasing Burland and saw Burland not complying by getting on the ground. Lyngstad made the statement, "Had he (Burland) listened, it wouldn't have been so bad." I took his contact information and then passed it on to Sgt. Hartman to interview.

I transported Burland to jail where he was booked for his DOC warrant and a new charge of Obstruction. Since I never told Burland he was under arrest prior to or while struggling with him, I did not charge him with resisting arrest. I asked Burland to verify his phone number or address and he would not do either. He told me he was not living anywhere.

Burland sustained some minor injuries when he was taken into custody. I began an administrative investigation. I was wearing and using my department issued body camera. I did interview Wells about the incident.

Brandon Lyngstad interview: Officer Wells directed me to Brandon Lyngstad who was standing a short distance away. Brandon was working as part of a landscaping crew and told me he saw the arrest. He heard the officer tell the suspect to get on the ground and he didn't comply. He didn't see the officer do anything inappropriate. He saw wrestling/grappling between the officer and suspect, but didn't see any strikes.

I noticed Officer Wells' uniform was dirty on the front, indicative of a struggle. I asked Cpl Beckley to photograph him uniform along with a shoe belonging to the suspect that came off during the struggle, indicating to me some level of resistance. I also requested photos of the terrain. It appears the arrest and struggle went down on asphalt adjacent to a raised concrete curb and abrasive bushes.

I did conduct a canvas of the area looking for potential witnesses to the arrest. I contacted the business at the southwest corner of Mayfair and Rowan (46 E Rowan). The person I contacted inside didn't see the arrest.

At 1510 hours Radio alerted me to a related call-16-94647. The complainant Tammy Joslyn was calling in to report she worked at 46 E Rowan. She saw the arrest, but was away at lunch when I stopped by.

Tammy Joslyn interview: I did telephone Joslyn from my office. She said she saw the suspect walking fast NB on Mayfair. He was saying something like-'l didn't do anything wrong'. The officer was asking him to stop, but he didn't comply. The suspect was yelling and screaming and 'going off'. She saw the suspect try to take off running, but the officer caught him and took him down. She saw an older man stop to help the officer. She described the suspect as, "completely uncooperative" and saw nothing inappropriate on the part of the officer. She said her coworker Shaun Stanley also saw the incident.

Shaun Stanley Interview: I spoke with Shaun Stanley on the phone. She told me she was walking out of her workplace when she saw the officer following the suspect, with about a 15-20 foot gap. The "kid" took off when he reached Rowan. The officer told him many times to stop. She said the suspect wasn't cooperative at all and she had no concerns with the officer's behavior.

Daniel Burland (suspect) interview: At jail I contacted the suspect Daniel Burland. He had an abrasion on the right front of his forehead and another abrasion alongside his right jawline. He said he had a small cut on the inside of mouth on the right side. Burland said the officer dropped a knee on the back of his head and punched him in the mouth. I was using my department issued body camera for this interview. I tried to question Burland more in depth about his level of cooperation, but he was evasive when I tried to pin him down to an answer or would just refuse to talk. Burland didn't claim any other injuries than those listed above.

I tried to clean up Burland's abrasions with a wet paper towel in hopes of obtaining an accurate view of the injury, without the dried up blood around the abrasion. Burland refused to cooperate with me cleaning his injuries. The jail staff advised me they were having an emergency on one of their floors. The jail nurse who might be able to clean the abrasions and provide a better look was unavailable.
