



Officer statements were consistent with the incident report and BWC (Incident Report 16-263144). Nothing further to add.

Subject Interview Summary:

Subject was irrational and uncooperative. He refused medical treatment due to his belligerence. What comments he made were also consistent with the incident report and BWC (Incident Report 16-263144).

Witness Interview Summary:

The apparent DV victim, that may have witnessed the use of force, fled from the scene and was not identified. Neighbor statements were consistent with incident report and BWC (Incident Report 16-263144).

Witness Officer Interview Summary BWC Y/N:

No officers witnessed the use of force. Information is consistent with the incident report and BWC (Incident Report 16-263144).

Sergeant Findings:

The pointing of firearm was justified with knowledge that the suspect was reported to have a gun, and the suspect was seen drawing from a holster and attempting to hide an apparently real firearm when contacted. The pointing was temporary and only during the duration of the threat. Application of OC justified given the proximity of the apparent firearm and for active non-compliance and confrontation requiring a sensory disruption which allowed the officers to take physical control without injury to the suspect. Medical treatment was provided for alleviation of the pepper spray by medical personnel but the suspect was uncooperative. The force used was within policy.

On 7-18-16, at approx 0119 hrs, I was dispatched to Napa/Wabash for a report of a DV. The complainant, **1**/2 (**1**/2) called police to report that a female was arguing with her exboyfriend. The caller claimed it sounded as though it had been physical and the male sounded as though he was intoxicated. The caller advised 911 that the male's name was "Todd", that he arrived on foot and it sounded as though he was "slamming her against the door." As officers were responding **1**/2 stated that it appeared that the male had the female by the hair and possibly was trying to "choke" her.

At approx 0121 hrs, while officers were still enroute a female caller, later identified as 12 14 (16)) called 911 to report the same incident. She further advised that the male was trying to get into the residence " a brick duplex" and the female would not let him in. She then reported that the male had a gun and that the male was "wrestling with the female."

At approx that time Ofc Kirby was onscene.

As I arrived onscene from the north I turned W/B on Wabash directly in front of the location. I illuminated the suspect Todd E Miller (09-28-72) with the spotlight in my car. Ofc Kirby was cleary issuing verbal commands for the suspect to get to the ground, but he was refusing and was trying to walk away. The suspect turned enough that I could see on his right hip was a Serpa Style Tactical holster, but it appeared empty at that time. Ofc Kirby was issuing clear and concise commands to Miller who was refusing to obey while arguing. There was a female in a dark shirt and what appeared to be jeans huddled up on the front porch of the home. It was clear that Miller was intent of hindering and delaying this investigation. Miller was belligerent and his shirt was open and appeared torn. He was clearly being aggressive and the situation was unpredictable. I had information about a gun and had no idea where it was located. It should be noted that where Miller discarded the gun was in the direction he was trying to walk away to while refusing to obey commands.

Miller was on his knees after an application of OC. He was near the front steps and facing away from me. I used both hands to push Miller into a prone handcuffing position where he was handcuffed (dl). He was yelling at the female something similar to "<u>1a</u> tell them I didn't do anything." The female began to walk W/B on the sidewalk while we were detaining Miller. I asked her to stop where she was which she did, but when I turned my full attention back to Miller she slipped down the sidewalk. Another officer arrived shortly after and was told to locate the female but she was gone.

Miller was identified when he was searched incident to arrest and I immediately summoned medics to decontaminate Miller from the OC application. He continued arguing the It should be noted that during the decontamination process he refused to let medics finish and tried to spit at them.

I contacted 1a who made herself available. She stated that she initially heard the arguing from Miller near a vehicle parked on Napa that left. Then another vehicle was there which also left. She claimed she believed that Miller forced his way into the duplex and she heard the female yelling "get off me" and "you're hurting me". She began to walk to where she could see the male and heard him yelling "You're coming with me". 1a made verbal contact with the male who told 1a to leave. He then turned toward her and pulled his shirt to the side revealing what appeared to be a firearm in a holster. He tapped the holster and again told 1a to "get outta here". 1a stated that she did not know if he would use the gun and that it was enough to "make her shake" she yelled at her husband to call the police back about the male having a gun. Due to the circumstance at that time and place 1a believed the firearm to be real and Miller had intentionally showed it to her and

implied it was real.

Ofc Kirby had seen the male discard the gun and it was photographed in the flower bed. While waiting for a Cpl I looked at the gun before handling it. It appeared to be a two tone (black/silver) 1911 variant pistol. It had realistic markings, such as a serial number (#51113106) that was in white lettering. The gun had a grip (beavertail) safety and exposed hammer, which was cocked to the rear. Miller who was still in a prone position while waiting for medics was screaming at us "what weapon" and then claimed it was an airsoft. The gun appeared so realistic it was still photographed and only upon holding it could you tell it was an airsoft gun. It was of even a realistic weight as a real handgun.

Other officers could not located the female and the initial complainant (1a) could not be located or contacted.

Ofc Kirby advised he witnessed him assault the female and had PC for Obstructing on Miller. I believed that PC existed for Intimidation with a Weapon for Millers actions toward

He had been advised of the charges, which he continued to argue with officers and demand to be released. We could not determine if a DV relationship existed between Miller. Miller was arguing about the charges and wanted to tell me that there was no witnesses and we contacted no one. I told him there was actually more than one complainant and he made the statement that there was only the female (12) that he told to leave the yard.

He was booked into jail for the aforementioned charges. The replica firearm was placed onto police property as evidence and fingerprints were requested. His holster was taken as and placed onto property.

On 07-18-16 at about 0119 hours, Officers J Anderson and J Arrendondo were dispatched to a possible DV at the intersection of Napa and Wabash. The caller stated that an adult male and female were arguing outside and it sounded like a physical fight. The caller also stated that it looked like the male was pulling the female by the hair and possibly choking her.

I was near the area and responded to assist as it sounded like a physical fight in progress.

I was 1st on scene and parked off 1 block to the east. I could hear a male yelling to the west. He was a block away and I could hear his voice. He was begging for someone to come with him. I could hear a female crying continuously. I slowly approached the scene and the male continued to yell at the female. He was telling her, "Come with me" "The neighbor called the cops" "If I stay here I'm going to jail." I had snuck up to about 30 yards away from the 2 at that time. I was in the street behind a vehicle. I could see the male and female but my body camera was pointing at the vehicle I was behind.

At that time, radio advised the male had a gun. That information came from a 911 caller. I could see that the male had a cell phone in 1 hand and was pulling at the female trying to get her to come with him. She was pulling back away from him. I could hear her scream between cries. The male did not appear to have a weapon. It seemed that based on the heated argument and violence that I was witnessing, the caller was trying to get police to the location quickly.

The male then started to walk away to the east going away from me. At that time I broke cover to give chase. The male turned and walked back towards the female. He was completely unaware I was in the area. I did not expect him to turn and come back because it appeared he was leaving. I

was about 20 feet away at that time and had given up my position of cover and concealment. I was concerned that the male would continue his assault on the female. I yelled, "Police" to identify myself and shined my flashlight at the male. He turned back to the east and quickly went to the S/E corner of the residence. I told him to stop but he continued to the corner and drew a pistol off his right hip and quickly dropped the weapon in the bushes.

At that time, I was investigating and had witnessed an assault, probably DV related. There was information provided by radio that the suspect may be armed. I had witnessed the male draw a pistol from his right waistband area. I had drawn my pistol and had it pointed at the male as a reaction to him pulling a pistol. Although he had quickly discarded the pistol, there was still a threat as he was within 6 feet of where the gun was dropped. I was pointed in with my pistol at center mass. I directed him to lay down on the ground. He was compliant at first and went down to his knees then to his stomach. It took approximately 5 to 10 seconds for him to comply. I then switched to the low ready at that time and continued to give verbal commands.

I was still the only officer on scene. It was my fear that the male would make a move to try and recover the weapon before he was detained in handcuffs. At that time, the male told the female, "Don't tell them nothing happened." He continued to tell the female not to say anything and call her a bitch. The female was cowering down on the porch up against the door. The male then stood up to his feet and verbally began challenging me to shoot him. He told me that he did not have to listen to me. He also told me that he was going to walk away. He made it clear that he was not going to cooperate. The male was pacing around and still had the opportunity to lunge for the pistol. I heard another officer arrive on scene at that time.

Due to the fact I had witnessed an assault, the male was not compliant and following commands, verbally hostile, and still within about 6 feet of the gun he dropped I determined there was a need to use force to gain compliance. It was now safe to go hands on as another officer was on scene. I holstered my pistol, closed distance to about 6-8 feet deployed OC spray to his face. He was sprayed in the face and eyes with a 1 second burst of OC. I chose OC as it would cause vision difficulties should he try and locate the weapon he dropped or attempt to use it. The male then dropped to his knees after being sprayed and Officer Anderson pushed him down to the prone cuffing position. We then cuffed the male in the prone cuffing position. He was not completely compliant to being handcuffed and it took several seconds to get the handcuffs on.

In the time that it took us to detain the male, the female walked off. Officers responding to the area were not able to locate her.

I identified the male as Todd Miller by his WA ID. Medics responded to the location and treated him for the OC application.

The handgun he had discarded was photographed and collected as evidence. At that time, I

discovered it was a realistic looking replica of a Colt 1911 .45. The gun fired 6mm airsoft pellets from a CO2 cartridge.

Officer Anderson arrested Miller for assault, obstructing, and having a weapon capable of producing bodily harm.
