On 05-14-16, at about 0338 hours, Ofc. Brooks, Ofc. Spolski and I were dispatched to Gardner/Ash on a report of a person with a knife. The complainant, Ken Willoughby, called 911 and told the operator that there was a male standing in the roadway, waving a knife around. Willoughby said the male with the knife was an African American, 20-30 years old, 5-10 to 5-11, and thin. Willoughby said the male was wearing a white shirt and white pants.

Upon arrival, I briefly spoke with James Creighton, who was sitting on the porch of 1713 W. Gardner. Creighton pointed to across the street, 1712 1/2 W. Gardner and said the male with the knife was at that location.

I directed my attention to the apartment complex on the north side of Gardner. A female who lived next door to 1712 1/2 looked out her door. I asked the female to step outside. The female said she was just letting her dog out and went back inside her apartment. Then, a male matching the description given by Willoughby exited 1712 1/2 W. Gardner. The male was very animated and could not stand still. I asked the male how he was doing. The male, whom was later identified as #14 more, said he knew my mom, my dad, my grandmother and my kids. #14 put his hands on his hips and began to pace back and forth on the porch. #14 told Ofc. Spolski and I not to approach him. #14 pointed to the building east of our location and said it was occupied by the FBI. CIA and GIA.

A second male exited 1712 1/2 W. Gardner. The male was later identified as Damon Council. Ofc. Spolski asked Council for his name. #14 said Council had 2 children inside the home. Ofc. Spolski asked Council if he would walk over to our location and talk to us. #14 told Council to go inside. #14 told Council that he (Council) was not going to take him down to our location. #14 told Council that he was smarter than that. #14 said we/police would have to shoot him first. Council told #14 that we/police did not want to shoot him. In addition, Ofc. Spolski and I both told #14 we did not want to shoot him. Council ignored #14 and walked down the stairs.

Council said **#14** responded to his house around 0235 hours. Council said **#14** took some unknown pills just prior to police arrival. Council said **#14** was high and needed to go to the hospital. Council said **#14** used meth and suffered from mental health issues. Council confirmed

his two children were inside his apartment.

While talking with Council, #14 talked non stop about topics that did not make any sense. #14 cursed at Ofc. Spolski. #14 said, "I want to die! Cause I'm going to run up on you so you can shoot me!" I told #14 not to run up on us. #14 ignored what I told him and said he wanted to die. #14 ran down the stairs and lifted his arm in the air, over his head. #14 stopped when he got about 3 to 5 feet away and said we were not going to shoot him. #14 returned to the porch.

I asked #14 if he wanted to go to the hospital. #14 said no and added that we/police were not going to take him. Ofc. Spolski asked if medics could check on his welfare and or take him to the hospital. #14 said no.

I asked Council what did ______ do with the knife. Council said ______ tossed the knife into the street. Council said he took all his knives and hid them. Council said ______ was admitted into the hospital a couple of days prior because he had tried to kill himself. I told Council that hopefully we could talk #14 into going to the hospital. I requested AMR.

Council walked back up to the porch. **#14** called Council a "Dummy". **#14** told Council that he was going to be a celebrity and that he was going to be on the news like the white people. **#14** said he wanted to get his service animal and tried to go back inside the apartment. We told **#14** to stay outside. Council stopped **#14** from going inside.

#14 said he was getting frustrated. #14 began to yell at Council. #14 said if police were not going to kill him then police were going to hear him yell. #14 said police were making him mad.
#14 yelled for Council to go back inside the apartment. #14 told "Edward" not to move. #14 said he did not care about what he was about to do.

#14 grabbed a hoe that was lying next to the porch. #14 yelled for Council to go inside the apartment. #14 walked down one stair and slammed the hoe on the ground. I removed my service weapon from my holster. I looked at Ofc. Brooks and asked him if he was less than lethal. I yelled for #14 to put the hoe down. #14 yelled at Council to go inside the house. #14 put the hoe down and quickly re-entered the apartment. I yelled at #14 not to go inside but he ignored me requests. Council followed #14 inside.

Ofc. Spolski, Ofc. Golladay, Ofc. Brooks, Ofc. Zimmerman and I entered the apartment. #14 immediately went to the kitchen and armed himself with several knives. I heard Ofc. Spolski tell Council to get away from #14. Other officers yelled at #14 to drop the knives. #14 said he wanted officers to "kill him"! Officers continued to yell at #14 to drop the knives. A taser deployment was administered and #14 was taken into custody without further incident.

#14 yelled at Council for not allowing him to die on the pills and for calling the police. #14 said all

he wanted to do was die.

I re-contacted Creighton, who said #14 was armed with a knife prior to police arrival. Creighton said #14 threw the knife into the street just prior to my arrival. Creighton said he heard the taser deployment. Creighton said police handled the situation very well. Creighton said that #14 was very fortunate that he was not killed.

On 5/14/16 at approximately 0340 hours I was working as D474. I was in the area of 2nd/Maple and heard northside was responding to a person with a weapon near Ash/Garland. Due to my close proximity, I responded to assist.

Upon my arrival I saw Officers standing on the sidewalk speaking to a male standing on the front porch to 1712 1/2 W Gardner Ave. The male was later identified as #14 #14 was shouting and making very little sense in his language. I stayed off to the side so as to not add undue stress to the situation. I was out of #14 sight for the majority of my time on scene. At one point I heard #14 make comments that he wanted Officers to kill him. #14 also charged from the porch to the fence that Officers were standing behind in an effort to provoke Officers into action.

Officers continued to try and converse with #14 however there was little to no effect. #14 was able to pick up a gardening hoe. The hoe had a metal end, wooden shaft, and was approximately 5' long. #14 swung the hoe around before dropping it and running inside of the apartment. As #14 was running inside of 1712 1/2 W Gardner Ave I heard the resident of that location, who was also standing outsie, say his children were inside. I started to run to get into the residence.

As I was running inside I heard someone shout to deploy a conducted electrical weapon (CEW). I saw Officer Spolski had deployed his firearm and unholstered my CEW. I saw #14 appear from behind a wall on the east side of the residence. This part of the residence appeared to be the kitchen. #14 had multiple knives in both hands at this point. I heard Officers give multiple commands to drop the knives however #14 refused all commands and held the knives up in a threatening manner.

#14 was going through a mental crisis. #14 had made numerous comments to Police that he wanted them to kill him. #14 had armed himself with a gardening hoe while in direct contact with Police. #14 had displayed a very erratic behavior and had fled into an apartment where there were children sleeping. #14 had not been searched and the original caller stated #14 had been armed with a knife. Once inside of the apartment #14 ran directly to the kitchen, an area that had not been secured by Officers. #14 armed himself with numerous knives and refused multiple commands to drop those knives. #14 had his back to a wall and the only direction he could go was directly at Officers. #14 had the the knives in both hands and he was holding them in front of

him. ##14 crossed his forearms in an "X" and was shouting. At this time I saw an opportunity to deploy the CEW into the torso of #14 in an effort to safely disarm him. I aimed my CEW at the upper stomach of #14 and deployed it. #14 immediately dropped all of the knives and fell to the ground.

Officers moved in and began the process of placing #14 in handcuffs. #14 received the full 5 second cycle of the CEW. The CEW was only activated once. #14 was placed into handcuffs however he continued to struggle and was unable to sit still. Medics were requested and they responded to check on #14. Fire personnel removed the CEW probes. During the struggle with #14 , the probes had come out on their own and were only in the clothing. Sgt Teigen was on scene and notified of the CEW deployment.

The probes, the wires, the empty cartridge, and CEW confetti were collected for evidence.

#14 was moved to the ambulance. While inside of the ambulance I heard #14 tell the paramedics that he had recently taken heroin and methamphetamine. #14 was taken to Sacred Heart for an involuntary hold.

I delivered the recovered evidence to property.

On 05/14/2016 I responded to the area of W Gardner Ave and N. Ash St for a person reported swinging a knife around in the middle of the roadway. When I arrived, Officers J. Arredondo and N. Spolski were already on scene talking to the male.

It appeared to me that the male was under the influence of a mind altering substance. The male, later identified as #14 was acting erratic on the steps of 1712 1/2 W Gardner. #14 friend was attempting to calm him down but was ineffective. #14 shouted something to the effect of "I'm going to make you shoot me" among other things. #14 became more agitated while being spoken to. Officers attempted to calm #14 down and to either go inside for the night or go to the hospital for an evaluation. #14 continued to yell and speak to people that were not on scene.

At one point, **14 14** and the stairs towards officers and shouted "Shoot me!" before running back up the stairs towards the residence before being stopped by his friend. **14 14 16** continued to act vulgar and out of control. **16 17 17** then grabbed a garden hoe and swung it while standing on the stairs. He then slammed the garden hoe on the ground causing fear in his friend and officers. **17 17 17** then dropped the garden hoe and ran into his residence where there were small children inside.

I along with officers ran into the residence to protect the welfare of the children who were in their rooms. #14 ran into the kitchen and grabbed several knives screaming "Shoot me!". A taser was deployed to gain compliance of #14 . I placed my handcuffs on him and he was taken into protective custody without further incident.

I was taking cover behind a vehicle while other Officer's already on scene were speaking to a agitated black male, later identified as **#14**. I kept hearing **#14** request to be killed by Officer's and state he was going to charge Officer's so they would have to kill them. Officer's Spolski and J. Arredondo spoke with **#14** for several minutes, in an attempt to calm him. See their reports for further.

While Spolski and Arredondo spoke with #14, I observed #14 pick up a large gardening Hoe approx. five feet in length and with a metal head affixed to the end of the shaft. #14 waved the Hoe in the air. While waving the Hoe another black male attempted to have #14 drop the Hoe, which #14 eventually dropped.

After dropping the Hoe #14 ran toward the front door of the residence he was standing in front of. I heard the black male which had #14 drop the Hoe yell my kids are in there.

At this time, I observed Officer Spolski, Arredondo and Golladay advance on the residence in an attempt to stop <u>#14</u>. I followed the Officer and was the fourth Officer inside the residence. I observed <u>#14</u> in the kitchen with three knives in his right hand and two knives in his left hand. I heard Ofc. Spolski and Golladay repeatedly tell <u>#14</u> to drop the knives. <u>#14</u> refused to drop the knives. <u>#14</u> was approx 10 feet away from Ofc. Spolski and Golladay. I observed Ofc. Golladay use his CEW to subdue <u>#14</u>. See Ofc. Golladay's report for further.

After the CEW struck #14, he immediately dropped the knives and fell to th ground. I moved in with Ofc. Spolski and handcuffed #14 without further incident.

Ofc. Golladay and I followed AMR to Sacred Heart and released #14 into the care of medical staff.

On 051416, I responded to the area of Ash/Gardner for a person with a weapon call. Dispatch advised that the complainant was mobile and reported that a male was standing in the road waving a knife around. Another male was sitting on the sidewalk. He described the male as BM, 20-30's, approx 5-10, thin build wearing a white shirt and pants.

Upon arrival Ofc. J. Arredondo had just arrived. He pointed at 1712.5 W. Gardner and I saw a male matching the description looking out of the window. The male, later identified as ________, came outside to the front porch.

had very erratic behavior and was speaking very quickly and about random topics. He could not standstill. He stated several times something to the effect that he was going to make us shoot him. At one point he said he was going to run up on us to make us shoot him. He ran towards me but stopped a few feet from me and walked back. He also stated he took several pills.

I did not see any weapons visible on him. His friend came outside and spoke to Ofc. J. Arredondo. His friend then attempted to try and talk #14 in to going to the hospital. #14 refused to go to the hospital and walked down the steps and in to the front yard. He reached down and picked up a garden hoe. #14 waved the hoe around and at one point lunged towards officers. His friend was able to take the Hoe away from him.

#14 then ran into the apartment and his friend was following him. I ran towards the apartment and heard the friend state, "I have kids in there." I entered the apartment and heard **14** in the kitchen. It sounded like he was searching through the silverware.

His friend was standing at the opening to the kitchen. I could not see #14 . I ordered the friend to step away and get back. He eventually complied and _____#14 ____ walked out of the back of the kitchen and in to

#14 had several kitchen knives in both of his hands.

Crimes: #14 appeared to be suicidal and homicidal. His mental state was altered, erratic and unpredictable. There were children located inside the apartment which could be seriously injured or killed by #14

Threat: #14 had stated several times he wanted police to shoot him. He stated he had taken several pills. During the earlier contact #14 had run to within a few feet of me after stating he was going to make us shoot him.

#14 had picked up a garden hoe and was swinging it around and at one point lunged towards police while holding it.

#14 friend as well as police officers were in very close proximity to #14 who had armed himself with several knives. There were children inside the apartment that were in danger of being hurt or killed should #14 get past us.

Resisting: I told **#14** several times to drop the knives but he refused. **#14** refused to cooperate with police and his friend. He was told numerous times to not enter the apartment. He refused and ran away from police and entered the apartment which had children inside.

#14 had run towards me in an attempt to get me to shoot him. He refused to drop a hoe that he picked up and was swinging around and had lunged towards police with it.

Because of the above circumstances I pointed my pistol at him and ordered him several times to drop the knives. I heard another officer advise to get a Taser out and then another officer advise he had his Taser out. I saw an officer to my left via my peripheral vision and was confident this officer had a Taser ready to deploy. After ______#14 _____ refused to drop the knives Ofc. Golladay Tased him.

After being Tased **#14** dropped the knives. There was a very narrow area so I had to pull him in to the living room where we were able to detain, handcuff (DL), him.

Medics arrived and transported him to SHER.
