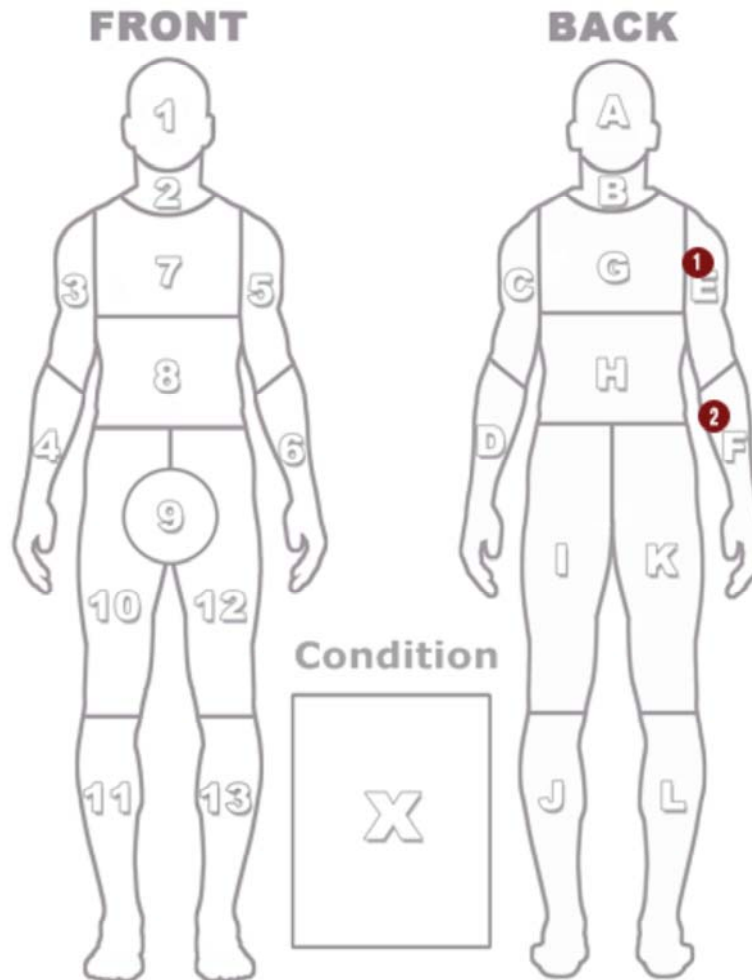

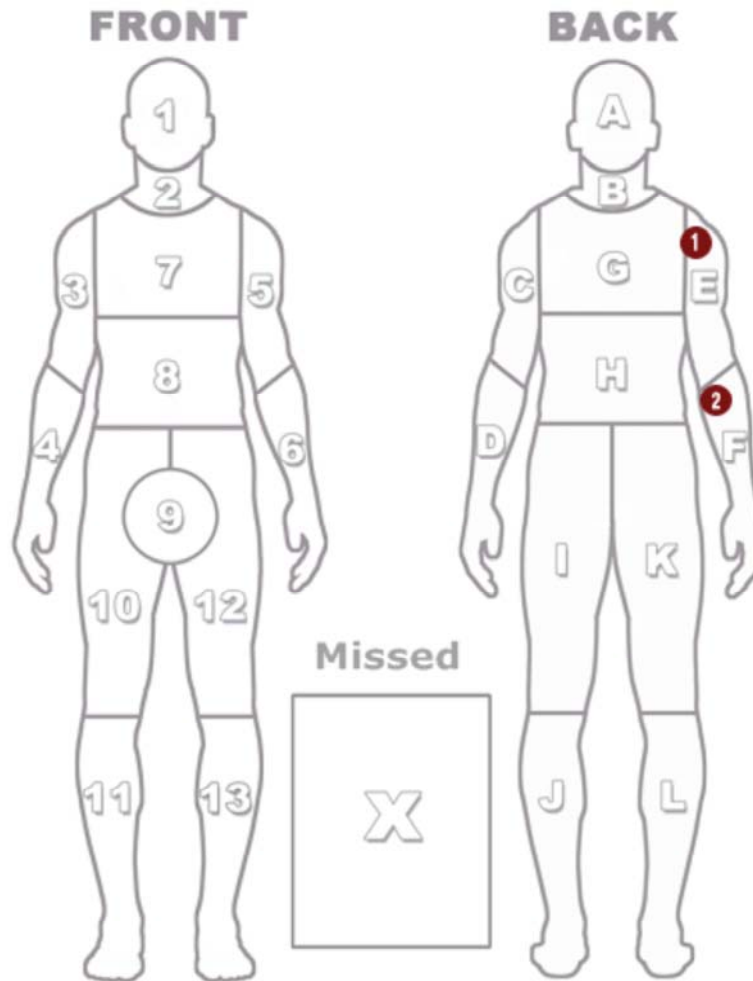

**Investigative Summary**

I was not able to respond to the scene at the time of the force application. I reviewed the officer's reports and the limited body camera. I did speak with Lt. Sprague after the incident. He told me he was standing directly behind Berrow when he applied the TASER to the suspect. The suspect was actively assaulting another male with a small metal chair. Lt. Sprague described the assault as follows:

The suspect had a small metal chair and had already struck the victim multiple times. It appeared to Lt. Sprague that the victim had his hands out in an attempt to keep the suspect out of his house.

Berrow did not have an opportunity to turn on his body camera prior to the use of force; it starts immediately after the use of force. Spolski and LeQuire both arrive after the use of force but

their video captures the interview with [REDACTED] #1a who was being assaulted by the suspect at the time of the TASER application. Based on [REDACTED] #1a statement, it is clear the suspect was assaultive in his behavior with the chair while force was delivered to the suspect.

After the force was delivered, officers recognized the signs of possible Excited Delirium and initiated the protocol. Woodgeard was transported to the hospital to be checked out by a doctor.

Based on my review of the incident, the involved citizen, Woodgeard, was assaultive in his behavior when force was used. I believe this TASER application was within department policy.

On 6/13/16 at approximately 0004 hours, I responded to [redacted] #1d Ave for report of a domestic dispute. The caller [redacted] #1a was reporting that her husband Matthew Woodgeard was trying to kill her and that he also strangled her. Just before arriving on scene, Officers that were on scene advised that there was a taser deployment and they were taking one in to custody.

Once on scene, I observed that Ofc Berrow had Matthew detained in the front yard of [redacted] #1a. I was told that [redacted] #1a was at [redacted] #1a. That is where I contacted her.

My first impression was that [redacted] #1a was hysterical and crying heavily. The pants she was wearing were soaking wet. It was initially very hard to get her statement. She said that she and Matthew were outside after having a small cookout. While outside they both shared a "bowl" of marijuana, which they do nightly. She went inside to find a sock to use as a head pad. She then saw Matthew come running into the home towards her as if he was worried. He stated, "your going to kill yourself." [redacted] #1a asked him what he was talking about. He asked her why she was in the closet and to lift her shirt. Matthew began sucking on [redacted] #1a's stomach and told her that she "would understand tomorrow." She had no idea what that meant. Matthew then went into the bathroom and began vomiting. She remembered the vomiting being very loud so she shut her children's bedroom door and went into the bathroom to help Matthew.

While in the bathroom, Matthew began rambling about religious stuff. He then grabbed her by the shoulder and slammed her into the towel rack that is above the toilet. He then put his forearm into the front of her neck and pressed hard. She said that it was hard to breath and she felt as if she was going to "blackout." While his forearm was against her neck, Matthew made unusual statements. Such as, "You have to believe" and "you have to be cleansed." He then threw [redacted] #1a into the bathtub. While in the tub, Matthew reached around [redacted] #1a's neck from behind similar to a "rear naked choke." Again Matthew made concerning comments such as, "leave my wife, you cant have her" and "believe or I'll kill you, don't make me kill you." I could see red marks on the front of [redacted] #1a's neck.

While still in the tub, Matthew turned the hot water on. [redacted] #1a said that the water burned her. She was able to tuck her chin down and roll out of the tub. She was able to put her shoulder into Matthew's neck in an attempt to fight him off. After she thought he was unconscious she grabbed her daughters from the bedroom and ran outside screaming. She knew that Matthew was still in the bathroom so she yelled for her son's to come outside. Her oldest daughter [redacted] #2d took her sister [redacted] #2d and ran to a neighbors. [redacted] #2d took her sons [redacted] #2d and [redacted] #2d across the street to [redacted] #1a at [redacted] #1d.

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While at #1a there was a knock at the door. #1a told #1a not to open it. At the door was Matthew who was pleading with #1a to let him speak to #1a. She then saw Matthew assault #1a while he was still standing in his home. #1a grabbed her sons and took off running out of the back door. There was a neighbor waiting at the fence who took the children so #1a could jump the fence. She stayed with that neighbor, #1a until I contacted her.

Cpl Hager took photographs of #1a's injuries. I also conducted a LAP in accordance with policy.

I developed Probable Cause to arrest Matthew for Assault 2nd Degree DV- Strangulation. I was also advised there was probable cause to arrest Matthew for Assault 2nd and 1st Burglary for his assault on #1a. The PC affidavit was completed by Ofc Spolski.

Matthew was transported to Holy Family by Ambulance. We were advised it was an undetermined amount of time before Matthew would be discharged. I booked Matthew into jail once he is cleared medically.

On 6/12/16, at approximately 2358 hrs. I was dispatched to a DV assault call at **#1d**. Dispatch indicated the female caller, **#1a**, was screaming that her husband was trying to kill her, and that he tried to strangle her in the bathroom. I was at E North Foothills, and Standard when I received the call. While en route, dispatch was giving further updates. The updates consisted of **#1a** still screaming that her husband was going to kill her, and concerns for her children getting out of the house safely. At one point, she was just screaming, and was no longer answering questions.

I arrived at 0001 hrs. and parked to the west of the residence, on Pittsburg St. Lt. D. Sprague arrived at the same time and we exited our patrol cars. We hurried thru the neighboring yards approaching on foot. At this time, I attempted to turn on my body camera, but later realized it did not turn on. During our approach, we could hear a female screaming to the east of us, and to the north. The screaming sounded like it was coming from behind **#1d** and possibly in the alley. Just as I heard the screaming, I saw a male wearing shorts and no shirt, run directly north from the area of the target address (**#1d**). He ran directly into the front yard across the street, which I later found to be **#1d**, and right to the front porch. At that time, I lost sight of him as a tree was in my view. At first, I thought the male with no shirt might be a neighbor, running to assist the female, and that the suspect was with the female, hence the constant screaming. We began running across the street to the north, toward the screaming, when my view became un-obstructed to the yard where I had just seen the male run to with no shirt. At about that time, I heard radio advise that the male had left the house. I also saw the male with no shirt in an altercation with someone on the front porch of **#1d**. There was a male standing closest to the open door of the residence, facing out, with his back to the

door. He was yelling at the male to get off of his property, and the male without the shirt struck the man on the porch with an object. I quickly realized the male without the shirt was likely the domestic violence suspect, who was identified as Matthew Woodgeard. Also, the male standing on the porch appeared to be the homeowner of #1d.

The two men were yelling at each other as Matthew tried to strike the other man, but I did not hear what else was said between them. There was still screaming from the female toward the back of the yard, as well as children. I began running toward the front of #1d at this point to stop the assault taking place on the front porch. I saw Matthew pick up what appeared to be a metal, folding chair, and hit the man on the porch with it. The male stood his ground as if he were afraid of Matthew gaining access to his home, and Matthew struck him again. I saw Matthew struck him at least twice with the chair, and was raising it again to strike the man with it. At this time, I was just getting thru the front gate of the yard and rapidly approaching Matthew. I yelled at him "Stop! Police! Stop!" but, he paid no attention to me. Matthew was raising the chair up over his head and about to strike the man again, and I decided to use my Taser in probe mode to stop the threat.

### CRIME/CRIMES:

Matthew was reported to have physically assaulted his wife, #1a, by strangling her. She reported that he was trying to kill her and the children in the house. I observed him strike a man with a large object, drop it, then pick up a folding, metal chair and strike the man at least two more times with the chair.

### THREAT:

Matthew was actively looking for his wife, who had managed to escape from the home after he tried to strangle her. Matthew had also just assaulted the resident of #1d, who was trying to keep Matthew out of his home. Matthew had a metal chair in his hands, over his head and was about to strike the male on the porch again.

### RESISTANCE:

As I approached, I was yelling at Matthew to stop, and I identified myself. I yelled at least twice, but Matthew completely ignored my commands as if I were not there.

I yelled "stop" one last time as I pointed and took aim with my Taser (s/n X12000MKN). I had a clear view of Matthew's back and lower extremities for large muscle groups, but just as I deployed the Taser, he turned to the right, and the top probe struck him in the upper, right arm/shoulder area, and the lower probe struck him just to the outside of his right elbow. This caused Matthew to drop the chair before he could strike the male

again, and Matthew turned toward me as he let out a yell from the Taser application. Matthew fell on the ground, right in front of the porch, but then got up to his feet. As he began getting up, I continued telling him to stay on the ground. He continued standing, disregarding my instruction. Matthew managed to get to his feet before the Taser cycle was complete, and he then charged at me. I quickly backed up and side stepped to my right, and applied the Taser a second time. During this time, I continued to tell Matthew to get on the ground. Upon the second application and stepping out of the way, Matthew fell to the grass in the front yard, face first.

Lt. Sprague quickly moved in and grabbed Matthew's right arm, gaining control over it. I then grabbed his left arm, gaining control, and we effectively placed him in handcuffs without further incident. After having Matthew under control, I removed my Taser cartridge, put my Taser away and moved Matthew into the recovery position on his side. It was after the situation had calmed down that I realized my body camera was not on, and I activated it.

Lt. Sprague and I immediately noticed that Matthew was breathing heavily, sweating profusely, and talking very fast. We immediately recognized this as a possible excited delirium situation and Lt. Sprague called for medics to respond, adding that there was a Taser application. I held Matthew in the recovery position and waited for medics. From the time I deployed the Taser, Matthew was speaking very rapidly. He was saying things such as being Jesus Christ, and that he needed to get the demons out of his wife, and various other unrealistic claims. It was obvious that Matthew was suffering from an extreme mental breakdown or a heavy use of an illegal drug, or both. Medics arrived quickly and assessed Matthew's condition. Fire personnel removed the Taser probes without issue. I then assisted medics in placing Matthew on the gurney. Matthew was then transported to Holy Family Emergency Room for treatment. Officer K. Vaughn, who was on scene for assistance, collected my Taser cartridge and wiring, and later placed it on property for me. I then followed AMR to Holy Family. I advised the doctor of what transpired, and of the Taser application. I also advised him that Matthew was under arrest and we would need to be notified prior to his release from the hospital.

On Sunday, 6-12-16 I was working uniform patrol, and heard Radio dispatch a domestic violence call at **#1d** at 2358 hours. Female complainant (**#1a** **#1b**) was screaming that her husband was trying to kill her, and had strangled her in the bathroom. Also broadcast was that there were children in the house.

I responded with other units as further information was broadcast. Much of it was that **#1a** was screaming for help, not answering questions and referring to her children. Other neighbors began calling 911 as well to add to the confusion of the call, with reports people and children running through yards, and with **#1a** now telling her children to run from their house, with lots of accompanying screaming and crying.

Another neighbor reported that a naked female was outside yelling for help with a male yelling at her, and with the children's location now unknown and other neighbors beginning to collect them. Meanwhile **#2d** was saying that her husband was going to kill her, and was hysterical.

I arrived on scene at 0001 hours, with Ofc. Berrow following behind me NB on Pittsburg to Crown. We began walking in from the west, and saw a male run across the street which we initially believed might have been a neighbor. As we neared the address we suddenly heard a loud commotion of male and female voices along with crying children coming from behind **#2d** and believed that the problem was emanating from there.

As I started through a fence to get to the alley, my attention was then drawn to the lit front porch of **#2d** where two males had begun yelling under the porch light. They began to physically push against each other, then throw punches. Ofc. Berrow and I diverted to the porch, and as we reached the front gate one of the males (subsequently identified as Matthew K. Woodgeard 8-30-83) grabbed a child sized metal-legged folding chair and began swinging it hard and repeatedly overhand at the victim with his back to the open front door. Matthew struck the victim several times with the chair, while the victim had his arms up to protect himself and apparently prevent Matthew from entering the home.

Ofc. Berrow was directly ahead of me going through the gate. I heard him yell something to the effect of "Police! Stop!" but he got no response from the actively assaulting Matthew. Ofc. Berrow

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then fired his Taser, striking Matthew with the chair in the right elbow and upper right arm. Matthew dropped the chair, then turned away from the victim and began screaming nonsensically and it appeared that he was going to advance on us. Ofc. Berrow began giving loud commands to stop resisting and get on the ground, and began initially walking toward Ofc. Berrow before turning away as if he were going to try and run away. Matthew was covered in sweat and was still rambling about government conspiracies, that he was an American citizen about to be shot, then identifying himself as "Jesus Christ incarnate" and demanding to see his wife so he could kiss her.

Matthew appeared to lose his footing and went down to the ground. I then placed my knee in the middle of his back between his shoulder blades to keep him on the ground, and was able to gain right arm control after telling him to put it behind his back. Ofc. Berrow and I then handcuffed Matthew and had him stay lying down while medics were called in for removal of the probes and a medical assessment. Other officers responding contacted #1a helped locate the four children for return to their mother, and interviewed the victim resident of #2d who Matthew had been assaulting upon my arrival.

Matthew was subsequently transported to Holy Family ER by ambulance in 4-point restraints, as his thrashing, sweating and screaming hallucinations kept him at risk for harming himself or others, or experiencing Excited Delirium. It was determined that Matthew was to be charged with 2nd Assault DV (strangulation), 2nd Assault with a weapon and 1st Burglary (both witnessed by Ofc. Berrow and myself).

## NARRATIVE

On 061216, I responded to a DV at [REDACTED] #1d. Dispatch advised that [REDACTED] #1a reported her husband, Matthew Woodgeard, was trying to kill her and strangled her in the bathroom.

While driving to the call I heard Lt. Sprague advise that Matthew had been tased and was in custody. I arrived and saw Lt. Sprague and Ofc. Berrow in the front yard of [REDACTED] #1d with Matthew on the ground in handcuffs. He was yelling and screaming and appeared to be high on something.

I contacted the home owner, [REDACTED] #1a, of [REDACTED] #1d who stated the following:

He was home in bed when he heard a knock on his front door. He saw the two neighbor kids from [REDACTED] #1d at his door naked. He let them in and then saw their mother, [REDACTED] #1a, running towards him as well naked. He let her in and she told him Matthew was trying to kill her.

He heard another knock on his front door. He opened the door and saw Matthew who hit him in his face with the palm of his hand and pushed his way in to his home crossing the threshold. Matthew told him he would kill [REDACTED] #1a.

[REDACTED] #1a slammed him on the ground outside of his door. Matthew got up, grabbed a green with silver metal frame camping chair and hit [REDACTED] #1a at least three times with the chair. [REDACTED] #1a blocked it with his left forearm. Police arrived and tased Matthew.

On 06-12-16 I responded to **#1d** for the report of a domestic dispute. The female complainant called 911 screaming that her husband as trying to kill her. 911 reported the female could be heard screaming throughout the call. Officers arrived on scene and advised they had deployed a taser.

I arrived on scene where I observed officers out with the suspect Matthew Woodgear. Woodgear was handcuffed and laying in the front yard of **#1d**. I observed taser probes in Woodgear's upper and mid arm. Despite the temperature being approximately 60 degrees and Woodgear only wearing basketball shorts he was sweating profusely. Woodgear was yelling constantly about scripture and bible references. Woodgear's speech was rapid and made little sense.

Due to Woodgear's mental and physical state AMR was called to transport Woodgear to the hospital. Medics arrived on scene and removed the taser probes. I assisted with placing Woodgear on the stretcher and securing him in restraints. Woodgear was then transported to Holy Family Hospital for treatment.

I collected the taser cartridge and taser wire and placed them in a property bag. The probes were not available because medics had placed them in their sharps container after removal. I then placed the taser cartridge on property as evidence.

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The undersigned, a law enforcement officer, competent to testify, states as follows: That he/she believes a crime was committed by the above named defendant/defendants in the City and County of Spokane, State of Washington, because:

**#1a** can testify to the following:

- On 6/12/16 close to midnight, she was home with her husband Matthew Woodgeard. They have been married for six years.
- After having a bbq, **#1a** came inside to find a sock in the closet.
- Matthew came running into the home to where she was.
- After both went into the bathroom, Matthew pushed **#1a** against a towel rack that was above the toilet. He used his forearm to press against her neck and hold her there.
- **#1a** stated she had a hard time breathing and felt as if she was going to blackout.
- She was then thrown into the bathtub and the hot water was turned on.
- Matthew stood behind her and reached round and wrapped his arm around her neck. This time it was similar to an MMA move of a "rear naked choke".
- Again it was hard for her to breath and her vision was blurry.
- Matthew was yelling, "Leave my wife's body" and "Don't make me kill you."
- After fighting free, she grabbed some of her children and ran outside. She screamed for help and ran to **#1d** which is across the street.
- Inside **#1d**, she observed Matthew at the front door and assault the neighbor, **#1a**.

- #1a ran out of the back of the house and jumped a fence after handing her kids off to neighbors.

Ofc C. LeQuire can testify to the following:

- On 6/13/16 around 0003 hours, responding to #1a for report that a female stated her husband was trying to kill her. The female was also screaming that her husband strangled her.
- Observing that Ofc Berrow had a male detained in the front yard of #1d.
- Contacting the victim, #1a at #1d and taking her statement.
- Observing red marks on the front of #1a neck.
- Observing large amount water on the floor of the bathroom and damage to the walls.
- Developing Probable Cause to arrest the defendant for Assault 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree DV.
- Completing a LAP Assessment in accordance with policy. #1a screened in.

Officer Berrow can testify to the following:

1. He was employed as a Spokane Police Officer on 6/13/16, and was working uniformed patrol at that time.
2. He responded to a domestic violence call at #1d Ave. at approximately 0001 hrs.
3. He observed the domestic violence suspect, later identified as the defendant, Matthew Woodgeard, run across the street in front of him.
4. He observed the defendant strike a male resident from #1d, with an object from the front porch.
5. He observed the defendant then pick up a metal chair and strike the male at least twice with it.
6. He entered the yard as the defendant was raising the chair over his head to strike the male again.
7. He identified himself and yelled at the defendant to stop, but the defendant paid no attention to him.
8. He deployed his Taser, striking the defendant in the arm, causing him to drop the chair.
9. The defendant fell, but got back up and charged at him (Officer Berrow), to which the Taser was activated again, and the defendant fell to the ground.
10. He then detained the defendant in handcuffs.

#1a can testify to:

- Being home at #1d asleep, hearing a knock on his front door, opening it and seeing #1a naked with her two children. She was screaming and panicking.
- He let them inside and shut his door.
- He heard another knock on his front door, opened it and saw the defendant standing outside.
- The defendant hit him with his open palm on his chin and pushed his way in to his home crossing the threshold.
- He slammed the defendant on the ground outside.
- The defendant grabbed a green with silver metal frame camping chair and hit him at least three times with it before police tased the defendant.
- He blocked the chair with his left forearm.
- He wished to press charges.

D. Sprague can testify to:

-HE ARRIVED ON SCENE, WALKED IN FROM THE WEST. HEARD SCREAMING FROM BACK YARD OF [REDACTED] #1d FROM [REDACTED] #1a & HER KIDS.

-SAW DEFENDANT AND [REDACTED] #1a AT FRONT DOOR OF [REDACTED] #1a  
-SAW A PHYSICAL STRUGGLE BETWEEN THE TWO, WITH FRONT DOOR OPEN AND PUNCHES THROWN.

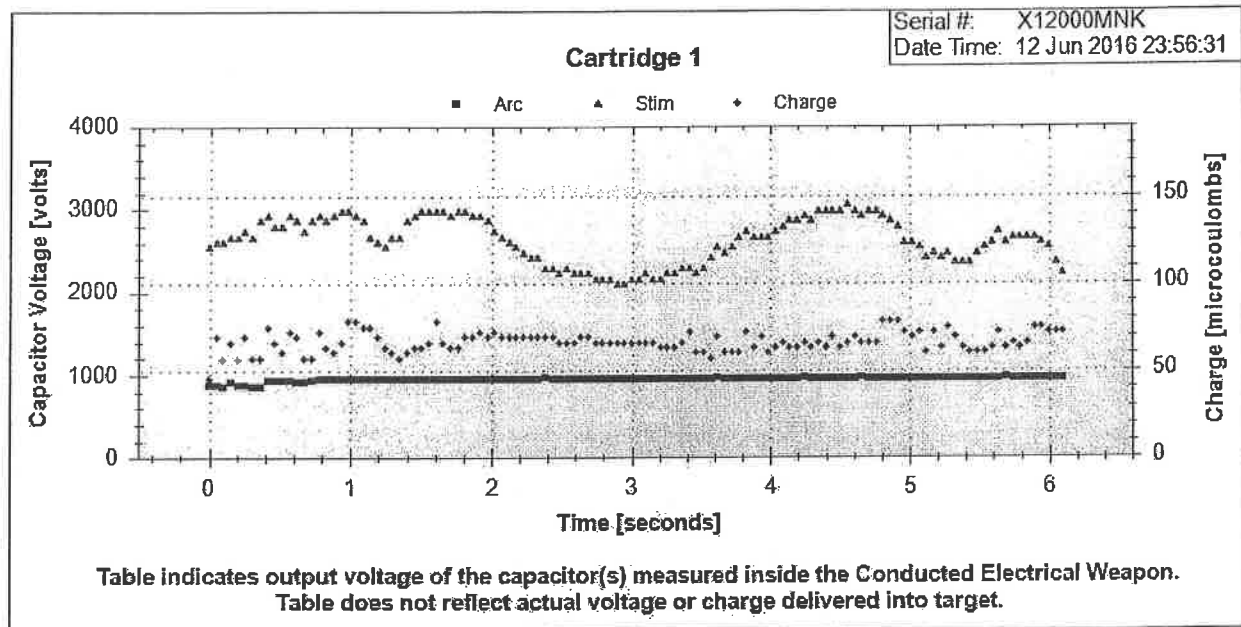
