After reading the attached documentation and debriefing Ofc. Hamilton I find that Ofc. Hamilton's deployment of K-9 "Leo" as a searching and apprehension tool was reasonable, within State and Federal Law, within Department Policy and met Department expectations.

It was within Department Policy because at the time Ofc. Hamilton deployed his K-9 he believed the suspect, Gustafson, had committed the crime of City Assault—DV (misdemeanor). Ofc. Hamilton had information that the suspect may be armed with a 3 foot machete which had not been located by other Officers that were onscene. He also believed this was the safest and most efficient way to take Gustafson into custody for Gustafson, other Officers, and himself. Gustafson was actively resisting by hiding in the house and refusing to comply with Officers commands. Because of this Ofc. Hamilton believe the use of his K-9 "Leo" appeared necessary to overcome his resistance.

The suspect was wanted on out of state felony warrants, probable cause for city assault-DV, and resisting arrest. He failed to cooperate with the police and chose to hide under a bed instead. Countless announcements were made from outside of the house. Multiple K9 announcements were made inside the house and on every change of floor. The suspect never tried to communicate or give up.

Report Narrative

On 07-11-16 at about 1902 hours, I responded to **16 to 16 to 16** to assist officers on scene at the residence reference a warrant call, where the suspect was wanted on 2 out of state felony warrants, in addition to a new charge of city assault-DV against his wife.

Jonathan D. Gustafson's wife, **Experimental Action 1**, called 911 and reported that he was at their house, was wanted, and was armed with a machete. She then left the house on foot. When officers arrived on scene, they did not get any cooperation from anyone else still inside.

I offered my assistance and then responded with K9 Leonidas (Leo). We are a WAC certified police patrol dog team and have been for over 7.5 years. We are also accredited with the Washington State Police Canine Association (WSPCA). In addition, I am a Master Trainer with the WSPCA. Leo is my second working dog in over 12 years as a handler.

I was driving my fully marked "Spokane Police K9" SUV and had parked in front of his house. I, along with all the other officers on scene, was wearing the uniform of the day. Leo was wearing a harness marked "POLICE" along both shoulders and had a Spokane Police patch affixed to the left side. We were clearly identifiable as the police.

After numerous announcements from outside the house, 3 people came out, none being the suspect. They did not cooperate with us as far as telling us where Gustafson was hiding or why he wasn't coming out.

Verbal announcements from the street, over the PA systems of a patrol SUV and then eventually the SWAT armored vehicle, had been given countless times during the whole process without any response from the suspect. Eventually a search warrant was written, even though the complainant/victim gave us verbal consent. It was signed by a judge and then we decided to execute it to search for and arrest Gustafson.

During this process, I requested the on duty SWAT officers to respond to assist us. mentioned he was most likely in the attic, which had an access that was hard to reach. We had equipment on scene ready to deal with that obstacle if needed.

There was information Gustafson was armed with a machete that was described as being about

3 feet in length. I was told he might have left it in the back yard so I requested to the officer's in the rear of the house to look for it, but it was not found so it was believed he was likely armed with it still.

After the search warrant was signed by the judge, we implemented our plan and moved up to the front door and opened it. From the front door I yelled 2 more loud K9 announcements, advising Gustafson he was under arrest, we had a signed search warrant, and the house was going to be searched with a police dog. I told him if he didn't give up and my dog found him, he would get bit. I waited after the first announcement for about 30 seconds, got no response so I yelled another into the house and waited for at least 30 seconds. However, there was still no response so I decided to release Leo to search for and locate the suspect for the following reasons:

THREAT:

Gustafson posed an immediate threat to the searching officers and the victim, who's house he was hiding in. He was believed to be armed with a 3 foot machete and had shown signs of violence based on the probable cause to arrest him for assaulting his wife. It was unknown what other weapons he possessed or had access to. This was his house as well and he knew the layout, which gave him the advantage over us. His lack of responding to our announcements also heightened the threat, so it was unknown if he was lying in wait to ambush any searching officers. His level of desperation appeared elevated based on his out of state felony warrants, which were extraditable and his lack of cooperation.

CRIME:

There was probable cause to arrest the suspect for the violent misdemeanor for a prior city assault - DV charge. There were also two out of state felony warrants for his arrest. One was for illegal possession of a controlled substance out of Arizona and the other was out of Colorado for possessing stolen property. There was also probable cause for resisting arrest for failing to give up after hours of lawful orders and advising him he was under arrest.

RESISTANCE:

The suspect was actively resisting arrest by failing to give up after countless lawful orders to do so. Instead he chose to hide inside the house and lay in wait.

After yelling two loud announcements into the house at the front door and there was no response, I released Leo to search for the suspect. After we stepped inside, we saw a replica handgun in plain sight on a table near the door. We cleared the main floor of the house and moved to the basement. I yelled another K9 announcement into the basement. I again warned him about the use of the police K9, that we had a search warrant, and that he was under arrest. There was no response so we searched and cleared the basement.

We moved to the bottom of the stairs that led to the second floor of the house. I again yelled another announcement with the same information, but yet again, there was no response from Gustafson. Leo also barked after the announcement. After waiting for nearly a minute, in hopes the suspect would give up, I released Leo and he began clearing the upper floor.

Just under a minute and a half into the search, I heard the suspect screaming from deep into the upper floor and out of sight. We moved towards the screaming and got to the bedroom the suspect had been hiding in. I was yelling for the suspect to show his hands and I saw him crawl out from under a bed that was up next to a wall. I didn't see Leo till the suspect was most of the way out. Leo followed behind the suspect as he had control of the suspect's right lower leg. I also yelled to him that he was under arrest. However, the suspect kept screaming, reached behind him towards Leo and grabbed Leo by the neck in a violent intentional manner. I yelled for the suspect to stop fighting my dog and several of us moved into the room to stop the assault on Leo. I took control of Leo as he had already let go of the suspect's leg due to assault taking place. While I pulled Leo away from the suspect, the other officers tried taking him into custody but he continued to fight and resist arrest. I yelled numerous times for him to stop

resisting, stop fighting, and that he was under arrest.

After a brief struggle, the suspect was taken into custody and handcuffed without further incident. I heard him saying he hadn't done anything wrong and was only sleeping.

Medics were on scene and they briefly looked at Gustafson's very minor injuries. I told the medics we were transporting him to Deaconess hospital prior to being booked into jail so his injuries could be tended to.

I went back inside and looked closer at where Gustafson had hidden himself. It was under a bed, which was up next to a wall. It looked like he had pulled some items up to the edge of the bed on the floor in an attempt to barricade himself under it, however Leo was still able to locate him. There was also a mirror on a handle that he might have had with him under the bed, which could have been used to watch for the police prior to the police seeing him under the bed.

Gustafson was transported to Deaconess hospital. His injuries were very minor but tended to by the medical staff. They consisted of some raking on both ankles and some rake marks on his right pectoral/armpit area. He also had a small cut on his right thumb.

Cpl. Hager took photos of Gustafson's injuries.

Sgt. Lee was on scene of the incident and was aware of the K9 contact.

I spoke with Gustafson at the hospital. He denied using any drugs or alcohol. He claimed he was sleeping under the bed and denied hearing any announcements. He did tell me he used to train Akita dogs, which showed in how he was trying to control Leo.

Gustafson was transported to the SCSO jail and released to the jail staff. He was charged for the felony crime of being a fugitive, city assault - DV, and resisting arrest.

I never did find the machete that he was apparently armed with.

While approaching the residence, two juvenile males approached the residence as well. I contacted them both, and one of them said they were 2d Jonathan's son.

^{2d} said he has not seen his dad for several days. ^{2d} told me Jonathan had been asking him to come over so they could hang out. 2d stated he last saw Jonathan this morning, and had recently received a text from him to come over.

While waiting for additional officers to arrive, I saw a male inside the residence. I could not confirm if this male was Jonathan as there was no picture of him. This male later turned out to be Billy.

I knocked on the door multiple times and there was no answer inside. Ofc. Brown-Bieber continued knocking while I contacted 1a again. 1a gave verbal consent to enter her residence, however, it was determined Jonathan had standing there.

Ofc. Howe positioned his patrol car in front of the residence and activated the red/blue lights. I used the PA system to make announcements into the residence. After approx. twenty-five minutes, of making PA announcements, Billy, 2d and the white female exited the residence.

I detained Billy and and briefly interviewed them. Billy told me Jonathan had left an hour or two before our arrival and did not know where he was at. 2d said he did not know if Jonathan was even at the residence. The female that came out was later "identified as Hannah A. Emerson, who was later arrested and booked for providing false statements. She was issued citation # 6Z0721690. See Ofc. Brown-Bieber's report for further.

Billy, and Emerson were less than cooperative with providing any information as to where Jonathan was located at inside the residence.

Based on the fact Jonathan had standing in the residence, I completed a search warrant for him. After multiple attempts to have the warrant reviewed by the on judge without success, Commissioner Anderson was contacted and responded to the scene where she reviewed my warrant and signed three copies of it.

I showed the signed warrant to those units who were stagged to enter the residence. Several more PA announcements were made for Jonathan to exit. K9 Ofc. Hamilton also made multiple announcements at 2133 hours. We entered the residence and located Jonathan hiding under a bed.

I heard several officers giving commands to "stop fighting" and to cooperate. Ofc. Hamilton later contacted me and said Jonathan had ahold of his K9 and was attempting to pull the dog off of him. There were minor injuries to Jonathan's legs. See Ofc. Hamilton's report for his K9 deployment.

Jonathan was advised he was under arrest for his warrants and Ofc. Stone read him his Miranda rights. Jonathan stated he understood his rights and told me he did not hear the multiple PA announcements or the K9 announcements made inside the residence. He kept stating he was "passed out" and sleep walks, so he did not know how he came to being under the bed.

Jonathan was transported to Deaconess where he was evaluated by a doctor before being medically released for jail. Jonathan was booked into jail for his two outstanding warrants, one count of resisting arrest, and booked for city assault DV as there was probable cause for his arrest from 16-243701. (See Ofc. Brown-Bieber's additional report for the DV).

I completed a PC affidavit for Jonathan for the fugitive charges and have turned in copies of the warrant and signed return into Records, and placed one in the Superior Court box. He was given a copy of the warrant and receipt.

On 07-11-16 at about 1902 hours, I responded to **10 to assist officers** on scene at the residence reference a warrant call, where the suspect was wanted on 2 out of state felony warrants, in addition to a new charge of city assault-DV against his wife.

I offered my assistance and then responded with K9 Leonidas (Leo). We are a WAC certified police patrol dog team and have been for over 7.5 years. We are also accredited with the Washington State Police Canine Association (WSPCA). In addition, I am a Master Trainer with the WSPCA. Leo is my second working dog in over 12 years as a handler.

I was driving my fully marked "Spokane Police K9" SUV and had parked in front of his house. I, along with all the other officers on scene, was wearing the uniform of the day. Leo was wearing a harness marked "POLICE" along both shoulders and had a Spokane Police patch affixed to the left side. We were clearly identifiable as the police.

After numerous announcements from outside the house, 3 people came out, none being the suspect. They did not cooperate with us as far as telling us where Gustafson was hiding or why he wasn't coming out.

Verbal announcements from the street, over the PA systems of a patrol SUV and then eventually the SWAT armored vehicle, had been given countless times during the whole process without any response from the suspect. Eventually a search warrant was written, even though the complainant/victim gave us verbal consent. It was signed by a judge and then we decided to execute it to search for and arrest Gustafson.

During this process, I requested the on duty SWAT officers to respond to assist us. mentioned he was most likely in the attic, which had an access that was hard to reach. We had equipment on scene ready to deal with that obstacle if needed.

There was information Gustafson was armed with a machete that was described as being about 3

feet in length. I was told he might have left it in the back yard so I requested to the officer's in the rear of the house to look for it, but it was not found so it was believed he was likely armed with it still.

After the search warrant was signed by the judge, we implemented our plan and moved up to the front door and opened it. From the front door I yelled 2 more loud K9 announcements, advising Gustafson he was under arrest, we had a signed search warrant, and the house was going to be searched with a police dog. I told him if he didn't give up and my dog found him, he would get bit. I waited after the first announcement for about 30 seconds, got no response so I yelled another into the house and waited for at least 30 seconds. However, there was still no response so I decided to release Leo to search for and locate the suspect for the following reasons:

THREAT:

Gustafson posed an immediate threat to the searching officers and the victim, who's house he was hiding in. He was believed to be armed with a 3 foot machete and had shown signs of violence based on the probable cause to arrest him for assaulting his wife. It was unknown what other weapons he possessed or had access to. This was his house as well and he knew the layout, which gave him the advantage over us. His lack of responding to our announcements also heightened the threat, so it was unknown if he was lying in wait to ambush any searching officers. His level of desperation appeared elevated based on his out of state felony warrants, which were extraditable and his lack of cooperation.

CRIME:

There was probable cause to arrest the suspect for the violent misdemeanor for a prior city assault -DV charge. There were also two out of state felony warrants for his arrest. One was for illegal possession of a controlled substance out of Arizona and the other was out of Colorado for possessing stolen property. There was also probable cause for resisting arrest for failing to give up after hours of lawful orders and advising him he was under arrest.

RESISTANCE:

The suspect was actively resisting arrest by failing to give up after countless lawful orders to do so. Instead he chose to hide inside the house and lay in wait.

After yelling two loud announcements into the house at the front door and there was no response, I released Leo to search for the suspect. After we stepped inside, we saw a replica handgun in plain sight on a table near the door. We cleared the main floor of the house and moved to the basement. I yelled another K9 announcement into the basement. I again warned him about the use of the police K9, that we had a search warrant, and that he was under arrest. There was no response so we searched and cleared the basement.

We moved to the bottom of the stairs that led to the second floor of the house. I again yelled another announcement with the same information, but yet again, there was no response from Gustafson.

Leo also barked after the announcement. After waiting for nearly a minute, in hopes the suspect would give up, I released Leo and he began clearing the upper floor.

Just under a minute and a half into the search, I heard the suspect screaming from deep into the upper floor and out of sight. We moved towards the screaming and got to the bedroom the suspect had been hiding in. I was yelling for the suspect to show his hands and I saw him crawl out from under a bed that was up next to a wall. I didn't see Leo till the suspect was most of the way out. Leo followed behind the suspect as he had control of the suspect's right lower leg. I also yelled to him that he was under arrest. However, the suspect kept screaming, reached behind him towards Leo and grabbed Leo by the neck in a violent intentional manner. I yelled for the suspect to stop fighting my dog and several of us moved into the room to stop the assault on Leo. I took control of Leo as he had already let go of the suspect's leg due to assault taking place. While I pulled Leo away from the suspect, the other officers tried taking him into custody but he continued to fight and resist arrest. I yelled numerous times for him to stop resisting, stop fighting, and that he was under arrest.

After a brief struggle, the suspect was taken into custody and handcuffed without further incident. I heard him saying he hadn't done anything wrong and was only sleeping.

Medics were on scene and they briefly looked at Gustafson's very minor injuries. I told the medics we were transporting him to Deaconess hospital prior to being booked into jail so his injuries could be tended to.

I went back inside and looked closer at where Gustafson had hidden himself. It was under a bed, which was up next to a wall. It looked like he had pulled some items up to the edge of the bed on the floor in an attempt to barricade himself under it, however Leo was still able to locate him. There was also a mirror on a handle that he might have had with him under the bed, which could have been used to watch for the police prior to the police seeing him under the bed.

Gustafson was transported to Deaconess hospital. His injuries were very minor but tended to by the medical staff. They consisted of some raking on both ankles and some rake marks on his right pectoral/armpit area. He also had a small cut on his right thumb.

Cpl. Hager took photos of Gustafson's injuries.

Sgt. Lee was on scene of the incident and was aware of the K9 contact.

I spoke with Gustafson at the hospital. He denied using any drugs or alcohol. He claimed he was sleeping under the bed and denied hearing any announcements. He did tell me he used to train Akita dogs, which showed in how he was trying to control Leo.

Gustafson was transported to the SCSO jail and released to the jail staff. He was charged for the

On 7/11/2016 at approximately 2113 hrs, I received a phone call from Sgt. Lee requesting assistance with serving a search warrant at **10** assistance with serving a search warrant at **10** are to arrest wanted suspect, Jonathan Gustafson. I was at Swat medic training at this time with OFC Kernkamp and McVay. We were wearing our black Swat uniforms with plate carriers complete with Police markings.

We arrived on scene at approximately 2117 hrs. I was advised of the following information:

Units first arrived on scene at approximately 1858 hrs. They had contacted several people from inside the residence who came outside. There was good information that Gustafson was inside the residence. **1**a (suspect's wife) had called 911 and stated that Gustafson was inside the residence armed with a machete and that he was possibly high/intoxicated.

Police had made several announcements with no cooperation from Gustafson. These announcements occurred at approximately 1936, 1958, 2042, and 2129 hrs. Gustafson never made it known that he was inside and nor did he try to give up peacefully and contact LE via phone or exiting the residence. The residence was surrounded and the announcements were loud enough to be heard on the back side of the residence. There was a large crowd of people gathering because they could hear the announcements and came outside to see what was going on.

At approximately 2117 hrs, the search warrant for an and to arrest Gustafson was signed.

At approximately 2133 hrs, LE began to move up to the front door. I was point with a ballistic shield with police markings on it. I kicked the door (not hard, but to knock on it since my hands were full with equipment) several times and then opened the unlocked front door. K-9 OFC Hamilton made several K-9 announcements from the front door prior to releasing his K-9 inside the house to search for the suspect. Gustafson failed to comply and refused to give up prior to releasing the K-9. The K-9 announcements could be heard from LE in the back alley outside.

I entered the residence and as soon as I came inside I saw a black realistic looking BB gun on the

table near the door. I first thought it was real, but after looking at it for a few seconds, I saw that it was not only because the bottom was broken and I saw the battery wires sticking out.

I continued to clear towards the kitchen on the main floor. An Officer held on the stairway upstairs. Another K-9 announcement was made towards the downstairs. There was no response. I went downstairs and cleared the downstairs area. So far the main floor and basement were clear - no suspect- Gustafson.

Prior to going up the stairs, another set of K-9 announcements were made. There was no response. The K-9 was released and went upstairs. I could hear the K-9 walking around upstairs checking areas. I heard a distinct ping multiple times and it sounded like the K-9 was very interested in something metal. A several seconds of hearing that, I heard a male voice (Gustafson start yelling and screaming). I was point and began up the stairs. There were still several rooms upstairs that we had not cleared, but I moved towards the sound of yelling. I turned to the south at the top of the stairs and looked into the middle room. I saw the metal bed bouncing around. I knew that the K-9 and male voice I heard were underneath the bed. I began to tell the suspect to come out with his hands up. Gustafson was not cooperating very well and was fighting and punching at the K9 as he crawled out.

At this point, I applied a neck restraint (level 1 - little to no pressure) for the following reasons:

Crime: Gustafson was wanted for two extraditable felony warrants (Possession of stolen property probation violation - Prescott, AZ; Felony FTA drugs- possession of controlled substance, Ft. Collins, CO). There was also probable cause to arrest Gustafson for City Assault DV.

Threat: Gustafson was a large male at approximately 6'2" weighing about 190 lbs with an athletic build. He was supposedly armed with a machete per his wife and he had not been searched at all - so he could have armed himself with other weapons. I had already seen a realistic looking handgun in the residence.

Gustafson knew the layout of the residence and had several hours to fortify his position prior to LE making entry. The house was cluttered with furniture and other broken items making a close guarter apprehension very difficult and dangerous to Officers.

Gustafson was punching at the K-9 and flailing his arms and legs all over instead of listening to commands.

Resistance: Gustafson was actively resisting by punching at the K-9 and kicking his legs towards the K-9. Gustafson was told get on the ground, which he refused to do. He was given several hours to comply and give up peacefully which he refused to do. He had crawled underneath the bed to hide which showed his intent to not give up and refuse to cooperate.

Gustafson was facing away from me sitting up punching and kicking at the K-9. I put the shield down in front of me and reached over it to try and control Gustafson's upper body since he was not cooperating and still resisting. I put my right arm around his neck in the Neck restraint technique. I could not get to his arms to control them so this was the safest and fastest way to gain control of his upper body. I applied very little pressure (level 1) just to gain control and compliance from him. Gustafson stopped punching at the K-9 and began to grab for my arm. I was telling him to stop resisting, which he did not. His legs were still kicking.

OFC Hamilton removed the K-9 and Gustafson was told again to get on his stomach. I released my neck restraint (which Gustafson never loss consciousness) and used my shield to pin Gustafson on the ground and control his entire body. I could feel Gustafson's legs kicking back on my shield. Other Officers were able to move in and control his arms. As soon as they had his arms I moved off of his back area with my shield and they placed him in handcuffs at approximately 2151 hrs.

Gustafson mentioned several times that he was sleeping. I found that statement very interesting since most people do not sleep on the floor underneath a bed. This bed was approximately 1 foot off the ground, so Gustafson had to work very hard to crawl underneath it to supposedly fall asleep. It appeared to me that Gustafson was trying to hide from LE.

I stepped back and they rolled Gustafson to his side. Gustafson was told multiple times that he was under arrest during the altercation. I advised him once again that he was under arrest and read him his Miranda rights, which he verbally stated that he understood. Medics were on scene and checked out Gustafson. OFC Toal took custody of Gustafson.

Gustafson had approximately 2 hours and 50 minutes to give up prior to being taken into custody. He had approximately 18 minutes to give up peacefully once we entered the residence. Once we entered the residence, there was a lot of noise. Numerous police K-9 announcements (made on the main, basement, and upstairs area) and a lot of noise from the dog searching the residence. Gustafson was given plenty of opportunities to surrender peacefully prior to force having to be used.

On 07/11/2016 at approximately 2015 hours I self dispatched to assist officers with a barricaded wanted subject at 10 The wanted subject was identified as Jonathan Gustafson.

I drove the Spokane PD armored "Bearcat" to the scene along with fellow SWAT Officer M. Russo and parked directly in front of the residence facing north. I then confirmed that a immediate reaction team was in place and that it included less lethal options. I spoke with K-9 Officer C. Hamilton who informed me Jonathan was the only subject remaining inside **1**^d and he was wanted for extraditable felony warrants out of both Colorado and Arizona. Probable cause also exists for city assault DV for Jonathan from July 4th. I was also informed that Jonathan frequently carries a machete style knife and was seen with it today. A search warrant for **1**^d was completed by Officer A. Toal and was signed by a judge then reviewed by Sgt. T. Lee.

At approximately 2133 hours after several rounds of announcements, including K-9 warning announcements, entry was made at the front door, which was unlocked. A slow, methodical search was conducted with Officer C. Hamilton's Police Service Dog (PSD). The entry level and basement were cleared with no subjects located. Another set of K-9 warning announcements were made from the base of the stairs up to the second level with no response. Again the PSD was deployed upstairs to search for Jonathan.

On 07/11/16 at 1845hrs, I was sent to **1**d and **1**d on a Warrant call. Dispatch advised **1**a was calling to report her husband was at the location and that she believes he has warrants. She identified her husband as Jonathan Gustafson. **1**a said Jonathan arrived with an 18 y/o female with red hair named Hannah.

Dispatch found Jonathan was wanted on felony warrants out of Arizona and Colorado. Both warrants showed nationwide extradition. Dispatch further advised Jonathan was a suspect in a call of Domestic Violence at this address on 07/04/16. There was probable cause of DV assault from that incident in which he was not located.

While enroute to the Gardner address I contacted 1a by phone. She provided the following information: She had been living at the Gardner address with Jonathan. After the incident on 07/04/16 Jonathan had left the house. Officers knocked on the front door of the house but received no answer. Once Ofc. Hamilton arrived he took my position at the rear of the house and I went to the front of the house. I knocked loudly on the front door and announced myself as the police several times. A short time later the front door opened, a male came out, and the male immediately shut the door behind him. I detained that male in handcuffs and he identified himself as Billy Gustafson. Dispatch checked Billy for warrants but was unable to locate any active warrants for Billy. from the loudspeaker of a police car asking the occupants of **Particular** Ave. to step out. A few minutes later the back door opened and a red-haired white female who appeared about 18 years old stepped out. I directed her to come out of the back yard and she did so.

As the female approached me, Ofc. Erdman asked if she was Hanna. The woman said she was Stacy. I asked her to step behind the garage of the house to speak with me. At that point I suspected the female was Hanna and was lying about her name. I asked who else was in the house and she said she had been sleeping in the living room, had woken for an unknown reason, and had decided to leave the house. She denied knowing anything about anyone else in the house. The female began walking off eastbound towards the alley and I told her to stop, since I suspected she was lying about her name and about who was inside the house.

The female ignored me and continued to walk away. I then took hold of her right upper arm and escorted her back to the garage. She immediately began to yell that I was hurting her arm and continued to pull away from me, even though I was using no pain compliance holds and was merely holding her upper arm with one hand. Ofc. Erdman and I were able to secure the female in handcuffs. I again asked her her name and this time she identified herself as Hanna Emerson. She adamantly denied having ever identified herself as Stacy. Dispatch was unable to find any local record of Hanna.

Hanna stated she had previously had identification in Idaho. Dispatch checked her record in Idaho and discovered a listing for a suspended driver's license under the name Hanna Emerson in Idaho. Based on the fact that Hanna had provided me with a fake name initially in a matter that would require a report, I placed her under arrest for making false statements to police. I secured her in Ofc. Stadelman's patrol car while officers continued to work on locating Jonathan in the house.

On 07-11-2016 at approx. 2115 hours I was called to **10** in reference to a warrant. Patrol was on scene at the above location. Gustafson was inside and refusing to come out. He had several felony warrants out of Arizona in addition they had PC for city assault DV. Sgt. Lee called me to the scene as a member of the SWAT team to assist in serving a search warrant on the location to take Gustafson in custody.

Upon arrival I was advised there was a valid/signed search warrant for the above location. At this time myself and a small entry team entered the residence to search for Gustafson. Officer Hamilton and his K-9 also assisted with the search.

Officer Hamilton made numerous K-9 announcements during the search. Upon searching the upstairs with his K-9 we could hear him making contact with Gustafson in the upstairs of the location. Upon getting to Gustafson he was struggling with the dog and attempting to push him off. Several commands were given to Gustafson at this time that he was under arrest and to quit fighting with the dog. Gustafson would not stop struggling with the dog and continued to resisting by kicking his legs and refusing our verbal commands.

We were able to pin Gustafson to the floor using a ballistic shield at this time he continued to tense up his arms, kick his feet, and refused to get on his stomach. During this time I pinned his right leg to the ground using my knee and body weight. This was necessary because prior to me getting control of his leg he was kicking it around and I felt myself or one of my partners may be struck if I was unable to gain control of the leg. Eventually we were able to get Gustafson in handcuffs and take him into custody.

Standard Condition No. 12: I will not possess or use illegal drugs or controlled substances and will submit to drug and alcohol testing as directed by the APD.

On December 9, 2013, the defendant admitted in writing to using methamphetamines and marijuana on December 7, 2013. A urinalysis test conducted at the probation office confirmed the presence of amphetamines, methamphetamines, and marijuana in the defendant's system.

On December 9, 2013, the defendant was directed in writing to participate in random urinalysis at TASC. The defendant failed to supply a testable sample on December 9, 2013 December 24, 2013, and January 7, 2014 and January 15, 2014.

Standard Condition No. 15: I will be financially responsible by paying all restitution, fines, and fees in my case as imposed by the Court. I understand, if I do not pay restitution in full, the Court may extend my probation.

The defendant has failed to make any Court-ordered payments toward fines and fees, including Probation Service Fees. He is currently \$450.00 arrears toward Probation Service Fees and \$120.00 arrears toward other Court-ordered fines and fees.

It is respectfully requested that the Court revoke the probation of the defendant and sentence him in accordance with the law. To secure the defendant's presence, it is requested that a warrant be issued pursuant to Rule 27.6 (b) of the Rules of Criminal Procedure. Whereabouts are unknown and last contact was on December 11, 2013.
